Oregon State (14-9, 4-7) vs. Utah (14-9, 5-6)

February 13, 2020 • 6:00 p.m. PT • Gill Coliseum • Corvallis, Ore.

THE GAME: Oregon State will play its second contest of a three-game homestand when it hosts Utah at 6 p.m. on Thursday at Gill Coliseum.

QUICKLY: Oregon State has two wins over Top 25 teams this season; it's the first time with multiple wins over ranked teams since 1998-99 ... The Beavers lead the Pac-12 in free throw percentage at 74.6%; the last time they led the conference in that category was 1990-91 (74.0%) ... Tres Tinkle has scored in double figures in 88 consecutive games; the Oregon State record is 89 straight games by Mel Counts (Dec. 1961 to March 1964) ... Tinkle is the only Pac-12 player in the top 10 in the league in scoring (fourth, 19.0), rebounding (10th, 6.8), assists (10th, 3.7) and steals (first, 2.0) ... Kylor Kelley needs six points to reach 500 in his two-year Oregon State career ... Ethan Thompson has made one 3-pointer in five straight games, the longest current streak on the team ... Zach Reichle has gone 5-for-8 from beyond the arc the last two games ... Jarod Lucas is shooting 91.7% from the free throw line (22-for-24) in Pac-12 play ... Sean Miller-Moore has shot 50% or better from the field in all seven Pac-12 games he has taken a shot.

vs. UTAH: Oregon State and Utah are meeting for the 33rd time with the Utes leading the series 19-13. The home team has dominated the series with the Beavers holding an 11-3 advantage in Corvallis and Utah owning a 14-2 clip in Salt Lake City.

Utah won the first meeting this season, 81-69, on Jan. 2 at the Huntsman Center in the Pac-12 opener for both teams. Tres Tinkle led Oregon State with 19 points, and Ethan Thompson and Zach Reichle added 15 apiece. Timmy Allen posted a double-double for the Utes with 25 points and 10 rebounds.

The Beavers won the only meeting last season, 81-72, on Feb. 2, 2019 in Salt Lake City. Tres Tinkle exploded for 31 points, while Kylor Kelley and Ethan Thompson added 13 points apiece.

AMONG THE PAC-12's ELITE: Tres Tinkle needs 76 points to pass Gary Payton and become the all-time leading scorer in Oregon State history. Tinkle recently moved into the top 10 on the Pac-12 career scoring list.

THE TEAM: Here are some quick-hitters about the 2019-20 Oregon State men's basketball team:

- Oregon State is 23-0 the last three seasons when scoring 80-plus points (6-0 in 2017-18; 7-0 in 2018-19; 10-0 in 2019-20).
- The Beavers are 14-0 when shooting a better percentage from the field than their opponent; 0-9 when the opponent shoots a better percentage.
- Oregon State leads the Pac-12 in free throw percentage at 74.6%; the last time they led the conference in that category was 1990-91 (74.0%).
- The Beavers are shooting 26.7% from beyond the arc (52-for-195) in Pac-12 games; they shot 36.7% from deep (81-for-221) in non-conference play.
- Oregon State is outscoring its opponents 782-668 in the paint.
- In six seasons under Wayne Tinkle, Oregon State is 67-16 (11-2 this season) when leading at halftime and 75-9 (12-2 this season) when leading with five minutes to play.
- Oregon State received a Team Academic Excellence Award from the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Committee for achieving a cumulative team GPA of 3.0 or better during the 2018-19 season.
- Isaiah Johnson, a 6-foot-7, 210-pound forward from Cerritos, Calif., signed a National Letter of Intent to join the program next season. He attends Bishop Montgomery High and is a three-star recruit by Rivals.com and 247 Sports.

TRES TINKLE: Here are some quick hitters about Tres Tinkle, a senior forward from Missoula, Mont.:

- Has scored in double figures in 88 consecutive games, the second longest streak in Oregon State history; Mel Counts holds the record with 89 straight.
- Is the only Pac-12 player in the top 10 in the league in scoring (fourth, 19.0), rebounding (10th, 6.8), assists (10th, 3.7) and steals (first, 2.0).
- Is seventh in the Pac-12 in free throw percentage (81.1%).
- Has at least one steal in 10 consecutive games; it's the second time this season he has a streak of 10 games with a steal.
- In games played at Gill Coliseum, he's averaging 21.1 points, while shooting 50.0% (85-for-170) from the field and 46.9% (30-for-64) from deep.
- In road and neutral site games, he's averaging 16.6 points, while shooting 40.8% (60-for-147) from the field and 20.0% (9-for-45) from deep.
- Set the Oregon State record with 35 consecutive free throws made; the streak ended on his third free throw attempt against USC.
- On Oregon State's career lists, he's fourth in field goals made (696), seventh in 3-pointers made (173) and second in free throws made (532).
- Named Pac-12 Player of the Week on Nov. 11; the fourth career weekly award ties him with A.C. Green and Charlie Sitton for the second most in Oregon State history trailing only Gary Payton's league-record nine.
- Named to the preseason watch lists for the John R. Wooden Award, the Naismith Trophy Men's Player of the Year, the Lute Olson Award, the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award and the Oscar Robertson Trophy.
- Selected to the preseason All-Pac-12 First Team.
- Has earned Pac-12 All-Academic recognition each of the past three years.

KYLOR KELLEY: Here are some quick hitters about Kylor Kelley, a senior forward from Gervais, Ore.:

- Leads the Pac-12 and is second in the nation in blocked shots per game (3.70).
- Has at least one blocked shot in 52 of his 54 career games.
- Is fifth in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage (57.6%).
- Has gone 8-for-9 from the free throw line the last four games.
- Has scored in double figures in 15 of the 23 games; he scored in double figures in 11 of the 31 games last season.
- Holds the school records for career blocked shots (187), single-season blocked shots (104), blocked shots in a game (9), single-season blocked shots average (3.35), consecutive games with multiple blocked shots (15) and consecutive games with at least one blocked shot (30).
- His 85 blocks this season are the second most in Oregon State single-season history.
- Selected preseason All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention.
- Became the fifth Oregon State player to be selected to the Pac-12 All-Defensive Team (Seth Tarver, Jared Cunningham, Eric Moreland, Gary Payton II).
- Selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court in July 2019.

ETHAN THOMPSON: Here are some quick hitters about Ethan Thompson, a junior guard from Los Angeles, Calif.:

- Has made one 3-pointer in five straight games, the longest current streak on the team.
- Is shooting 49.5% (54-for-109) from the field in conference games.
- Is 12th in the Pac-12 in scoring (15.1), eighth in assists (4.0), eighth in assist/turnover ratio (1.57) and 15th in field goal percentage (47.6%).
- Leads the team with 87 assists.
- Is third in the Pac-12 in minutes played per game (34.70).
- Has started all 86 games in his Oregon State career.
- Became the 43rd Oregon State player in history to score 1,000 career points.
- His 1,087 points are the 33rd most in Oregon State history.
- Selected to the preseason All-Pac-12 Second Team.
- Selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court in July 2019.
- Named to the Pac-12 All-Academic Second Team in March 2019.

ZACH REICHLE: Here are some quick hitters about Zach Reichle, a junior guard from Wilsonville, Ore.:

- Has started all 23 games.
- Has scored in double figures in 11 games; he scored in double digits twice as a sophomore and no times as a freshman (61 total games).
- Has grabbed multiple rebounds in nine straight games and dished out multiple assists in five straight games.
- Shooting a team-best 38.9% from beyond the arc (14-for-36) in Pac-12 play.
- Shooting 87.1% from the free throw line (27-for-31) in Pac-12 play.
- Selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court in July 2019.
- Named to the Pac-12 All-Academic First Team in March 2019.

ALFRED HOLLINS: Here are some quick hitters about Alfred Hollins, a junior forward from San Francisco, Calif.:

- Has started 21 of the 23 games this season.
- Went 8-for-9 from the free throw line at California; he was 15-for-21 from the stripe the first 21 games.
- Scored 14 points at California, his most in a game since scoring 16 against San Jose State on Nov. 27.
