The Game

Oregon State and Washington conclude their three-game series Sunday at Husky Ballpark in Seattle. First pitch is scheduled for 2:05 p.m. PT.

All games air on the Beaver Sports Network with pre-game 30 minutes before first pitch. Last Game

Ryan Ober hit a three-run home run and Adley Rutschman picked up a key bases-clearing double in the seventh to send Oregon State to a 10-7 win over Washington on Saturday. Ober's home run capped a five-run first inning for the Beavers.

Going For A Sweep

The Beavers are going for their first three-game series sweep of Washington since 2005 in Seattle. The Huskies, meanwhile, haven't swept the Beavers since 1995, in Seattle. UW's last sweep in Corvallis came in 1979.

Series Win

Saturday's win pushed the Beavers to their sixth consecutive series victory over the Huskies, dating back to 2014. Overall, Oregon State is 14-7 (.667) versus Washington over that stretch.

Rutschman Climbing The Charts

Adley Rutschman's three-run double in the seventh gave him 145 runs batted in over his career. That moves him into sole possession of eighth for a career at Oregon State, surpassing Matt Bailie (144 RBI from 1995-98). Rutschman also walked three times, giving him 114 for his career. He holds the fifth spot in the OSU record books and is six away from tying Michael Conforto (2012-14), Danny Hayes (2010-13) and Ken Bowen (1984-87) for most in a career.

10 Wins In March

Oregon State won its 10th game in the month of March on Saturday. The Beavers have won 10 or more games in March for 15 consecutive seasons. In the last decade alone, the Beavers are 124-35-1 (.778) in March.

Big Home Run Variety

Ryan Ober has hit two home runs this season after going deep on Saturday. His home runs have accounted for seven of his eight RBI on the year as he's tallied a grand slam and a three-run blast.

Singles

- Fifteen of Oregon State's 22 home runs this year have come when the Beavers' batter was ahead in the count or on the first pitch. Only two have seen OSU behind in the count.
- With Saturday's win, the Beavers have now 20 of their last 23 Pac-12 Conference series.
- Oregon State is 129-23-2 (.844) since 2017. The Beavers are 52-15-1 (.772) in conference play over that stretch.

Initiated in 2011, **Beavers without Borders** is a program that offers global service-learning experiences for student-athletes at Oregon State University.

The program has successfully completed eight service projects including trips to Guatemala, Macedonia, Ethiopia, Costa Rica and most recently the Dominican Republic.

Throughout those trips, over 100 student-athletes were able to experience life in a distinct culture, learn about the impact of their work on a community and interact outside of the university context to maximize the intercultural experience.

This year marked the second-straight year that Oregon State Athletics has sponsored two Beavers Without Borders trips. In June, 12 athletes made the trip to the Dominican Republic, with another 12 heading to Guatemala in August. The full list is below:

In the spirit of camaraderie, Oregon State University's **Varsity OSU** Association is dedicated to upholding the long tradition of athletic and academic excellence at Oregon State. Varsity OSU serves its membership by enhancing relationships among alumni letter-winners, current student-athletes, and current and former coaches and administrators.

The #DamWorthIt Campaign was started last summer to bring awareness to mental health issues involving student-athletes. The program was spear-headed by former Oregon State gymnast Taylor Ricci, along with current men's soccer player Nathan Braaten.

The #DamWorthIt Campaign has already received national attention including winning a Giant Steps Award from the Institute For Sport and Social Justice and receiving attention from the NCAA APPLE Conference.


