



#### INTELLECTUALLY

Last year ORU student-athletes had a 3.43 GPA, 90% Graduation Rate and 1,000 APR with five student-athletes selected as their academic department's Student of the Year. They were part of an ORU graduating class of which 92% were employed or accepted into graduate school. Business management graduates scored in the top 1% in the nation. Business finance students scored in the top 5% in the nation.



#### SOCIALLY

100% of our student-athletes participated in over 3,000 hours of community service projects in the Tulsa area. ORU student-athletes serve in leadership positions in virtually every area of campus.



#### **SPIRITUALLY**

100% of our atudent-athletes are involved in a weekly Bible study led by our coaches and team chaplains. Student-athletes from all 16 of our teams are involved in a Sunday evening prayer walk at the ORU track, and over 75 of our student-athletes attend a weekly FCA group led by student-athletes.




#### MISSIONS







Our recent athletic accomplishments have provided invaluable national visibility for ORU and given us the opportunity to build a brand new athletic center that will forever change ORU Athletics.

#### TO PROVIDE STUDENT-ATHLETES AND COACHES WITH THE NECESSARY RESOURCES TO COMPETE NATIONALLY

Private support is the lifeblood of ORU Athletics. Financial stability is necessary to provide scholarship support and academic services for our 256 Student-Athletes and help them make the most of their educational opportunities and earn their college degrees.

#### **TICKETING REVENUE IS NOT ENOUGH**

Men's Basketball, Women's Basketball and Baseball ticketing revenues are not enough to adequately support all 16 of our intercollegiate athletic programs. Rising scholarship costs, escalating team travel expenses and the need for modern facilities require new sources of revenue.

#### MOST IMPORTANTLY OUR STUDENT-ATHLETES

At Oral Roberts University, we have student-athletes who are changing the world and taking full advantage of their opportunities. Our student-athletes have won Olympic medals, conference championships, NCAA Championships and have graduated with GPAs at the highest levels in memory. These opportunities are not possible without your private support.

## THE DREAM IS A REALITY

ORU Athletics recently began construction on the Mike Carter Athletic Center. This 50,000 sq. ft. building will house two regulation size practice gyms, one for both Men's Basketball and Women's Basketball. This building will put ORU facilities among the best, not only in the Summit League, but in the nation. The projected timeline projects a February 2023 finish date.

- The facility will provide ORU student-athletes with a state-of-the-art 10,000 sq. ft. strength and conditioning center which will house brand new machines, weights, racks, indoor turf, cardio equipment, and a new fueling station for all athletes.
- The second floor will be the new home of the ELI Academic Center and will allow student-athletes access to group study areas, individual study areas, computer labs, private conference rooms, and private study rooms. There will also be a 2,000 sq. ft. team meeting room located on this floor that can hold up to 100 people for meetings, film review, or scouting.
- The facility will house two practice gyms with full-size regulation basketball courts that will be separated, giving ORU men's and women's basketball individual practice space and the ability to practice at the same time. The gyms will feature video technology and replay for instant film review.
- The third floor will be the new home of all basketball operations, coaches offices, athletic administration, and a new athletic conference room that overlooks CityPlex.

#### **FUTURE PROJECTS**

On the horizon will be the Mabee Center south lobby renovation. This space will be home to a new basketball locker room/lounge, as well as a state-of-the-art sports medicine facility equipped to fulfill each and every need of the modern student-athlete. This space will feature a hot tub, cold tub, underwater treadmill, x-ray machine, and more to allow student-athletes maximum time to rest, recover, and heal for the best performance possible!



Membership to this group requires a \$5,000 donation. All donations to the Champions Club are 100% tax deductable.

#### GOLDEN EAGLE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

With the Athletic Department's additional need for private funding, a percentage of student-athlete scholarships need to be funded in order to be retained. The Golden Eagle Club is looking for donors who can make a scholastic impact both on an annual basis and for the creation of a Scholarship Endowment Program to provide scholarship support perpetuity. All donations to the GESF are 100% tax deductable.

#### CAPITAL PROJECTS

The Golden Eagle Club provides substantial support for the construction and renovation of ORU's first class athletic facilities. All donations to Capital Projects are 100% tax deductible.

#### GENERAL DONATIONS - UNRESTRICTED

Non-designated gifts provide additional funding and help ORU compete on a national level. These gifts help fill the gaps where needed.

#### GENERAL DONATIONS - SPORT SPECIFIC RESTRICTION

Philanthropic gifts to benefit ORU's sports programs truly do make a difference and are sincerely appreciated by the coaches and student-athletes. Many teams at Oral Roberts University rely on private support for locker room improvements, equipment purchases and many other expenses not covered in their operating budgets. All donations to the sports program giving are 100% tax deductible.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

#### Do I need to purchase a ticket for my children, even if they are in and out of their seats?

No! All kids 13 and under are free. A kids in free ticket is required for admission.

#### Are there any contactless tickets available for games?

Yes, for our sports that require tickets, we have both online ticket ordering options as well as an all-digital ticket ordering option available. Fans can find out more about the all-digital, flash seat tickets at this link: https://mabeecenter.com/axs/

#### What are the changes to Golden Eagle Game Night?

Golden Eagle Game night is no longer tied to your seat donation. These changes make Golden Eagle Game Night partially tax deductible. All season ticket holders are able to purchase Golden Eagle Game Night passes.

#### When are season tickets and parking passes mailed?

Golden Eagle Club information, as well as basketball season tickets and priority parking passes are mailed in October. Baseball tickets and priority parking passes, available to Grand Slam Club members, are mailed in February.

#### My company has a matching gift program. What do I need to do to ensure it is applied to my annual donation?

Contact the Golden Eagle Club and we will assist you in your matching gift request. Your company's matching gift form should be attached to your Golden Eagle Club donor form.

#### How do I get Summit League and/or NCAA Tournament tickets?

It is the goal of the Golden Eagle Club to offer an option to purchase tickets for post season games to all donors and season ticket holders based on availability.

#### How do I improve my seat?

For non-Golden Eagle Club members, you can improve your seating location to one of the eight center sections (101-104, 109-112) by providing a per seat donation as required by the Golden Eagle Club

#### **ALWAYS ASK BEFORE YOU ACT**

At Oral Roberts University, compliance with NCAA rules is of the utmost importance. As a member of the NCAA and the Summit League, the University is responsible for the actions of its coaches, staff, as well as alumni, boosters and fans. It is vital to the mission of the Athletic Department and the University that all NCAA, Summit League and University rules pertaining to boosters are strictly adhered to.

#### WHO IS A BOOSTER?

A booster is any representative of an institution's athletic interests. This includes: a person who has made fincancial contributions to the Golden Eagle Club, ORU Athletics or to an individual ORU Athletic supporter, a corporate sponsor of ORU Athletics, and a person who has purchased ORU Basketball or Baseball season tickets. A person who has been involved in promoting ORU's Athletic programs. Once an individual is identified as a booster, the person retains that identity forever.

#### BASICS FOR ALL BOOSTERS TO REMEMBER

Tickets: Boosters cannot receive complimentary admission to any ORU sporting event from an ORU student-athlete, unless the student-athlete is a family member.

Recruiting: Boosters cannot be involved in the recruitment process in any way. Boosters may continue pre-existing relationships with family and friends provided the booster does not encourage enrollment at ORU to participate in athletics.

Employment of Student-Athletes: A student-athlete may be employed by a booster so long as the following conditions are met. 1.) The student-athlete is only paid for actual work performed. 2.) The student-athlete is paid for the "going rate" in the Tulsa area for similar services. 3.) The student-athlete is NOT compensated based on his or her reputation, athletic ability or for any value his or her athletic status brings to the employer. 4.) The student-athlete registers the job with the ORU Athletics Complaince Office prior to beginning work.

Extra Benefits and Preferential Treatment: Student-Athletes must be treated as regular students or members of the general public. Student-Athletes must receive the same treatment as any other customer. They may not receive discounts or free items unless the same offers are advertised and available to the general public. Examples of impermissible activities: 1.) Signing or cosigning a note for a loan for a prospect or student-athlete.

2.) Providing a prospect or student-athlete with the use of an automobile. 3.) Arranging free or reduced charges for professional or personal services for prospects or student-athletes. 4.) Promising financial aid for post-graduate education to any prospect or student-athlete. 5.) Providing free or reduced rent or housing to any prospect or student-athlete.



## **CAN YOU HELP? YES!**

## THE ERA OF NAME, IMAGE, LIKENESS

Name, image, likeness (NIL) also known as the right to publicity, will allow student-athletes to receive compensation for non-athletically related performances such as endorsements, business ventures, autographs and sports camp.

Oral Roberts University Athletic Department follows state legislation related to NIL. NIL rules became effective July 1st, 2021 and will continue to evolve over the following months and years. Please use the information below as a guide and communicate directly with ORU Athletics compliance staff with any questions.

#### WHAT CAN I DO AS A BOOSTER?

If you have a business, your business may engage student-athletes in a manner consistent with any business. You must provide student-athletes with benefits consistent with the market value of thier service.

All deals with student-athletes must be disclosed regardless of who is involved. Additionally, you will need to disclose your status as a representative of ORU's atheltic interest, or booster, when entering into a business deal with an ORU student-athlete.

As a representative of ORU's athletics interest, or booster, you can participate in institutional education programs surrounding NIL. We may ask you to assist our student-athletes in your area of expertise. This assistance will only go through the athletic department and cannot be arranged independently.

#### WHAT CAN I NOT DO AS A BOOSTER?

You may NOT directly compensate a student-athlete for their name, image, likeness without exchange of consideration. If you decide to purchase a student-athlete's autograph, gear, clinic, etc... you must pay market value for those items.

You cannot individually enter into an endorsement deal with a student-athlete. If you have a business that wants to use a student-athlete's NIL, it must follow all Oklahoma and NCAA policies. A business whose product conflicts with ORU's policies such as gambling and banned substances cannot enter into contracts with student-athletes.

You cannot communicate with, make contact with, or direct payments to a prospective student-athletes in high school or another university, directly or indirectly, in order to influence their decision to come or not come to ORU or any other institution.
