**WHEN LAST WE MET THE COYOTES:** Three Otters scored in double-figures, including another double-double from **Charles Johnston**, but San Bernardino claimed a 72–63 win Jan. 18 in The Kelp Bed. Johnston recorded his seventh double-double of the season, with 12 points and 10 rebounds. The Otters were within five with just over three minutes remaining before San Bernardino used an 8–2 run to push the lead to double-digits. In addition to Johnston, **Jaden Tengan** and **Jailen Nelson** scored 12 points apiece. Sedrick Altman led three Coyotes in double figures with 25 points.

**NELSON PASSES 800-POINT MARK:** **Jailen Nelson's** 25 points last Saturday versus Cal Poly Humboldt brought his career total to 812, making him the 14th player in Otter history to pass 800 career points and the first since Jahvon Johnson turned the trick back in 2019. FYI, Johnson finished his career No. 3 on the Otter scoring list with 1,224 points.

**TRIPLE 300s:** For just the second time ever, that Otters will claim three 300+ point scorers in a season for two consecutive seasons after **Jaden Tengan** (306) passed the 300-point plateau with 14 points Thursday at Cal Poly Pomona. He is joined by **Jailen Nelson** (339) and **Charles Johnston** (325). Last season Levi Frankland (444), **Joe Wall** (349) and Nelson (330) were members of that exclusive club.

The only other time the Otters claimed three 300+ point scorers in consecutive seasons came when they did it three times in a row between 2005–06 and 2007–08.

**JOHNSTON EXTENDS DOUBLE-DOUBLE RECORD:** With 11 points and 16 rebounds last Thursday versus Chico State, **Charles Johnston** recorded his CSUMB record 12th double-double of the season. He broke the record he shared with Joe Mitchell, who had 10 as both a junior (2007–08) and senior (2008–09).

**CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLES:** **Charles Johnston** continues to chip away at Joe Mitchell's Otter career record of 23 double-doubles from 2006–09. Dexter Amey (2001–02) is next with 17. Johnston (15), Andrew Ferguson (12) and Devoughn Lamont (10) round out the Otter Top 5 for career double-doubles.

**REBOUNDING RECORD WATCH:** With five rebounds Thursday at Cal Poly Pomona, **Charles Johnston** moved to within 19 boards of the CSUMB single-season record for rebounds (273) set by Joe Mitchell during the 2008–09 season. He enters the final two games averaging 10.6 rebounds per game.

**JOHNSTON JOINS REBOUNDING ELITE 8:** With five boards last Thursday at Pomona, **Charles Johnston** solidified his hold on the No. 8 spot on the Otter career rebounding list with 390. He needs nine more to pass Jay Demaestri for the No. 7 spot.

**FROM WAY DOWNTOWN, PLAYER EDITION:** **Joe Wall** went 5-of-9 from long range last Saturday versus Cal Poly Humboldt to tie Augie Johnston (2006–08) for No. 2 on the Otter all-time 3-point field goals list with 137.

**JOHNSTON PLAYS THE PERCENTAGES:** **Charles Johnston** enters the weekend ranked No. 6 nationally in field goal percentage at 62.7 percent.

**JOHNSTON'S OTHER RANKINGS:** Sharp shooting isn't the only area where **Charles Johnston** ranks amongst the NCAA leaders. He enters play Saturday ranked No. 6 nationally in rebounding (10.6 rpg) and No. 10 nationally in double-doubles (12).

**NELSON MOVES UP REBOUNDING LADDER:** **Jailen Nelson** keeps moving up in the CSUMB career rebounding ladder. He enters play Saturday at No. 16 last week with 319. He needs three to pass Kris Gallop (2013–14) for No. 15.

**OTTERS AMONGST THE CCAA LEADERS:** The Otters are well represented amongst the CCAA leaders as we enter the final fortnight of CCAA action.

**Blocks:** Charles Johnston (11th, 0.7 bpg); Javon Johnson (15th, 0.6); Joey Bilello (19th, 0.5 bpg); Jordan Archie (24th, 0.4 bpg)

**THE 20–20 CLUB:** Charles Johnston joined an ultra exclusive club with his 20-point, 21-rebound effort in the 99–92 win over Western Oregon on Nov. 12. He joined Richard Jenkins as the only Otters ever to accomplish that feat. Jenkins did it as part of a 57-point, 20-rebound night in a 126–122, 4 OT win over — wait for it — Western Oregon on Dec. 15, 2006.

**THE 20–REBOUND CLUB:** Charles Johnston joined an almost as exclusive club by becoming just the third player in Otter history to pull down 20+ rebounds in a game. The others were Jenkins (in the aforementioned WOU game of 2006) and Jared Jungworth, who had 15 points and 20 boards in a win over Pacific Union College on Jan. 28, 2003.

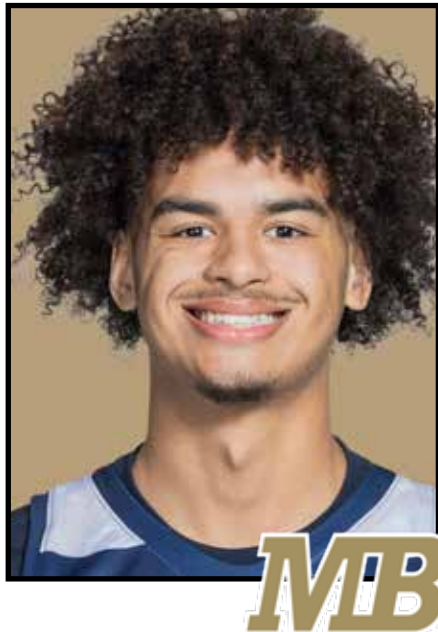
