The Tigers took No. 4 seed Boston College to double overtime, and nearly pulled off the upset. Although Pacific fell behind early, the Tigers rallied to even the score at halftime. Falling behind again in the second half, Pacific was down 53-40 with 9:49 remaining in regulation, but once again turned to seniors Christian Maraker, Johnny Gray and Mike Webb. With Pacific down by three, the Tigers' senior captain stepped up again, as Maraker knocked down his second shot from behind the arc to send the game into overtime, knotted at 65-65. In the first overtime, the Tigers took a six point lead on back-to-back three-pointers by Webb. With the Tigers up 74-69 with 1:12 remaining in overtime, the Eagles responded, scoring the final five points of the period. In the second overtime, the Eagles used a 9-0 run to start the period and sealed the game from there. The Tigers were led by Maraker who finished the game with a game-high 30 points on 8-of-16 shooting, including 12-of-14 from the line, in his final college game.

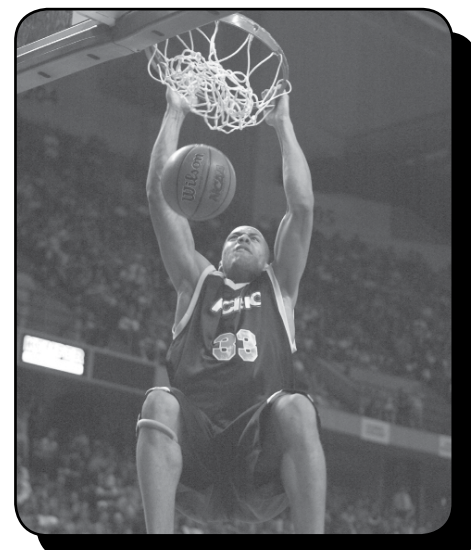
Miami 78, Pacific 49

Pacific dropped a 78-49 decision to No. 5 ranked Miami on Friday, March 22nd in an NCAA Tournament Second Round matchup at the Frank Erwin Center. The 15th seeded Tigers finish the season with a record of 22-13. Miami, the No. 2 seed, improved to 28-6 with the victory. Pacific scored first on a layup by junior Khalil Kelley. The Hurricanes went up 8-4, but Kelley converted a short jumper and free throw for a three-point play to make it 8-7 with 14:35 to play in the half. The Tigers then got stuck at the seven point mark, as six Miami players scored in a 14-0 run that gave the Hurricanes a commanding 22-7 lead with 7:30 to play. A Kelley dunk sparked a 4-0 spurt for the Tigers that made it 22-11, but Miami answered with a 14-2 stretch that pushed the lead to 23 (36-13) with 1:42 to play. Senior Markus Duran hit a three-pointer at the halftime buzzer to make it 40-19 at the break. Miami hit four straight three-pointers to account for a 12-2 run and take a 59-29 lead with 11:47 to go. Fulton led the Tigers with 18 points, 15 of which were scored in the second half. Kelley scored 11 points. It was Kelley's sixth game with double-figure points and first since scoring 12 against Cal State Fullerton on Jan. 26, 2013.

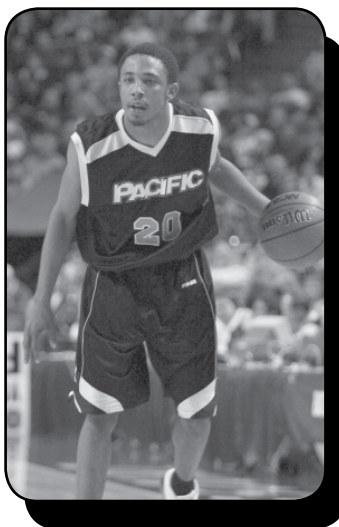

#32 • Keith Swagerty 1965-67

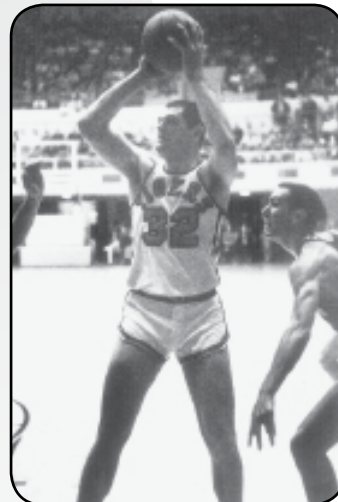
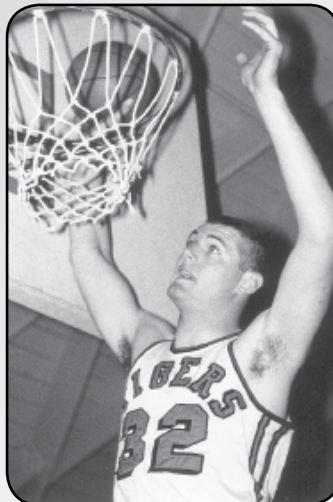


The first Tiger to have his number retired was the most prolific rebounder in Pacific history (he cleared the boards 1,505 times during his career) and is third all-time in scoring with 1,650 points.

The 6-7 center was the hub of Dick Edward's first "great" team and the Tigers went 46-10 during Swagerty's final two seasons, winning two West Coast Athletic Conference titles and making two trips to the NCAA Tournament.

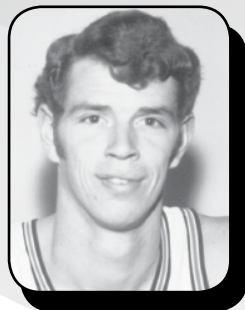
Swagerty was first team All-WCAC and conference MVP both years and earned All-American recognition as a senior. He was also named Northern California Player of the Year for his performance, which included 18.9 ppg and an incredible 18.5 rpg. He finished fourth in the nation in rebounding after being third the season before while grabbing 18.4 per contest.

Not surprisingly, Swagerty was Pacific's leading scorer and rebounder for three consecutive seasons and 33 times during his career he accounted for 20 or more rebounds. One of the finest games was a 26-point, 23-rebound effort in the 1966 NCAA West Regionals against Houston.



Ranked among the nation's leaders in rebounds, Swagerty was also a first team Academic All-American in 1967.

#23 • John Gianelli 1970-72

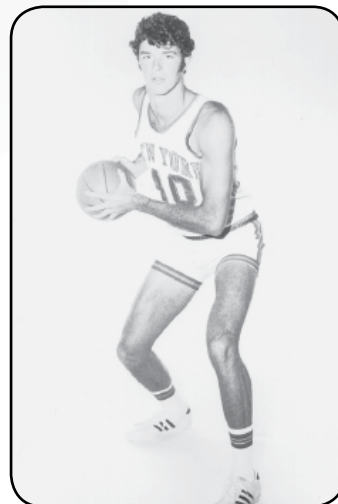
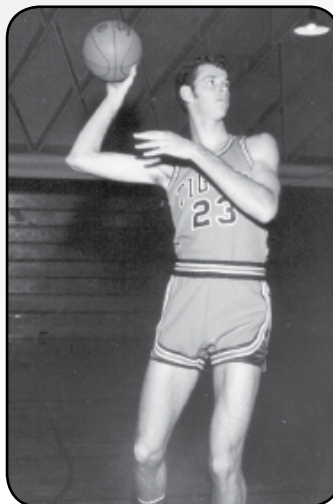


A hometown hero from Stockton's Edison High School, John Gianelli guided the Tigers to a pair of WCAC titles in 1970 and 1971, breaking Swagerty's school record for points scored (1,659) and helping Pacific build a 60-21 overall mark in his three seasons with the varsity.

Gianelli was MVP of the WCAC in 1971 and first team All-PCAA the following year, which saw him garner All-American accolades.

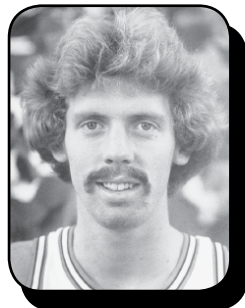
In his senior year, 1972, he finished 2nd in the nation in rebounding (17.9 pg) and wound up 4th as a junior (18.2 pg). Gianelli is currently third on Pacific's all-time scoring list and third in career rebounding.

His career scoring average of 20.5 per game is the best total in Pacific history and he topped the squad in scoring twice and rebounding in each of his three seasons. Nine times he scored 30 or more points in a game and 20 times he collected at least 20 rebounds. Following his collegiate career, he enjoyed a lengthy stint with the New York Knicks.



Gianelli blocked and swatted opponents through three college seasons at Pacific and a pro career in the NBA.

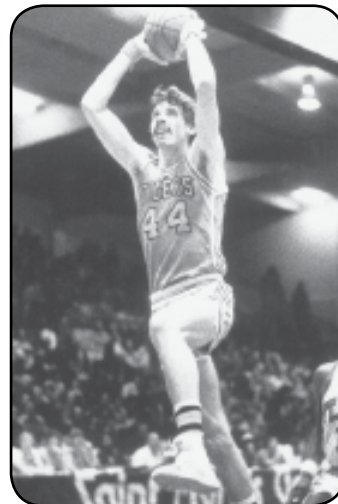
#44 • Ron Cornelius 1978-81



Ron Cornelius was the third player to have his number retired. He broke Gianelli's all-time scoring record and finished up with 2,065 career points, also a Pacific Coast Athletic Association record. He also set a PCAA mark for career rebounds and is fourth all-time in that department at Pacific.

Three times, Cornelius was first team All-PCAA and he won conference MVP honors as a sophomore after leading Pacific to the hoop crown and a berth in the NCAA Tournament.

He led the Tigers in scoring twice, rebounding and field goal percentage four times. He earned All-American recognition after his junior and senior seasons and was a third round pick by the Los Angeles Lakers in the 1981 NBA Draft.



The Pacific Coast Athletic Association MVP in 1979, Cornelius led Pacific to the PCAA title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament.



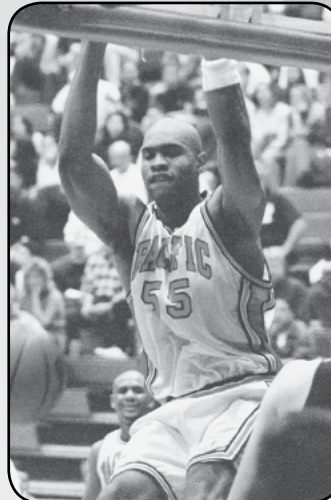
#55 • Michael Olowokandi 1995-98

Michael Olowokandi was the fourth player to have his number retired at Pacific. He was Pacific's first All-American since Matt Waldron in 1982, after earning NABC All-America Honorable Mention honors in 1998.

His amazing story has been well-documented, making the journey from England as a walk-on, having not played organized basketball to that point in his life. He improved to the point of being

the first pick in the 1998 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Clippers.

In his final year at Pacific, Michael earned Big West Conference Player of the Year honors, leading the Tigers to a Big West Western Division championship, and the National Invitation Tournament. He set the single-season scoring mark for Pacific with 732 points in 1997-98, averaging 22.2 points per game. He also shattered the single-season and career blocks records at Pacific, with 95 in his senior year and 160 in his career. He also holds the career and single-season records for field goal percentage, shooting 61 percent as a senior and 59 percent for his career.



Michael Olowokandi dominated the floor during his senior season with the Tigers, earning Big West Conference Player of the Year honors.



In 1998, the Pacific basketball program created a limited edition lithograph, featuring the four players who have had their jerseys retired at Pacific.
