- **Pete Golding** begins his first full season at Ole Miss as a head coach ... Golding is 2-1 as a head coach and helped lead Ole Miss to the CFP semifinals last season.
- As a coach, Golding has been on the sidelines for eight consecutive 10-win seasons, with his teams combining for a 96-14 (.873) record.
- Ole Miss is coming off the program's first-ever 13-win season and appearance in the College Football Playoff.
- This marks the second meeting between Ole Miss and Louisville, with the other also being a season-opening, neutral-site game ... The Rebels defeated Louisville 43-24 in the 2021 Chick-fil-A Kickoff game in Atlanta.
- The Rebels have taken the field at Nissan Stadium three times before ... Ole Miss knocked off Georgia Tech, 25-17, in the 2013 Music City Bowl ... The Rebels toppled Vanderbilt 41-3 in their SEC opener on Sept. 6, 2014 ... Ole Miss lost the 2000 Music City Bowl to West Virginia, 49-38.
- The Rebels begin the season No. 9 in the AP poll and No. 10 in the Coaches poll ... It's the second time in the last three years that Ole Miss has debuted top-10 in the preseason.
- Ole Miss has now cracked the national top-10 in each of the previous six seasons, the longest such streak since 1959-64.
- The Rebels are 75-18 (.806) vs. non-conference opponents dating back to 1994 ... Ole Miss is 121-41-6 (.740) all-time versus non-conference opponents during the month of September.
- Of its 59 newcomers, Ole Miss welcomes in 19 new transfers as part of its No. 2 ranked transfer class.
- QB **Trinidad Chambliss** and RB **Kewan Lacy** are both on the watch lists for the Maxwell Award and Walter Camp Award.
- Preseason All-America DT **Will Echoles** led the Power Four in both pressures (39) and defensive stops (35) last year.

In planning your coverage of Ole Miss Football in 2026, media are asked to review the following information. Contact the Athletics Communications office at 662-915-7522 if you have any questions.

WORKING CREDENTIALS: To request game credentials, go to Ole Miss' online credentialing site: www.olemisssports.com/credentials. Credential requests must be made as early as possible by the sports director of each media outlet and are limited to those media who will be attending the game in a working capacity. Media must approve the SEC Media Policy before requesting credentials. Due to the high number of applications, it is not possible to accommodate all requests. Accredited, working media will have first priority and all others will be on a space-available basis. Freelance media requests will not be accepted. No one under 18 years of age will be issued a press box credential or sideline vest without the prior approval of Ole Miss Athletics Communications. All credentials, both season and single-game, must be picked up at media will call on gameday. No credentials will be sent via mail.

PARKING: Gameday media parking will be located in the garage adjacent to The SJB Pavilion or overflow lot to the southwest of Vaught-Hemingway Stadium. Each pass is for a specific numbered parking spot. Cars parked in the wrong spot will be towed. Parking passes are digital and must be requested during credential application process. If a parking pass is requested and approved, a digital pass will be sent to every applicant via text message on the Thursday prior to gameday.

MEDIA GATE/WILL-CALL: Media will enter Gate 35 on the west side of the stadium beginning three hours prior to kickoff. The media will-call table will be located beside the elevators on the concourse level of The SJB Pavilion. Photographers may receive a vest at this location.

PHOTOGRAPHERS/SIDELINE ACCESS: All photographers must wear a photo vest in order to be admitted to the sidelines. This may be received beside the elevators on the concourse level of The SJB Pavilion. Gameday flip cards will be available there or in the photo workroom, which is located at The Grill at 1810 inside the Manning Center. Per NCAA rules, images or likeness of current student-athletes may not be sold, distributed or used for commercial purposes without appropriate consent.

SIDELINE ACCESS: Excluding select portions of the game, media sideline access is reserved for photographers/videographers. Credentialed photographers/videographers who arrive at media will-call without proper equipment will not be granted a vest for sideline access. When on the sideline, media must remain outside the bench area and may not shoot behind the benches. During pre-game activities, media must remain in the designated area, as posted in the photo workroom, until the team leaves the field after warm-ups.

RECAP VS. LOUISVILLE (SEPT. 6, 2021)

ATLANTA — (AP) Matt Corral threw for 381 yards and accounted for two touchdowns, Snoop Conner ran for a pair of scores and Mississippi romped to a 43-24 victory over Louisville on Monday night even without its head coach.

Corral completed 22 of 32 passes, including a 6-yard touchdown to Dontario Drummond. The Ole Miss quarterback also ran 6 yards for a score, while Drummond finished with 177 yards on nine receptions.

Conner had TD runs of 1 and 11 yards, barreling right over a Louisville defender on the second score. Jerrion Ealy also powered over from the 1 and Caden Costa kicked three field goals.

The Southeastern Conference school showed no signs of letting off the gas. Ole Miss led 26-0 at halftime before a

sparse crowd announced at 30,709.

But the biggest improvement came on the defensive side, where Ole Miss broke out a new scheme mainly using three down linemen, two linebackers and a bunch of defensive backs.

While Louisville quarterback Malik Cunningham ran for two TDs and passed for another, all of his production came in the second half with the outcome no longer in doubt.

Cunningham was held 17 yards passing in the first half to cap a brutal opening weekend for the Atlantic Coast Conference.

OLE MISS HEAD COACH PETE GOLDING

Pete Golding, one of college football’s premier defensive minds, enters his first full season as the head coach of the Ole Miss football program in 2026 after being named the 40th head coach in Rebel history on Nov. 30, 2025. Golding took over the program after three seasons as Ole Miss’ defensive coordinator, where he helped transform the Rebels into one of the SEC’s top defensive units and mentored eight NFL Draft picks. During his tenure, Ole Miss produced one of the nation’s most dominant defenses in 2024, leading the FBS in both sacks (52) and tackles for loss (120), with both marks establishing new program records. The Rebels also ranked second nationally in rushing defense that season, allowing just 80.5 yards per game, while holding nine of 13 opponents below 100 rushing yards. In 2023, Golding helped Ole Miss to its first 11-win season in program history, with the Rebels ranking fifth nationally in turnover margin (+11). His defenses during his three seasons in Oxford have limited opponents to 18.5 points and 330.8 yards per game while recording 31 interceptions, 27 forced fumbles and 19 fumble recoveries. Golding was immediately tested after being named head coach following the 2025 regular season, leading Ole Miss to its first-ever College Football Playoff appearance. The Rebels earned a first-round home victory over Tulane before defeating Georgia in the Sugar Bowl to advance to the CFP Semifinals, where Ole Miss’ storybook season ended against Miami. Golding arrived at Ole Miss following five seasons as Alabama’s defensive coordinator from 2018-22, helping the Crimson Tide win three SEC championships and the 2020 national championship. During his time in Tuscaloosa, Alabama ranked among the FBS top 20 in scoring defense every season and produced numerous defensive stars, including two-time Bronko Nagurski Trophy winner Will Anderson Jr. Prior to Alabama, Golding served as defensive coordinator at UTSA (2016-17), where his 2017 unit ranked seventh nationally in total defense, and spent time coaching at Southern Miss, Southeastern Louisiana, Delta State and Tusculum. A native of Hammond, Louisiana, Golding began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Delta State in 2006 after playing four seasons at safety for the Statesmen from 2002-05. He graduated from Delta State in 2005 with a degree in business.

LOUISVILLE HEAD COACH JEFF BROHM

Jeff Brohm enters his fourth season in charge of the Louisville football program in 2026, owning a 28-12 record with the Cardinals and a 94-56 mark in 13 seasons as a head coach. Brohm has led Louisville to three consecutive nine-win seasons, including a 10-4 campaign in 2023 that culminated in the program’s first appearance in the ACC Championship Game and a Holiday Bowl berth. In 2025, Brohm guided the Cardinals to a 9-4 record and a 24-21 upset at No. 2 Miami, Louisville’s first road victory over an AP Top 10 opponent, before closing the season with a 41-0 shutout of Kentucky and a Boca Raton Bowl victory over Toledo. Prior to returning to his alma mater, Brohm spent six seasons at Purdue (2017-22), leading the Boilermakers to four bowl appearances and the 2022 Big Ten West Division title, while also earning three victories over top-three opponents. Brohm began his head coaching career at Western Kentucky (2014-16), compiling a 30-10 record and leading the Hilltoppers to back-to-back Conference USA championships and three consecutive bowl victories. A Louisville native and former Cardinal quarterback, Brohm played eight seasons in the NFL after graduating from Louisville in 1994. He began his coaching career as an assistant at Louisville before stops at Illinois, Florida Atlantic and Western Kentucky prior to becoming a head coach.

LOUISVILLE SCOUTING REPORT

Louisville enters 2026 ranked No. 24 in the first AP Poll after posting back-to-back nine-win seasons. The Cardinals went 9-4 in 2025, highlighted by a 24-21 upset at No. 2 Miami, their first road win over an AP Top 10 opponent, before closing the season with a 27-22 victory over Toledo in the Bush’s Boca Raton Bowl. Louisville returns a talented roster led by Ohio State transfer quarterback Lincoln Kienholz and Vanderbilt transfer wide receiver Tre Richardson, who headline a deep receiving corps. Defensively, the Cardinals return defensive lineman Clev Lubin to anchor a unit expected to be among the ACC’s strongest, while co-defensive coordinator Mark Ivey takes over as the team’s new defensive play-caller.

TALL TASK

Ole Miss is coming off the most successful season in program history, finishing 13-2 and advancing to the College Football Playoff semifinals for the first time. The 2025 Rebels set a new program record with 7,345 total yards while averaging 36.9 points and 176.3 rushing yards per game. The 2026 squad will look to replace significant production from last year's historic unit while transitioning to a new head coach in **Pete Golding**, but returns 12 starters and adds a talented group of transfers and newcomers.

NEXT MAN UP

Ole Miss still has plenty of returning firepower, led by quarterback **Trinidad Chambliss** and running back **Kewan Lacy**. Chambliss returns after throwing for 3,937 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2025, while Lacy rushed for 1,567 yards and 24 touchdowns. The Rebels will also look to their top-tier transfer and recruiting classes to make an immediate impact this fall.

TRANSFER TO THE 'SIP

In the transfer portal, Ole Miss has become an attractive destination for players in the transfer portal. This past year, the Rebels earned the No. 2 ranked portal class according to 247Sports. The class included players like linebacker **Keaton Thomas**, linebacker **Luke Ferrelli**, wide out **Johntay Cook II**, quarterback **Deuce Knight**, and safety **Edwin Joseph**. The Rebels accounted for 33 transfers for a total of 59 newcomers.

NEW COORDINATORS

The Rebels enter the 2026 season with new offensive and defensive coordinators in **John David Baker** and **Bryan Brown**. Baker returns to Oxford for his second stint with the Rebels after serving as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at East Carolina from 2024-25. Brown enters his first season as defensive coordinator after spending the previous two seasons as Ole Miss' co-defensive coordinator and secondary coach. Both coordinators bring previous experience, with Baker having served on the Ole Miss staff from 2021-23 and Brown spending four seasons as Louisville's defensive coordinator from 2019-22.

CARDIAC REBS

Ole Miss proved its ability to thrive in close games throughout the 2025 season, winning six of eight games decided by one score. The Rebels earned one-score victories over Kentucky (30-23), Arkansas (41-35), LSU (24-19), Washington State (24-21), Oklahoma (34-26) and Georgia (39-34) in the Sugar Bowl, while their two one-score losses came at Georgia (43-35) and against Miami (31-27) in the CFP Semifinal.

LACY LEADS THE WAY

Kewan Lacy returns for his junior season after a record-setting 2025 campaign in which he started all 15 games and established Ole Miss' single-season records with 306 rushing attempts, 1,567 rushing yards and 24 rushing touchdowns. Lacy finished among the nation's top three in rushing yards, touchdowns and total points scored (144) while earning FWAA and Phil Steele first-team All-America honors, first-team All-SEC recognition and becoming the first Rebel in program history to be named a Doak Walker Award finalist. He posted four games of at least 140 rushing yards, including a career-high 224 yards and three touchdowns against Florida, and closed the season with 103 rushing yards and a touchdown in the CFP Semifinal against Miami. Lacy was also featured as one of the cover athletes for EA Sports College Football 27, further highlighting his status as one of the sport's premier returning players.

THE TRINIDAD ERA

Trinidad Chambliss enters 2026 as the returning starting quarterback after a breakout 2025 campaign that saw him emerge as one of the SEC's most dynamic playmakers. Chambliss totaled 3,937 passing yards and 22 touchdowns while providing a dangerous dual-threat presence for the Rebel offense. His play helped guide Ole Miss to its first-ever College Football Playoff Semifinal appearance, including a historic Sugar Bowl victory over Georgia and a first-round CFP win over Tulane. With another year in the Ole Miss offense, Chambliss enters 2026 as one of the Rebels' top offensive weapons and a key piece of an offense that averaged 36.9 points per game last season.

WILL POWER

Returning for his junior season is defensive tackle **Will Echoles** after emerging as one of the SEC's top defensive tackles in 2025. Echoles started all 15 games and finished with 68 tackles, 11.5 tackles for loss and five sacks while earning All-America honors from Phil Steele and first-team All-SEC recognition from the Associated Press. According to Pro Football Focus, Echoles led all Power Four defensive linemen in pressures (39) and defensive stops (35), while his five pass breakups tied for ninth nationally among defensive linemen. He capped the season by earning Sugar Bowl Defensive MVP honors after recording five tackles, 2.0 TFL and two pass breakups in Ole Miss' historic win over Georgia.

SUNTARINE PERKINS WINS CHUCKY MULLINS COURAGE AWARD

Ole Miss senior **Suntarine Perkins** was recently named the winner of the 2026 Chucky Mullins Courage Award. The award, sponsored by Phi Beta Sigma fraternity, honors the late Chucky Mullins, who had his Ole Miss career come to an end during the 1989 Homecoming game against Vanderbilt when he was paralyzed after making a tackle. After returning to his studies at Ole Miss, Mullins passed away May 6, 1991.

RECEIVER RELOAD

Ole Miss enters 2026 with a revamped wide receiver room featuring a mix of returning production and talented newcomers. **Deuce Alexander** is the lone primary returning receiver after recording 44 catches for 684 yards and two touchdowns in 2025, including a school-record 88-yard touchdown reception against Mississippi State. The Rebels added transfers **Johntay Cook II** and **Horatio Fields**, who bring significant Power Four experience to the room. Cook led Syracuse in 2025 with 45 receptions for 549 yards and two touchdowns, while Fields totaled 39 catches for 463 yards and four touchdowns at Wake Forest in 2024. Ole Miss also returns **Caleb Odom**, who had 19 receptions for 197 yards and two touchdowns as a sophomore last season.

NEW FACES AT LB

Ole Miss added two proven linebackers through the transfer portal in **Keaton Thomas** and **Luke Ferrelli**. Thomas arrives from Baylor after starting all 25 games over the past two seasons and totaling 219 tackles, 14.0 tackles for loss, 3.5 sacks, two interceptions and two defensive touchdowns. A first-team All-Big 12 selection in 2024, Thomas recorded 103 tackles, seven TFLs and an interception in 2025. Ferrelli joins the Rebels from California after earning ACC Defensive Rookie of the Year honors in 2025, when he started all 13 games and finished second on the team with 91 tackles while adding five TFLs, a sack and an interception. Together, the duo brings significant production and starting experience to the Rebel linebacking corps.

SPECIAL DELIVERY

Ole Miss enters 2026 with one of the nation's most reliable special teams units under fourth-year special teams coordinator **Jake Schoonover**. The Rebels ranked third nationally in net punting in 2025 at 43.61 yards per punt, helping consistently win the field position battle during their College Football Playoff run. Kicker **Lucas Carneiro** also enjoyed a record-setting season, converting 31-of-35 field goal attempts and making a program-record five field goals of 50-plus yards. Carneiro provided one of the biggest moments of the season with the game-winning field goal against Georgia in the CFP Quarterfinal and followed with four made field goals against Miami in the Semifinal, including a career-long 58-yarder.

FIRST-DOWN FIREPOWER

Ole Miss was dominant on first down offensively in 2025, totaling 383 first downs, including 149 rushing first downs and 199 passing first downs. The Rebels' 383 first downs ranked first in both the SEC and the FBS.

CAUSING MAYHEM

Ole Miss totaled 83.0 tackles for loss for 320 yards in 2025, with several key contributors returning in 2026. Defensive lineman **Will Echoles** and linebacker **Suntarine Perkins** combined for 24.0 TFLs, with Echoles recording 11.5 and Perkins adding 12.5. Defensive lineman Kam Franklin also returns after registering 9.0 TFLs a season ago.

TOP 100 TALENT

Four Rebels earned spots among the top 100 players in college football in ESPN's preseason rankings, led by quarterback **Trinidad Chambliss** at No. 5 and running back **Kewan Lacy** at No. 6. Chambliss broke out in his first season at Ole Miss, throwing for 3,937 yards and 22 touchdowns while adding 527 rushing yards and eight rushing touchdowns. Lacy set Ole Miss' single-season records with 1,567 rushing yards and 24 rushing touchdowns on 306 carries. Defensive tackle **Will Echoles**, ranked No. 26, totaled 68 tackles, 11.5 tackles for loss and five sacks, while linebacker **Suntarine Perkins**, ranked No. 62, recorded 84 tackles, 11.5 tackles for loss and 5.5 sacks.

Pete Golding was named the 40th head coach in Ole Miss football history on Nov. 30, 2025 following the regular season. He guided the Rebels to a 2-1 mark in the College Football Playoffs en route to a semifinal run and a 13-2 final record.

Golding took over one of the Southeastern Conferences' top teams of the 2020s after a brilliant career as a defensive guru in the SEC over the last eight years. During that span, Golding helped lead his teams to eight consecutive seasons of 10 or more wins, including a home record of 54-2. Since 2018, Golding owned an SEC record of 55-11, winning six College Football Playoff games, three SEC titles, a National Championship in 2020, while going 13-3 in postseason play. Since arriving in Oxford in 2023, Golding has orchestrated several dominant Ole Miss defenses, including a school-record pass rush in 2024, and with the Rebels he has mentored eight NFL Draft picks.

He was immediately put to the test as Ole Miss' leader during its first-ever College Football Playoff appearance just weeks into his tenure. The Rebels earned a first round home game in the CFP, a dominant 41-10 rematch win over 11-seed Tulane that setup another rematch for Ole Miss in the Sugar Bowl against Georgia. This time, the Rebels had destiny on their side, clawing back from a nine-point halftime deficit to cap off one of the most iconic wins in Ole Miss football history, 39-34.

In the CFP Semifinals against Miami, the Rebels and Hurricanes battled to the bitter end, but a late drive by Miami ended the storybook season for both Golding and the Rebels.

Golding — who owns nearly two decades of defensive coaching experience — cut his teeth in the SEC as a key member of Nick Saban's powerful Alabama squads as Saban's defensive coordinator from 2018-22, which included three SEC titles in 2018, '20 and '21, as well as a national title with the Crimson Tide in 2020.

During his time as Ole Miss' defensive coordinator since 2023, Golding has transformed the defensive mentality of the Rebels into one of the SEC's better units. In his Ole Miss career, Golding's defenses have stuffed opponents to just 18.5 points and 330.8 yards per game (210.4 passing, 120.4 rushing) while tallying up nearly three sacks and seven tackles for loss a game alongside 31 total interceptions, 27 forced fumbles and 19 fumble recoveries.

This season, Golding has mentored Ole Miss to one of the SEC's top pass defenses, yielding only 182.6 yards per game (SEC No. 3, FBS No. 20), while also ranking FBS top-25 in both fourth-down defense (ninth, .360) and scoring defense (25th, 20.1 ppg).

Golding had the unenviable task of replacing one of the greatest defenses in Ole Miss history, but his 2025 Rebels have been productive from both the transfer portal and high school ranks alike. Top returners and junior linebackers TJ Dottery and Suntarine Perkins lead the team in tackles, owning a combined 124 stops and 11.0 tackles for loss, but the underclass of powerful sophomore linemen Kam Franklin (6.5 TFL, 3.5 sacks) and Will Echoles (6.0 TFL, 3.5 sacks) — as well as team-leading transfer Princewill Umanmielen (7.5 TFL, 5.5 sacks) — has proven just as talented at causing mayhem in the backfield.

Golding put together one of the best all-around defenses in Ole Miss history in 2024, highlighted by one of the nation's most feared rush defenses and pass rush attacks. The Rebels led the nation in sacks (52)

and tackles for loss (120), with both standing as new program records. The Ole Miss defense stifled opponents to just 80.5 rushing yards per game, which ended the season ranked second in the FBS and was the fewest allowed by a Rebel defense since 1966.

Ole Miss held nine of its 13 opponents to fewer than 100 yards rushing, six below 50 yards -- including a Gator Bowl record 44 yards allowed to Duke to close the season. Only two Rebel opponents broke 400 yards of total offense, while the Rebels held five to fewer than 300.

Leading the charge were first team All-Americans defensive tackle Walter Nolen and linebacker Chris Paul Jr., who were both among a seven-round NFL Draft record eight selections for Ole Miss. Nolen, the 14th consensus All-American in program history, was the first Rebel selected in the first round at No. 16 overall to the Arizona Cardinals, while other defensive draftees included cornerback Trey Amos (Round 2, Washington Commanders), defensive end Princely Umanmielen (Round 3, Carolina Panthers), Paul Jr. (Round 5, Los Angeles Rams) and defensive tackle JJ Pegues (Round 6, Las Vegas Raiders).

With the Rebels in 2023, Golding's new defensive scheme helped propel Ole Miss to its first 11-win season in program history. The Landshark D led the SEC and ranked fifth in the FBS in turnover margin at +11 and stifled SEC defenses, holding Arkansas (288), Auburn (275) and Vanderbilt (229) to fewer than 300 total yards in consecutive games -- the first such streak at Ole Miss within the same season since 1993.

Golding's squad was well-rounded, ranking within the top-35 nationally in sacks (19th, 2.7/game), TFL (29th, 6.3/game), passes intercepted (25th, 13 INTs) and scoring defense (34th, 22.1 PPG). Those 13 picks were the most by a Rebel defense since 2015, and the 35 Rebel sacks helped give Ole Miss at least 35 sacks in three straight seasons for the first time in program history.

The 2023 defense was led by three NFL Draft picks -- corner Deantre Prince (fifth round), edge Cedric Johnson (sixth round) and safety Daijahn Anthony (seventh round) -- as well as other returning stalwarts like defensive end and Peach Bowl Defensive MVP Jared Ivey, veteran safeties John Saunders Jr. and Trey Washington, and star freshman linebacker Santarine Perkins.

In his five seasons leading the Crimson Tide defense, Alabama ranked top-20 in the FBS in scoring defense every year and finished top-10 in either scoring or total defense four times.

The 2022 Alabama defense again proved to be one of the best in the nation, ranking ninth in scoring defense (18.2) and 13th in total defense (318.2 ypg). The Crimson Tide allowed just 4.6 yards per play last season, which led the SEC and ranked No. 4 nationally.

Two-time Bronko Nagurski Trophy winner Will Anderson Jr., anchored Golding's defense the last several seasons. Anderson became the first Alabama player ever to earn unanimous All-America honors after leading the SEC and finishing No. 11 in the country in sacks (10.0).

Alabama ranked fourth in rushing defense (86.0 ypg) and seventh in total defense (304.1 ypg) in 2021, while allowing just 20.1 points per game and holding opponents for a 31.1 percent conversion rate on third down, which was seventh nationally. Middle linebacker Henry To'oTo'o led the team with 112 tackles, while Anderson set the NCAA record (since 2000) for tackles for loss in a season with 34.5.

Golding's 2020 defense led the SEC in scoring (19.0 ppg) and got better as the season progressed, allowing just 15 points per game over the final nine contests en route to the national championship. The Tide ranked third in the league in total defense and rushing defense while the pass efficiency defense also led the league and ranked 18th nationally.

Golding's unit was devastated by injuries in 2019 and forced the staff into starting two true freshmen at the mike and will positions in the Tide's base 3-4 scheme. Alabama still managed a top-20 defense, limiting opponents to just 324.4 yards and 18.6 points per game.

Alabama's defense finished the 2018 season ranked third nationally in scoring (18.1 ppg) and 16th in total defense (319.5 ypg). The rushing defense was 19th nationally (121.3 ypg) while the pass efficiency defense ranked 23rd. Alabama also ranked 10th nationally in sacks per game at 3.0.

Prior to Alabama, Golding coached cornerbacks and handled defensive coordinator duties at the University of Texas-San Antonio in 2016 and 2017. Golding's 2017 defense at UTSA ranked seventh in the Football Bowl Subdivision, allowing just 287.8 yards per game. The Roadrunners finished eighth in scoring defense (17.0 ppg), second in first downs defense (166) and 19th in pass efficiency defense (112.19).

In his first season with the Roadrunners in 2016, Golding helped lead the program to six wins and its first bowl game -- the 2016 Gildan New Mexico Bowl. His defense set several school records, including single-season standards for tackles (934), TFLs (77), sacks (27) and QB hurries (38).

Golding joined the UTSA staff after spending two years as an assistant at Southern Miss where he coached the safeties. The Golden Eagles posted a six-win improvement in his second season, finishing 9-5 overall with a trip to the Heart of Dallas Bowl while winning the Western Division of Conference USA.

Prior to his time in Hattiesburg, Golding was the defensive coordinator and defensive backs coach at Southeastern Louisiana for two seasons (2012-13). He helped guide the Lions' program to a school-record 11 wins and its first conference title (Southland) since 1961 with a 7-0 league record.

Before heading to Hammond, Golding was the defensive coordinator at his alma mater Delta State from 2010-11, leading the Statesman to the 2010 NCAA Division II National Championship Game and the Gulf South Conference title.

He also spent three years on staff at Division II Tusculum, coaching the defensive backs while coordinating the defense the final two years as the Pioneers developed into a record-setting defensive unit under his direction.

Golding began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Delta State in 2006 after starting four seasons at safety for the Statesmen (2002-05). Golding graduated from Delta State in 2005 with a degree in business.
