January 2, 2020 • 5:30 p.m. PT • Huntsman Center • Salt Lake City, Utah

THE GAME: Oregon State opens Pac-12 play against Utah at 5:30 p.m. PT on Thursday at the Huntsman Center in Salt Lake City.

QUICKLY: Oregon State has won three of its last four Pac-12 openers (70-57 vs. Oregon on Jan. 3, 2016; 76-57 vs. Colorado on Dec. 29, 2017; 77-72 at Oregon on Jan. 5, 2019 ... The Beavers have equaled their best start since the 1984-85 team opened 11-1 (the 1989-90, 2011-12 and 2015-16 teams also started 10-2) ... Tres Tinkle (1,906) became the 25th Pac-12 player in history to score 1,900 career points; he needs 68 to pass Mel Counts and move into third on Oregon State's career scoring list ... Ethan Thompson has scored 20-plus points in three of the last four games; he scored a career-high 25 against North Dakota ... Kylor Kelley leads the Pac-12 and is second in the nation in blocked shots per game (4.33) ... Roman Silva played a season-high 16 minutes against North Dakota and had six points and four rebounds ... Sean Miller-Moore is averaging 6.7 points and 5.0 rebounds in 15.0 minutes over the last three games ... Wayne Tinkle has used the same starting lineup all 12 games (Thompson, Reichle, Tinkle, Hollins, Kelley).

vs. UTAH: Oregon State and Utah are meeting for the 32nd time with the Utes holding an 18-13 advantage, including a 13-2 mark in Salt Lake City.

The Beavers won the only meeting last season, 81-72, on Feb. 2 at the Huntsman Center. Tres Tinkle exploded for 31 points, while Kylor Kelley and Ethan Thompson added 13 points apiece. Oregon State's other win in Salt Lake City came on Feb. 4, 2012 when they cruised to a 76-58 victory behind Jared Cunningham's game-high 20 points.

The teams have alternated wins the last six games with the average margin of victory being only 4.7 points (Oregon State, 81-72, Feb. 2, 2019; Utah, 66-64, Dec. 31, 2017; Oregon State, 68-67, Feb. 19 2017; Utah, 86-78, Jan. 28, 2017; Oregon State, 71-69, Feb. 4, 2016; Utah, 59-53, Jan. 17, 2016).

CHASING THE GLOVE: Tres Tinkle needs 267 points to pass Gary Payton and become the all-time leading scorer in Oregon State history.

THE TEAM: Here are some quick-hitters about the 2019-20 Oregon State men's basketball team:

- The Beavers are 22-0 the last three seasons when scoring 80-plus points (6-0 in 2017-18; 7-0 in 2018-19; 9-0 in 2019-20).
- Oregon State is third in the Pac-12 and 19th in the nation in field goal percentage (48.8%).
- The Beavers lead the Pac-12 and are sixth in the nation in blocked shots per game (6.4).
- The Beavers are 10-0 when shooting a better percentage from the field than their opponent; 0-2 when the opponent shoots a better percentage.
- In six seasons under Wayne Tinkle, Oregon State is 66-15 (10-1 this season) when leading at halftime and 73-7 (10-0 this season) when leading with five minutes to play.
- Oregon State received a Team Academic Excellence Award from the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Committee for achieving a cumulative team GPA of 3.0 or better during the 2018-19 season.
- Isaiah Johnson, a 6-foot-7, 210-pound forward from Cerritos, Calif., signed a National Letter of Intent to join the program next season. He attends Bishop Montgomery High and is a three-star recruit by Rivals.com and 247 Sports.

TRES TINKLE: Here are some quick hitters about Tres Tinkle, a senior forward from Missoula. Mont.:

- Is the only Pac-12 player in the top 10 in the league in scoring (second, 20.4), rebounding (ninth, 7.3), assists (ninth, 4.2) and steals (tied for second, 2.0).
- Has three steals in each of the last two games.
- Is averaging 23.4 points, 8.6 rebounds and shooting 55.3% from beyond the arc in the seven games at Gill Coliseum; 16.2 points, 5.4 rebounds and shooting 35.3% from deep in the five games away from Gill.
- Shooting 49.1 percent (27-for-55) from beyond the arc; his career percentage entering this season was 32.4 percent (134-for-413).
- Has scored in double figures in 77 consecutive games, the second longest streak in Oregon State history; Mel Counts holds the record with 89 straight.
- Has grabbed 757 career rebounds, the sixth most in Oregon State history; next up is Eric Moreland with 762.
- His 25 career double-doubles are the seventh most in Oregon State history; next up is Steve Johnson with 26.
- On Oregon State's career lists, he's tied for fourth in field goals made (636), seventh in 3-pointers made (161) and third in free throw made (473).
- Named Pac-12 Player of the Week on Nov. 11; the fourth career weekly award ties him with A.C. Green and Charlie Sitton for the second most in Oregon State history trailing only Gary Payton's league-record nine.
- Named to the preseason watch lists for the John R. Wooden Award, the Naismith Trophy Men's Player of the Year, the Lute Olson Award, the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award and the Oscar Robertson Trophy.
- Selected to the preseason All-Pac-12 First Team.
- Has earned Pac-12 All-Academic recognition each of the past three years.

KYLOR KELLEY: Here are some quick hitters about Kylor Kelley, a senior forward from Gervais, Ore.:

- Averaging 14.3 points and shooting 64.5% from the field (20-for-31) and 81.0% from the free throw line (17-for-21) over the last four games.
- Leads the Pac-12 and is second in the nation in blocked shots per game (4.33).
- Has four or more blocked shots in eighth of the 12 games.
- Is seventh in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage (60.2%).
- Has scored 20-plus points twice this season, including a career high 23
 against UTSA; his career high entering this season was 16 points.
- Has 55 rebounds and 52 blocked shots this season.
- Had his streak of games with multiple blocked shots end at 11 when he had one at Texas A&M; he set the program record last season with 15 straight.
- His 156 career blocked shots are the fourth most in Oregon State history; Eric Moreland holds the record with 184.
- Selected preseason All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention.
- Became the fifth Oregon State player to be selected to the Pac-12 All-Defensive Team (Seth Tarver, Jared Cunningham, Eric Moreland, Gary Payton II).
- Selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court in July 2019.

ETHAN THOMPSON: Here are some quick hitters about Ethan Thompson, a junior guard from Los Angeles, Calif.:

- Has scored 20-plus points in three of the last four games; he scored a career-high 25 in the last game against North Dakota.
- Is averaging 16.9 points and shooting 49.1% from the field in the 10 wins; 10.5 points and 32.0% from the field in the two losses.
- Is the only player on the team with multiple assists in all 12 games.
- Is 11th in the Pac-12 in scoring (15.8), sixth in assists (4.7) and fifth in assist/ turnover ratio (2.15).
- Is first in the Pac-12 in minutes played per game (34.74).
- Is second on the team in rebounding (4.7 average; 56 total).
- Has started all 75 games in his Oregon State career.
- Has scored 930 career points.
- Selected to the preseason All-Pac-12 Second Team.
- Selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court in July 2019.
- Named to the Pac-12 All-Academic Second Team in March 2019.

ALFRED HOLLINS: Here are some quick hitters about Alfred Hollins, a junior forward from San Francisco, Calif.:

- Has grabbed multiple rebounds in 11 of the 12 games.
- Is tied for second on the team with an assist/turnover ratio of 2.00.
- Is averaging 1.6 points and shooting 13.3% from the field (2-for-15, including 0-for-5 from deep) over the last five games.
- Averaged 10.1 points and shot 54.0% from the field (27-for-50) and 40.0% from beyond the arc (8-for-20) the first seven games.
- Shooting 44.6% (29-for-65) from the field, 32.0% (8-for-25) from beyond the arc and averaging 6.6 points this season.
- Shot 37.7% (52-for-138) from the field, 23.1% (12-for-52) from beyond the arc and averaged 4.8 points last season.

ZACH REICHLE: Here are some quick hitters about Zach Reichle, a junior guard from Wilsonville, Ore.:

- Has scored in double figures in six games; he scored in double digits twice as a sophomore and no times as a freshman (61 total games).
- Is shooting 11.8% from beyond the arc (2-for-17) over the last five games; he shot 43.5% from deep (10-for-23) the first seven games.
- Shooting 44.0% (33-for-75) from the field, 30.0% (12-for-40) from beyond the arc and averaging 8.4 points this season.
- Shot 30.2% (29-for-96) from the field, 32.4% (24-for-74) from beyond the arc and averaged 3.5 points last season.
- Selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court in July 2019.
- Named to the Pac-12 All-Academic First Team in March 2019.

SEAN MILLER-MOORE: Here are some quick hitters about Sean Miller-Moore, a junior guard from Toronto, Ontario:

- Is shooting a team-best 64.3% from the field (18-for-28) this season.
- Is averaging 6.7 points and 5.0 rebounds in 15.0 minutes over the last three games; during the three-game stretch his 20 points are the fourth most on the team and his 15 rebounds are tied for the most on the team (Kylor Kelley).
- Had career highs with 10 points, six rebounds and four field goals made against UTSA.
- Played the last two years at Moberly Area Community College in Moberly, Mo.
