Oregon State takes on Oregon the Civil War Series presented by PacificSource Health Plans, Spirit Mountain Casino, Safeway-Albertsons, Your Local Toyota Dealers and First Interstate Bank. First pitch Tuesday is slated for 5:35 p.m. PT at Goss Stadium at Coleman Field.

Last Game

Preston Jones doubled home the game-winning run in the 11th Saturday to send Oregon State to a DH sweep of Utah, 11-0 and 3-2.

Versus Oregon

Oregon State is looking for its 11th consecutive win over Oregon, which would set a school record. The Beavers equaled the program-record win streak of 10 games originally set from 1922-24 with a 7-6 victory on March 12 at Goss Stadium. OSU is 98-75 in games played in Corvallis.

Ober's Big DH

Ryan Ober had a big day versus Utah on Saturday. The sophomore combined to go 5-for-7 with four runs, four walks and an RBI as the Beavers swept the doubleheader.

1/2 Game Behind 2018

Oregon State is half a game behind the 2018 team's pace through 30 games. The Beavers were 24-6 last season, with a 7-5 record in Pac-12 Conference play.

Another Note On The Bullpen

The Oregon State bullpen gave up a run in the second game Saturday but otherwise held steady. The bullpen has allowed just one earned run in 19 2/3 innings in April, an ERA of 0.46. The pen has allowed just eight hits while striking out 15 to seven walks.

Rutschman's Homer Streak

Adley Rutschman hit a home run in all three games versus Utah, joining Tyler Malone and Alex McGarry as Beavers to homer in three straight games over the last two seasons. Malone hit one in five straight while McGarry's streak stretched to four.

Top 10

Oregon State finds itself in the top 10 by at least one major poll for the 43rd consecutive week - every set of rankings since the start of the 2017 season. OSU has been in the top 10 in all six polls in 41 of those 43 weeks.

Singles

- Adley Rutschman moved into a tie for sixth with Mitch Canham in the Oregon State record books with 152 RBI. He's now also just nine hits shy - he has 192 - for a tie for 10th.
- Oregon State improved to 18-0-1 this season when out-hitting an opponent.
- OSU is 67-9 (.882) at home since 2017.

Initiated in 2011, **Beavers without Borders** is a program that offers global service-learning experiences for student-athletes at Oregon State University.

The program has successfully completed eight service projects including trips to Guatemala, Macedonia, Ethiopia, Costa Rica and most recently the Dominican Republic.

Throughout those trips, over 100 student-athletes were able to experience life in a distinct culture, learn about the impact of their work on a community and interact outside of the university context to maximize the intercultural experience.

This year marked the second-straight year that Oregon State Athletics has sponsored two Beavers Without Borders trips. In June, 12 athletes made the trip to the Dominican Republic, with another 12 heading to Guatemala in August. The full list is below:

In the spirit of camaraderie, Oregon State University's **Varsity OSU** Association is dedicated to upholding the long tradition of athletic and academic excellence at Oregon State. Varsity OSU serves its membership by enhancing relationships among alumni letter-winners, current student-athletes, and current and former coaches and administrators.

The #DamWorthIt Campaign was started last summer to bring awareness to mental health issues involving student-athletes. The program was spear-headed by former Oregon State gymnast Taylor Ricci, along with current men's soccer player Nathan Braaten.

The #DamWorthIt Campaign has already received national attention including winning a Giant Steps Award from the Institute For Sport and Social Justice and receiving attention from the NCAA APPLE Conference.
