- Oregon State travels to Berkeley, Calif. to take on California.
- Oregon State has had an entire week off between games after hosting Stanford on April 5 and having games on April 6 and 7 cancelled due to rain.

BEAVER EXPERIENCE:

- Sophomore Missy Nunes has started all 33 games this season. Nunes is batting .289 with 28 hits, seven doubles and six home runs. Nunes has racked up 23 RBIs, 17 runs, and two stolen base. Nunes started the season with a home run in each of the first-three games of the season.
- Jessica Garcia is batting .277 with 26 hits, including one triple. Garcia has racked up 10 RBIs and 15 runs whiling only being walked three times. Garcia leads the Beavers with 12 stolen bases and a 1.000 fielding percentage after seeing time in 33 games and starting 32 of them.
- Redshirt senior Lovie Lopez has seen time in 29 games this season. Lopez is batting .274 with 11 runs, two doubles and three RBIs. Lopez has recorded 17 hits this season and walked eight times while stealing a base seven times.
- Shelby Weeks has recorded 12 stolen bases this season - bringing her career total to 55, just three away from holding the OSU Career Record. Weeks has tallied 27 hits, three doubles, one triple and one home run while scoring 27 runs. Weeks has 13 RBIs and has been walked 11 times.
- Kayleen Shafer has started in 22 games behind the plate and is batting .315 with 17 hits, five doubles and two home run. Shafer has 10 RBIs and eight runs scored while getting hit by a pitch once and walking seven times.
- Michelle Sass has made an appearance in 18 games this season. Sass is currently batting .276 with five doubles and one RBI. Sass has tallied four runs, four walks and gotten on base three times after being hit by a pitch.
- Camryn Ybarra has made 23 game appearances primarily at designated player. Ybarra has for doubles, six RBIs and three runs. Ybarra hit her first homerun of the season against Portland State. Ybarra also helped start the rally in the bottom of the seventh vs. Stanford with a single down the first-base line.
- Sophomore Mariah Mazon has been the main pitcher in the circle for the Beavers with a 10-9 record, 3.71 ERA with three-solo shutouts and 13 complete games. Mazon has struck out 120 batters in 116.1 innings.
- Meehra Nelson also returns to the circle for her senior season. Nelson has pitched 72.2 innings in 18 appearances with 86 strike outs and only 19 walks. Nelson has three-solo shutouts this season in six complete games and one save. Against Portland State, Nelson recorded 11 strike outs in six innings.

- OSU rounds out the upper classman with Chance Burden, Fallon Molnar and Nerissa Eason all seeing time in at least seven games.

GOING HAM-MOUEDE:

- Frankie Hammoude has wasted no time making herself a permanent in the OSU lineup starting at first base and batting cleanup in the first 33 games.
- Hammoude hit a two-run homer in the first at bat as a Beaver in the first inning vs. CSUN and finished her first collegiate weekend at the Kajikawa Classic with six hits, three home runs and nine RBIs. Hammoude batted .545 with a 1.364 slugging percentage.
- The second weekend, Hammoude batted .500 with three home runs, 10 RBIs and three runs scored. Hammoude had a 1.063 slugging percentage that weekend and was on base .556 percent.
- Hammoude's third weekend, she hit one double and one home run with two RBIs and two runs scored. She was also walked four times over the course of four games.
- Against No. 11 Arizona, Hammoude recorded four RBIs after she hit a grand slam in the bottom of the third inning. Hammoude was also walked twice.
- Against Stanford last weekend, Hammoude recorded a homerun in the bottom of the second inning.
- Hammoude holds a .276 batting average on the year and a .598 slugging percentage. She has 24 hits including one double, nine home runs and has been walked 21 times. Hammoude leads the team with 29 RBIs and has scored 13 runs.
- Hammoude was named one of the top freshman by Fast Pitch News on March 20 for being one of the most impactful freshman on a roster this season.
- Hammoude made the 2019 Junior Women's National Team roster prior to the start of this season.

NEWCOMER PRESENCE:

- Oregon State added seven newcomers during the offseason: Karla Calderon, Payton Goodrich, Hammoude, Bailey McLaughlin, Izzy Owen, Ashton Phillips and Maia Rader.
- Rader has started 30 games this season, all at shortstop. She is currently batting .282 with four doubles and two triple.
- Owen has seen time in 26 games. She is batting .197 with three RBIs and four runs scored. Owen has also tallied two stolen bases.
- Phillips has started in 14 games this season in right field. Phillips is batting .200 with one double, one RBI and six runs scored. She has also stole two bases.
- Calderon has seen time in 17 games as a pinch runner scoring six runs.

ALWAYS AWAY:

- Oregon State was on the road for the first six weeks of the season starting with five tournaments and finishing with a three-game series at ASU.
- Of the 33 games played to date, the Beavers have been listed as the home team on only nine occasions - three include the first home series the Beavers held against Arizona and one game against Stanford.
- OSU was scheduled to have 12 home games this season, spread over four Pac-12 series. This is the fewest home games the Beavers have had since 2016.
- With two-of-three games cancelled against Stanford due to rain, OSU will play 10 games on the OSU Softball Complex if no other games get cancelled.

RANKINGS:

- Pac-12 Rankings: No. 3. Batters SO looking (71), No. 3. Stolen bases (40) and No. 4 Batters SO (228).
- The Beavers broke into the Top 25 in week three - USA Today/NFCA at No. 25 and ESPN.com/USA Softball tied at No. 23.
- OSU was picked to tie for fifth in the Pac-12 Preseason Poll. Currently, the

<p>Beavers are ranked eighth in the Pac-12.</p> <p>COACHING PROFILES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Head coach Laura Berg hung up her cleats after nearly 20-years of playing softball and spent a year with the LAPD in 2010-11 before returning to the game as an assistant coach for the 2012 season at Oregon State. • Berg enters her seventh season at the helm of the Oregon State program in 2019, recording four NCAA Tournament appearances. • Berg holds a 183-170-1 overall record and is 46-103 in Pac-12 play. • Associate head coach Marcie Green also has experience with law enforcement. Green studied criminology at Fresno State and spent five years as a prison guard at Corcoran State Prison in California following graduation before starting to coach. • Assistant coach Eric Leyba joins the staff after stints with the Northwest Bullets and being the head coach at Churchill High School for the past 15 years. • Volunteer Assistant Coach Hannah Akamine is also new to the coaching staff, but not the Orange and Black. Akamine played for Berg and Green in 2015 as the starting catcher for the Beavers. • Heather Smith also returns for her 18th season as Director of Operations. <p>NATIONAL SOFTBALL:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Laura Berg has been announced as one of the Assistant Coaches for the Women's National Team by USA Softball. Berg will join Howard Dobson, Tairia Flowers and WNT Head Coach Ken Eriksen for the 2019 season. • Freshman Frankie Hammoude has been named to the 2019 USA Softball Junior Women's National Training Team for the summer of 2019. • Sophomore Mariah Mazon will be trying out for the Mexico National Team following the 2019 regular season. • Recent OSU Softball signee, Grace Messmer, has made the Canadian Junior WNT. <p>NCAA TOURNAMENT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 2018 season marked the fourth time the Beavers reached the NCAA Tournament under the direction of head coach Laura Berg, as well as the 14th time in program history. • The Beavers are 32-29 all-time in their 14 tournament appearances following two wins and two losses at the Tuscaloosa Regional in 2018. • The last time OSU won a regional was in 2006 when it played Nevada and No. 19 Baylor twice. OSU went on to play in the Women's College World Series that year. • Berg and former head coach Kirk Walker (1995-2012) are the only head coaches in program history to reach the NCAA Tournament. <p>KNOW WHAT IT TAKES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oregon State's coaching staff is no stranger when it comes to the NCAA Tournament and WCWS. • Both Berg and Green played at Fresno State in the '90s and gained plenty of experience in the path to the WCWS. • Coach Berg played from 1994-95 and 1997-98 making it to the WCWS three times and won the national championship in '98. • Coach Green played from 1990-93 and appeared in three WCWS, including a runner-up finish in 1990. • Volunteer assistant coach Hannah Akamine made the WCWS as the catcher for Tennessee in 	<p>its 2013 runner-up finish.</p> <p>TICKETS ON SALE NOW:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tickets for Oregon State's six remaining home games are on sale now at BeaverTickets.com/softball. • Single game tickets can be purchased at \$7 for adults and \$5 for youth. <p>2019 SCHEDULE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The non-conference portion of Oregon State's 2019 schedule featured a gauntlet of games over the course of five-tournaments and two non-conference games. • OSU opened the season with the Kajikawa Classic for the ninth time in 10 years. • The Stacy Winsberg Tournament in Long Beach and Los Angeles, Calif. featured two 2018 NCAA Regional teams, Long Beach State and Ole Miss. • The Beavers went to Norman, Okla. to face 2018 WCWS participant, Oklahoma, and NCAA Regional qualifier Louisiana. • Oregon State also made appearances at the UOP-Libby Matson Tournament and LMU Tournament before finishing out the non-conference schedule with a double-header at Portland State. • The conference portion features six opponents that made varying finishes in the 2018 NCAA Tournament: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cal - Regionals. - Arizona - Super Regionals. - Arizona State, UCLA and Oregon - WCWS. - Washington - 2018 WCWS Runner-Up. • In total, Oregon State will face 11 opponents from the 2018 NCAA Tournament. • 14 opponents finished with a top-100 RPI in 2018, 10 opponents had a top-50 RPI, eight had a top-25 RPI and five had a top-10 RPI.



Laura Berg starts her seventh season at the helm of OSU Softball in 2019.

Berg joined the Beavers' staff as an assistant prior to the 2012 season after one of the most successful softball careers in NCAA and Team USA history. During the summer of 2012, she also served as an assistant coach for the U.S. Women's National Team in its run at the ISF XIII World Women's Championships in Whitehorse, Yukon, Canada, and has worked with Team USA in every summer since.

In her first year as head coach, Oregon State posted a 34-24 record, the most wins ever for a Beaver head coach in his or her first year.

In the process, OSU secured its second straight season with at least 30 wins and an NCAA post-season berth. The Beavers tied a school record by batting .280 and also notched some big wins; including the school's first-ever sweep of nationally-ranked Arizona and a road shutout of No. 10 California, its first top-10 road victory since 2007.

Berg followed her inaugural season up with another strong offensive showing in 2014, as the Beavers set another school record by batting .287. Berg led the Beavers to a number of big victories in the 2014 campaign, including a series win over No. 5/7 Arizona State and Oregon State's first series win over Stanford since 2007.

Oregon State would continue to build on their strong offensive output in 2015, Berg's third season. Under her tutelage, the Beavers hit .298, the second-best total in school history. Oregon State also scored 300 runs, one shy of a school record, en route to a 26-26 season.

In 2016, Berg led the Beavers back to the NCAA Regional for her second time as head coach, while also reaching 30-wins. Oregon State also recorded its highest batting average in program history with a .306 mark. Berg led eight Beavers to earn Pac-12 postseason honors, including her fifth student-athlete to NFCA Pacific Region honors.

Berg again led the Beavers back to the NCAA Regional in 2017 for her third time as head coach and for the first time in back-to-back years since 2012-13. Oregon State post some impressive wins over the Pac-12 Conference schedule, including winning its first game by run-rule over a top-10 league opponent. The Beavers run-ruled No. 8/9 UCLA for the first time in program history on April 13. The Beavers would go on to win the series for the first time ever after a walk-off homer by Natalie Hampton gave OSU the win. Oregon State also picked up a series win against No. 10/11 Utah. Senior pitcher, Taylor Cotton carried a no-hitter into the final out of game one, but could not finish it off.

2018 marked the fourth time Berg has led OSU to the NCAA Regional. The third-consecutive return trip also marked the longest post-season streak the Beavers have had since the team made a nine-year run from 1999-2007. Oregon State posted its third 30-win season under Berg, including a 4-3 win over No. 2 Oregon at the OSU Softball Season. This was the first win over Oregon since 2012. The Beavers also took down No. 7 Arizona State, 4-2, a week later after jumping out to an early lead. Oregon State finished sixth in the Pac-12 in 2018, the highest finish under Berg's tutelage.

Working mainly with the team's slappers and outfielders, Berg helped put Oregon State back among the nation's elite in 2012. The Beavers went 36-23 en route to their first NCAA Regional appearance since 2007. OSU batted .273, the fifth-best mark in program history, set team records for both RBI (269) and runs scored (301) and its 70 stolen bases tied for third all-time.

The Beavers' renaissance in 2012 saw the team re-enter the national polls for the first time since 2008, defeat a total of 10 ranked opponents and claim a number of defining wins, including an extra-innings upset of No. 3 Arizona State and a road victory over No. 14 UCLA in April. OSU defeated its opponent by at least 10 runs on five occasions and scored more than 10 runs eight times, the second-highest totals in those respective categories in the 38-year history of the program.

Berg also helped tutor Dani Gilmore into becoming one of the best center-fielders in the Pac-12, as the Beaver freshman batted .322 with nine home runs and 33 RBI while posting a nearly flawless .990 fielding percentage. Gilmore was named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team and was also tabbed All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention after her inaugural season in the Orange & Black.

Berg previously had two stints as an assistant coach at her alma mater, Fresno State, from 2000-03 and 2005-06, stepping down to train with the U.S. Women's National Team in the interim. Joining the national team in 1994 as a center-fielder, she is the most decorated USA Softball Olympic athlete in history, helping her nation to three golds (1996 - Atlanta, 2000 - Sydney, 2004 - Athens) and one silver (2008 - Beijing). She has won 11 total medals, 10 gold, while competing for the U.S. in the Olympic Games, the ISF Women's World Championship and the Pan American Games. Her eighth-inning hit in the gold medal game in the 2000 Sydney Olympics drove in the winning run to help the Stars and Stripes defeat Japan, 2-1.

Berg had served four years as an Assistant Coach for the Women's National Team Program before being named the Head Coach for the Junior Women's National Team in 2017. With the Women's National Team, Berg helped lead the Red, White and Blue to three Gold Medal finishes at the World Cup of Softball, two WBSC World Championship Silver Medals and a Silver Medal at the Toronto 2015 Pan American Games. With the Junior Women's National Team, Berg first served as an Assistant Coach in 2013 where the team earned a Silver Medal at the WBSC Junior Women's World Championship.

In her first year as Head Coach of the Junior Women's National Team, Berg helped lead one of the most dominant Junior Women's National Teams in USA Softball history. As a team, the U.S. broke the team home run record with 15 total throughout the banner event while Bubba Nickles established three world championship records, recording home runs (six), RBI (30) and a .690 batting average.

Berg will look to continue her success with the WNT as she was recently named one of the assistant coaches with for the 2019 season.

As a player for the Bulldogs in the mid-1990s, Berg was a four-time All-American whose collegiate career was highlighted by a NCAA Championship title in 1998. She led her squad to three Women's College World Series appearances, two Western Athletic Conference crowns and helped Fresno State to a 206-60 (.774) record in her four-year career.

Berg's name is scattered throughout the NCAA, WAC and Fresno State record books in a number of offensive categories. She is second all-time in career hits in NCAA history (396), is 12th in runs (245) and her 25 career triples tie her for 23rd. Berg finished her career with a .414 batting average and by the time her senior season ended in 1998, she ranked first in school history in triples, runs, hits and stolen bases, while also finishing as the WAC's career leader in triples, runs, hits, at bats, games played and total bases. She is the only Fresno State player to amass 300 or more career hits and also posted a 160-game defensive error-less streak in the field.

A native of Santa Fe Springs, Calif., she received her bachelor's degree in commercial recreation from Fresno State in 1998.

Initiated in 2011, **Beavers without Borders** is a program that offers global service-learning experiences for student-athletes at Oregon State University.

The program has successfully completed eight service projects including trips to Guatemala, Macedonia, Ethiopia, Costa Rica and most recently the Dominican Republic.

Throughout those trips, over 100 student-athletes were able to experience life in a distinct culture, learn about the impact of their work on a community and interact outside of the university context to maximize the intercultural experience.

This year marked the second-straight year that Oregon State Athletics has sponsored two Beavers Without Borders trips. In June, 12 athletes made the trip to the Dominican Republic, with another 12 heading to Guatemala in August. The full list is below:
