LITTLE ROCK IS TWO-FOR-TWO

...when facing Southeastern Conference opponents so far this year. When the Trojans held off Auburn in a 57-49 win on Nov. 24, Little Rock claimed its SECond win over the preeminent league as that victory followed a 56-40 dispatching of Vanderbilt on Nov. 12.

SO IS SALI

Little Rock forward Sali Kourouma has repeated as the Sun Belt's Player of the Week. Kourouma averaged 28.0 points and 8.0 rebounds per game as the Trojans claimed a pair of wins over Memphis and Arkansas-Pine Bluff. She scored 56 points in all, including a career-high 32 points in Little Rock's 55-50 win over Memphis. The redshirt sophomore shot an impressive 43.2% (19-for-44) and a dominating 78.9% (15 of 19) from the charity stripe on the week while averaging 28.0 minutes per game. She recorded five steal and one block, helping the Trojans prevent Memphis from hitting a field goal in the final six-plus minutes of the game last Thursday.

LITTLE ROCK STANDS ALONE...

...as the only non-P5 team so far this season to record multiple wins over Southeastern Conference opponents. While some other teams have managed to claim wins against the competitive league, Little Rock is the only team to have found repeated success against the SEC. Two wins just means more than one.

TROJANS ON THE BOARDS

The Trojans are relentless on the glass. That is why Little Rock ranks 119th in the nation in offensive rebound rate (34.5%), which measures the percentage of offensive rebound opportunities actually rebounded. The Trojans also rank 156th in the nation in offensive rebounds per game (12.2).

Little Rock extends its efforts to total rebounds as the Trojans' total rebound rate of 52.2% ranks 115th in the nation in the top third.

FORGET THE MATCH, THE TOTALS ADD UP

Those percentages too complicated? Then just look at the totals. Little Rock ranks 89th in the nation in defensive rebounds (126), 90th in the nation in total rebounds (187) and 96th in the country in offensive rebounds (61). All three of those marks have Little Rocks Team ranked in the top third in the nation.

LIMIT THE MISTAKES

With an average of just 15.0 turnovers per game, Little Rock is in the top third in the nation - ranking 78th overall - in the fewest turnovers it is committing per game. That also includes an 18.8% turnover rate, a mark that ranks 115th in the country. The turnover rate is the percentage of plays where a turnover is committed.

THE BALL ISN'T GETTING THROUGH THE LIQUE

Angelique Francis will not be denied. The junior forward is in the top 10% in the country in all manners of rebouding, particularly in total rebounds and defensive rebounds. Additionally, her turnover rate of 0.2 per game ranks 52nd in the nation. You can try going up against her for the ball, but we don't advise it.

- ★ Abilene Christian enters the weekend with a 3-1 mark. The Wildcats had won three straight before falling at Kansas State on Tuesday, 93-53.
- ★ ACU ranks fifth in the nation and first in the WAC in 3-pointers made per game (11.0).
- ★ That's primarily thanks to Kamryn Mraz and Taylor Morgan. Mraz ranks ninth nationally by averaging 60.0% from beyond the arc while Mrogan ranks 16th nationally with a 57.1% clip from long range.
- ★ Taylor Morgan leads the nation in field goal percentage (100.0%), having not missed a shot at the free throw line this season.
- ★ Abilene Christian ranks 52nd nationally in scoring offense (78.0) and 63rd nationally in scoring margin (17.5).
- ★ The Wildcats rank 37th in the nation in assists per game (17.5) and 54th in the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio.

Sali Kourouma is off to a hot start this year and the Sun Belt better take notice. Entering this game, Kourouma leads the Sun Belt in several categories and has been the league's most prolific scorer. She's had a hot start to the season, ranking as the nation's sixth-leading scorer and she leads the Sun Belt in total points, points per game and field goals made.

VALUE ADD

Sali Kourouma joining Little Rock's team has been one of the most impactful additions to any Sun Belt team this year, scoring 20 or more points in three of her first five games and instantly becoming a difference maker on the court.

Not just that, her 43.7% Usage Percentage - detailing the percentage of plays during her time on the floor that a player used by either shooting, getting to the line or committing a turnover - leads in the nation and the Sun Belt Conference. Additionally, Kourouma ranks 34th in the nation in Player Efficiency Rating (40.5) which is an advanced statistic that estimates the per minute value of a player from the box score stats.

CAICEDO APPROACHING THE TOP 10

Little Rock point guard Mayra Caicedo enters this game needing only 30 assists to reach the top-10 in Little Rock's record book for career assists. The Buga, Colombia native has 205 assists entering this game after recording her 200th career assist in Little Rock's 57-49 win over Auburn. She needs only 13 assists to match Taylor Gault's 2018 assists to rank 12th in school history. *See a list of record book updates on Page 6.*

YOU DIDN'T REALIZE MAYRA WAS THIS FAST

Mayra Caicedo is fast, really fast. But she set a new standard for speed becoming the fastest player in Little Rock history to record 200 career assists. Caicedo recorded her 200th career assist in a 57-49 win over Auburn on Nov. 24, 2021, her 31st game played in the Maroon and Silver. That was faster than Heather Morris recording her 200th career assist in her 47th game played.

IT WASN'T THE FIRST...

When Little Rock beat Auburn on Nov. 24, that win was big but wasn't necessarily be a first. With the win over Vanderbilt already on the books, the Trojans victory over Auburn marked the third time in program history that Little Rock has registered multiple wins over Power 5 teams in a single season. It first happened in 2008 (Oklahoma State, at Ole Miss) and then again in 2014 (at LSU, Oklahoma).

In just her second game wearing a Little Rock uniform, Sali Kourouma was on fire for the Trojans. Kourouma scored 30 points and led Little Rock to a 56-40 win at Vanderbilt on Nov. 12. That performance marked the first 30-point scoring outing for a Trojan player since Kyra Collier in 2018 and Kourouma was the first Sun Belt player to score 30-or-more points against a Division I opponent this season.

She topped that the following week with a 32-point performance against Memphis on Nov. 18 at the Jack Stephens Center. She posted her first career double-double in that game against the Tigers as she also grabbed 10 rebounds.

BACK WHERE SHE BELONGS

Basketball is back and so is Mayra Caicedo - and the offense she can create on the court. Entering this game, the Colombian speedster leads the Sun Belt in minutes played and assists while ranking among the national leaders in both categories.

ANCHOR UP?

With a dominating 56-40 win over the Commodores on Nov. 12, Little Rock registered a sweep of the homeand-home series between the Trojans and Vanderbilt. That marked the second straight year Little Rock has topped Vandy and brings Little Rock's all-time record against the 'Dores to 2-0.

WELCOME TO THE ROCK

It didn't take long for some of the newcomers to get acclimated to their place within the program as the 2021-22 season go tunderway. After just one game in a Trojans uniform, Raziya Potter (16 points), Sali Kourouma (15 points) and Amari Conn (7 points) showed they have the ability to make a difference on the court. Even more impressive, they did that against a Missouri State team that has been to back-to-back Sweet 16s and is the preseason pick to win the Missouri Valley Conference.

MY-OH-MAYRA

Mayra Caicedo has been etching her name in the Little Rock record book but on Jan. 29, 2021, she wrote her name in the Sun Belt record book as well. With a 17-assist performance in Little Rock's 71-36 win over ULM last season, Caicedo tied the Sun Belt (overall) record for most assists in a game, matching the 17 assists recorded by UAB's Kitty Price against Alabama-Huntsville on Feb. 6, 1986.

It also set a record for the most assists in a Sun Belt Conference game, surpassing the 16 assists by Kortni Jones (Middle Tennessee) against Troy on Jan. 25, 2012. For her efforts, she was named the Mid-Major National Player of the Week by College Sports Madness. Yet the speedy point guard is still searching for her first Sun Belt Player of the Week honor... Regardless, we're thankful for the national honors.

OFFENSIVE GLASS

Krystan Vornes is becoming a relentless worker in the paint. The Trojan fifth-year enters the season ranked 10th all-time in Little Rock history with an average of 2.2 offensive rebounds per game. Vornes will look to improve upon that number when the Trojans face Vanderbilt Friday evening.

Last season, Vornes averaged 3.4 offensive rebounds per game - a mark that ranks second in school history. Her average of 8.9 rebounds throughout the season ranks third in program history.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Krystan Vornes made the most of her senior year and was a cause for concern for Little Rock opponents. With her engine kicked into high gear in her "final" season, Vornes has churned out nine double-doubles. This is notable as Vornes had not recorded a double-double prior to the 2020-21 season.

Now she can try to pick up where she left off as she returns for her "Covid" year, a welcome opportunity after suffering a season-ending knee injury in the first four minutes of the Sun Belt Conference Tournament last season.

NOT HER FIRST ACTION IN THE NATURAL STATE

After two seasons at New Mexico and in the Mountain West Conference, Azaria Robinson has joined Little Rock's Team. But when the Trojans tip off the season on Nov. 9, it won't be her first action in the Natural State. As a member of the Lobos, Robinson played at Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 17, 2020 and saw six minutes of action. She'll see the Golden Lions once more on Nov. 16 when UAPB visits the Jack Stephens Center.

FIRST OPPONENTS, NOW TEAMMATES

Azaria Robinson is not the only Mountain West player to transfer so she could be part of Little Rock's Team. Raziya Potter spent three seasons at San Jose State (albeit the Spartans only played four games in a COVID-shortened 2020-21 season) and faced off against Robinson in Mountain West play. Now the tandem will have to work together as part of the Trojans roster.

MENTAL HEALTH MATTERS

Standing at 5-foot-11, Little Rock forward Angelique Francis may not be the tallest player on the floor but she casts an imposing figure. With her muscles bulging out of her sleeveless jersey, there is little doubt who is the most physical player on the court. But look closely at those sleeveless arms and you will see the fading scars of a past that gives a glimpse at the adversity she is still overcoming to this day.

Those scars tell the story of a past that has been focused on survival between abusive relationships and multiple suicide attempts. It is a story she is just now coming to terms with in order to tell others, refocusing her life from merely trying to survive to wanting to help others mired in the darkness from which she has broken free. *Read more about Angelique's story here*.

JOE FOLEY

Head Coach | 19th Season | Central Arkansas (1979)

Joe Foley, the 2010, 2011, 2015, 2017 and 2018 Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year and 2010 Russell Athletic/WBCA Regional Coach of the Year, has led the Little Rock Women's Basketball program to 20win seasons 11 of the last 14 years, outright Sun Belt Conference West Division titles in the final six years the Sun Belt had divisions, three Sun Belt regular-season championships, post-season appearances in 10 of the last 12 years - including five NCAA berths - and Sun Belt Conference Tournament titles in 2011, 2012, 2015 and 2018. Foley has recorded an 816-285-274 (.741) career record and a 345-193 (.638) record at Little Rock as he begins his 19th season in 2021-22. He has led the Trojans to the semifinals of the Sun Belt Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years.

The Hall of Fame coach reached a remarkable milestone during the 2019-20 season when he recorded his 800th career victory - one of only five active head coaches to reach that plateau. In that season, Kyra Collier claimed first team All-Sun Belt honors marking the seventh consecutive year a Trojan has been represented on the first team. Little Rock has placed a Trojan on the league's all-conference teams list every single season Foley has guided Little Rock's Team.

Foley earned his 700th career victory in the NCAA Tournament's first round in 2015, and he signed a contract extension in April 2015 that will keep him as the Trojans' head coach through the 2023-24 season.

In his tenure at Little Rock, Foley has compiled the most overall wins (29) and conference victories (18) in a season while producing the school's first All-Sun Belt Conference selection in Alicia Cash in 2004. He also recruited back-to-back Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year winners in Renee Renz (2006) and Kim Sitzmann (2007). No other Sun Belt Conference school has achieved this feat. Foley also coached the school's first-ever Honorable Mention All-America honoree in Chastity Reed in 2010. His Trojan student-athletes have earned 23 All-Conference selections.

Foley began his coaching career at the high school level as both the boys and girls basketball coach at Oxford (Ark.) High School from 1979-81, and then at Morrilton High School as an assistant for the boys team until 1984.

Foley has earned many personal accolades during his career. He has been named national coach of the year twice, region or district coach of the year seven times, chosen to be on the 1994 United States Olympic Festival coaching staff and was inducted into the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame as a member of the class of 2002.

Foley earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Central Arkansas in 1979. He is married to the former Chris Fields of Alpena, Ark. The couple has two children, C.J. and Miranda.



LITTLE ROCK, Ark. - Missouri State averaged over 103 points in its two exhibitions and entered Tuesday's season-opener looking to prove it belonged in the Top 25 polls after back-to-back Sweet 16 runs. They left thankful for a fourth-quarter run that prevented the Lady Bears from being another victim of Little Rock's suffocating defense.

The host Trojans (0-1) threatened an early-season upset with a late third quarter lead but eventually fell to the near unanimous choice to win the Missouri Valley Conference in a 76-62 battle Tuesday night in front of 1,743 at the Jack Stephens Center.

For Little Rock, it was an all-out effort that saw the Maroon and Silver challenge Missouri State from the opening tip. The Lady Bears only briefly flirted with a double-digit lead a couple times before Little Rock would battle back and bring the Bears back to the reality that is Trojan Basketball.

But after losing two starters to injury in the fourth quarter — both Dariel Johnson and Mayra Caicedo are expected to return for Little Rock's next game at Vanderbilt - Missouri State (1-0) was able to use numbers to its advantage and pull away for the win.

New faces led the way for the Trojans as Raziya Potter led Little Rock's Team with 16 points while Sali Kourouma added another 15. Krystan Vornes, making her first appearance since a season-ending knee injury in March, flirted with a double-double by scoring 10 points and grabbing eight boards.

Overall, Little Rock shot 40% (26-for-65) from the field and ended the game even with Missouri State in rebounds, 34-34. The Trojans refused to back down in a physical game that saw seven lead changes.

NASHVILLE - At the end of the first guarter, Vanderbilt was searching for answers on how to stop Little Rock's Sali Kourouma. Thirty minutes later, they were still had no solution.

Kourouma, in just her second game in a Little Rock uniform, scored 30 points and kept the host Commodores (1-1) at bay in a 56-40 win for the Trojans (1-1) at Vanderbilt. That included an 11-point outburst by Kourouma in the first quarter to go along with a 9-for-16 performance from the field and hitting 10 of 12 free throws in a dominating per-

The win gives Little Rock a sweep of the home-and-home series with Vanderbilt that began with an 82-74 win last season in Little Rock. It marked the second straight day a Sun Belt team had toppled a program from the Southeastern Conference after Georgia Southern beat Auburn Thursday night. Auburn visits Little Rock on Nov. 24.

Little Rock shot 40 percent from the field for the second straight game but even more impressive was the Trojans defense which turned 20 Vanderbilt turnovers into 22 points. The Maroon and Silver further punished the Commodores, going to the line eight times and connecting on 13 of 16 free throw attempts (81.3 percent).

Kourouma scored 15 points in her Little Rock debut and doubled that output Friday night against Vanderbilt. She was perfect from the free throw line for three quarters, going 10 of 12 from the charity stripe

Mayra Caicedo scored eight points and dished out five assists while Dariel Johnson and Krystan Vornes both scored six. Angelique Francis led the Trojans in rebounds with six. The tall Trojans controlled the pace of play in the paint, out-scoring Vandy 24-14 in that zone.

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. - Mayra Caicedo couldn't miss on Wednesday. Little Rock's senior point guard was 5-for-5 from the field, dished out eight assists and hit two critical free throws in the final minute as the Trojans topped Auburn, 57-49, for their second win over a Power 5 program this season.

Prior to Caicedo's trip to the line with 58 seconds to play, Little Rock (4-1) had struggled from the charity stripe, shooting just 38% at the time. But in that final minute, everything changed. Caicedo drilled her two shots, the Trojans hit 5 of 6 down the stretch and Little Rock turned a one-possession game into a nearly double-digit win.

It marked the second straight game the Maroon and Silver used a lock down defense to shutdown a comeback attempt after preventing Memphis from scoring a field goal in the final six minutes last week. This time, Auburn (2-3) fell prey to the defensive efforts orchestrated by Little Rock Head Coach Joe Foley. That defense made up for what the team described as an offensive effort that still needed work.

"We got the win but we know we have to be better," Caicedo said. "We will learn from this and use it to get better. I'm glad we got the win and thought we played well in some areas."

Despite the desire to improve, Little Rock shot 45.8% from the field, forced 17 turnovers and blocked three shots. But the Trojans entered the final minute of play having allowed Auburn to creep back within reach after leading by as much as 13 earlier in the half.

Krystan Vornes was a big part of the outcome for Little Rock, registering her first double-double of the season as she recorded 14 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. Sali Kourouma, the nation's fourth-leading scorer, led all players with 16 points and shot over 58% from the field.
