# SEASON OUTLOOK

# 2019 SEASON OUTLOOK

Temple women's gymnastics is poised for excellence in 2019, as the team looks to ascend to new heights following a record-breaking 2018 campaign. The Owls are set to open their 2019 slate on Friday, Jan. 4 in Tuscaloosa, Ala. They will face the No. 6 Alabama Crimson Tide, as well as the Northern Illinois Huskies and the Southeast Missouri Redhawks at 7:30 p.m.

The Owls had a strong showing in 2018. The team opened up the season with the highest season-opening score in program history, earning a 194.875 at the Little Boston Invitational. After this first week of competition, they had their highest-ever national ranking at No. 13. The second weekend in March was historic for the Owls. On March 9, they shattered the previous record team-score (194.975, set in 2017) with a 195.800. Two days later on March 11, the team bested this mark once again, posting a 196.050 team score. They also recorded the program's best floor score (49.300) that afternoon. Ten Owls earned spots on All-ECAC teams: four First-Team honors and eight Sec-

ond-Team honors. to make a statement in 2019. The team ranked first in the ECAC Preseason Poll with 26 points, two points ahead of Yale (24) and three ahead of Penn (23). Temple also received 30 votes in the WCGA Preseason Poll. Last season they received one vote. In preparation for competition season, the team has focused on a few concepts that will encompass what they value as team: depth, control and simplicity.

The squad is under new leadership, as head coach Josh Nilson begins his first season as the Owls' head coach. Nilson, along with assistant coach Rachel Inniss and graduate

assistant Zaakira Muhammad, are supremely qualified to lead the team to its ultimate goal: the postseason.

"My biggest expectation is for us to be a postseason team," said Nilson. "There is no reason why we shouldn't be top 36. I also believe we can win ECACs. It comes down to making every competition count."

The Owls are ready

Nilson. "Last year, they broke a lot of records, but they had some meets that were a little tough. In my opinion that was due to depth. This year, we will be much stronger at the end of the year. The freshmen coming in help us a lot. We also have a transfer in Jazymn Estrella who has experience with a team at regionals. We have individuals that have been to regionals as well. Their perspective is going to help us a lot."

Nilson and his staff want to highlight the gymnastics and style of their student-athletes without adding unnecessary intricacies. A key aspect of this is streamlining and controlling the controllables.

"There were a lot of moving parts that we removed," said Nilson. "A lot of things weren't simple, and my staff and I are big on simplifying things. The girls know exactly what they are in charge of and understand their roles. They have control over that. They should focus on what they have control over and do the best they can."

This year's team features two strong all-around competitors in sophomore Monica Servidio and freshman Ariana

Castrence. Servidio competed in the all-around twice last season for the Owls, posting a career best of 38.975. Castrence is looking to make her mark for the Owls in her first season in Cherry and White.

“Monica is calm and consistent,” said Nilson. “She is pretty much always doing the same thing for us. In the gym, she’s already right around our all-around

record. Ariana, on the other hand, brings some gymnastics that I don’t think our crowd has ever seen here before. She has really high-level tumbling and vaults. She’s one of our strongest bar swingers as well. Those two, I expect to see them in the all-around for the majority of the season.”

The squad is captained by senior India Anderson, junior Daisy Todd and sophomore Delaney Garin. Anderson is a mainstay on floor for the Owls, posting a career-best 9.850 last season. Todd became Temple’s first ECAC vault champion, scoring a 9.825 to earn the 2018 conference championship title. She also recorded career-bests of 9.825 on both bars and beam last season. Garin competed on bars and beam in her freshman campaign, scoring career-bests of 9.575 and 9.825, respectively.

“India Anderson is going to be one of our most entertaining floor routines,” said Nilson. “At the moment, Daisy is competing on bars. She led off our lineup on bars during our Cherry and White Intrasquad and did a great job. She will also work her way back into the vault lineup. Delaney is training for three events and has the potential to start in all three.”

Last season, two Owls, including junior Jaylene Everett, competed at the Penn State NCAA Regional as vault specialists. Sophomore Tori Edwards was selected as an alternate for the floor exercise. Their experience and talent will be instrumental to the Owls’ success this season.

“Jaylene Everett, a returning regional competitor, will be solid in her in events [vault and floor],” said Nilson. “She’s so steady for us. Tori Edwards is likely going to start on vault and bars. Like Monica [Servidio], Tori always shows up and does a great job. To a coach, that’s gold.”

Newcomer Jazmyn Estrella also promises to be a spark in

Temple’s lineup. Coming to North Broad from Utah State, the Allentown, Pa. native will make an immediate impact. Sophomore Aryanna Anderson emerged as a key contributor as a three-eventer for the Owls.

“Jazmyn Estrella is going to be key on vault and bars for us,” said Nilson. “In the past, our weakest event has been bars. Jazmyn’s incredible on them. That’s her number one event. Aryanna Anderson has really come out of her shell. She is key to our depth, as she is our top backup on three events.”

Temple has the components for success: a fresh and inspired coaching staff, experienced returners, talented newcomers and a unified passion to make the program relevant on a regional and national scale.

“Becoming relevant is something we’ve talked about a lot,” said Nilson. Last year and the year before, they had strong seasons. But to be relevant, you have to be in the postseason.”

The Owls’ 2019 slate is very competitive, as they will face two ranked teams (No. 6 Alabama at Alabama Quad Meet and No. 27 Penn State at Little Boston Invitational) in their first two meets. Overall, Temple will compete against seven teams that are ranked in the WCGA Preseason Poll (Alabama, Maryland, Ohio State, Penn State, Pitt, Southern Utah and West Virginia). The Owls will host four home meets this season with alumni night and senior day being held the second weekend in March. The regular season wraps up with ECAC Championships in Ithaca, N.Y. on March 23 and NCAA Regionals will be held the first weekend in April.

The Owls’ 2019 season will represent a mentality shift. The team aims to be considered among the best teams in the nation and they are primed to do just that.

“We are going to bring gymnastics to the table that is new to Temple,” said Nilson. “We will be something that our crowd has never seen before from Temple gymnastics.”

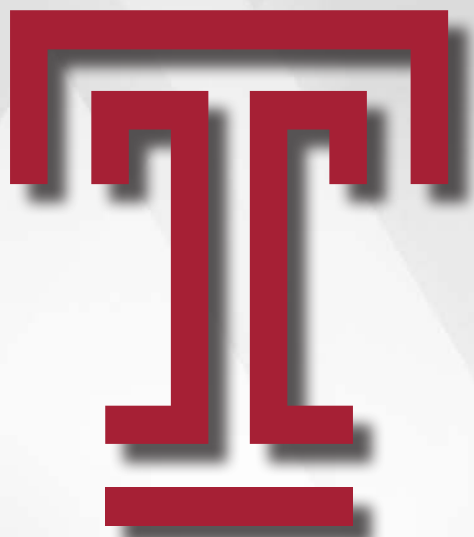

# COACHES & STAFF



*Head Coach*  
**JOSH NILSON**

First Season

Utah State '10

Josh Nilson, who has 13 years of coaching experience, was hired by Director of Athletics Dr. Patrick Kraft as the head coach of women's gymnastics at Temple University. Nilson was most recently the assistant coach at the United States Air Force Academy in Colorado, arriving there after a stint at Penn State University.

During the 2017-18 season at Air Force, Nilson helped guide the Falcons to their highest conference finish in six years, and their highest USAG Collegiate Nationals finish in seven years. In 2016, Nilson started as the first assistant coach at Penn State before serving as the co-interim head coach in his final months before heading to Air Force.

"It's an honor to be named head coach for Temple women's gymnastics," said Nilson. "I trust the leadership and the direction of the athletics department, and believe the foundation of the gymnastics program is strong. I'm excited to work with the team and the department as we continue to build on that foundation and make Temple women's gymnastics into an even stronger competitor at the regional and national level."

While Nilson was with the Nittany Lions as co-interim head coach, they saw a jump from 45th in the nation to 31st in the final four competitions of the year, while qualifying two all-around competitors to the NCAA Championships. He was also nominated for Northeast Regional Co-Head Coach of the Year honors. Additionally, Nilson served as the recruiting coordinator for Penn State, while also working to schedule future competitions. He was the team's primary coach on both uneven bars and vault, in addition to being the main spotter on all four events.

From 2013-16, Nilson was the first assistant coach at Utah State and the head coach for vault and uneven bars. The Aggies advanced to the NCAA Regional Championships for the third consecutive season in 2016 and finished the regular season with an average of 48.833 on the uneven bars, which ranked 28th in the nation. In the Utah State record books, the season average of 48.833 ranks second-best in school history and was the highest average in 13 years.

The 2015 season was a banner year for the Aggies as they made their second consecutive appearance at the NCAA Regional Championships. The Aggies re-wrote the record books that year, recording two of the top four team scores, setting three of the top 10 vault scores and tallying a program-best season average of 48.938 on the vault. For his efforts during the 2015 season, Nilson earned North Central Region Assistant Coach of the Year honors for the second straight year.

Nilson spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Texas Women's University from 2011-13, and was named the 2012 USA Gymnastics Collegiate National Assistant of the Year and Midwest Independent Conference Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the Pioneers' bars team to a 48.440 season average. On an individual level, he coached one student-athlete to the 2012 USAG Collegiate national title on bars.

During his time as an undergraduate at Utah State, Nilson was a student coach for women's gymnastics from 2005-08. He then spent three years as the second assistant coach before heading to Texas and returning to Utah in 2013. Nilson graduated from Utah State with a bachelor's degree in law and constitutional studies and a minor in family finance in 2010.

Nilson, a native of Cache Valley, Utah, is married to the former Amanda Corn. The couple has five sons, Tristan, Ezekiel, Remington, Liam and Asher.

First Season

Auburn '12

Rachel Inniss joined the Temple staff in August 2018. Inniss, a native of Rio Rancho, New Mexico, was a four-year gymnast for Auburn and brings several years of coaching and competitive experience to Temple.

Inniss served in two coaching capacities at Auburn. Inniss was a student coach as a fifth year student in 2012 and she spent the past two seasons as the volunteer women's gymnastics coach. As a volunteer coach, she worked with beam and floor, did the choreography and had a hand in operations duties. At Temple, Inniss will hold many of the same responsibilities. While at Auburn, Inniss choreographed floor routines for two All-Americans and three All-SEC gymnasts. Simultaneously, she coached at the Auburn Gymnastics Academy and interned with the Director of Operations.

Inniss returned to her alma mater after being a professional dancer at Walt Disney World for four years. She danced three contracts as an Equity dancer at the Beauty and the Beast Live on Stage in Hollywood Studios.

As an athlete, Inniss amassed numerous accolades in her career at Auburn. She was the NCAA Regional Floor Champion and a NCAA National Championship Qualifier in 2010. She holds collegiate career highs of 9.925 on both floor and beam.

Inniss earned her undergraduate degree in public administration from Auburn in 2012 and has a 4-year-old daughter named Charlotte.

**ZAAKIRA MUHAMMAD**

First Season

West Virginia '18

After a four-year career as a gymnast at West Virginia University, Zaaqira Muhammad joined the Temple gymnastics staff in August 2018. Muhammad, a native of Pennsauken, N.J., studied journalism and sports communication at West Virginia; earning her B.S. in journalism in May 2018.

Muhammad had a standout career as a Mountaineer. She was a two-time team captain and three-time recipient of the Linda Burnette-Good Award, which honors the team's most valuable gymnast. Her athletic accolades include earning a spot on the NCAA All-American Second Team and All-Big 12 Championship Team in floor, qualifying for the NCAA 2017 National Championship in 2017 and tallying over 1500 career points. Muhammad ranks No. 19 in West Virginia gymnastics history with 10 career scores of 9.9 or better. She also held the highest all-around score of the season twice. On the academic front, Muhammad was named to the academic All-Big 12 Gymnastics Second Team and was named to the Dean's List in December and May of 2018.

While at West Virginia, Muhammad gained experience mentoring young gymnastics as a coach and counselor for the West Virginia University gymnastics summer camp. She also was an assistant level 10 coach for TNT Elite Gymnastics. Here, she coached leaps and jumps on floor and beam worked with the athletes in individual and group settings.

Muhammad is currently a graduate student at Temple, pursuing her master's degree in higher education.

Kendra Miller was promoted to a full-time assistant strength & conditioning coach in May of 2017 after serving as a graduate extern since August 2015. Miller, who earned her master's degree in sport business at Temple in 2017, came to the University from

Wake Forest where she served as a sports performance intern for a year.

While at Wake Forest, Miller worked with both Olympic Sports and the men's and women's basketball sports performance departments. She assisted with men's basketball, women's basketball, women's soccer, women's golf, baseball, and men's tennis. Miller was also responsible for women's cross country, cheer, and dance teams.

Prior to Wake Forest, Miller spent a summer at the University of South Alabama as a strength & conditioning intern working with the football and women's basketball teams.

Miller is a native of Plainwell, Mich., where she grew up with three siblings, Caitlin, MacKenzie and Kody. She is the daughter of Tod and Tina Miller and Karen Miller. From a young age, Miller competed both nationally and internationally in powerlifting and nationally in weightlifting. In addition to lifting, she also played basketball, ran cross country and competed in a variety of track events while in high school.

While at NMU, she was a member of the Olympic weightlifting team at the US Olympic Training Site. In May, 2014, Miller graduated with a bachelor's degree in management of health and fitness.

Miller holds certifications from the National Strength and Conditioning Association as a Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist, from USA Weightlifting as a Level 1 Sports Performance Coach and from the American Heart Association in CPR/AED/First Aid.

### *Athletic Trainer* **BETH WARD**

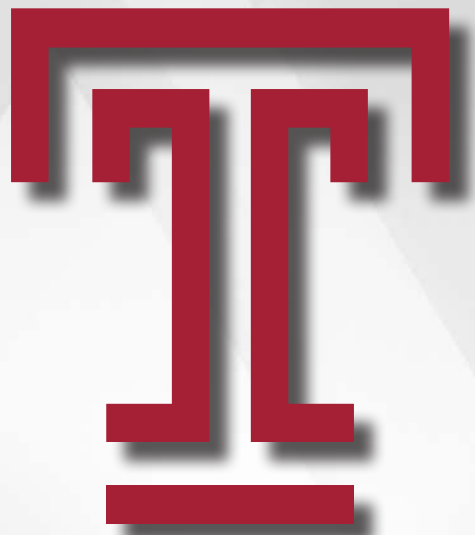
**Second Season

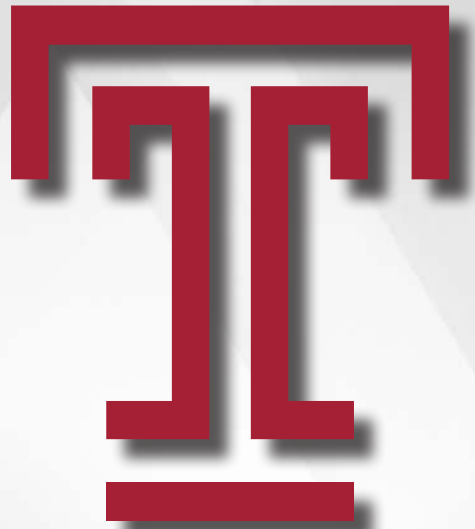

- > Sport administrator Kristy Bannon Sromovsky earned Northeast Regional sport administrator of the year.
- > Head coach Umme Salim-Beasley was named the 2018 ECAC Coach of the Year following another record-breaking season.
- > Sophomore Daisy Todd scored a 9.825 on vault to earn the conference championship title, writing her name in the record books as Temple's first ECAC vault champion in program history.
- > Todd was named to the Philadelphia Inquirer Academic All-Area At-Large team.
- > The team placed 11 on All-ECAC teams with four earning first team honors, eight earning second team honors, and seven earning All-Academic honors.
- > On March 9, the squad shattered its 2017 record (194.975) with a team 195.800. The Owls' top score came on floor where the squad pulled a 49.150 team floor score; the second-highest in program history. Freshman Tori Edwards tied for first on floor with a career-best 9.9, the highest individual score of 2018. Edwards is just the third Owl in Temple history to earn a 9.9 on the floor exercise, earning the highest individual floor score in six years.
- > On March 11, the team made history setting its second program record in two days with a team total of 196.05. The afternoon's floor score of 49.300 now sits at the top of the program best floor exercise score list. Everett posted a 9.925 on floor. Everett is just the second Owl in program history to earn a 9.925 for a floor exercise routine and the first since 2002.
- > Temple gymnastics opened up the 2018 season with the highest season-opening score in program history, totaling a 194.875 at the Little Boston Invitational. The Owls topped New Hampshire, Maryland and Towson.
- > After week one of competition, the Owls saw their highest-ever national ranking at No. 13.

Jan. 28 - Temple women's gymnastics snagged its first home win of the season on Sunday against SEMO, Ithaca, and Cornell. The Owls totaled a 193.225 to take first, Cornell tallied a 191.600 (second), SEMO scored 189.625 (third), while Ithaca collected a 188.075 (fourth). Five Temple gymnasts reached season-high scores across the four events.

## **Gymnastics Sweeps Quad Meet at Penn with a 194.70**

## **Todd Wins ECAC Vault Title; Salim-Beasley Named ECAC Coach of the Year**

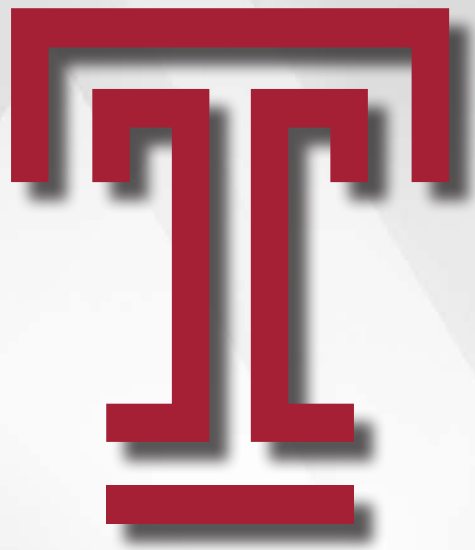

### *President* **RICHARD M. ENGLERT**

#### **42nd Year at Temple**

Accessible. High quality. Engaged with the community. Affordable. Diverse. These are the pillars of Richard M. Englert's presidency. They are also the values he has championed at Temple University for more than 40 years.

After serving Temple with loyalty and distinction in 16 different roles since 1976, Englert became president on July 21, 2016. Under his leadership, the university welcomed its largest and most academically qualified class of new students and broke records for freshman applications. It also began major campus renovations, highlighted by a state-of-the-art library. At the same time, Temple's faculty gained unprecedented national recognition, and its student-athletes reached new levels of success on the field and off.

"I can say without reservation that there has never been a better time to be part of the Temple family, whether you are a student, faculty member, administrator or alumnus," Englert said. "We have a strong dedication to our mission and an unrelenting commitment to our students, our neighbors and our great city."

Englert arrived at Temple as an assistant to the dean of the College of Education. Over the years, he has been provost and interim senior vice president for academic affairs, dean of the College of Education and vice president for administration, among many other roles. Since 1985, he has served as a professor in the College of Education.

Throughout his career, Englert has always responded to Temple's call. In recognition of his lifelong dedication, the Board of Trustees appointed him to the honorific role of university chancellor in 2012.

"President Englert has devoted his life to Temple University," said Board of Trustees Chair Patrick J. O'Connor. "Over the course of

his 40-year-plus career at Temple, he has earned a reputation as an outstanding teacher, administrator and leader who always puts the needs of our students first."

Englert earned a doctorate in educational administration from the University of California, Los Angeles. He also has a master's degree from Pepperdine University and a bachelor's degree from St. John's College.

As Temple's president, Englert has focused the university on its historic commitments: engaging with the city of Philadelphia; producing research that improves lives, including work on opioid abuse and traumatic brain injury; and energizing the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Most of all, as a lifelong educator, Englert takes every opportunity to empower Temple's inspiring students and faculty.

"Temple has proved that excellence in education, access, affordability, diversity and community engagement are not mutually exclusive," Englert said. "That's what we've done better than anyone else for more than 130 years. It is who we are and it is the dedication to our mission that will make Temple an even greater institution in the years to come."

## Director of Athletics DR. PATRICK KRAFT

### 6th Year at Temple 4th as Director of Athletics

Since his appointment as Director of Athletics in May 2015, after serving two years as Deputy Director of Athletics, Dr. Patrick Kraft has led a transformation in Temple University's Department of Athletics. During his tenure, investments and enhancements in student-athlete welfare, in support of coaches and staff, in academic support and in facilities have provided deserved regional and national attention for the University.

In 2016, Kraft was recognized by the Sports Business Journal and by the Philadelphia Business Journal's Forty Under 40 for his work at Temple.

Among the accomplishments and initiatives during Kraft's tenure:

#### On the Field

- Football won the 2016 American Athletic Conference Championship, marking its first Conference Championship since 1967 and first Conference Championship Game ever; won 20 games in a two-year span, was nationally-ranked for consecutive seasons and competed in a bowl game in consecutive seasons, all for first time in school history; and football is one of five FBS teams to win 10 or more games in each of the past two seasons and play in its conference championship game in each year. The Owls finished off the 2017 season with a win in the Gasparilla Bowl. It was the fourth consecutive season that Football was bowl eligible, and the third straight year for competing in a bowl game. Both are program records.
- Men's Basketball won its first American Athletic Conference Regular Season title (2016), and first regular season title since 2012; defeated nationally ranked teams (#24 Florida State, #19 West Virginia) in consecutive days for the first time in school history to win the 2016 NIT Season Tip-Off and earned a berth in the 2016 NCAA Tournament, marking its seventh appearance in nine years.
- Women's Basketball cracked the Top 25 in 2017 for the first time since the 2005-06 season and made its first NCAA appearance in five years.
- Volleyball finished #47 in NCAA RPI in 2016, its best finish since the 2002 season and posted its third straight 20-win season. In 2017, Volleyball advanced to post-season play for the first time in 15 years with a bid to the WNIVC.
- Men's Soccer cracked the Top 25 in 2015 for the first time since 1997 and posted its first road win over Penn State since 1989.
- Women's Lacrosse made an appearance in the Top 20 in 2016 for the first time since 2005.
- Women's Gymnastics posted its best 10 scores in program history during the 2016-17 season and sent its first individual qualifier since 2009, Daisy Todd, to NCAA Regionals. In 2018, the Owls reached their highest national ranking (#13) in program history.
- Women's Fencing set a school record for wins in 2017 and earned its' highest ever ranking (#6). In 2018, Malia Hee was named the NCAA's Elite 90 Award recipient for academic and athletic excellence.
- Men's Crew won the Varsity Eight, the JV Eight and the Freshman Eight championships at the 2018 Dad Vail Regatta. It is believed to be the first sweep of the eights at the Dad Vail in 50 years. The Varsity Eight set a course record of 5:34.409 and won Dad Vail gold for the first time since 2004. With the victory, the V8 earned an invitation to participate in the Henley Royal Regatta in Henley-on-Thames, U.K., for the first time since 1994.
- Women's Soccer posted consecutive double-digit win seasons (2014, 2015) for the first time in program history.
- Blanca Fernandez became the first ever All-American in Temple Women's Cross Country history and first women's track All-American since 1988. Men's Cross Country won its first-ever IC4A Championship and placed third in the AAC Championships, the best AAC finish in program history.

#### In the Classroom

- Student-athletes achieved a record seven consecutive semesters with a combined GPA of 3.10 or above and 13 consecutive semesters above a 3.0. Sixteen programs earned a cumulative GPA greater than 3.0, led by women's volleyball (3.58) and men's tennis (3.46). Twelve of those programs combined for GPAs above a 3.40.
- Men's Basketball, Men's Cross Country, Football, Men's Golf, Men's Soccer, Women's Cross Country, Fencing, Field Hockey, Lacrosse, Women's Rowing, Women's Soccer, Women's Tennis, Women's Track & Field and Volleyball (16 out of 19 sports) have achieved record team GPAs in the past six semesters.
- Sixty-nine percent of student-athletes earned at least a 3.0 GPA in the spring of 2017, setting a Temple Athletics record. Another record was set with seven teams earning public recognition for their Academic Performance Rate (APR) data. In the spring of 2018, an all-time record 178 student-athletes earned a semester GPA of 3.5+ as well as a record number of 27 student-athletes earned a perfect 4.0 semester GPA.
- With an average multi-year APR of 991, Temple ranked 12th in the nation among Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) institutions and led all full members of the American Athletic Conference in 2017. Temple also is one of just 17 FBS institutions with all sports having multi-year APR's of 970 or greater.
- Student-athletes posted a record high 88% Graduation Success Rate (GSR), setting a school-record for the seventh consecutive year. Temple also posted its highest Federal Graduation Rate (71%) since 2010. Temple's overall GSR number is tied for 24th among all Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) schools. Football posted a GSR of 86, tied for 14th in the nation along with Nebraska and Miami (Fla.). Temple is one of 11 FBS schools in the country with all teams over 77 in GSR. The other 10 schools are Alabama, Duke, Michigan, Northwestern, Notre Dame, Stanford, Tulane, UCF, Vanderbilt and Virginia Tech.
- Eight programs have earned record high GSRs in the last two years: Football,

Men's Basketball, Men's Golf, Men's Soccer, Men's Tennis, Fencing, Women's Lacrosse, Women's Tennis.

- Temple teams earned three conference Team Academic Excellence Awards in 2015-2016: Men's Basketball, Volleyball, Lacrosse (Big East).
- The Graduating Class of 2016 was the largest in Temple Athletics history.

#### Student-Athlete Welfare

- Facilitated the development of a number of initiatives aimed at improving the mental health of student-athletes, including the establishment of a partnership with Temple's Department of Clinical Psychology to deliver onsite behavioral health coaching for student-athletes. Partnered with the University's Student Health Services so its staff can be a resource for all student-athletes.
- Hired the first full-time mental health professional dedicated solely to handling student-athlete needs.
- Instituted a career program with more than 50 national and regional employers attending career development events, during which student-athletes have the opportunity to hone their networking skills and establish professional connections.
- The Verified Program was developed in 2016 to provide student-athletes with access to high level professionals to assist in their professional growth. The Verified program is a product of a strong collaboration between the Resnick Center and the Temple Career Center, which provides regular programming and career coaching for student-athletes throughout the academic year and summer.
- Students have served more than 9,000 community service hours in 65 projects since 2014-2015, four times more than in previous periods.

#### Enhancing Facilities

- The Temple Sports Complex, home to men's and women's soccer, lacrosse, field hockey and track opened in the fall of 2016.
- The newly restored East Park Canoe House, home to men's crew and women's rowing, opened in 2016.
- New practice facility for Men's Golf opened in 2017.
- New practice facilities for Men's Crew, Women's Rowing and Women's Fencing were opened in the Fall of 2018.
- In the Winter of 2018, Temple opened the New York City Angels Student-Athlete Lounge, an on-campus location in which student-athletes can study, interact and relax.
- Enhancements have been made to athletic training facilities, strength and conditioning facilities, and to the student-athlete academic support center while locker room renovations and upgrades were also completed for each varsity team, including new locker rooms for Temple's Olympic sports programs unveiled in 2015.
- Temple Athletics opened the doors to the brand-new STAR (Student Training and Recreation) Complex in the fall of 2017. The Complex offers a 10,000 square foot weight and cardio area, facilities for the Athletics and Campus Recreation departments, an indoor turf field, and a two-lane track outside the building.

#### Enhancing Revenue and the Brand

- Annual donations have increased 75% over the last three years and the development office has had three consecutive record-setting years in annual fund raising, including multiple six and seven-figure commitments in support of our football program, the new Temple Owls Sports Complex, and the Men's Crew and Women's Rowing programs.
- Key partnerships with Learfield Sports Properties, Learfield Licensing Partners, and IMG/Learfield Ticket Solutions have been secured and enhanced as well as a lucrative rights deal with Under Armour.
- Created Owls TV, a video services arm dedicated to athletics, and developed a broad-ranging digital and social media department to integrate video and engage the Temple fan base.
- Temple Football posted the largest attendance gain among FBS programs during the 2015 season, playing in front of an average home crowd of 44,159, an increase of 20,789 per game.
- In 2015, ESPN's College GameDay made its first trip to Philadelphia for a Temple football game.

Prior to Temple, Kraft served two years (2011-13) as the Executive Senior Associate Athletics Director at Loyola University Chicago. He was also a member of the senior staff at his alma mater, Indiana University, serving as Senior Assistant Director from 2009-11.

Kraft played football as an undergraduate at Indiana and holds three degrees from the University. He earned a bachelor's degree in sports marketing/management (2000), a master's degree in athletic administration (2005), and a doctorate in sports management (2008).

Kraft and his wife, Betsy, reside in Haddonfield, N.J., with their daughter, Annabelle, and son, Joseph.





## *Deputy Dir. of Athletics* **CRAIG ANGELOS**

### 4th Year at Temple

Craig Angelos is in his fourth year as Temple University's Deputy Director of Athletics. Angelos joined the Owls staff in June of 2015.

At Temple, Angelos works with the Owls external team that includes the communications, corporate sales (Learfield), creative services, development, marketing and promotions, social and digital media, ticket operations, ticket sales (IMGL), video services, and strategic planning. He also serves as the sports supervisor for men's basketball, field hockey, men's

soccer and golf.

Angelos, who has served on the athletics senior staff at five different Division I institutions as well as the NCAA national office, came to Temple from Florida International University where he served as the Senior Associate Athletic Director for Revenue Enhancement from 2014-15. While at FIU, he was responsible for finding new revenue sources for the athletic department and engaging in all aspects of development activities, while helping overall fundraising to a 20% increase.

Before his stint at FIU, Angelos was the number two person as the Executive Senior Associate Athletic Director at the University of South Florida, overseeing all external areas as well as having oversight of the football program.

Prior to USF, Angelos served nine years as the Director of Athletics at Florida Atlantic University from 2003-2012. At FAU, he led the effort to build a \$70 million, 30,000 seat on campus football facility, which opened on campus in 2011.

Angelos also held number two positions as the Deputy Athletic Director and Chief Operating Officer at Indiana University overseeing all the external areas as well as the football program and was the Senior Associate Athletic Director at the University of Miami (Fla.). Prior to his tenure at Miami, Angelos spent three years at the NCAA as a legislative assistant interpreting NCAA rules and regulations.

A graduate of the Creighton University School of Law, Angelos worked for a short time in a mid-sized litigation firm in Los Angeles, Calif. He earned his bachelor's degree from Brigham Young University where he was the starting first basemen on the baseball team and later played in Buttrio, Italy for an Italian professional baseball league.

Angelos and his wife, Kristin, have six children.



## *Executive Sr. Assoc. AD / SWA* **MARY McELROY**

### 4th Year at Temple

Mary McElroy is in her fourth year as Executive Senior Associate Athletic Director and Senior Woman Administrator (SWA) at Temple.

At Temple she coordinates the overall administration of varsity sports and serves as the primary sport administrator for women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, women's track, fencing and volleyball. She also oversees Temple's sports medicine and strength and conditioning staffs.

McElroy joined the Owls' staff in July 2015 from the Collegiate Licensing Company (CLC) in Atlanta, Ga., where she served as the Director for Partner Services. A majority of her work saw her responsible for 65 of the 150 Division I member institutions served by the company.

Prior to her experience at CLC, McElroy served as the Associate Director of the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship in 2013. Her duties at the NCAA included the management of a \$6 million budget for the event, as well as directing the game day operations during the Women's Final Four.

McElroy has served on the staff of five different NCAA schools, most recently as the Assistant Director of Student Services for the Georgia Tech Athletic Association. She also served as the Senior Associate Athletic Director and SWA at Southern Methodist University in 2009, and was the Director of Athletics at Georgia State University from 2005 to 2008. McElroy served in various other roles at Georgia Tech from 1999 to 2005, including Senior Associate Athletic Director and Director of Compliance.

McElroy got her start in college athletics at her alma mater, the United States Naval Academy. She spent three years with the Naval Academy Athletic Association as SWA and Assistant Athletic Director, before a stint as the academy's Director of Alumni Services.

A former Division I varsity basketball player, McElroy earned a degree with merit from the Naval Academy in 1987. After graduation, she served as a supply officer in the U.S. Marine Corps for five years, attaining the rank of captain. McElroy completed her MBA at Georgia Tech in 2000.

McElroy and her husband, Terry, have two sons, Darrin, a second lieutenant in the Marines, and Austin.



## *Assoc. AD / Chief of Staff* **VINNIE JAMES**

### 5th Year at Temple 2nd as Chief of Staff

Vinnie James, who joined the Temple Athletics staff in July, 2014, was promoted to the position of Associate Athletics Director/Chief of Staff in June 2017. He previously held the position of Assistant Athletics Director for Business Operations.

In his role, James provides high-level support to the Director of Athletics by handling special projects, conducting research and facilitating comparative analyses. In addition, James serves as the

sport administrator for the football program and helps to monitor operating budgets for the department's 19 sport programs and administrative areas.

James came to Temple from La Salle University where he spent two years as Athletics Business Manager for the Explorers. He was solely responsible for executing the daily business operations for La Salle's athletics department. James distributed monthly budget reports for all sports and departments, and assisted in the overall budget planning for the department.

Prior to his time at La Salle, James spent a year at Villanova University as an intern in the Athletic Director's office. His responsibilities at Villanova were widely varied, and included working with the business office as well as providing administrative support and serving as event manager for women's soccer.

James is a 2007 graduate of Bloomsburg University with a bachelor's degree in political science. He was a four-year varsity captain and two-year team captain for Bloomsburg's baseball team, and he went on to earn a master's in business administration from Bloomsburg in 2009. While completing the MBA program, James served as a graduate assistant baseball coach.



## *Faculty Athletic Rep.* **JEREMY JORDAN**

### 11th Year at Temple 4th as FAR

Dr. Jeremy S. Jordan, Associate Dean, in the School of Sport, Tourism and Hospitality Management, was appointed the university's Faculty Athletics Representative (FAR) in May, 2015.

Faculty Athletics Representatives help ensure academic integrity of intercollegiate athletics programs and enhance the student-athlete experience. Jordan serves as the representative of Temple and its faculty to the American Athletic Conference, NCAA

and other stakeholder groups.

A former student-athlete, coach and administrator, Jordan has conducted research on intercollegiate athletics and teaches courses on the topic at the undergraduate and graduate levels. His primary research focus is on sport engagement as he studies the individual and community level impact of sport participation and events. He has worked with a number of industry partners including the NCAA, NFL, PHL Sport and Under Armour Japan. He is currently the principal investigator on a study funded by the NCAA that examines the relative consistency of sanctions issued by its Committee on Infractions over the last 50 years.

In March of 2016, Jordan along with the other FARs of the American Conference hosted the first Academic Consortium Symposium on student-athlete well-being in Philadelphia. This American Academic Consortium, formed in 2015, is charged with creating collaborative research opportunities for faculty, staff, and students from all American member institutions.

The FAR reports directly to the president and is the president's senior advisor outside of the athletics department on matters related to intercollegiate athletics. The FAR also advises the athletics director.

In collaboration with Temple Athletic Director Dr. Patrick Kraft, Jordan developed a two-year experiential learning extern program in the athletics department for School of Sport, Tourism and Hospitality Management graduate students.

Jordan has also served as a member of the Faculty Senate Athletics Oversight Committee and the Nancy and Donald Resnick Academic Support Center Faculty Advisory Committee. Since June of 2017, Jordan has served as the FAR representative to the American Conference SAAC group.

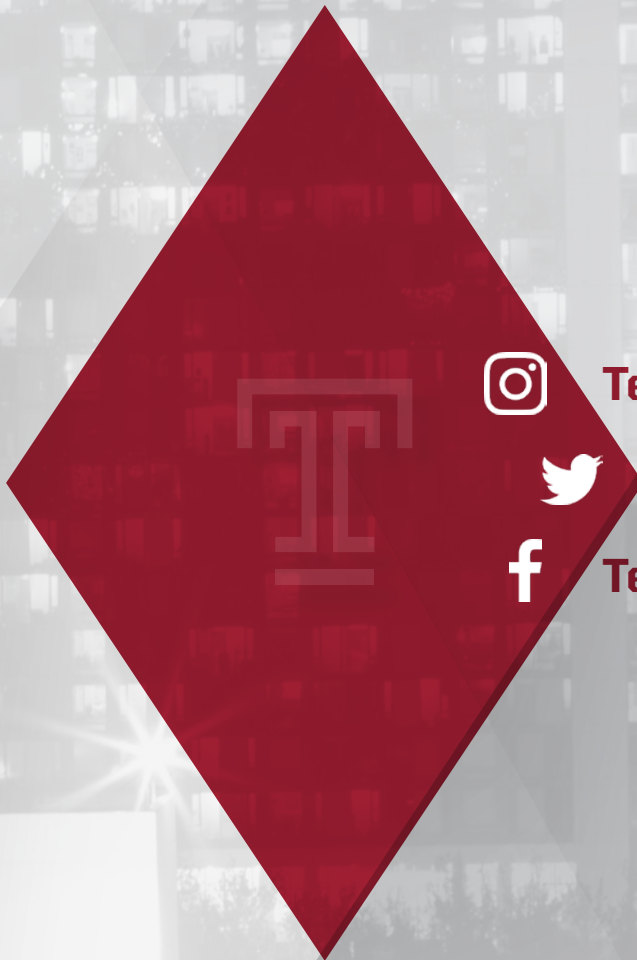
