**THE GAME:** The No. 11 Oregon State women's basketball team will take on Boise State in the first round the NCAA Tournament at Gill Coliseum. The game will be played at 2:30 p.m. on Saturday.

**FOLLOW ALONG:** Saturday's game will air live on ESPN2 with Tiffany Greene and Mary Murphy on the call. Viewers in the state of Oregon can watch the game in its entirety, while the majority of the nation will get whip-around coverage. The game can be streamed in full anywhere on Watch ESPN. Fans can listen on KEX 1190 in Portland or on KEJO 1240 in Corvallis with Ron Callan, and live stats will be available at OSUBeavers.com. Live updates for all Oregon State women's basketball games can be found on twitter @BeaverWBB.

**OSU VS. BSU:** Oregon State and Boise State have met 12 times in program history, but have not gone head-to-head since 2000. The Beavers are 9-3 in series history, 6-1 at home, and have won the last four meetings. The Broncos last win over OSU came in 1993, when they took a 64-52 decision.

**WHAT'S UP NEXT:** The winner of Saturday's game will advance to face the winner of Gonzaga vs. Little Rock on Monday. Game time for Monday's contest will be announced Saturday evening. The advancing team from the second round will head to Albany, N.Y. to play in the Sweet 16.

Initiated in 2011, **Beavers without Borders** is a program that offers global service-learning experiences for student-athletes at Oregon State University.

The program has successfully completed eight service projects including trips to Guatemala, Macedonia, Ethiopia, Costa Rica and most recently the Dominican Republic.

Throughout those trips, over 100 student-athletes were able to experience life in a distinct culture, learn about the impact of their work on a community and interact outside of the university context to maximize the intercultural experience.

This year marked the second-straight year that Oregon State Athletics has sponsored two Beavers Without Borders trips. In June, 12 athletes made the trip to the Dominican Republic, with another 12 heading to Guatemala in August. The full list is below:

**QUICK HITTERS:**

- Oregon State is 140-30 since the start of the 2014-15 season, the seventh-best record in the nation over that span, trailing only UConn, Notre Dame, Baylor, Maryland, South Carolina and Louisville.
- This is the sixth-straight season the Beavers have made the NCAA Tournament. Oregon State has earned 11 wins over their prior five appearances.
- The Beavers are one of nine teams in the nation to make the Sweet 16 in each of the last three seasons, joining UConn, South Carolina, Notre Dame, Baylor, Stanford, Texas, UCLA and Mississippi State.
- Oregon State is hosting the first two rounds for the fourth time in program history. OSU previously hosted in 2015, 2016 and 2017, before playing their opening games in Knoxville, Tenn. last season
- The Beavers' 24-7 mark through the first 31 games of the season is tied for the fifth-best start through 31 games in program history.
- OSU's record is one win better than last season's team at the conclusion of the regular season (23-7).
- Oregon State has notched the 14th 20-win season in program history, and its sixth-straight 20-victory campaign. The Beavers have reached the 20-win mark for the seventh time in Scott Rueck's nine seasons as head coach.
- The Beavers' four highest win totals have all come over the last four seasons (27 in 2014-15, 32 in 2015-16, 31 in 2016-17, 26 in 2017-18).
- Oregon State has already tallied 24 wins this season, matching the fifth-highest win total in program history.
- The Beavers are fourth in the nation in 3-point percentage.
- The Beavers currently sit alongside Baylor, UConn, Rice and SFA as the only teams in the top-20 nationally in both field goal percentage and field goal percentage defense.
- OSU went 25-8 in calendar year 2018.
- Oregon State set the Pac-12 record for rebounding margin in consecutive games this season. The Beavers posted a +47 showing Dec. 9 vs. Santa Clara, a little over a week after winning the rebounding battle vs. La Salle by 46.
- The Beavers have been ranked in every USA Today/WBCA Coaches' poll, dating back to the 2013-14 postseason rankings. Oregon State is one of five teams in the nation to be ranked every week over that period, joining UConn, Notre Dame, Baylor, and Maryland.
- Oregon State is currently ranked No. 11 in the AP Poll and No. 11 in the WBCA Coaches' Poll.
- OSU's highest ever ranking came at the end of the 2015-16 campaign, when the Beavers came in at No. 2 in the WBCA Coaches Poll.
- OSU has led the Pac-12 in defensive field goal percentage for five-straight seasons, and is first the league in the category so far this season.
- Oregon State has only lost back-to-back games once since the start of the 2014-15 season, with those defeats coming to USC and UCLA on Jan. 5 and 7 of 2018.
- The Beavers have earned 10 wins over top-10 opponents since the start of 2014-15.
- The Beavers have not lost three-straight games since falling to Notre Dame, California and Stanford from Dec. 29 2013 to Jan. 5, 2014.
- Oregon State is one of seven teams to have four players selected over the course of the last three WNBA Drafts, and is one of two programs to have players picked in the first round of the last two drafts.

- All-Pac-12 honoree
- One of five finalists for the Nancy Lieberman National Point Guard of the Year Award.
- Pac-12 Academic Second Team
- Redshirted the 2017-18 season due to NCAA transfer rules
- Was named to the Wooden Award Late-Season Top-20, the Naismith Trophy Midseason Team and the mid-season Wade Watch.
- Slocum is the sixth player in Oregon State history with multiple point-assist double-doubles in her career.
- Has scored at least 15 points in 19 of her 31 games this season, including 12 20+ point outings.
- Has a total of 15 20+ point games in her collegiate career (Oregon State + Maryland), the most by any player on the OSU roster.
- Is shooting 46.6 percent from the floor this season, the third-best shooting percentage by a guard in the Pac-12.
- Finished the regular season with 144 assists, leaving her 13 away from cracking the top-10 in program history.
- Slocum's 15-point, 11 assist performance on Nov. 14 marked the third time in OSU history that a player has had at least 15 points and 11 assists in a game.
- Was named to the Naismith Trophy Early Season Watch List
- Pac-12 All-Preseason selection
- 2017 WBCA National Freshman of the Year during her debut campaign at Maryland.
- Averaged 11.5 points, and 6.0 assists per game at Maryland.
- Scored 23 points, including 19 in the second half of the Terrapins' matchup with UConn on Dec. 29, 2016.
- Big Ten Freshman of the Year

- All-Pac-12 selection this season.

- Has three double-doubles in her last four games, and four in her last six.
- Is averaging 19.2 points and 10.2 rebounds per game over her last five contests.
- Has played at least 37 minutes per game in her last six games, including two 40 minute performances and a 47-minute outing vs. Arizona. Pivec is averaging 39.8 minutes per game over that stretch.
- Has scored in double-figures in 28 of the Beavers' 31 games this season
- Has 11 or more points in 18 of her last 20 games.
- Needs 17 more rebounds to move into a tie for ninth in Oregon State history for career rebounds, currently sitting at 702.
- Averaged 15.3 points per game during Pac-12 play, and shooting 52.9 percent from the floor.
- Is shooting 54.4 percent on the season, the fifth-best percentage by a guard in the nation, and the second-best percentage from a guard in a power-five conference. Her shooting percentage is second in the Pac-12 overall and 33rd in the nation.
- Leads the team with 9.1 rebounds per game this season, the third-best mark in the Pac-12, and the highest total among Pac-12 guards.
- Is eighth in the nation in terms for rebounds per game from the guard position.
- Leads the team in rebounds and steals, and is second in points and assists.
- Has pulled down seven or more rebounds in 23 of her last 25 games.
- Has at least five rebounds in every game this season.
- Is currently 18th in Oregon State history for career points
- Earned CoSIDA Academic All-District First Team honors and Pac-12 All-Academic First Team honors in her sophomore year.
- Shot 45.0 percent from the floor last season.
- Shot 48.2 percent from two-point range on 2017-18 the season.
- Served as Oregon State's starting point guard last season, playing the position for the first time since 7th grade.


