HEADLINES

- > Temple concludes its first four-game homestand in 16 years with Cincinnati Thursday.
- > The Owls have lost two of the three games in this stretch, including Sunday against Tulane.
- > Temple players will be wearing "Coach" patches on their jerseys in honor of legendary coach John Chaney, who passed away on Jan. 29.
- > Damian Dunn continues to lead Temple and ranks 10th in the AAC in scoring (14.1 ppg). He also leads league (7th NCAA) in FTs made (6.0 pg).
- > Sophomore reserve Khalif Battle is second on the team in scoring (11.8 ppg) and third in rebounding (5.8 rpg).
- > Jake Forrester (10.0 ppg), who has scored in double figures in four straight games, tops TU in rebounding (6.7) and is third in the AAC in FG% (.596).
- > Senior De'Vondre Perry averages 8.3 ppg while freshman Jeremiah Williams (7.6 ppg) tops the Owls and is third in the AAC in assists (5.0 apg).
- > Senior J.P. Moorman II (7.7 ppg, 6.2 rpg) rounds out the starters while graduate reserve Brendan Barry (7.6 ppg) ranks second in the AAC in three-point percentage (20-42, .476).

NEWS AND NOTES

SCOUTING CINCINNATI

> Cincinnati, which has had its last five games postponed due to COVID-19, has not played since Jan. 10. are 10th in the AAC standings, winning just one conference game this season.
> Keith Williams (15.0 ppg) and Jeremiah Davenport (10.1 ppg) lead the rebuilding Bearcats in scoring .

SERIES HISTORY

> Temple and Cincinnati are meeting for the 34th time with UC holding a 24-9 lead in the series.
> The Bearcats have won seven straight, winning both games in last season's series.
> The Owls had previously won three straight and swept the regular season series in 2015-16, winning 77-70 at #22/23 Cincinnati on Dec. 29, 2015 and coming out on top in double overtime, 67-65 at home on Jan. 16, 2016.
> Before being members of The American, the last time the teams had met was on Dec. 9, 2006 at the Atlantic City Lenape Trail Classic at Boardwalk Hall. Cincinnati won that game, 80-71.
> Temple won three contests in a row before 2006, each time upsetting Cincinnati as the Bearcats were ranked #11, 4 and 1.
> On Feb. 20, 2000, the 15th-ranked Owls upset top-ranked Cincinnati 77-69 on the Bearcats' home court. It is one of only two wins by Temple over the #1 team in the nation.
> Temple advanced to the Sweet Sixteen on March 14, 1999, after unranked TU topped #11 Cincinnati, 77-69 in the NCAA 2nd Round.

LAST MEETING: @ Cincinnati 64, Temple 63 (3/8/20)

> Jaevin Cumberland, the reigning AAC Player of the Year, was a force all night. He had game highs of 20 points and seven assists to go along with his seven rebounds.
> Quinton Rose matched Cumberland with a team-high 19 points while grabbing five rebounds and dishing two assists
> Temple led for almost the entire contest on the strength of a stifling defense and timely offense. The Owls limited the Bearcats to 17 first half points on 24 percent shooting, including 10 percent (1-10) from three-point range.
> Cincinnati flipped the script in the second half, shooting 50 percent overall and from long range (6-12) to wipe away a 14-point halftime deficit to eke out the victory on its Senior Night.

LAST GAME: Tulane 81, @ Temple 64 (1/31/21)

> Playing just two days after the passing of legendary coach John Chaney, Temple fell to visiting Tulane, 81-64.
> Junior Jake Forrester and redshirt freshman Damian Dunn each scored 15 points to lead the Owls, with Forrester adding nine rebounds.
> Jaylen Forbes led five Tulane double-figure scorers with 23 points.
> After trailing 35-27 at the half, Temple jumped out quickly to start the final 20 minutes, scoring the first nine points during a 14-4 run to take a 41-39 lead.
> The lead would then change three times before an 11-3 run gave Tulane a 57-49 advantage with 8:55 remaining.
> The Green Wave extended its lead to 60-51 on a three-point play by Kevin Cross, only to have the Owls answer with an alley-oop dunk by J.P. Moorman II off a dish from Dunn. Then a Dunn pull-up jumper to cut the margin to five, 60-55.
> Tulane then clamped down defensively, holding the Owls scoreless for over four minutes, taking its largest lead, 67-55, at the three-minute mark on a trey by Jordan Walker.
> The Green Wave then sealed the win down the stretch at the line, making nine of 10 over the final 2:33.

5th All-Time in Wins

- > Temple's 90-73 victory over ECU on Feb. 7, 2018 put the Owls in elite company as they joined Kentucky, Kansas, North Carolina and Duke with 1,900 wins. Temple Basketball owns a 122-year won-loss record of 1,942-1,097. The Owls history also includes:
 - > 52 postseason tournament appearances (33 NCAAs, 19 NITs)
 - > Two Final Four appearances (1956 and 1958) under Harry "The Chief" Litwack.
 - > Five regional finals in 22 years under John Chaney (1988, 1991, 1993, 1999 and 2001)
 - > NIT championships in 1938 and 1969.
 - > Two Naismith Basketball Association Hall of Fame Coaches in Litwack and Chaney.

NEWS AND NOTES

MOURNING A LEGEND

- > John Chaney, the Hall of Fame Temple coach who drove his student-athletes to excellence on the court while teaching them to succeed off it, died on Jan. 29 after a short illness. He had celebrated his 89th birthday last week (Jan. 21).
- > One of the most respected figures in college sports, Coach Chaney led Temple's men's basketball program for 24 years. He was twice named the national Division I coach of the year, and his 1987-88 team ended the season ranked No. 1 in the country.
- > Coach Chaney's run at Temple was one of the most successful of any coach in the nation. Twenty-three of his 24 Temple teams played in postseason tournaments, including 17 NCAA Tournament appearances.
- > Before Coach Chaney's arrival in 1982, the men's basketball program had never participated in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments. Under his leadership, the Owls earned five consecutive berths between 1984 and 1988.
- > The program rode a school-record streak of 12 straight appearances in the March Madness field from 1990 through 2001, including five trips to the Elite Eight (1988, 1991, 1993, 1999 and 2001). Only four schools went to as many regional finals in those 16 years.
- > "John Chaney was a great coach, but he was so much more. For generations of Temple University students, he was a wise counselor, a dedicated teacher, an icon of success, and a passionate leader who always led by example and with conviction. For generations of his players, there is only one man whom they all lovingly called Coach even to this day. That was John Chaney. Our most sincere condolences go out to his wonderful family members. We will keep them all in our prayers." - Temple President Richard M. Englert, who has known Chaney since he came to Temple in 1982. "I am also honored to say he was a dear friend."
- > "John Chaney was more than just a Hall of Fame basketball coach. He was a Hall of Famer in life. He touched countless lives, including my own. I will miss him dearly and my thoughts and prayers go out to his family during this difficult time." - Fran Dunphy, Acting Director of Athletics and former Temple coach (2006-19).
- > "Coach Chaney was like a father to me. He taught not just me, but all of his players more than just how to succeed in basketball. He taught us life lessons to make us better individuals off the court. I owe so much to him. He made me the man I am today." - Temple coach Aaron McKie.

COACH CHANEY MEMORIAL SERVICE - FEB 8 AT LIACOURAS CENTER

- > Services for legendary men's basketball coach John Chaney will be held at The Liacouras Center on Monday, Feb. 8.
- > All are welcome to a socially-distanced Public Viewing scheduled from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- > A private family viewing will take place at 2 p.m. In addition, a private Celebration of Life service, by invitation only, will start at 3 p.m.
- > There will be a free video stream of the Celebration of Life service on YouTube.

HONORING HIS LEGACY

- > Temple players will wear patches on their uniforms the remainder of the season with the word "Coach" to honor John Chaney's memory.

RECORD PACE

- > Graduate student Brendan Barry, who joined the team two days before the season opener, is off to a record setting pace in his first season as an Owl.
- > The Dartmouth transfer leads the American Athletic Conference and ranks third in the nation in three-point percentage (20-42, .476) and is seventh in the AAC in three-pointers made per game (2.2).
- > The Owls' current single season records are held by Dionte Christmas (3.14, 2008-09) and Lynn Greer (50-106, .472). Jake O'Brien, another graduate transfer, made a similar impact from long range (58-135, .430) in helping lead the Owls' 2012-13 team to a 24-10 record and a NCAA Tournament berth.
- > Barry, who has come off the bench all season, ranks fourth on the Owls (20th AAC) in minutes played (28.3 mpg). He also is tied for sixth on the team in scoring (7.6 ppg).

CHARITY STRIPE

- > Redshirt freshman Damian Dunn has been living at the foul line this season.
- > The Owl guard not only leads the team in scoring (14.1 ppg), but is tied for seventh in the NCAA in free throws made per game (6.0) and ranks fifth in attempted (8.22).
- > His numbers could also challenge Temple single season records. Bill Kennedy holds the school record for free throws made per game (6.8, 1959-60) while Jim Williams holds the mark for free throws attempted per game (8.9, 1963-64).

NEWS AND NOTES

LEGACY OWL

> Temple junior forward Jake Forrester is following in his father's footsteps as a member of the Owls' basketball team. Jake's father, Dwight Forrester, played in 54 games from 1981-82 through 1984-85, scoring 58 points and grabbing 55 rebounds.

BATTLE RETURNS TO BATTLE

> The NCAA approved Khalif Battle's waiver to compete during the 2020-21 season on Nov. 25 making the sophomore guard immediately eligible.
 > Battle, however, was sidelined with a hamstring injury for the first five games before debuting at Tulane with three points and six rebounds in 19 minutes off the bench.
 > He followed that with 14 points, six rebounds and two assists in 33 minutes against #8 Houston and then his first double-double, 22 points and 11 rebounds in a win over Tulsa. The 22 points were a season high for all Temple players.
 > Currently he ranks second on the team in scoring (11.8 ppg) while ranking third on the Owls in rebounding (5.8 rpg).

SIXTH MEN

> Khalif Battle and Brendan Barry are the top sixth men in the nation in one category -- minutes per game.
 > Battle leads the nation in minutes per game for reserves who have not started a single contest, averaging 29.0 mpg.
 > Barry is second in the country with a 28.3 minutes per game average.
 > Third (as of Feb. 3) is Chris Childs of Bryant at 27.3 mpg.

BROOKS IS BACK

> Ryan Brooks, the first recruit by former head coach Fran Dunphy, has returned as one of three graduate managers for this season's team. He is joined by two other former collegiate standouts, Cameron Ayers (Bucknell, '10-14) and Sean O'Brien (Colgate, '14-18).
 > A familiar face to Temple fans, Brooks was Fran Dunphy's first recruit in 2006 and was instrumental in the Owls winning three straight Atlantic 10 Conference Championships (2008, 2009 2010). As a senior, he led Temple in scoring (14.3 ppg.), helping the Owls win 29 games and finish the season ranked 12th in the nation. Brooks, who played 10 seasons in Europe, finished his career with 1,225 points, 383 rebounds and 191 assists.

CALL TO THE HALL

> On Dec. 14, Temple University announced its 2020 Temple Athletics Hall of Fame Class. The 14 new individual members and the 1992 NCAA Champion Fencing Team included former men's basketball great, the late Mik Kilgore.
 > Kilgore, who played from 1988-92, started all 124 games during his career, scoring 1,471 points, pulling down 627 rebounds, dishing 380 assists and making 148 steals.
 > His TU teams advanced to three NCAA Tournaments, including the 1991 Elite Eight.

PASSING FANCY

> Temple University freshman point guard Jeremiah Williams is having a tremendous rookie season, leading the Owls and ranking third in the AAC in assists per game (5.0).
 > If he continues at this pace he will become the ninth Temple player, and just second freshman to average five or more assists, joining Pepe Sanchez, who averaged 5.3 apg during the 1996-97 season.

WALKING ON

> Temple University men's basketball coach Aaron McKie announced on Nov. 25 the addition of senior transfer Colin Daly to the 2020-21 roster. The 6-4, 185-pound guard, who will join the team as a walk-on, played the previous three seasons at West Chester.
 > Daly, whose brother Ryan is the leading returning scorer at Big 5 rival Saint Joseph's, scored 305 points, grabbed 113 rebounds and dished 59 assists over a 71-game career with the Golden Rams.

HOME SWEET HOME

> The Liacouras Center has proven to be a tremendous home court advantage. Since the arena opened its doors in 1997, the Owls have posted a 236-82 (.739) all-time record, and set the record for wins in a single season with 16 in 2014-15.
 > Temple is 143-46 (.759) at home since the start of the 2007-08 campaign.

FOR THREE

> Temple has made at least one three-pointer in 806 consecutive games.
 > The last time the Owls did not make a three-pointer in a game was February 1, 1996. Temple missed all 16 three-point attempts that day in dropping a 59-35 decision to #1 UMass at McGonigle Hall.

JOINING THE NEST

> Zach Hicks, a 6-7, 185-pound forward from Camden (N.J.) Catholic High School and Hysier (ha-SEER) Miller, a 6-1, 170-pound guard from Neumann Goretti in Philadelphia, signed National Letters of Intent to attend Temple University.
 > Hicks, a native of Camden, N.J., averaged 20 points, 7.6 rebounds and connected on 49 three-pointers last season as a junior. The standout small forward earned a spot on the All-South Jersey Second Team.
 > Miller, a third team All-State selection, averaged 14.3 points, 4.8 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game last season. The talented point guard led the Saints to the Philadelphia Catholic League Championship with the team finishing with a 24-4 record. Neumann-Goretti advanced to the quarterfinals of the PIAA Class 3A tournament when play was shut down because of the coronavirus outbreak.

 > Temple was originally scheduled to play at East Carolina on Jan. 16 but the game was postponed due to Covid issues with members of the ECU program.

FORRESTER HONORED AGAIN

> Jake Forrester was named to the American Athletic Conference Honor Roll for the week ending on January 24. It is the second straight week he has been so honored.
 > Forrester led the Owls in scoring (15 pts) and rebounding (8 reb) in a 78-61 loss to #8 Houston on Jan. 23 in the team's only game of the week.
 > The Harrisburg, Pa. native shot six-of-seven from the field while playing a career-best 32 minutes.
 > Temple was originally scheduled to play at East Carolina on Jan. 16 but the game was postponed due to Covid issues with members of the ECU program.



HEAD COACH AARON MCKIE

One of the greatest players in Temple Basketball history, Aaron McKie is in his second season as the head coach at his alma mater.

McKie officially took over the program where he starred under Hall of Fame coach John Chaney and served as an assistant coach for five seasons under Fran Dunphy, in April

of 2019. He is the 18th head coach in Temple men's basketball history, but just the fifth since Hall of Fame coach Harry Litwack took over the reins of the program in 1952. He is also the first alum to serve as the Owls' head coach since Litwack, who won 373 games and made two Final Four appearances in his 21-year tenure.

His first season at the helm was a year of transition for the new Temple mentor. After starting the season with four straight wins, which is the best start by a first-year Temple coach since Josh Cody ('42-43), the Owls fell in a close contest, 76-69, to #5 Maryland. The team ended the calendar year with a 9-3 mark, but the 2020 took its toll.

Temple posted just one win in January, but that victory, a 65-53 defeat of #16 Wichita State, extended the program streak of 13 straight seasons with a win over a ranked foe. McKie also became the first first-year Temple coach to defeat a nationally-ranked team since 1952-53 (Harry Litwack).

After regrouping, the Owls finished the 2019-20 campaign with a 14-17 record with the season coming to abrupt end to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Prior to the 2019-20 season, McKie served five seasons on Dunphy's staff at Temple, the last as associate head coach. In 2018-29, the Owls went 23-10, earned an NCAA Tournament berth and tied for third in the American Athletic Conference after being picked to finish sixth. The 20-win season was the third for Temple in McKie's five years on the staff, during which the Owls went to the NCAA Tournament twice and to the NIT Semifinals in 2015.

The Philadelphia basketball roots are deep for McKie and started in high school where he played at nearby Simon Gratz ('90). There, under the tutelage of legendary coach Bill Ellerbee, he helped lead the Bulldogs to the 1990 Philadelphia Public League Championship, their first title since 1939.

McKie then took his talents to North Broad Street to play under another legend in Chaney. Arguably one of the best players in Temple history, he had an incredible three-year playing career for the Owls (1991-92 through 1993-94) and is tied for sixth on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,650 points. A starter for all 92 games, he averaged 17.9 points per game while leading the Owls to three NCAA Tournaments and a trip to the 1993 Elite Eight. He earned many accolades during his heralded collegiate career, including Atlantic 10 Confer-

ence and Philadelphia Big 5 Player of the Year for his performance in the 1992-93 season, when he averaged a team-best 20.6 points per game.

Selected in the first round (17th overall) of the 1994 NBA Draft by the Portland Trail Blazers, McKie played 13 seasons, including eight with the Philadelphia 76ers where he was coached by another basketball giant in Larry Brown. As a member of the Sixers in 2000-01, McKie enjoyed his best season, taking home Sixth Man of the Year honors while helping his hometown team reach the NBA Finals.

McKie has more than a decade of coaching experience. Besides serving as an assistant coach under Dunphy for the past five seasons, he was also a five-year assistant (2007-13) on the 76ers staff and helped lead the franchise to four NBA playoff appearances.

McKie resides in the Philadelphia area with his wife, Lisa, and their four children, Erin, Jaron, and twin sons Justin and Julian.
