QUICK HITS

- Max Abmas was the nation's highest scorer on December 20 recording 32 points at South Dakota. Abmas went 50 percent overall and from the three-point line in the league opener. It was the second time this season and ninth time in his career he's recorded 30-plus points in a game. He played all 40 minutes at South Dakota.
- Abmas (21.3 ppg) and Weaver (11.0) both score in double figures to lead the Golden Eagles offense, which ranks 26th in the NCAA at 81.1 points per game.
- Behind his season-best 38 points in the Mayor's Cup win over Tulsa, Abmas now ranks 7th in the nation in points per game and is third the country making 4.3 3-pointers a game. The junior recently moved past Eric Perry (1996-2000) for fifth in program history in career triples and has 234 in his tenure. He is currently 14th all-time in scoring with 1,368 career points.
- ORU is hitting 12.8 triples per game, second in the nation, thanks to a school-record 21 against Southwestern Christian and 19 versus Tulsa. The team has made double-digit 3-pointers in 10 of 12 outings this season.
- The Golden Eagles currently rank 43rd in the NCAA pulling down 40.5 rebounds a contest.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

- ORU has battled the Jackrabbits to an 11-17 record in the all-time series, including an 90-88 win when the teams last met in the Summit League semifinal. ORU is 3-9 all-time at in Brookings.
- The Jacks are coming off an 89-57 win against Kansas City Monday to open Summit League play. SDSU sits 9th in the country in field-goal percentage and third in scoring offense. The squad from Brookings, South Dakota, also sits 3rd in total rebounds and 9th in field-goal percentage defense.
- Baylor Scheierman is second in the nation and leads the Summit League in defensive rebounds per game. Noah Freidel is second in the league in points per game at 18.0. Douglas Wilson ranks 11th in the nation in total free-throws made.

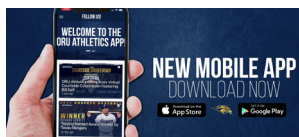

> VETERAN COACH

Although ORU is Mills' first NCAA head coaching job, Mills has been in the Division I ranks since 2002 when he joined Rice as the director of operations. Before coming to ORU, Mills served on the staff of Scott Drew at Baylor for 14 years.

> POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE

Mills and the Golden Eagles made their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2021 reaching the Sweet 16. While at Baylor, Mills made nine postseason appearances, including seven NCAA Tournaments. Baylor made the Elite Eight twice and made two additional appearances in the Sweet 16. The Bears were the 2012-13 NIT champions.

ABOUT ORU

Founded in 1963 by evangelist Oral Roberts, ORU is a 400-acre campus located in South Tulsa. ORU boasts a total enrollment of over 4,000 students from all 50 states and more than 30 foreign countries. Some famous ORU alums include entertainer Kathy Lee Gifford, Pulitzer-prize nominated author Clifton Taulbert and two-time NCAA track & field national champion and 2008 Olympic silver medalist Andreotti Bain, 2012 NCAA outdoor national champion Jack Whitt and 2012 Olympians Prince Mumba (Track) and Dominique Allen (Women's Basketball). "The Simpsons" creator Matt Groening briefly attended ORU, and subsequently, many of the characters on the show are modeled after former ORU students and staff members. In fact, if you look closely over Ned Flanders' fireplace, his college diploma reads "Oral Roberts University".

ABOUT THE SUMMIT LEAGUE

Through 38 years of Division I athletics, The Summit League offers 19 championship sports and has a combined enrollment of around 98,000 at nine institutions, including four located in top 60 U.S. metropolitan populations and two land-grant universities. Member institutions include: the University of Denver, University of Missouri-Kansas City, University of North Dakota, North Dakota State University, University of Nebraska Omaha, Oral Roberts University, University of South Dakota, South Dakota State University and Western Illinois University.

The Summit League was previously known as the Mid-Continent Conference before undergoing a rebrand in 2007. The Summit League has produced 15 NCAA National Champions with over 125 All-Americans and 100 Academic All-Americans including numerous student-athletes competing at the highest professional level.

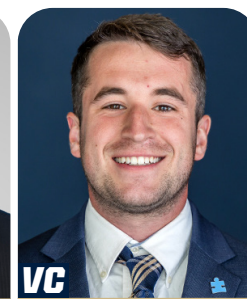
