Series Record: First Meeting

- Ottawa moved to 14-9 overall and 5-0 in the KCAC with a 3-0; 25-23, 25-18, 25-23; victory over Bethel College on Tuesday night. It was OU's 18th straight victory over the Threshers. In the win, OU had 46 kills, a .170 attacking percentage, 42 assists, three service aces, 66 digs, and five team blocks. The Braves have not dropped a set in KCAC play this season.
- The Braves are receiving votes in the latest NAIA Women's Volleyball Coaches Top 25. After receiving 11 votes a week ago, OU has is now receiving 94 points by the NAIA raters.
- Through 23 matches this season, Ottawa is averaging 12.1 kills per set, 11.2 assists per set, 2.05 blocks per set, 1.4 service aces per set, and 17.9 digs per set. The Braves have a .191 attacking percentage.
- OU is ranked 43rd in the NAIA in kills per set (1,018), 31st in total attacks (3,182), 45th in assists (941), 22nd in digs (1,507), 30th in digs per set (17.9), 40th in solo blocks (53), 34th in block assists (239), 26th in total blocks (173), 33rd in blocks per set (2.05), 47th in ball handling errors (24), and 38th in points (1,313.5).
- Radaisy Valdez leads the Braves in kills with 282 and is averaging 3.4 per set. Haylee O'Meara leads the team in assists (436) and is averaging 5.3 per set. Jadore Hays is OU's leader in service aces with 27 and digs with 402. She is averaging 4.9 digs per set. Valdez is also Ottawa's leader in blocks with 74. She is averaging 0.9 per set.
- Haylee O'Meara was named KCAC Setter of the Week for her efforts in OU's victories over Avila and Kansas Wesleyan. In two matches last week, O'Meara had 36 assists, five service aces, 17 digs, and six blocks. In OU's 6-2 offense, she averaged 18 assists per match and six assists per set. O'Meara also averaged 2.8 digs per set and 8.5 digs per match.
- Ottawa leads the series against William Woods University 4-2 and defeated the Owls 3-0 on Sept. 16 in Wilson Field House. The Braves have won four straight matches against WWU. The first meeting between the two teams took place on Sept. 14, 1991. Ottawa lost to the Owls 16-14, 15-10. Friday's match between Ottawa and nationally ranked Xavier University of Louisiana will be the first time that the two teams have played.
- In the three set victory over William Woods on Sept. 16, Ottawa finished the match with 46 kills, a .298 attacking percentage, 43 assists, seven service aces, and a total of nine blocks. Radaisy Valdez and Lillian Holden finished the match with double digit kills. Valden had 13 and hit .500. Holden finished with 10 kills, four blocks, and had a .409 attacking percentage. Haylee O'Meara led OU with 27 assists and Kaitlyn Haller had a double-double, 12 assists and 12 digs. Jadore Hays led OU with 18 digs and Kennedi Wyrick finished with 10.
- William Woods University is 7-12 overall and 4-1 in conference place. The Owls enter Friday's match coming off a 3-0 victory over Cottey College. Through 19 matches, WWU is averaging 10.3 kills per set, 9.8 assists per set, 2.3 blocks per set, 1.3 service aces per set, and 16.2 digs per set. William Woods has a .147 attacking percentage. The Owls are ranked 48th in the NAIA in total blocks (154) and 12th in blocks per set (2.3).
- Kassidy Phillips leads WWU in kills (126), Logan Finneran is the team's leader in assists (171), Phillips is the Owls' leader in service aces (16), Tori Rosemann leads the team in digs (345), and Lauren Adams lead WWU in blocks (66).
- Xavier University of Louisiana is 15-2 overall and 10-0 in conference play. The Gold Nuggets have won 14 straight and are receiving votes in the latest NAIA Women's Volleyball Coaches Top 25 Poll. Through 17 matches, XULA is averaging 12 kills per set, 11.3 assists per set, 1.8 blocks per set, 1.9 service aces per set, and 14.8 digs per set.
- XULA is ranked 14th in the NAIA in attacking percentage (.238) and 46th in service aces per set (1.94).
- Kennedy Wade is the team's leader in kills (215), Emi Rigioni is XULA's leader in assists (290), Wade leads the Gold Nuggets in service aces (26), Linda Mungai is Xavier's leader in digs (291), and Maya Smith is leads the team in blocks (53).

Through eight seasons, Blessington has an overall record of 220-86 and a KCAC record of 128-14. She has led the Braves to five KCAC Regular Season Championships, six KCAC Tournament Championships, seven NAIA National Tournament Appearances, and five NAIA Final Site Appearances. Blessington has coached 10 NAIA All-Americans, 14 AVCA All-Region selections, 48 All-KCAC performers, three KCAC Player of the Year, five KCAC Setters of the Year, one KCAC Libero of the Year, and one KCAC Freshman of the Year. She has also been named KCAC Coach of the Year five times.

The 2021 Braves continued to be not only one of the top teams in the KCAC but in the NAIA as well under Blessington's leadership. She led the Braves to a KCAC regular season championship, a KCAC tournament championship, and a trip to the NAIA National Tournament. Ayona Tharps became the program's first three-time NAIA All-American and six Braves were named to the All-KCAC teams. Tharps was named Co-KCAC Player of the Year, the first Brave to earn player of the year

twice. Adriana Skipper was named KCAC Assistant Coach of the Year and AVCA West-Central Region Assistant Coach of the Year. Blessington was named KCAC Coach of the Year for the fifth time in her career.

In an uncertain COVID-19 environment the 2020 Braves excelled. Ottawa finished the season ranked 21st in the NAIA, won over 30 matches for the sixth time in program history (31-9), captured the KCAC regular season championship (22-2), won the KCAC Tournament Championship, earned a victory in its NAIA Opening Round match, and qualified for the NAIA Final Site in Sioux City, Iowa. Under her leadership, Ayona Tharps was named NAIA All-American for the second straight season, five Braves were named to the All-KCAC Teams, and OU assistant coach Adriana Skipper was named KCAC Assistant Coach of the Year, AVCA West-Central Region Assistant Coach of the Year, and AVCA Assistant Coach of the Year.

The 2019 Braves continued with their winning ways under Blessington, finishing with an overall record of 24-17 and a KCAC record of 9-3. OU won the KCAC Tournament for the fourth time in the last five years. Ottawa qualified for the program's fifth straight and seventh overall NAIA National Tournament. For the fourth time, the Braves earned a trip to the NAIA National Tournament Final Site. OU had four players earn All-KCAC honors led by KCAC Player of the Year, Ayona Tharps. She became the program's first NAIA Second Team All-American selection. The Braves set three school records in 2019. Makayla Aspegren broke the single season block assist record and the career total blocks school record. The team set a new school record in block assists.

The 2018 Braves finished the season with an overall record of 27-13 and a second place finish in the KCAC with a record of 11-1. Under Blessington's leadership, OU captured its third KCAC Tournament Championship in the last four years. The Braves qualified for its fourth straight, sixth overall, NAIA National Tournament and its third NAIA Final Site appearance. Ottawa had two NAIA and AVCA All-Americans and three AVCA NAIA All-West Central Region selections. Seven Braves earned All-KCAC honors with Morgan Berry being named KCAC Setter and Freshman of the Year. The Braves excelled in the classroom as well with three earning Daktronic Scholar Athlete honors.

Under Blessington's leadership, the 2017 Braves continued with their winning ways. OU won 30 matches for third straight season and the fifth time in program history. Ottawa won a share of the KCAC Championship and qualified for the NAIA National Tournament for the third straight season. Blessington led the Braves to the NAIA National Tournament Final Site for the second time in three seasons. Ottawa had five players earn All-KCAC honors led by Adriana Skipper's second straight KCAC Setter of the Year honor. Skipper and Kenna Hall were named Honorable Mention NAIA All-American and were named to the First Team AVCA All-West Central Region Team.

In Blessington's third year at the helm, 2016 the Braves won 30 games for just the fourth time in program history, finishing with an overall record of 31-8. She led the Braves to their second straight KCAC Regular Season Championship with a record of 22-0, their second straight KCAC Tournament Championship, and their second straight appearance in the NAIA National Tournament. For the third straight year OU had the KCAC Setter of the Year and she coached seven All-KCAC performers, two AVCA All-Region selections and one NAIA All-American.

The 2015 Braves became just the third team in program history to win 30 games, finishing the season with a school record tying 34 wins to just seven losses. The Braves won the KCAC regular season championship, finishing with a record of 19-1. OU also won the KCAC Championship and qualified for its third trip to the NAIA National Tournament. Under Blessington's tutelage the Braves won their first NAIA Opening Round Game in program history with a 3-0 victory over Wayland Baptist University. Blessington was named KCAC Coach of the Year and she had eight Braves earn All-KCAC

honors with Janaya Fox being named KCAC Player of the Year, Bethany Farres earned KCAC Setter of the Year honors, and Hannah Sittig being selected as the KCAC Libero of the Year. Fox and Farres earned NAIA and AVCA All-American honors with Fox earning Third Team and Farres being named Honorable Mention. The Braves also excelled in the classroom with Keri Tanking earned CoSIDA Academic All-American Second Team honors and four Brave being named Daktronic Scholar Athletes.

Under Blessington's leadership in 2014 the Lady Braves finished with an overall record of 24-11 and a third place finish in the KCAC with a record of 15-3. OU won over 20 games for the third straight season, a first in program history, and competed in its third straight KCAC Tournament Championship Game. Six Lady Braves earned All-KCAC honors with Christa Hill being named KCAC Setter of the Year. Allie Arnold became just the

fourth OU women's volleyball player to earn NAIA All-American honors with her Honorable Mention selection.

Blessington comes to Ottawa University from Southwestern Community College (SWCC), where she spent the past three seasons at the helm. She led the team to a 37-10 mark in 2013 while receiving votes in the NJCAA II Poll. Blessington finished her three years at SWCC with an overall record of 72-52. Under her leadership, SWCC finished fifth at the 2013 NJCAA II Tournament and earned Region D Coach of the Year honors. Blessington coached one NJCAA All-American, six All-Region and eight All-Conference players; 10 Academic All-Region players; and had a 90 percent graduation rate.
