TEMPLE VS. UCF

SERIES HISTORY

- > Temple leads the all-time series against the Knights, 8-6.
- > The first meeting between the two programs came on Dec. 28, 1995 in Orlando, where the Owls fell 84-66.

LAST TIME THEY MET

- > Temple fell 67-64 at UCF on Feb. 26, 2020.
- > Mia Davis led Temple with 23 points, 14 rebounds and six assists.
- > The Knights were paced by senior Kay Kay Wright with her game-high 24 points.

HEADLINES

THE OWLS

- > Temple is currently on a three-game winning streak to remain one-of-three undefeated teams in the American Athletic Conference. #19 USF (8-1, 5-0 AAC) and UCF (5-1, 3-0 AAC) are the only other two programs without a conference loss this season. The Owls enter Saturday's game at 3-3 (3-0 AAC) on the year.
- > Senior Mia Davis averages a double-double of 21.5 points and 10.5 rebounds to lead the Owls. So far, Davis totals four double-doubles this season.
- > Junior Alexa Williamson is Temple's second-leading scorer with 11.7 points per game, while pulling down 5.8 boards each game. The Houston, Pa. native was recently named the Big 5 Player of the Week and earned a spot on the AAC Weekly Honor Roll.
- > Rookie Jasha Clinton was tabbed the AAC Freshman of the Week on Dec. 28 to mark Temple's first weekly honor by the conference this year. Clinton averages 9.2 points, 4.2 boards, 3.5 assists and 1.6 steals per contest.
- > Sophomore Asonah Alexander ranks ninth in the country with her 6.3 assists per game. The guard also leads the conference with 1.8 blocks per outing.
- > Senior Emani Mayo adds 9.2 points and 4.7 rebounds per game to round out the starting lineup for Temple.

SCOUTING UCF

- > One of the three undefeated AAC teams, UCF arrives in Philadelphia with a mark of 5-1 (3-0 AAC).
- > The Knights have topped Tulane (66-62), Tulsa (53-42) and Houston (55-46).
- > UCF has been receiving votes in both the USA Today and WBCA Top 25 for the past three weeks.
- > Courtajia Sanders is the leading scorer for the Knights, averaging 12.8 points per game.
- > Leading UCF on the boards are both Masseny Kaba and Destiny Thomas with 6.0 rebounds per night.
- > UCF leads the conference in scoring defense, holding their opponents to 50.3 points per game.

UCF'S LAST TIME OUT

- > UCF topped Houston 55-46 at home on Jan. 3.
- > Courtajia Sanders led UCF with her double-double of 17 points and 10 rebounds.
- > Diamond Battles added 13 points and Brittney Smith chipped in 12 to round out the Knights' double-digit scorers.
- > Houston led 23-19 at halftime, forcing UCF to claw their way back after the break. The Knights worked to gain a one-point edge at the end of the third quarter before outscoring the Cougars 17-9 in the final frame to remain undefeated in AAC play.
- > UCF finished the game shooting 38.3% from the floor, 22.2% from long range and 65.4% from the charity stripe.

THE GAME

> The Owls welcome UCF to McGonigle Hall as they look to remain undefeated in American Athletic Conference action.

THE OWLS' LAST TIME OUT: Temple 66, ECU 57

- $\,>$ The Cherry and White won their third-straight conference game on Jan. 6 at ECU.
- > Temple controlled the first quarter to hold an 18-14 lead after the first 10 minutes of play.
- > However, ECU was able to hold a two-point lead at halftime after outscoring the Owls 22-16 in the second frame.
- > The Owls shot 41.7% (25-60) from the floor, holding the Pirates to a 33.3 field goal percentage.
- > The back-and-forth game featured 12 lead changes.
- > Temple held a 43-37 edge on the boards.
- > Williamson recorded a game-high 19 points for her third-straight game in double digits. The forward 77.8% from the field while adding seven rebounds, two blocks and a steal.
- > Davis registered her third consecutive double-double with 17 points and 11 boards. Davis now holds four double-doubles on the season, improving her career total to 39.
- > Clinton added 11 points, a career-best nine assists, seven rebounds and three steals
- > E. Mayo shot 50% from three-point range as she finished the game with nine points.
- > Alexander added an impressive stat line of five points, eight assists, eight rebounds, two blocks and two steals.

TEMPLE VS. THE TOP TEAMS

- > Temple is 0-1 against nationally ranked teams this season, falling to #5 South Carolina on Dec. 17, 103-41, in Columbia, S.C.
- > The Owls finished the 2019-20 season 0-3 against nationally ranked teams.
- > Temple's last win against a nationally ranked team was a 77-71 victory at No. 22 USF on Feb. 19, 2017.

AN UNPRECENDENTED SEASON

- > The Owls are set to play a 23-game schedule for the 2020-21 season. They will face only three non-conference opponents and play a 20-game American Athletic Conference slate.
- > Temple typically plays 30+ games in a season but due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the schedule has been shortened in abundance of caution for the health and safety of players, coaches and support staff.
- > Due to limited indoor capacity numbers mandated by Philadelphia city officials, spectators will not be permitted at home games to start the season.

OWL OPENERS

- > Temple is 55-26 all-time in season openers, including an 11-2 mark under Cardoza.
- > The Owls opened the 2019-20 season with a 77-59 win over Fairfield at home.
- > This year marks the first time Temple has started their schedule in December since the 1996-97 season.
- > Temple fell to Villanova in their 2020-21 debut, breaking their nine-year streak of winning home openers.

AMERICAN PRESEASON PICKS

- > Temple was picked to finish fifth in the American Preseason Poll this year, three spots ahead of where they finished in 2019-20.
- > For the first time since the conference's inception in 2013, USF was selected as the favorites to win the American this year.
- > Mia Davis earned a unanimous selection to the Preseason All-Conference First Team while being named the Preseason co-Player of the Year alongside

CHERYL MILLER AWARD

- > Davis was one of 20 women's basketball players named to the 2021 Cheryl Miller Award Watch List at the beginning of the 2020-21 season.
- > This marks the second-straight season the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association have added Davis to this prestigious award watch list.
- > On Feb. 12, 2020, Davis made it to the top 10 finalists list for the 2020 Miller Award.
- > The annual award in its third year recognizes the top small forwards in Women's NCAA Division I college basketball and named in honor of three-time Naismith Player of the Year, Cheryl Miller.
- > The winner of the 2021 Cheryl Miller Award will be announced on Friday, April 9, 2021 along with the other four members of the Women's Starting Five Awards.
- > Davis' high school teammate out of St. Frances Academy in Baltimore, Md., Angel Reese, was also named to the Cheryl Miller Award Watch List. Reese, the top recruit from the 2020 class, is a freshman at No. 12 Maryland.

BECKY HAMMON MID-MAJOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR CANDIDATE

- > Davis has also been named to the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Watch List by Her Hoop Stats. The Becky Hammon award will name it's second-ever recipient in 2021.
- > The Becky Hammon Award was first awarded in 2020, with South Dakota's Ciara Duffy being named the inaugural winner.
- > This year's preseason watch list includes representation from 23 teams and 15 conferences.

RECORD WATCH

- > Davis is already in the top-10 for career points, rebounds and free throws in Temple women's basketball histroy.
- > Davis reached the third-most recorded free throws in program history on Dec. 20, 2020 against SMU when she went 14-for-17 from the foul line. Her career total currently stands at 348.
- > The Baltimore, Md. native passed the 1,000 point milestone during the fifth game of the 2019-20 season. She currently ranks eighth in program history with 1,589 points.
- > Davis has the sixth-most career rebounds with 865. The forward is chasing down Theresa Goven's fifth-place mark of 896 career boards.

THE PLAYMAKER

- > Sophomore guard Asonah Alexander leads the Owls with a total of 38 assists to average 6.3 a game.
- > Alexander dished out 117 assists during her rookie year to average 3.7 per contest.
- > The 5-10 guard finished the 2019-20 season ranked 12th in the country with her 2.54 assist turnover ratio.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE QUEEN

- > Davis registered 18 double-doubles over the course of the 2019-20 season, tallying sixth-most in the country.
- > Davis has registered four double-double thus far this season, improving her career total to 39.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- > Temple's 2020-21 squad features four freshmen and one graduate transfer.
- > Freshmen guards Jasha Clinton and Kash Ayuso will be great additions to the Owls' backcourt.
- > Clinton was named the 2020 Virginia Girls Basketball Gatorade Player of the Year after averaging 14.5 points, 4.8 assists, 3.9 steals and 2.7 rebounds per game for her Princess Anne High School team.

NEWS AND NOTES

- > Ayuso averaged 18 points, five rebounds and five assists per game and capped off her impressive senior year as the Palm Beach 7A-6A Sun Sentinel Girls Basketball Player of the Year.
- > Rounding out the freshmen class is walk-on guard Janelle Johnson and 6-3 center Aniya Matthews. Unfortunately, Matthews is expected to miss the 2020-21 season due to injury.
- > Graduate transfer Jada Graves arrives on Broad Street following four years at Elon University in North Carolina. Graves, who was named the Colonial Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year in 2018, will bring a spark on the defensive end for the Owls.

CARDOZA SIGNS FIVE IMPRESSIVE RECRUITS

- > Cardoza announced the signing of five notable recruits from the class of 2021.
- > Hailing from Louisville, Ky., 5-10 guard Tierra East signed her national letter of intent to play for the Owls in the 2021-22 season. East is ranked the No. 65 overall player and No. 27 guard from the 2021 recruiting class by ESPN HoopGurlz.
- > Buffalo, N.Y. native Kyra Wood is an impressive 6-2 forward out of City Honors School. Wood crossed the 1,000 point milestone during her sophomore year and enters her senior season on track to join the 2,000 point club.
- > Jada Williams comes from nearby Williamstown, N.J. The Gloucester Catholic senior holds a career average of 13.5 points per game as she heads into her final season of high school basketball.
- > Aniya Gourdine of Baltimore, Md. is a senior at St. Frances Academy where current Temple star Mia Davis graduated from in 2017. Gourdine is a three-time IAAM Champion and two-time All-Metro First Team honoree.
- > Upper Marlboro, Md. native Makayla Waleed rounds out the 2021 recruiting class for the Owls. Waleed helped her St. Vincent Pallotti High School team to a 21-6 record during the 2019-20 season, before falling to local rival St. Frances and future teammate Aniya Gourdine in the IAAM Championship.

CARDOZA'S CREW

- > The all-time winningest head coach in Temple women's basketball history, Tonya Cardoza, is in her 13th year on North Broad Street, compiling an overall record of 227-162.
- > She's led the Owls to seven post-season berths, including four NCAA Tournament appearances and a spot in the WNIT Final Four.
- > Cardoza is a two-time conference Coach of the Year and four-time Big 5 Coach of the Year.
- > In 2017, she was one of 10 finalists for WBCA National Coach of the Year Honors.
- > Prior to taking the reigns at TU from former college teammate Dawn Staley, Cardoza spent 14 seasons as an assistant coach at UConn with Geno Auriemma.
- > During her tenure, the Huskies captured five national championships.

SEEING DOUBLE

- > The 2020-21 Temple rosters features twin sisters Emani and Nicolette Mayo.
- > The senior duo have each played important roles for the Owls. Emani was named to the 2018 American Athletic Conference All-Freshman team and was team captain her sophomore year (2018-19).
- > Nicolette served as a captain for the 2019-20 season.
- > The Mayos are one of 24 known twin sisters playing NCAA Division I basketball for the 2020-21 season.

Temple's all-time winningest head coach Tonya Cardoza enters her 13th season at the helm of the nationally recognized Owls.

Cardoza led the 2019-20 Owls to a 16-15 record for their best finish in three seasons. Junior Mia Davis led Temple with her 18.8 points and 10.2 rebounds per game. Davis garnered national recognition in her third season in the Cherry and White, as she was named a Top 10 Cheryl Miller Award Finalist and earned USB-WA All-America Honorable Mention. Davis was named the 2019-20 Big 5 Player of the Year, First Team All-Big 5 and First Team All-AAC.

Cardoza's 2016-17 season was one of her best, as Temple went 24-8 overall, earned an NCAA bid, and finished second in the tough American Athletic Conference. The Owls' success garnered her several individual honors, among them being named one of 10 finalists for the WBCA National Coach of the Year Award. Cardoza shared American Athletic Conference Coach of the Year honors with UConn's Geno Auriemma and was also named the Philadelphia Big 5 Coach of the Year for the fourth time in her career.

Temple's 2015-16 season marked the second-straight 20-win campaign, as Cardoza guided the Owls to an overall mark of 23-12. In the AAC, Temple finished third, compiling an impressive 13-5 record, the best finish for the team in American history. The culmination of the 2015-16 season saw the Owls earn a post-season bid, where they advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2016 WNIT, before a narrow 77-76 loss at Michigan.

Cardoza's 2014-15 squad made the first post-season final four in program history, advancing to the WNIT semifinals before falling in overtime at West Virginia. The Owls finished with a 20-win season, going 20-17 overall, including a 12-6 mark in the tough American Athletic Conference.

2013-14 marked a new era of women's basketball at Temple for Cardoza— competing in the inaugural season of the American Athletic Conference. The Owls faced seven nationally ranked opponents— tying the school record for the most in season— including two games against defending national champion and No. 1 Connecticut and Final Four participant Louisville. The young Owls finished fifth in American play after predicted to finish ninth, showing the league and the nation that they had fight.

The 2010-11 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year, Cardoza led the Owls to three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances, advancing to the Second Round in both 2010 and 2011. The Owls narrowly missed earning a berth in the NCAA Tournament in 2011-12, but took a top spot in the Women's National Invitation Tourna-

ment (WNIT) and advanced to the third round.

Along with earning Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year honors for the Owls' performance in 2010-11, Cardoza was honored as the Big 5 Coach of the Year for a third time. She earned that honor in each of her first three seasons at Temple, and the Owls earned their sixth straight Big 5 title in her first year with the program. Temple won the Big 5 again in 2011, and finished as runner-up in both 2010 and 2012.

Cardoza led Temple to at least 20 wins in her first four years at the helm. During her inaugural season in 2008-09, Cardoza guided TU to a 21-10 mark and an NCAA Tournament appearance. She was a finalist for the National Rookie Coach of the Year award. The Owls reached 25 wins in 2009-10 which tied for the second-most in the history of the program. In 2010-11, the Owls finished 24-9 which included a 15-game win streak and a 13-1 record in the A10. The 2011-12 season saw Temple go 23-10 and win 14 in a row, once again with a 13-1 mark in the conference. During their final year of A10 Conference play in 2012-13, Cardoza guided the nation's second-youngest team (six freshmen).

The Owls finished in the Top 3 in the A10 for three consecutive seasons. In Cardoza's first season she coached the squad to an upset over No. 13 Xavier, making her the first coach in TU women's basketball history to upset a ranked team during her rookie season.

Arriving at Connecticut at the start of the 1994-95 season, Cardoza helped guide the Huskies to an unprecedented 465-41 record, seven Final Four appearances and six No. 1 National Rankings in the final Associated Press poll. Cardoza was a part of four undefeated regular seasons, including two unbeaten national championship teams in 1994-95 and 2001-02.

A 1991 University of Virginia graduate with a degree in anthropology, Cardoza starred for the Cavaliers, leading the team to four consecutive NCAA National Tournament appearances. As a senior, she led UVA in scoring (15.5 ppg), while earning the following honors: Kodak Honorable Mention All-America; Kodak First Team All-District III; First Team All-ACC; NCAA Final Four All-Tournament Team, and NCAA Regional All-Tournament Team. She was also a First Team All-ACC pick in 1988-89.
