Oregon State (2-10, 0-2) vs. Utah (8-4, 1-1)

December 30, 2021 • 6:00 p.m. PT • Gill Coliseum • Corvallis, Ore.

THE GAME: Oregon State returns to conference play when it hosts Utah at 6 p.m. on Thursday at Gill Coliseum.

QUICKLY: Oregon State has shot better than 50% from the field in each of the last two games; the Beavers shot better than 50% from the field one time in the first 10 games ... Jarod Lucas has gone 16-for-29 from beyond the arc over the last four games ... Lucas has made 16 consecutive free throws; the school record is 35 straight by Tres Tinkle ... Dashawn Davis is averaging 10.0 points, 6.75 assists and 2.25 steals over the last four games ... Warith Alatishe (1.33) and Ahmad Rand (1.17) are sixth and eighth, respectively, in the Pac-12 in blocked shots per game ... Glenn Taylor Jr. is averaging 7.5 points over the last two games, while shooting 62.5% (5-for-8) from the field ... Wayne Tinkle (115) needs one win to pass Bob Hager (115) and become the third-winningest coach in Oregon State history; he would trail only Naismith Memorial Hall of Famers Slats Gill (599) and Ralph Miller (359) ... Gianni Hunt has missed the last three games due to personal reasons ... Rodrigue Andela will miss 8-12 weeks after breaking a bone in his left foot at practice on November 23.

vs. UTAH: Oregon State and Utah are meeting for the 37th time with the Utes holding a 19-17 advantage. The home team has dominated the series with the Beavers holding a 13-3 advantage in Corvallis and Utah owning a 14-3 clip in Salt Lake City.

Oregon State has won four straight games in the series, including a sweep last season -- 74-56 on Feb. 8 in Corvallis and 75-70 on March 3 in Salt Lake City. Warith Alatishe averaged 14.5 points and 9.5 rebounds in the two wins.

LAST SEASON: The 2020-21 season was highlighted by one of the greatest runs in program history:

- Won win nine straight road and neutral-site games that included the first Pac-12 Conference Tournament championship in program history.
- Won an NCAA Tournament game and advanced to the Elite Eight for the first time since 1982.
- Won three games in the NCAA Tournament, tying the 1963 Final Four team for the most tournament wins in program history.
- Ranked No. 20 in the final coaches poll; it's the first time the Beavers have been ranked in any poll since March 13, 1990.
- Defeated five Top 25 teams, the most in a season since the 1975-76 team also won five against ranked opponents.
- Beat a Top 25 team on the road for the first time since 1985 (at No. 21 Oregon).
- Defeated four Top 25 teams at a neutral site; the last time Oregon State beat a ranked opponent at a neutral site came in 1992 (vs. No. 25 BYU in Portland).

THE ROSTER: Here are some quick-hitters about the 2021-22 Oregon State men's basketball team:

- The roster has five seniors, eight juniors, one sophomore and one freshman.
- There are seven new scholarship players: one senior transfer (Xzavier Malone-Key), five junior transfers (Dexter Akanno, Dashawn Davis, Chol Marial, Ahmad Rand, Tre' Williams) and one true freshman (Glenn Taylor Jr.)
- Six letterwinners from last season are gone (Julien Franklin, Joey Potts, Zach Reichle, Tariq Silver, Ethan Thompson, Dearon Tucker).
- There are three starters returning (Warith Alatishe, Jarod Lucas, Roman Silva) and two starters lost (Zach Reichle, Ethan Thompson).

THE TEAM: Here are some quick-hitters about the 2021-22 Oregon State men's basketball team:

- Oregon State is 29-2 the last five seasons when scoring 80-plus points (6-0 in 2017-18; 7-0 in 2018-19; 10-0 in 2019-20; 5-1 in 2020-21; 1-1 in 2021-22).
- In eight seasons under Wayne Tinkle, Oregon State is 84-20 when leading at halftime and 97-12 when leading with five minutes to play.

WARITH ALATISHE: Here are some quick hitters about Warith Alatishe, a senior forward from Houston, Texas:

- Has scored 20-plus points three times in the 12 games; he scored 20-plus points one time in the 33 games last season.
- Is 3-for-9 from beyond the arc this season; he went 1-for-14 from deep last season.
- Is seventh in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage (.540) and sixth in blocked shots per game (1.33).
- Selected to the preseason All-Pac-12 First Team.
- Became the first Oregon State player to be named the Pac-12 Tournament Most Outstanding Player.
- Named Pac-12 All-Defensive Honorable Mention last season.

MAURICE CALLOO: Here are some quick hitters about Maurice Calloo, a senior forward from Windsor, Ontario:

- Started the first four games of the season and was averaging a team-best 12.8 points (8-for-17 from beyond the arc; 13-for-14 from the free throw line).
- Since then he missed the Princeton game with knee tendonitis and the UC Davis game due to COVID-19 protocols; in the last eight games he has scored 14 total points, while shooting 25% from the field and 0-for-8 from deep.
- Had career highs with 20 points and five 3-pointers at Tulsa.
- Leads the team in free throw percentage at 94.4% (17-for-18).
- Finished fifth in the Pac-12 in 3-point field goal percentage (.420) last season; the percentage of 42.0% (34-for-81) is the seventh best in Oregon State single-season history.

ROMAN SILVA: Here are some quick hitters about Roman Silva, a senior center from Rancho Cucamonga, Calif.:

- Is struggling with knee tendonitis that has limited him to 12.5 minutes, 3.3 points and 48.3% shooting (14-for-29) from the field.
- Averaged 16.2 minutes, 5.6 points and shot a team-best 65.3% (77-for-118) from the field last season.
- Had his best game of this season with nine points and five rebounds in 17 minutes against Nicholls.
- Had career highs with 16 points and eight field goals against Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament last season; went 8-for-8 from the field.
- Selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court in 2020.

RODRIGUE ANDELA: Here are some quick hitters about Rodrigue Andela, a senior forward from Yaounde, Cameroon:

- Will miss 8-12 weeks after breaking a bone in his left foot during practice on Tuesday, November 23.
- Scored in double figures in two of his seven games this season; he scored in double figures once in his 32 games last season.
- Had career highs with 16 points and six field goals against Wake Forest.
- Had then-career highs with 13 points and five field goals against Oregon in the Pac-12 Tournament last season.

GIANNI HUNT: Here are some quick hitters about Gianni Hunt, a junior guard from Lakewood, Calif.:

- Missed the last three games due to personal reasons.
- Is averaging 24.2 minutes per game this season; he averaged 20.2 minutes last season and 13.9 minutes as a true freshman.
- Shot 37.1% (26-for-70) from beyond the arc last season; has struggled from deep early this season at 17.4% (4-for-23).
- Had 10 points, two rebounds and two assists against Colorado in the Pac-12 Championship game last season.

JAROD LUCAS: Here are some quick hitters about Jarod Lucas, a junior guard from Hacienda Heights, Calif.:

- Has gone 16-for-29 from beyond the arc over the last four games and moved up to ninth in the Pac-12 in 3-point field goal percentage (42.5%).
- Has made 16 consecutive free throws over the last three games.
- Has scored 20-plus points in back-to-back games for the first time in his career (25 vs. Texas A&M; 24 vs. Nicholls).
- Is fifth in the Pac-12 in 3-point field goals made per game (2.58).
- Averaging a team-high 30.5 minutes per game.
- Tied a career high with five 3-pointers against Texas A&M and Arizona; he made five triples in three different games entering this season.
- Selected to the preseason All-Pac-12 Second Team.
- Selected to the 2021 Pac-12 Winter Academic Honor Roll.

DEXTER AKANNO: Here are some quick hitters about Dexter Akanno, a junior guard from Valencia, Calif.:

- Has played in all 12 games, with five starts, and is averaging 3.3 points and 1.7 rebounds in 13.8 minutes per game.
- Is 10-for-20 on two-point attempts and 4-for-20 on 3-point attempts.
- Had season highs with 10 points and four rebounds against Wake Forest.
- Attended Marquette University the last two seasons.
- Played in 12 games and averaged 0.7 points and 0.6 rebounds in 5.3 minutes per game as a redshirt freshman last season.

DASHAWN DAVIS: Here are some quick hitters about Dashawn Davis, a junior quard from the Bronx, N.Y.:

- Has played in 11 games with seven starts and is third on the team in scoring at 8.5 points per game.
- Is second in the Pac-12 in assists (4.64), fourth in steals (1.36) and seventh in assist/turnover ratio (1.89).
- Averaging 10.0 points, 6.75 assists and 2.25 steals over the last four games; he averaged 7.6 points, 3.0 assists and 0.75 steals in the first eight games.
- Played the last two seasons at Trinity Valley Community College.
- Named a NJCAA First-Team All-American following his sophomore season.

ISAIAH JOHNSON: Here are some quick hitters about Isaiah Johnson, a sophomore forward from Cerritos, Calif.:

- Has played in 10 of the 12 games and is averaging 1.3 points and 1.2 rebounds in 6.4 minutes per game.
- Is 6-for-12 from the field and 1-for-2 from the free throw line.
- Had four points and four rebounds in 12 minutes against Nicholls.
- Played in 16 games last season and averaged 1.4 points, 0.9 rebounds, 0.4 assists, 0.5 steals and 0.3 blocked shots in 6.1 minutes.

XZAVIER MALONE-KEY: Here are some quick hitters about Xzavier Malone-Key, a senior guard from Philadelphia, Pa.:

- Got first career start in the last game against Nicholls and grabbed a seasonhigh seven rebounds.
- Has played in eight of the 12 games and is averaging 3.6 points and 1.6 rebounds in 9.3 minutes per game.
- Has scored 21 points the last three games; he scored eight total points in his first five games.
- Attended Farleigh Dickinson the last three years after transferring from Rider University; opted to sit out the 2020-21 season.
- Started 26 games in 2019-20 and averaged 12.3 points, 3.0 rebounds and 2.2 assists, while shooting 48.1 percent from the field.

AHMAD RAND: Here are some quick hitters about Ahmad Rand, a junior guard from Lincolnton. Ga.:

- Has played in all 12 games and is averaging 5.9 points, while shooting a teambest 57.7% (30-for-52) from the field.
- Posted first career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds against UC Davis.
- Scored a career-high 15 points in 15 minutes against Samford.
