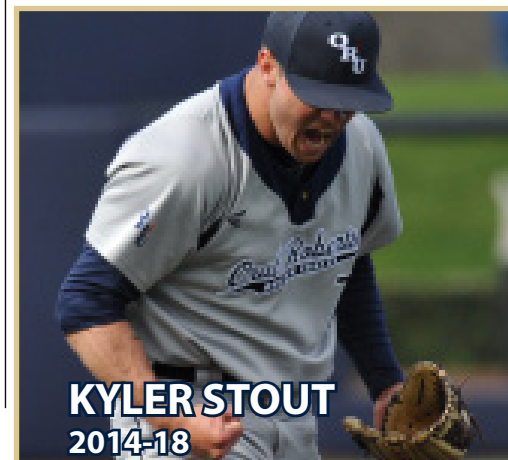

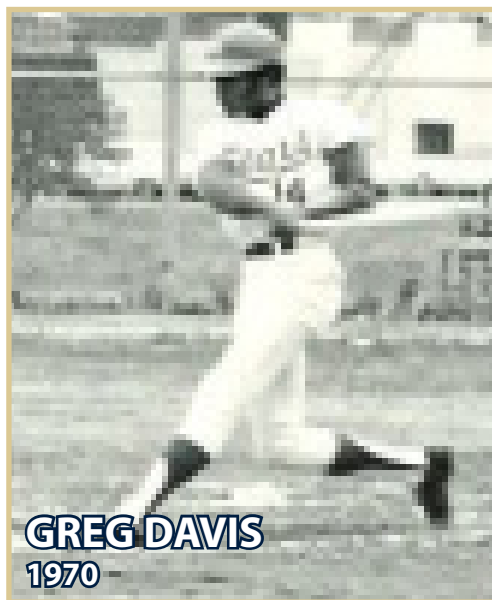

NO-HITTERS AT ORU

Nick Jones
vs. Chicago State, May 7, 2006
 Jones went 7.0 innings with no hits, nine strikeouts and only one walk in a 9-0 victory.

Taylor McIntyre
at Chicago State, May 20, 2005
 McIntyre tossed the sixth no-hitter in ORU history and the first 9-inning accomplishment in school history. The junior lefty struck out 10, walked one batter and hit a batter in the 6-0 victory.

Dennis Bigley
vs. Chicago State, April 3, 2004
 After hitting a pair of home runs in the opening game of a Mid-Continent Conference doubleheader, junior right-hander Dennis Bigley twirled the fifth no-hitter in ORU history in the Golden Eagles' 8-0 win over Chicago State in a 7-inning game. Bigley struck out 12 -- including the side in the seventh -- and hit a batter in the sixth for his only base runner, but the baserunner was later erased on a double play.

Tim McCoy, Joe Klancnik and Larry Gryskevich
vs. SW Oklahoma State, Feb. 15, 1986
 A combined no-hitter in the home and season opener, a 6-0 victory for ORU.

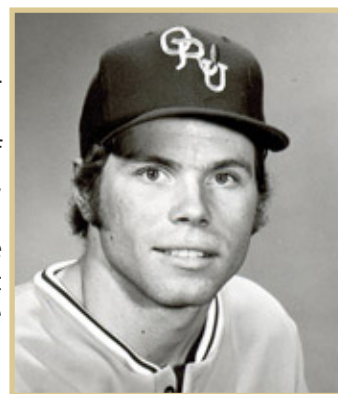
Roger Lewis and Steve Selberg
vs. Notre Dame, March 14, 1983
 Lewis went 7.0 innings with 11 strikeouts and Selberg went 2.0 innings. Selberg gave up the only ball to leave the infield, a fly out to left in the ninth. An error on the second baseman with two outs in the ninth also prevented a perfect game. ORU came away with the 8-0 win.

Warren Hollier

Bob Volk
at UC-Riverside, March 31, 1977
 Bob Volk was the first player to hit for the cycle in program history on March 31, 1977, at UC-Riverside. He got all of his four hits in consecutive at bats, singling in the first and doubling in the second. He then got a triple in the fourth inning, rounding out the feat when he belted a home run in the sixth inning.



Eric Vandeventer
at Centenary, May 5, 1997
 Freshman Eric Vandeventer became the second Golden Eagle to hit for the cycle on May 5, 1997, at Centenary. Vandeventer started off with a double in the second inning, followed by a solo shot in the fourth. In the next inning, he added a triple to the right field corner, sliding into third in celebration, knowing he just completed one of baseball's ultimate accomplishments.
