THINGS TO LOOK FOR...

- > The win over Georgetown marked the first time that Temple has won while scoring less than 50 points since Dec. 17, 2016 when the Owls topped Rutgers 48-37.
- > Last game against Georgetown, Mia Davis recorded her third double-double of the season and her 43rd double-double of her career when she put up 14 points and 11 rebounds against the Hoyas.
- > Freshman Aniya Gourdine was named American Athletic Conference Freshman of the Week as well as being named to last week's Big 5 Honor Roll.
- > The Owls are 3-0 when shooting 40% from the field or better.

HEADLINES

THE OWLS

- > The Owls are coming off back-to-back wins for the first time this season. In the past two games, the Owls have won two nail biters, winning by a combined eight points.
- > Graduate forward Mia Davis leads the way for the Owls averaging 15.4 points per game to go along with 7.6 rebounds per game. Against the Hoyas, Davis recorded her third double-double of the season.
- > Freshman Aniya Gourdine was named this week's AAC Freshman of the Week after averaging 13.0 points per game last week. Gourdine scored a season-high 17 points against Villanova two games ago and hit the game-winning bucket to lift the Owls past the Hoyas.
- > Alexa Williamson is second on the team in points per game and rebounds per game through the first seven games of the season. The senior is averaging 11.3 PPG and 6.3 RPG.

SCOUTING DUQUESNE

- > Duquesne enters the contest having won their past three games against Akron, Siena, and Canisius. The Dukes won by an average of 10 points over that stretch.
- > Duquesne is led by guards Megan McConnell and Fatou Pouye. Pouye leads the team in points per game with 12.3. On the other hand, McConnell leads the team in assists per game and steals per game, averaging 5.1 and 2.5, respectively.

NEWS AND NOTES

THE GAME

- > Temple's three-game road stretch comes to an end when the Owls take on the Duquesne Dukes in Pittsburgh, Pa. on Dec. 5 at 1:00pm.
- > The game is scheduled to air on ESPN+.

LAST GAME

- > In their last time out, the Owls managed to win back to back games for the first time this season, completing a comeback to defeat Georgetown 49-47.
- > Down by 11 points entering the fourth quarter, the Owls drained four threes in the final period to spark the comeback to win the game.
- > Forward Mia Davis recorded her third double-double of the season with 14 points and 11 rebounds.
- > Sophomore forward Caranda Perea made three three-pointers in the fourth quarter to spark the comeback for the Owls. Perea finished with a season-high nine points and four assists.

REGULAR SEASON HONORS

- > On March 7, 2021, the American Athletic Conference announced last season's regular season awards.
- > Graduate Mia Davis earned First Team All-Conference for the third consecutive season. She is the first Temple women's basketball player to earn First Team All-Conference three times in their career.
- > Sophomore Jasha Clinton earned a spot on the All-Freshman team.

400 AND COUNTING

- > Last season's game at Tulane marked head coach Tonya Cardoza's 400th game coaching the Temple Owls.
- > Cardoza has coached more games for the women's basketball program than any other coach in school history. Linda MacDonald, who coached the Owls from 1980-90, holds the second-most games coached with 296.
- > Cardoza holds a 242-176 record in her 14th season in North Philly.
- > Cardoza has led the Owls to seven postseason berths, including four NCAA Tournament appearances and a spot in the WNIT Final Four.
- > Cardoza is a two-time conference Coach of the Year and four-time Big 5 Coach of the Year.
- > In 2017, she was one of 10 finalists for WBCA National Coach of the Year Honors.
- > Prior to taking the reigns at TU from former college teammate Dawn Staley, Cardoza spent 14 seasons as an assistant coach at UConn with Geno Auriemma.
- > During her tenure, the Huskies captured five national championships.

ALWAYS THE STARTER

- > On Saturday, Jan. 24, Mia Davis played and started in her 100th career game in the Cherry and White. She currently sits at 119 games played.
- > The most games played by an Owl is 134 by both Alliya Butts and Feyonda Fitzgerald.

ONE AT A TIME

- > On Feb. 27, 2021, Mia Davis became Temple's all-time leader in made free throws. The forward currently has a career total of 433.
- > She surpassed Feyonda Fitzgerald's previous record of 402.

CHASING GREATNESS

- > Davis passed the 1,000 point milestone during the fifth game of her junior season. She currently ranks second in program history with 1,957 points.
- > Davis totals the third-most career rebounds with 1,022. To move into second place, Davis has to collect more than Tanaya Atkinson's 1,053 career boards.

- > Alliya Butts and Marissa Mackins each scored in double-figures for the Owls, scoring 15 and 14, respectively. Current Owls Emani Mayo, Shantay Taylor, and Alexa Williamson combined for 16 points.

SOPHOMORE SENSATION

- > Sophomore Jasha Clinton enjoyed an impressive first season in North Philly.
- > Last year's AAC All-Freshman team selection averaged 14.4 points, 4.1 assists, 3.4 rebounds and 2.1 steals per game for the Owls.
- > Clinton was named the AAC Freshman of the Week twice last season, along with earning Big 5 Player of the Week on Jan. 25.

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM

- > Davis was one of 20 women's basketball players named to the 2021 Cheryl Miller Award Watch List at the beginning of the 2021-22 season.
- > This marks the third-straight season the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association have added Davis to this prestigious award watch list.
- > Davis is one of only three players to be named to the prestigious list for the past three seasons.
- > The annual award in its fifth year recognizes the top small forwards in Women's NCAA Division I college basketball and named in honor of three-time Naismith Player of the Year, Cheryl Miller.

SEEING DOUBLE

- > The 2021-22 Temple program features twin sisters Emani and Nicolette Mayo.
- > Emani enters her fifth season as a player having being named to the 2018 American Athletic Conference All-Freshman team and being named a team captain her sophomore year (2018-19).
- > Nicolette enters her first season as a graduate assistant coach after being a captain for the 2019-20 season and a four-year player for the Owls.

LOCKED IN

- > The Owls' mantra this season is "Locked In." This mantra is to ensure that all members of the program are focused and 100% committed to the team. This mindset keeps the Cherry & White concentrated on the goal of the season despite the ups and downs that occur.

OWL OPENERS

- > Temple is 56-26 all-time in season openers, including an 11-2 mark under Cardoza.
- > The Owls opened the 2021-22 season with a 73-53 win over Saint Francis (PA) at home.
- > Last season, Temple fell to Villanova in their 2020-21 debut, breaking its nine-year streak of winning home openers.

#TEMPLETUFF

- > The phrase "Temple Tuff" is synonymous with the fight and grit of Temple Athletics. Coined by legendary Temple basketball coach John Chaney whose teams were noted for their hard-nosed, lunch-pail passion by which they played, the philosophy has embedded itself in the women's basketball program. An ever-present figure on Temple's campus, Chaney passed away on January 29, 2021.

AMERICAN PRESEASON PICKS

- > The Owls were picked to finish fifth in the American Preseason Poll this year, the same position that they were picked to finish in 2020-21.
- > For the second time in as many years, South Florida was selected to win the conference receiving 10 first-place votes.
- > Mia Davis was selected as the American Athletic Conference Preseason Player of the Year and the only unanimous selection to the All-AAC First Team.

Temple has two new faces at the helm now as Dr. Jason Wingard took over as the university's new president over the summer, and Arthur Johnson was announced as the Owls' new Vice President and Director of Athletics on October 7. Wingard comes to Temple after formerly serving as the dean of the School of Professional Studies at Columbia University. Johnson joins the Owls most recently from The University of Texas where he served as the Executive Senior Associate Athletic Director for Facilities and Operations.

NEWS AND NOTES

NEW TO THE NEST

- > The Owls welcome nine new players to the team this season by way of three transfers and six freshmen.
- > The nine new players are: Tiarra East, Aniya Gourdine, Jalynn Holmes, Destiney McPhaul, Caranda Perea, Jiselle Thomas, Makayla Waleed, Jada Williams, and Kyra Wood.
- > Graduate transfers Holmes and Thomas come to Philadelphia after spending the last few seasons at Norfolk State and FIU, respectively. Both players led their previous teams in scoring last season, averaging double-digit points. Sophomore transfer Perea provides the Owls with a versatile forward from George Washington. Perea made 18 appearances as a freshman last year for the Colonials.
- > The freshmen recruiting class all offer different skillsets to the Owls mixed with guards and forwards. McPhaul will not play this season due to NCAA transfer rules.

WELCOME BACK

- > Graduate student Shantay Taylor returns to the court this season after missing nearly two full seasons due to injury.
- > The Columbia, S.C., native brings a wealth of experience to the Cherry & White having appeared in 85 games, starting 21 of those.

WILLNETT AND WILLIAMSON

- > Assistant coach Willnett Crockett has been instrumental in developing post players during her 13 seasons on Broad Street, and senior Alexa Williamson is no exception.
- > After averaging 12.5 points per game and 6.7 rebounds per game, Williamson was named to the 2021 All-Big 5 Second Team. She was also named Philadelphia Big 5 Player of the Week in the last week of December.

THE SCRIPT - HALL OF FAME

- > The Temple Hall of Fame Class of 2020 was announced on December 14, 2020 and included Temple women's basketball great Kamesha Hairston.
- > Hairston was named the 2007 Atlantic 10 and Big 5 Player of the Year at the conclusion of her senior season.
- > The Toledo, Ohio native ended her career with 1,573 points (9th all-time at TU), 757 rebounds (11th) and 235 steals (5th).
- > Hairston was selected with the 12th pick of the 2007 WNBA Draft by the Connecticut Sun.
- > In 2019, The Temple star was inducted into the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame.

- > The Cherry & White return home for a Big 5 battle against Saint Joseph's on Dec. 11 at 12:00pm.

TEMPLE AT A GLANCE...

Temple is in the 4th largest media market in the country, with over 2.9 million TV homes according to Nielsen. The designated market area (DMA) is 7.6 million.

Temple is located in a region of 6.53 million people, and is only 95 miles from NYC and 120 miles from Washington, D.C. In fact, more than 40% of the US population is within a day's drive from Philadelphia.

Temple is the 26th largest public University in the country with over 41,000 students founded in 1884 and has 404 academic programs including five professional schools of law, medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, and podiatry.

Temple is a Research I institution, a Carnegie Classification in 2015 as the highest level and

ranked by US News and World Report at 115 (6th) with an overall graduation rate of 70%, and has a full time retention rate for undergraduate students at 89%.

Temple is one of 11 institutions in the country with multi-year APR scores of 970 or greater for all teams including a 2015 multi-years APR score of 971.

Temple has over 300,000 alumni around the world including over 170,000 alumni that live in the Philadelphia DMA.

Temple's athletic department has 18 sports and over 500 student-athletes.

Temple's athletic facilities are among the finest in the country. The women's basketball team's primary home stadium, McGonigle

Hall, was recently renovated in 2012 to provide state-of-the-art practice facilities for the basketball programs.

The men's basketball team's primary home stadium, The Liacouras Center, is a state-of-the-art facility with a capacity crowd of 10,000.

Over the last five years, Temple has spent over \$50 million for athletics multipurpose facilities with all the athletic facilities being state-of-the-art.

The University itself has over \$400 million planned for capital projects over the next five years including a \$170 million state of the art library that opened in the fall of 2019.

Temple's all-time winningest head coach Tonya Cardoza enters her 14th season at the helm of the nationally recognized Owls.

During the 2020-21 season, Cardoza led the Owls to an 11-11 record during the shortened season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Cardoza led the 2019-20 Owls to a 16-15 record for their best finish in three seasons. Junior Mia Davis led Temple with her 18.8 points and 10.2 rebounds per game. Davis garnered national recognition in her third season in the Cherry and White, as she was named a Top 10 Cheryl Miller Award Finalist and earned USB-WA All-America Honorable Mention.

Cardoza's 2016-17 season was one of her best, as Temple went 24-8 overall, earned an NCAA bid, and finished second in the tough American Athletic Conference. The Owls' success garnered her several individual honors, among them being named one of 10 finalists for the WBCA National Coach of the Year Award. Cardoza shared American Athletic Conference Coach of the Year honors with UConn's Geno Auriemma and was also named the Philadelphia Big 5 Coach of the Year for the fourth time in her career.

Temple's 2015-16 season marked the second-straight 20-win campaign, as Cardoza guided the Owls to an overall mark of 23-12. In the AAC, Temple finished third, compiling an impressive 13-5 record, the best finish for the team in American history. The culmination of the 2015-16 season saw the Owls earn a post-season bid, where they advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2016 WNIT, before a narrow 77-76 loss at Michigan.

Cardoza's 2014-15 squad made the first post-season final four in program history, advancing to the WNIT semifinals before falling in overtime at West Virginia. The Owls finished with a 20-win season, going 20-17 overall, including a 12-6 mark in the tough American Athletic Conference.

2013-14 marked a new era of women's basketball at Temple for Cardoza— competing in the inaugural season of the American Athletic Conference. The Owls faced seven nationally ranked opponents— tying the school record for the most in season— including two games against defending national champion and No. 1 Connecticut and Final Four participant Louisville. The young Owls finished fifth in American play showing the league and the nation that they had fight.

The 2010-11 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year, Cardoza led the Owls to three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances, advancing to the Second Round in both 2010 and 2011. The Owls narrowly missed earning a berth in the NCAA Tournament in 2011-12, but took a top spot in the Women's National Invitation Tourna-

ment (WNIT) and advanced to the third round.

Along with earning Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year honors for the Owls' performance in 2010-11, Cardoza was honored as the Big 5 Coach of the Year for a third time. She earned that honor in each of her first three seasons at Temple, and the Owls earned their sixth straight Big 5 title in her first year with the program. Temple won the Big 5 again in 2011, and finished as runner-up in both 2010 and 2012.

Cardoza led Temple to at least 20 wins in her first four years at the helm. During her inaugural season in 2008-09, Cardoza guided TU to a 21-10 mark and an NCAA Tournament appearance. She was a finalist for the National Rookie Coach of the Year award. The Owls reached 25 wins in 2009-10 which tied for the second-most in the history of the program. In 2010-11, the Owls finished 24-9 which included a 15-game win streak and a 13-1 record in the A10. The 2011-12 season saw Temple go 23-10 and win 14 in a row, once again with a 13-1 mark in the conference. During their final year of A10 Conference play in 2012-13, Cardoza guided the nation's second-youngest team (six freshmen).

The Owls finished in the Top 3 in the A10 for three consecutive seasons. In Cardoza's first season she coached the squad to an upset over No. 13 Xavier, making her the first coach in TU women's basketball history to upset a ranked team during her rookie season.

Arriving at Connecticut at the start of the 1994-95 season, Cardoza helped guide the Huskies to an unprecedented 465-41 record, seven Final Four appearances and six No. 1 National Rankings in the final Associated Press poll. Cardoza was a part of four undefeated regular seasons, including two unbeaten national championship teams in 1994-95 and 2001-02.

A 1991 University of Virginia graduate with a degree in anthropology, Cardoza starred for the Cavaliers, leading the team to four consecutive NCAA National Tournament appearances. As a senior, she led UVA in scoring (15.5 ppg), while earning the following honors: Kodak Honorable Mention All-America; Kodak First Team All-District III; First Team All-ACC; NCAA Final Four All-Tournament Team, and NCAA Regional All-Tournament Team. She was also a First Team All-ACC pick in 1988-89.

Cardoza played in 121 games for UVA and graduated ranked third on the career steals list (375), fifth on the career blocked shots list (110), eighth in points (1,622) and 10th in rebounds (667).

In 2002, Cardoza was named to the ACC 50th Anniversary Women's Basketball Team along with seven other former Cavaliers including Staley.

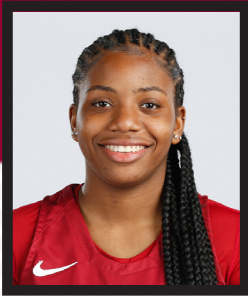

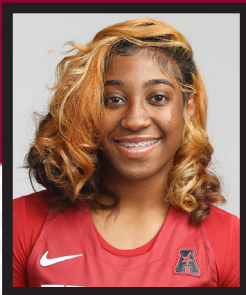
