Oregon State and Utah conclude their three-game series with a doubleheader Saturday at Goss Stadium at Coleman Field. Game one is scheduled for 12:05 p.m. PT, with game two slated to start approximately 45 minutes after game one ends.

#### Last Game

Adley Rutschman hit his ninth home run of the season and Oregon State scored six runs in the second inning en route to a 6-2 win over Utah to open the series Friday. Brandon Eisert improved to 7-0 on the year, allowing two runs in six innings.

#### Ticket Info Saturday

#### Eisert To .850

The win for Brandon Eisert on Friday pushed the left-hander to a 17-3 career mark at Oregon State. That's an .850 winning percentage, and a No. 6 spot in the Oregon State record books. He is just shy of Bryce Fehmel's .857 winning percentage (30-5).

#### Harvey & Philip

Beau Philip's two-hit effort on Friday gave him 12 multiple-hit games this season, which leads the team. Jake Harvey also had two hits, his second multi-hit effort. Philip's day pushed him to a five-game hit streak.

#### Continuing The Bullpen Note

The Oregon State bullpen has now held opponents to 14 1/3 scoreless innings in the month of April. Overall, the bullpen has given up just 18 earned runs in 117 2/3 innings for an earned run average of 1.38.

#### One More On Eisert

Brandon Eisert struck out seven and did not issue a walk in the win. The junior has struck out 51 to just five walks on the season. That's 10.2 strikeouts for every walk this season.

#### McMahan To Five, Too

Kyler McMahan was 1-for-3 with a run and a walk in the win over Utah. That effort moved his hit streak to five games, where he is 6-for-18 with three runs and two walks.

#### Singles

- Adley Rutschman has 119 career walks, which is one shy of tying Michael Conforto (2012-14), Danny Hayes (2010-13) and Ken Bowen (1984-87) for most in a career.
- Oregon State is ranked in the top seven by all major polls this week. The Beavers have been ranked in the top 10 by at least one major ranking for 42 consecutive weeks.
- OSU is 12-1-1 when scoring first.

Initiated in 2011, **Beavers without Borders** is a program that offers global service-learning experiences for student-athletes at Oregon State University.

The program has successfully completed eight service projects including trips to Guatemala, Macedonia, Ethiopia, Costa Rica and most recently the Dominican Republic.

Throughout those trips, over 100 student-athletes were able to experience life in a distinct culture, learn about the impact of their work on a community and interact outside of the university context to maximize the intercultural experience.

This year marked the second-straight year that Oregon State Athletics has sponsored two Beavers Without Borders trips. In June, 12 athletes made the trip to the Dominican Republic, with another 12 heading to Guatemala in August. The full list is below:

In the spirit of camaraderie, Oregon State University's **Varsity OSU** Association is dedicated to upholding the long tradition of athletic and academic excellence at Oregon State. Varsity OSU serves its membership by enhancing relationships among alumni letter-winners, current student-athletes, and current and former coaches and administrators.

The #DamWorthIt Campaign was started last summer to bring awareness to mental health issues involving student-athletes. The program was spear-headed by former Oregon State gymnast Taylor Ricci, along with current men's soccer player Nathan Braaten.

The #DamWorthIt Campaign has already received national attention including winning a Giant Steps Award from the Institute For Sport and Social Justice and receiving attention from the NCAA APPLE Conference.
