#### The Game

Oregon State makes the trek to Los Angeles to open a three-game series with UCLA at Jackie Robinson Stadium on Friday. First pitch is slated for 6 p.m. PT.

All games air on the Beaver Sports Network with pre-game 30 minutes before first pitch. #### Last Game

Oregon State outlasted Oregon, 7-6, Tuesday in a midweek game that featured a combined 20 walks, 17 strikeouts, 15 hits and three errors. Oregon State went ahead for good with a four-run third inning and Beau Philip and Adley Rutschman each drove in a pair of runs to pace the Beavers. Christian Chamberlain earned his second win of the season after holding UCLA to three walks, with three strikeouts, in 2 2/3 scoreless relief innings.

#### Top-Five Matchup

Oregon State and UCLA are both ranked in the top-10 in all six major polls, and both teams find themselves in the top-five in at least five rankings. Oregon State was 4-1 versus top-10 teams a year ago, and 8-2 against top-25 clubs.

#### First True Road Game

Friday's game will be the first true road contest for the Beavers. However, it will mark the 12th away from home for Oregon State, which is 10-0-1 in neutral-site contests this season.

#### To LA

Oregon State has won three of the last four and five of the last seven series between the teams in Los Angeles. The Beavers are 13-8 at Jackie Robinson Stadium since 2005 after going 3-11 there from 1967-2003.

#### Rutschman To Top 10

Adley Rutschman's two RBI in the midweek win over Oregon gave him 132 for his career, which surpasses Ken Bowen (131 from 1984-87) for 10th in a career at OSU. Rutschman now also has 103 walks, tied for eighth with Dave Backen (1978-81). Rutschman leads the Pac-12 with 23 free bases this season.

#### TV Saturday And Sunday

The final two games of the series will air on the Pac-12 Network, with Ted Enberg and Wes Clements on the call.

#### Singles

- Alex McGarry has hit safely in all four games he has batted leadoff - he moved to that spot in the lineup in the first game in Seattle. He is 5-for-15 with seven runs and four walks over that stretch.
- UCLA and Oregon State rank 1 and 2 in the Pac-12 for fewest hits allowed. The Bruins have given up 87, while the Beavers are at 88.
- WarrenNolan.com has Oregon State with the No. 1 unofficial RPI. The Beavers have a strength of schedule of 18 and have played 10 games against teams with a top 50 RPI.
- The Beavers are hitting .296 away from home this season, and have 24 doubles and 10 home runs in 11 games.
- OSU is 63-13-2 away from home since 2017.

Initiated in 2011, **Beavers without Borders** is a program that offers global service-learning experiences for student-athletes at Oregon State University.

The program has successfully completed eight service projects including trips to Guatemala, Macedonia, Ethiopia, Costa Rica and most recently the Dominican Republic.

Throughout those trips, over 100 student-athletes were able to experience life in a distinct culture, learn about the impact of their work on a community and interact outside of the university context to maximize the intercultural experience.

This year marked the second-straight year that Oregon State Athletics has sponsored two Beavers Without Borders trips. In June, 12 athletes made the trip to the Dominican Republic, with another 12 heading to Guatemala in August. The full list is below:

In the spirit of camaraderie, Oregon State University's **Varsity OSU** Association is dedicated to upholding the long tradition of athletic and academic excellence at Oregon State. Varsity OSU serves its membership by enhancing relationships among alumni letter-winners, current student-athletes, and current and former coaches and administrators.

The #DamWorthIt Campaign was started last summer to bring awareness to mental health issues involving student-athletes. The program was spear-headed by former Oregon State gymnast Taylor Ricci, along with current men's soccer player Nathan Braaten.

The #DamWorthIt Campaign has already received national attention including winning a Giant Steps Award from the Institute For Sport and Social Justice and receiving attention from the NCAA APPLE Conference.


