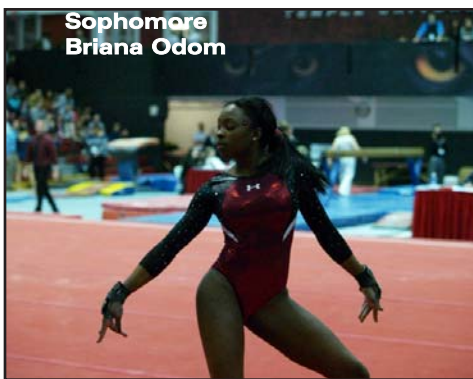


2015 SEASON OUTLOOK

After a record-breaking and history-making year in 2014, Temple women's gymnastics and Head Coach Aaron Murphy are set to reach bigger goals and continue the success of last season in 2015.

The Owls are coming off an 18-17 record from the 2014 season with a third place finish at the ECAC championships. The Owls produced four USAG All-Americans at the USAG National Championships, as well as an ECAC floor champion, Jasmine Johnson. The team also defeated Towson for the first time in program history to cap a winning streak of 11-0 through three weekends of competition in February.

Returning 15 gymnasts and introducing four newcomers on to the team, Murphy hopes to improve their third place finish at the conference championship



and score above the team's season high of 192.325. "Deirdre and I have challenged the girls this year by training them to be routine ready in November and not in December such as last year," said Murphy. "We hope that the outcome of this will

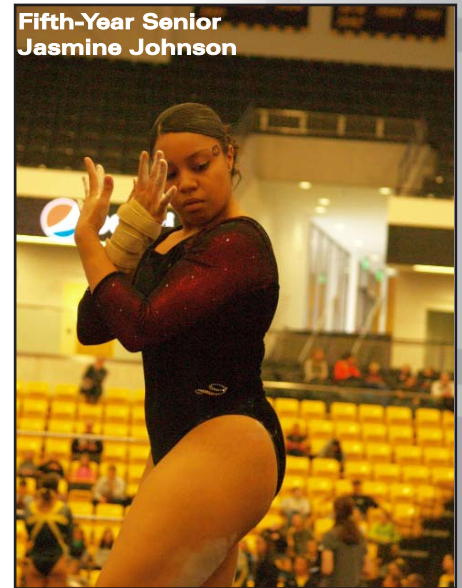
build their confidence and consistency on the events to be better prepared for the beginning of the season with a stronger finish at the end of the season."

Fifth-year senior captain Jasmine Johnson will be one of the team's key returners this season. Johnson is coming off a first place floor exercise finish at the conference championships, as well as a Second-Team All-American finish on vault at the USAG National Championships. In the 2014 season, she posted season highs on beam, floor and vault, scoring a 9.675, 9.8 and 9.775 respectively. "Jasmine Johnson made a statement last year with her first place finish on floor exercise at conference and wants to make an even bigger statement with the team score this year throughout the season."

Joining Johnson in a fifth year of competition is all-around competitor Brittanie DeMeno, who earned a career high 9.75 on vault last year at the Eagle Invitation in March. DeMeno also earned a season high all-around score of 38.15 at the dual meet against Ursinus.

Seniors Alexis Arena and Lauren Capone are coming off a successful 2014 season. Arena posted scores above 9.6 consistently on both vault and beam, with a season high of 9.75 on the beam. Capone looks to improve her third place finish on the floor exercise at the conference championships with a score of 9.725,

as well as continue her success on the vault where she earned first-team All American honors on the apparatus at the USAG National Championships. Capone posted season highs of 9.8 on



the floor and 9.825 on the vault.

Other key returners include the Owl's all-around competitor sophomore Briana Odom. Odom earned a First-Team All-American honor in the all-around for her performance at the USAG National Championships and earned a season high all-around score of 38.5. Also returning from the sophomore class will be Victoria Reggiani, who's strong bar work earned her a season high of 9.7 at the Towson quad meet last season, and Mikaela Postlethwait, who worked three events last season, earning a 9.575 on vault, 9.35 on bars, and an 8.95 on the floor as season highs. This season, both Reggiani and Postlethwait look to contribute on all four events.

2015 SEASON OUTLOOK

Entering her first full season as an Owl, Junior transfer Michaela Lapent made her mark on the Owls vault line up last season earning a season high of 9.6 at the Rutgers quad meet. Lapent looks to break into the lineups of all four events this season. Also looking to see action this season are fellow junior, Danielle Vahala, who trains on vault, beam, and floor exercise, and senior Ali Forcucci, a floor and beam specialist.

Looking to make strong comebacks are seniors Stephanie Verry and Natali Ruzich. Both took a redshirt in 2014, but they will be returning to contribute on all four events. Event specialists, Taylor Rakus and Hannah Popper also missed last season due to injuries, but looks to make a strong returns on beam and bars, respectively, in the 2015 season.

A notable loss for the 2015 season is junior Reagan Oliveri, who tore her Achilles tendon in the offseason. Last season Oliveri was named the Most Valuable Gymnast and earned career highs on all four events, tallying a 9.6 on vault, 9.8 on bars, 9.8 on beam, 9.75 on floor and a 38.75 in the all-around. She earned the silver medal in the beam finals at the USAG National Championships and earned First-Team All-American honors. Oliveri will be recovering in 2015 to return for the 2016 season.

Murphy has added a

strong set of freshman to this year's roster. Kerry Arone, a native of Westampton, N.J., was the state and regional bar champion in her senior year and qualified for the J.O national championships. Kayla Kennedy, of York, Pa., is also a successful bar swinger, taking the state title in her junior year and placing second in the region as a junior and senior just behind Arone. As Temple Owls, both girls look to make a strong impact in their rookie seasons. "Our freshman class looks to make a strong impact on vault and uneven bars for the Owls this year. All four freshmen have what it takes to break into the line-up this season, and we'll have to wait and see at what meet that unfolds."

Arone and Kennedy are joined by fellow rookies Gianna Gambutti, a three-time level 10 state and regional qualifier and J.O National Invitational qualifier from Wayne, N.J., and Gina Tucker, of Staten Island, N.Y., who was a two-time level 10 state and regional qualifier and current state-wide high school vault record holder.

Assistant coach Dierdre Mattocks-Bertotti will return for her third season with the Owls. Last season, she primarily trained the beam squad, who earned a season high event score of 48.3 and had one of its members (Oliveri) place second in the beam finals at the USAG National Championships.

This season, Mattocks-Bertotti will continue to focus her efforts on the beam squad, where she hopes to build a brand new squad with only two of the 2014 beam workers returning (Arena and Odom). "Deirdre has been incredible for this program and its success all-around. She will be stepping into the role of a recruiter and mastering all the skills that go along with that position."

After a revamped preseason training schedule, the Owls will take a flight to Eastern Michigan University on January 9 to take on the Eagles, one week earlier than the Owls traditional schedule.

Following the season opener, the Owls will visit the nation's capital for the Lindsey Ferris Invitational at George Washington University, followed by a home meet on the 24th against Ursinus in McGonigle Hall. The Owls then travel to New Hampshire on the 31st and begin February with a local competition at Penn.

The Ken Anderson Memorial Invitational will be hosted on February 14th, followed by meets against Ursinus, Pittsburgh, Cornell, and a travelling trip to Iowa State to round out the regular season. The ECAC conference championships will be hosted by Yale on March 21st. The Owls aim to continue their post-season with NCAA Regional action in early April.

Aaron **MURPHY** Head Coach Temple '02

Ninth Season at Temple



Aaron Murphy enters his ninth season as the head coach of the Temple women's gymnastics team. Murphy, who competed for the Owls on the men's gymnastics squad from 1996-2001, began assisting the late Ken Anderson with the women's program in 2002 and eventually moved into his current role in November, 2006.

Last season Murphy guided his squad to a third place finish in the ECAC Championships and the ECAC Floor Champion, Jasmine Johnson. Murphy also coached four USAG All-Americans, with two of them being selected on the first team. Off the mats and apparatuses, Murphy had four student-athletes named to the Philadelphia Inquirer Academic All-Area Women's Team.

Murphy was honored as the ECAC's Coach of the Year for the second time in his career in 2013, despite his Owls earning only six wins on the year. During that campaign, Murphy showed his ability to get the most out of his lineups several times when he was forced to fluctuate his intended order at the last minute, due to pre-meet injuries. Murphy demonstrated a knack for getting his student-athletes to step up when the pressure was on, which helped members of his squad receive eight ECAC weekly awards over the course of the season.

In 2012, Murphy guided the Owls to a record-setting performance by his squad at the annual Ken Anderson Memorial Invitational on Feb. 5. Not only did the Owls take the title on their home floor, they set the school record for a combined team total with a score of 193.275. Under Coach Murphy that same season, his vault lineup set a new program record for their highest score on the apparatus with a 48.650 at William & Mary in the final meet of the regular season. During the postseason, Murphy saw his team demonstrate an impressive performance at the ECAC Championships, where it placed third and produced Katie Canning as the program's first-ever ECAC All-Around

Champion.

The 2010 season was yet another successful endeavor for Murphy and his team. The Owls repeated as third place finishers at the ECAC Championships, a meet which they hosted in McGonigle Hall. Moving forward to the USAG Championships, the Owls qualified for the team competition and saw a record eight athletes earn USAG All-America honors.

In 2009, Murphy was recognized as ECAC Division I Coach of the Year, leading his team to a school-best third place finish at the ECAC Conference Championships. During that run, he also led the team to breaking the all-time team record, a mark that stood for six years. The Owls posted a team score of 192.625 against Cornell on March 15, 2009.

Prior to being named head coach, Murphy was the assistant coach for four years at Temple. The 2001 Temple graduate was named the USA Collegiate Assistant Gymnastics Coach of the Year in 2004.

In his four years as an assistant at Temple, Murphy was responsible for spotting all four events while constructing the strength and conditioning program. Under his guid-

ance, the program celebrated 16 USAG All-American honorees and several new school records.

Prior to his experience with the women's gymnastics program, Murphy spent the 2001-02 season as an assistant with the Temple men's program under head coach Fred Turoff. While responsible for spotting all skill events for safety purposes, he was integral in assisting the men's team to an ECAC Conference Championship and national recognition.

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, Murphy was the Public Gymnastics Clinic Director at Temple from 2001-03. In coaching all ages and skill levels, he utilized his several years of experience in supervising, coordinating and working hands-on with inner-city children participating in gymnastics.

A four-year letterwinner at Temple, Murphy served as a team captain his senior seasons (1999-2001). His career as a performer, and 2001 U.S. Championship participant, is headlined with several honors including the 2001 Bill Braverman Award Recipient for Excellence and the 2001 Most Consistent Gymnast Award.

Murphy, born in Barberton, Ohio, currently resides in Upper Darby, Pa.

Third Season at Temple



Former All-American Deirdre Mattocks Bertotti is in her third season as the assistant coach for the women's gymnastics team at her alma mater.

Bertotti, a Temple gymnast from 2003-2006, still holds a share of the program's all-time individual record score on uneven bars with a 9.900, which helped the Owls set a program record team score of 49.050 against Cornell (March 14, 2004) on the apparatus.

Providing support for head coach Aaron Murphy, Bertotti is assisting on all events, but is primarily training the balance beam lineup.

Before her return to Temple, she coached at Metzler's Gymnastics in Downingtown, Pa., where she trained Level 6-10 gymnasts, while specializing in coaching balance beam routines.

During her gymnastics career at Temple, Bertotti was named the team's Most Consistent Gymnast in 2004-05. A year later, she was elected co-captain and served on the Student-Athlete Advisory Council.

Bertotti graduated from Temple with her Bachelor's degree in Sport and Recreation Management before going on to Saint Joseph's to earn her Masters' degree in Adult Learning and Training.

A native of New Berlin, Pa., Bertotti currently resides in Media, Pa. with her husband Steve and their son, Vincenzo.
