## The Tigers at a Glance

### GIO-B-P

Freshman OF/DH Gio Brusa homered four times in a stretch of six games, as he's continued to blossom in the second half of the season for Pacific. Brusa struggled out of the gate (after turning down the Boston Red Sox 5th round draft offer), but is hitting .333 in his last 27 games, (32-of-96), starting with an 8-for-11 series against Long Beach State. He's also walked 11 times to reach base 46 times in his last 110 plate appearances (.418). Against UC Davis, Brusa went six-for-13 with a pair of home runs and six runs batted in. Brusa now leads the Tigers in home runs on the season with his four. Brusa's nine-game hit streak was snapped Saturday at UC Santa Barbara, but he has hit safely in 20 of 27 games with nine multi-hit games.

### EYE OF THE TYGER

2B/DH Tyger Pederson has reached base in a team-high 14 consecutive games entering Tuesday's action. Pederson has a seven-game hit streak and has hit safely in 13 of the last 14 games, hitting 15-for-48 (.313). Pederson has also walked four times in that stretch, while scoring six runs. Pederson reached base in 12 consecutive games to start the season and has reached in 41 of his 49 games.

### THE TORCH BEARER

3B Dustin Torchio is hitting .367 in his 15 games, 22-for-60, with a four of doubles and six RBI. He's also walked twice and been hit four times for a .424 on base percentage in that stretch. Torchio has hit safely in 12 of those 15 games, with eight multi-hit games. Since sliding over from SS to the 3B position he'd manned in 2011 and 2012, Torchio is hitting .319 in 18 games. His eight-game hit streak came to an end on Tuesday against Sacramento State. Torchio leads Pacific with 18 multi-hit games this season.

### HABERMAN HURLING GEMS

John Haberman tossed eight shutout innings on Friday (May 10) against UC Davis, scattering six hits and striking out seven in a hard-luck no decision. Against UC Santa Barbara, Haberman stretched his streak to 14 shutout innings before giving up two runs, one in the seventh and eighth innings. In his last three outings, Haberman has a 1.66 ERA (4 ER in 21.2 IP) with a 1.10 WHIP, 16 strikeouts and four walks.

### HE'S BAAAACK

RHP Michael Benson made his return to the mound Sunday against UC Davis (5/12). Benson pitched for the first time since April 13, when he broke his non-throwing hand against UC Riverside. Benson retired the first five he faced before allowing an unearned run in two innings of work. Against UC Santa Barbara, Benson tossed the ninth allowing just one hit for his first save. After starting in his first 22 career appearances, Benson has a 0.00 ERA with a save, two hits allowed and two strikeouts in his 3.0 bullpen innings.

### BIG WEST TENURE WINDS DOWN

The Tigers have three games remaining in the Big West slate as Pacific will wrap up the 43rd and final season as members of the conference at home against Cal Poly.

Pacific is 252-515 all-time in Big West play, and 202-422-1 all-time against current Big West members.

Pacific will join the West Coast Conference on July 1. All-time against current WCC members, the Tigers are 221-205-3.

### UP NEXT:

The Tigers wrap up the 2013 campaign at home against Cal Poly in a Thursday-Saturday series. Pacific will honor four seniors: Jacob Goulder, Travis Lumby, Tyger Pederson and Dustin Torchio before Saturday's game three.

## Head Coach Ed Sprague

Head Coach Ed Sprague enters his 10th season at the helm of the Pacific Baseball program in the spring of 2013. The Stockton native took over the hometown program after an 11-year Major League career, and has guided the Tigers to 195 wins. In 2005 and 2006, his Tigers posted back-to-back seasons with 30 or more wins for the first time in program history. In 2010, the Tigers set a school record for wins in a season with 31 and received votes in the national polls. He has a combined 195-303 record in his nine seasons with the Tigers, posting a pair of 30 win seasons at 30-25 in 2006 and a 30-28 mark in 2005. He guided Pacific to one of the best seasons in program history in 2010, finishing with a 31-23 overall record that included a new program record of 31 victories over Division I opponents. That season Pacific won nine of its 14 series, including sweeping San Jose State from March 26-28. The Tigers also received votes in national top 30 polls on four occasions during the 2010 season.

During his tenure, 13 of his players have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, with 10 players currently active in the professional ranks, including a pair of major leaguers (Chase Headley and Erik Hamren of the San Diego Padres); Twenty-eight players have earned All-Big West honors, including seven first team selections, and a school-record six honorees in 2010.

In the 2009 season, Sprague helped gear Pacific in the right direction of another winning season, laying the foundations for 2010 after recording victories over No. 8 Baylor, No. 11 San Diego, No. 16 Cal Poly and a series victory at No. 6 Cal State Fullerton in March. The series victory against Cal State Fullerton marked the first time one of Sprague's teams defeated the Titans in his career. Pacific finished with nine conference wins in 2009, tying the mark set in both the 2005 and 2006 seasons.

In 2011, Pacific posted three wins over ranked teams, topping No. 10 Cal State Fullerton and No. 13 Cal on the road, and a home win over No. 17 UC Irvine.

Sprague's 195 career victories have him in third place in Tiger history for most coaching victories.

In addition to his coaching efforts, Sprague's biggest accomplishment at Pacific has been spearheading a campaign to build an on-campus home field. That vision became a reality on Oct. 15, 2004, as the Tigers officially broke ground on Klein Family Field, the Tigers' current on-campus stadium. The stadium officially became the new home of the Pacific Tigers on April 18, 2006, as Pacific defeated Nevada, 8-3, in the inaugural game.

Between the lines, Sprague's arrival brought a championship pedigree to Pacific Baseball as he was the starting third baseman on the 1987 and 1988 NCAA Championship teams at Stanford. He finished his career among the school's all-time leaders in home runs (2nd with 41) and RBI (4th with 178). A 1988 All-American, he hit .339 with 22 home runs and 81 RBI. He was also a two-time All Pac-10 Conference selection in 1987 and 1988. For his accomplishments, Ed was a 2002 inductee into the Stanford Athletic Hall of Fame. In the summer of 1988, Sprague collected another championship as he won a Gold Medal with USA Baseball in the Summer Olympics.

Following his collegiate career, Ed was selected in the first round of the 1988 draft by the Toronto Blue Jays. He made it to the Major Leagues in 1991 with the Blue Jays and enjoyed an 11-year career as a big leaguer. His knack for winning championships continued at the major league level as Sprague helped the Blue Jays win back-to-back World Series Championships in 1992 and 1993. Later in his career, as a Pittsburgh Pirate, Sprague earned a selection to the 1999 All-Star Game. Sprague hit 152 career home runs and tallied 558 RBI, including single-season bests with 36 home runs and 101 RBI in 1996 with Toronto. He also played with the Boston Red Sox, Oakland A's, Seattle Mariners and San Diego Padres.

Ed's decorated playing career marks him as the only player ever to win a College World Series, Olympic Gold Medal and a Major League Baseball World Series.

A Stockton native, Sprague returned to his home prior to the 2003 season as an assistant coach at St. Mary's High School, helping the Rams to a Sac-Joaquin Section playoff berth. The following summer he took over as the 16th head baseball coach for Pacific. Sprague is one of two Olympic athletes in his family as his wife of 16 years, Kristen Babb Sprague, was an Olympic gold medalist in synchronized swimming in 1992. Ed and Kristen have four children, Payton, Jed, Paris and John.
