March 11, 2020 • Noon PT • T-Mobile Arena • Las Vegas

THE GAME: Oregon State will face Utah at noon on Wednesday in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament at T-Mobile Arena in Las Vegas.

QUICKLY: Oregon State has locked up a winning season for the fourth time in six years under Wayne Tinkle; the Beavers had two winning seasons in the 24 years before Tinkle became the head coach ... Oregon State leads the Pac-12 in free throw percentage (75.2%) and fewest turnovers per game (11.6) ... Tres Tinkle needs two rebounds to pass A.C. Green (880) and move into second on Oregon State's career rebounding list ... Kylor Kelley's 105 blocked shots are the most in Oregon State single-season history; he set the record last season with 104 ... Ethan Thompson (366) needs eight assists to move into Oregon State's top 10 career list ... Zach Reichle grabbed a career-high nine rebounds and tied career bests with six assists and three steals in the last game against California ... Alfred Hollins has scored 483 career points ... Gianni Hunt has a team-best six steals the last four games ... Dearon Tucker played 24 minutes the last seven games; he played two minutes total in the first 11 Pac-12 games.

- Utah leads Oregon State 19-14 in the overall series.
- Oregon State is 0-2 against Utah in neutral site games:
 - March 12, 1966: Utah 70, Oregon State 64 (NCAA West Regional in Los Angeles, Calif.)
 - Dec. 20, 1997: No. 7 Utah 69, Oregon State 61 (at Portland, Ore.)
- Oregon State and Utah split the series this season with each winning at home.
 - Jan. 2 in Salt Lake City: Utah 81, Oregon State 69
 - Feb. 13 in Corvallis: Oregon State 70, Utah 51

THE TEAM: Here are some quick-hitters about the 2019-20 Oregon State men's basketball team:

- Oregon State leads the Pac-12 in free throw percentage at 75.2%; the program record is 75.0% in 1965-66.
- The last time Oregon State led the conference in free throw percentage was 1990-91 at 74.0%.
- The Beavers shot 78.2% from the free throw line in Pac-12 play.
- Oregon State leads the Pac-12 and is 49th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (11.6).
- The Beavers are second in the Pac-12 and 34th in the nation in assist/turnover ratio (1.26).
- Oregon State is 18th in the nation in blocked shots per game (4.93).
- Oregon State is 23-0 the last three seasons when scoring 80-plus points (6-0 in 2017-18; 7-0 in 2018-19; 10-0 in 2019-20).
- In six seasons under Wayne Tinkle, Oregon State is 70-17 (14-3 this season) when leading at halftime and 78-9 (15-2 this season) when leading with five minutes to play.
- Isaiah Johnson, a 6-foot-7, 210-pound forward from Cerritos, Calif., signed a National Letter of Intent to join the program next season. He attends Bishop Montgomery High and is a three-star recruit by Rivals.com and 247 Sports.

TRES TINKLE: Here are some quick hitters about Tres Tinkle, a senior forward from Missoula, Mont.:

- Needs one assist to move into the top 10 on Oregon State's career list; he'll be the only player in the top 10 in scoring, rebounding, assists and steals.
- Is third on Oregon State's career rebounding list with 879 boards; next up is A.C. Green with 880.
- Has scored in double figures in 95 consecutive games, the longest streak in Oregon State history; Mel Counts previously held the record at 89 straight.
- Passed Mel Counts for the most free throws made (566) and free throws attempted (717) in Oregon State history.
- Is third in the Pac-12 in scoring (18.4) and ninth in rebounding (7.0).
- Leads the Pac-12 in steals (1.77).
- His 27 career double-doubles the sixth most in Oregon State history; next up is Gary Payton with 29.
- Set the Oregon State record with 35 consecutive free throws made; the streak ended on his third free throw attempt against USC.
- On Oregon State's career lists, he's third in field goals made (732), third in 3-pointers made (184) and first in free throws made (566).
- Named Pac-12 Player of the Week on Nov. 11; his fourth career weekly award.
- Named to the preseason watch lists for the John R. Wooden Award, the Naismith Trophy Men's Player of the Year, the Lute Olson Award, the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award and the Oscar Robertson Trophy.
- Selected to the preseason All-Pac-12 First Team.
- Has earned Pac-12 All-Academic recognition each of the past three years.

KYLOR KELLEY: Here are some quick hitters about Kylor Kelley, a senior forward from Gervais, Ore.:

- His career field goal percentage of 62.1% is the second best in Oregon State history, trailing only Steve Johnson (67.8%).
- Leads the Pac-12 and is second in the nation in blocked shots per game (3.50).
- Is second in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage (59.7%).
- Has scored in double figures in 19 of the 30 games; he scored in double figures in 11 of the 31 games last season.
- His 105 blocked shots are the most in Oregon State single-season history; he set the record last season with 104.
- His 209 career blocked shots are the most in Oregon State history and the seventh most in Pac-12 history.
- Also holds the school records for blocked shots in a game (9), single-season blocked shots average (3.35), consecutive games with multiple blocked shots (15) and consecutive games with at least one blocked shot (30).
- Selected preseason All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention.
- Became the fifth Oregon State player to be selected to the Pac-12 All-Defensive Team (Seth Tarver, Jared Cunningham, Eric Moreland, Gary Payton II).
- Selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court in July 2019.

ETHAN THOMPSON: Here are some quick hitters about Ethan Thompson, a junior guard from Los Angeles, Calif.:

- Has 44 assists the last seven games (6.3 average); the rest of the team has a combined 56 assists the last seven games.
- Is tied for 12th in the Pac-12 in scoring (14.9), fifth in assists (4.5), sixth in assist/turnover ratio (1.69) and third in minutes played (35.24).
- Has scored in double figures in 25 of the 30 games.
- Has started all 93 games in his Oregon State career.
- Had 13 points and 11 assists against Utah; it's the second time in his career with a points-assists double-double.
- His 1,188 points are the 25th most in Oregon State history.
- Selected to the preseason All-Pac-12 Second Team.
- Selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court in July 2019.
- Named to the Pac-12 All-Academic Second Team in March 2019.

ZACH REICHLE: Here are some quick hitters about Zach Reichle, a junior guard from Wilsonville, Ore.:

- Grabbed a career-high nine rebounds and tied career bests with six assists and three steals in the last game against California.
- Has scored in double figures in 14 games; he scored in double digits twice as a sophomore and no times as a freshman (61 total games).
- Shot a team-best 36.8% from beyond the arc (21-for-57) in Pac-12 play.
- Shot 83.7% from the free throw line (36-for-43) in Pac-12 play.
- Has started all 30 games; he started 13 of his 61 games entering this season.
- Selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court in July 2019.
- Named to the Pac-12 All-Academic First Team in March 2019.

ALFRED HOLLINS: Here are some quick hitters about Alfred Hollins, a junior forward from San Francisco, Calif.:

- Scored six points in the last game against California; it was his most in a game since scoring 14 on Feb. 1 at Berkeley.
- Went 1-for-2 from beyond the arc in the last game against California; he was 0-for-9 from deep in the previous five games.
- Has started 28 of the 30 games.
- Has scored 483 career points.
- Shot 82.4% from the free throw line (15-for-19) in Pac-12 play.
- Scored in double figures in two of the 18 Pac-12 games; he scored in double figures in four of the 12 non-conference games.

JAROD LUCAS: Here are some quick hitters about Jarod Lucas, a freshman guard from Hacienda Heights, Calif.:
