THE OPENING TIP

The Portland State Vikings face a formidable opponent in their final chance at non-conference play this Tuesday evening at Utah State. The Vikings (3-6) and the Aggies (8-4) will meet for the first time in four seasons and the first time in Logan since Dec. 18, 1978.

PSU goes into the contest off a pair of three-point losses that followed a similar script. The Vikings dropped a 61-58 game to Cal Poly on Dec. 11, then a 69-66 game at CSUN on Dec. 18. In both, Portland State started slow offensively, then roared back late in the second half behind a pressure defense that triggered the offense. Each game also saw a late, tying three-point attempt by the Vikings fall away.

Losers of three straight, the Vikings are still looking for offensive consistency to match their defensive and rebounding successes of the early season. Viking opponents shoot a mere .390 from the field and average 16.4 turnovers per game.

PSU will need to ignite its offense early to stay with Mountain West powerhouse Utah State. JR G Marlon Ruffin scored a season-high 26 points (10-15 FG, 2-3 3-pt, 4-4 FT) at CSUN, JR G Michael Carter III had 20 points against Cal Poly, and SR F James Jean-Marie is averaging 12.9 points on .488 shooting this season. Getting all three going early on Tuesday - as well as their teammates - will be vital to the Vikings' chances.

Utah State, an NCAA Tournament team in 2021, features a dynamic offense that shoots .486 from the field and averages nearly 10 made three-pointers per game. Senior forward Justin Bean leads the way with 19.2 points and 10.3 rebounds per game, while shooting .647 from the field.

The Aggies, who had a six-game winning streak earlier in the season are 3-2 at home. They have two common opponents with the Vikings: Weber State (won 95-80, PSU lost 80-69); and Iowa (lost 94-75 last Saturday, PSU lost 85-51).

HEAD COACH JASE COBURN

After years of effort, toil and passion, Jase Coburn's lifelong dream - to be a college basketball head coach - has come true. Coburn was named the new Head Coach on April 16, 2021. It comes after eight previous seasons in the program, first as an Assistant Coach from 2013-2018, then as Associate Head Coach from 2018-21.



Coburn takes over the Viking program as the 14th head coach in its 60-year playing history, and seventh since Portland State joined the Big Sky Conference in 1996-97. His experience prior to coming to PSU in 2013 includes coaching stops on the high school and junior college levels.

Coburn has played an instrumental role in recruiting at Portland State, particularly with the addition of top scorers DaShaun Wiggins and Cameron Forte, top transfer Calaen Robinson and many other Arizona prospects including PSU's all-time leader in assists and steals, Holland Woods.

Prior to coming to Portland State, Coburn gained a wealth of coaching experience. Though only 37, he has been coaching for 18 years, including a dozen years at the junior college and Division I levels. He was an assistant at Howard (TX) Junior College. Howard went 53-14 over the two seasons he was there, winning an NJCAA Region 5 Championship and reaching the NJCAA National Tournament final eight. Howard was a top-10 ranked program those two seasons.

Coburn was the Head Coach at McClintock High School in Tempe, AZ from 2007 to 2011. At 23, he was one of the youngest head coaches ever to be hired in Arizona, and by 26 had led the team to a state title. Coburn's 2009-10 team won the 4A state championship, and two other times his teams reached the quarterfinals. He was the consensus Arizona 4A Coach of the Year in 2009-10. Overall, his teams compiled a 74-39 record.

Coburn was an assistant coach at Phoenix College from 2005 to 2007 when the team twice reached the national tournament. He spent one season as an assistant coach at Corona del Sol (AZ) HS in 2004-05. He has also coached AAU basketball (Arizona Rage, 2003-07; and Compton Magic, 2011).

COMING UP

Portland State resumes Big Sky Conference play on Thursday, Dec. 30 at home when the Vikings host Eastern Washington. Idaho comes to the Viking Pavilion on Saturday, Jan. 1. Both games tip off at 7 p.m. and can be seen on ESPN+. They start a stretch of six out of eight games at home for the Vikings.

GAME NOTES: PORTLAND STATE vs. UTAH STATE

- **ALL-TIME SERIES:** Utah State leads the all-time series, 3-2... the Vikings have won the last two meetings - one coming in 1981 and the most recent on Nov. 20, 2017 - an 83-79 victory at Portland's Memorial Coliseum as a preliminary to the PK80 Basketball Tournament... the schools met four times between 1976 and 1981... USU has won the only two meetings in Logan with the last game there coming on Dec. 18, 1978, a 94-68 Utah State win.
- **PORTLAND STATE vs. THE MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE:** Portland State is 23-53 all-time against current members of the Mountain West Conference. The last MWC opponent for the Vikings was San Jose State in 2019 (a 91-76 PSU win).
- **COACHES:** Vikings Coach Jase Coburn (Arizona State, 2006) is in his first season as Head Coach. He has spent eight previous seasons on the Park Blocks as an Assistant and Associate Head Coach... Ryan Odom (Hampden-Sydney, 1996) is in his first year at Utah State. In seven seasons as a head coach at Charlotte, Lenoir-Rhyne and Maryland-Baltimore County (UMBC), he compiled a 126-81 record.

SCOUTING THE AGGIES

- Utah State is a member of the Mountain West Conference located in Logan, UT.
- The Aggies were 20-9 last season, including 15-4 and second place MWC play. Utah State received an 11-seed in the 2021 NCAA Tournament. Two starters and seven letterwinners return from that team.
- Utah State is 8-4 on the season, 3-2 at home. The Aggies average 79.4 points per game and allow 70.3 per game. They shoot .486 from the field, .379 from three-point range and .750 at the free throw line. USU averages a remarkable 20.0 assists per game.
- Senior forward Justin Bean leads the team with 19.2 points and 10.3 rebounds per game. He shoots .647 from the field, .480 from three-point range and .840 at the line. He also averages 2.9 assists and 1.9 steals per game.
- Senior forward Brandon Horvath averages 13.8 points and 5.7 rebounds per game while shooting .518 from the field and .478 from three-point range.
- Junior guard Rylan Jones averages 5.9 assists per game.

- Portland State is 3-6 on the season, 2-2 at home, 1-4 on the road.
- The Vikings have lost three in a row and five out of six.

Home Court(s)

- Portland State opened the Viking Pavilion at the Peter W. Stott Center in 2018-19. The Stoller Family Court is PSU's fifth home court since joining the Big Sky Conference in 1996-97. Previously, the main home court was the old Peter W. Stott Center. However, the Vikings also used the Rose Garden (now Moda Center) and Memorial Coliseum occasionally over the years. In 2017-18, PSU used Lewis & Clark College's Pamplin Sports Center as a home court while the Viking Pavilion was being completed. Here is the breakdown:

 - Peter W. Stott Center - 233 games, 168-65, .721
 - Rose Garden (Moda Center) - 28 games, 19-9, .679

- Portland State has lost only 14 non-conference home games in the last 13 seasons (61-14). PSU is 29-13 against Division I schools, and 32-1 against lower division schools over that span.

VIKING PAVILION VACCINATION POLICY

Portland State Basketball is welcoming back fans to the Viking Pavilion this season after the 2020-21 season was without spectators due to COVID-19. All attendees to Viking Pavilion ages 12 and older will need to show proof of vaccination, including a CDC-issued Vaccination Record Card (or photo of the card) and corresponding identification.

- In lieu of a vaccination card, attendees may also display documentation of a negative COVID test within the past 48 hours to gain entry.
- Because current PSU students and employees are already required to have proof of vaccine, PSU attendees will need to present their PSU ID to attend events in Viking Pavilion.
- Attendees under the age of 12 will not be required to show proof of vaccine or a negative test.
- PSU students, faculty, and staff can show their valid PSU ID as proof of compliance with the University's COVID-19 campus vaccination policy.
- Fans who have pre-purchased tickets, but choose not to comply with PSU regulations, may request a refund from the box office.
- Masks will continue to be required for spectators 5 years and older at all competitions, regardless of location, per the state-wide mandate.

0-1 in televised games in 2021-22.

- The Vikings are 54-2 against lower division schools in 26 seasons as a member of the Big Sky Conference and Division I (1996-2021).

WHO IS HOT

- Despite not starting for the first time this season, JR G Marlon Ruffin posted a Portland State season-high 26 points (10-15 FG, 2-3 3-pt, 4-4 FT) and five rebounds in 25 minutes at CSUN... Ruffin leads the Vikings in scoring at 13.1 per game.
- JR G Ian Burke has shot .500 or better in every game this season. He is currently shooting .607 from the field and .533 from three-point range. Burke scored a season-high 10 points (3-4 FG, 2-3 3-pt, 2-2 FT) with five rebounds and three steals at CSUN.
- SR F James Jean-Marie has six double-doubles this season. He ranks second in the Big Sky with 10.3 rebounds per game and is 12th in the nation. He leads the Big Sky in offensive rebounds per game (4.6) and ranks second in the nation.
- DEFENSE TRAVELS:** Head Coach Jase Coburn likes to say, "defense travels" meaning regardless of where you play, or how much you score, you can always have a consistent defensive effort. The Vikings have had that in 2021-22, leading the Big Sky Conference in field goal percentage defense (.390), steals (9.8), blocked shots (3.7), turnovers forced (16.4) and offensive rebounds (14.1)... the Vikings are currently 15th in the nation in offensive rebounds and 26th in the nation in steals per game... opponents average 66.0 points per game, which ranks second-best in the Big Sky.

ON THE REBOUND

SR F James Jean-Marie is averaging 10.3 rebounds per game to rank second in the Big Sky. The last Viking to average double figures in rebounds was Bob Sisul in 1978-79 (10.4). The highest rebounding average of PSU's Big Sky Conference era (1996-present) was 9.4 by Seamus Boxley in 2003-04.

- His four straight double-doubles to open the season were the most consecutive by a Viking in the Big Sky Conference era (26 seasons).
- Went for a season-high 17 points (7-17 FG, 3-4 FT) and 10 rebounds against Portland (11/23).
- Posted 16 points (3-4 FG, 1-1 3-pt FG, 9-12 FT) with 10 rebounds and a block in the win at Idaho State (12/2).
- Grabbed a season-high 15 rebounds in the loss at Iowa (11/26).

RESPECT THE SPECS

JR G Marlon Ruffin has found his way to Portland State with a unique look. Ruffin is one of the few collegiate players who wears glasses on the court... and his specs have style.

- Ruffin is averaging a team-leading 13.1 points per game and 4.1 rebounds.
- Has led the team in scoring three times, has seven double-figure scoring games and one 20-point game.
- Went for 18 points (6-9 FG, 5-6 FT) in 18 minutes against Evergreen State (11/12).
- Had 18 points (7-14 FG, 3-4 FT), four rebounds and two steals at Iowa (11/26).
- Posted a season-high 26 points (10-15 FG, 2-3 3-pt, 4-4 FT) and grabbed five rebounds at CSUN (12/18).

- Transfer JR G Michael Carter III is becoming a stat sheet filler. He averages 9.1 points, 2.9 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 1.3 steals per game. Carter averaged 14.6 points per game last year at Long Beach State.
- Carter ranks third on the team in scoring, second in assists and steals, and first in three-pointers made (8).
 - He has led the team in scoring twice and assists five times.
 - Posted 14 points (5-12 FG, 2-4 3-pt, 2-2 FT) with three rebounds and three assists at Weber State (12/4).
 - Racked up a season-high 20 points (5-10 FG, 2-3 3-pt, 8-12 FT) with three rebounds, three assists and two steals against Cal Poly (12/11).

EFFICIENCY, THY NAME IS IAN BURKE

JR G Ian Burke continues to be a reliable offensive performer on the Viking team as he is one of the team's top shooters and ball-handlers.

- In 154 minutes of playing time this season he has only four turnovers. That continues a trend as Burke has just 28 total turnovers in 62 career games at PSU. He made only nine in 22 games last season.
- He is shooting .607 from the field and .533 from three-point range this season, and has shot at least .500 from the field in every game this season.
- Burke is averaging 6.1 points, 3.1 rebounds, 1.1 assists and 1.5 steals per game.
- Logged a season-high 10 points (3-4 FG, 2-3 3-pt, 2-2 FT) with five rebounds and three steals at CSUN (12/18).

SHOOTING STAR

SR F Khalid Thomas is the Vikings' top returning scorer (11.2) and rebounder (5.0) and tied for the team-lead in three-pointers last season (32).

- Thomas averages 7.6 points, 6.0 rebounds to rank ninth in the Big Sky, and 1.9 steals per game to rank second in the Big Sky.
- Scored a team-high 16 points (6-13 FG, 4-9 3-pt) at Oregon State (11/9).
- Had 11 points and a career-high nine rebounds at Iowa (11/26).
- Matched his career-high with nine rebounds at Weber State (12/4).

UP WITH ALLEY

SR G Ezekiel Alley has been an impact player off the bench and is expected to do more as the season progresses. A transfer from Northwest Nazarene, he has made a smooth transition from Division II to Division I.

- Alley averages 6.8 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.2 assists in 21 minutes per game off the bench.
- Alley ranks ninth in the Big Sky in assists and has led the Vikings in assists seven times.
- Had a season-high seven assists to go with eight points (4-5) against George Fox (11/17).

BIG GAMES OFF THE BENCH

- JR F Gio Nelson scored a career-high 13 points (5-6 FG, 3-3 3-pt) with five rebounds in a win over Evergreen State (11/12).
- FR G Paris Dawson scored 19 points (6-8 FG, 1-2 3-pt, 6-6 FT) in 21 minutes in the win over George Fox (11/17).
- SR G Ezekiel Alley made a season-best seven assists to go with eight points (4-5 FG) in the win over George Fox (11/17).
- JR G Ian Burke had seven points (2-4 FG, 1-2 3-pt, 2-2 FT), five assists, four rebounds, three steals and two blocked shots in only 14 minutes against George Fox (11/17).
- SR G Ezekiel Alley scored 11 points (5-9 FG, 1-3 3-pt) with three assists and two rebounds in 20 minutes against Portland (11/23).
- SR G Ezekiel Alley had 10 points (5-12 FG), two rebounds and three assists in 22 minutes at Weber State (12/4).
- JR G Marlon Ruffin scored 26 points (10-15 FG, 2-3 3-pt, 4-4 FT) with five rebounds in 25 minutes at CSUN (12/18).
- JR G Ian Burke scored 10 points (3-4 FG, 2-3 3-pt, 2-2 FT) with five rebounds and three steals at CSUN (12/18).

SEASON HIGHLIGHT REEL

- **Nov. 12, PSU 100, Evergreen State 44:** Portland State picked up its first win of the season in relatively easy fashion. The Vikings rolled over the Geoducks, shooting .536 from the field - its best mark in two seasons. JR G Marlon Ruffin scored 18 points (6-9 FG, 5-6 T) in 18 minutes while SR F James Jean-Marie had 15 points (6-9 FG, 1-1 3-pt, 2-5 FT) and 10 rebounds. The victory was the first for new Head Coach Jase Coburn.
- **Nov. 17, PSU 104, George Fox 58:** The Vikings had another big offensive night, shooting 41-71 from the field (.577). PSU had 66 points in the paint, 26 on the fast break, and scored 50 points off 27 George Fox turnovers. FR G Paris Dawson came off the bench to score a career-high 19 points (6-8 FG, 1-2 3-pt, 6-6 FT). SR F James Jean-Marie registered his third straight double-double with 14 points (7-10 FG) and

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT PORTLAND STATE

Portland State University, located in Portland, has an enrollment of 26,012 students. PSU was founded in 1946 as Vanport College - a two-year institution.

Athletically, Portland State began as a junior college in 1946-47, but competed in the Oregon Collegiate Conference (NAIA) beginning in 1948-49 to 1964-65. PSU became a four-year institution - Portland State College - in 1955. The Vikings won five OCC titles and competed in the NAIA playoffs twice.

Portland State joined the NCAA in 1965-66. The Vikings reached the College Division playoffs in 1966-67. College Division was the forerunner to Division II. Portland State was given university status in 1969.

During the 1970s, Portland State competed as a Division I program. The Vikings' biggest star was Freeman Williams, who still ranks as the second all-time leading scorer in college basketball history behind Pete Maravich. Williams, a Division I All-American in 1978, scored 3,249 points in his career.

The university dropped the men's basketball program in 1981 for budgetary reasons. It remained dormant until 1996-97 when basketball was reinstated and Portland State joined the Big Sky Conference. PSU has had 10 winning records in its 21 years as a member.

Portland State won the Big Sky Conference regular season title in 2004-05 (19-9, 11-3), but lost in the Big Sky Tournament semifinals, missing a chance for the NCAA Tournament.

In 2007-08, the Vikings won the Big Sky Conference regular season and tournament titles going 23-10, 14-2 in the Big Sky Conference. The resulting NCAA berth was the first at the Division I level for the Viking program. The Vikings lost to eventual national champion Kansas, but concluded the most successful season in school history.

In 2008-09, PSU once again won 23 games - matching the school record - and reached a second straight NCAA Tournament after winning the Big Sky Conference Tournament for the second year in a row.

With 78 wins from 2007-10, PSU had its most successful era in school history.

Portland State has had 20 first team All-Big Sky Conference selections since 1996, including two Big Conference Players of the Year (Seamus Boxley, Jeremiah Dominguez), three Big Sky Defensive Players of the Year (Seamus Boxley - twice, Scott Morrison), and four Big Sky Newcomers of the Year (Jason Hartman, Ime Udoka, Dupree Lucas, Jeremiah Dominguez), one 6th Man of the Year (DaShaun Wiggins) and two Big Sky Freshmen of the Year (Seamus Boxley, Holland Woods).

Among Vikings in the NBA, Freeman Williams and Ime Udoka each spent seven playing seasons in the league. After several seasons as an assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs, Philadelphia 76ers and Brooklyn Nets, Udoka was named Head Coach of the Boston Celtics in July of 2021.

• **Dec. 2, PSU 63, Idaho State 55:** The Vikings handed new Head Coach Jase Coburn a win in his first Big Sky Conference game. PSU never trailed after the first two minutes, out-rebounded ISU 45-31 and forced 18 turnovers. SR F James Jean-Marie had his fifth double-double of the season with 16 points (3-4 FG, 9-12 FT) and 10 rebounds. JR G Marlon Ruffin added 10 points, nine rebounds and two steals.

2021-22 FAST BREAKS

- Jase Coburn was named Portland State's new head basketball coach on April 16, 2021. He is the 14th men's basketball coach in Portland State history and the seventh since PSU joined the Big Sky Conference in 1996-97.
- SR F Khalid Thomas is the Vikings' top returning scorer (11.2) and rebounder (5.0). He also tied for the team lead with 32 three-point field goals and made 29 steals and blocked 14 shots. Thomas shot .451 from the field and .800 at the line while starting all 22 games.
- Despite averaging only 17.1 minutes per game and being a starter for less than half the season in 2020-21, SO C Jacob Eyman ranked third in the Big Sky Conference with 24 blocked shots in 20 games (1.2 bpg). In league games, he led the Big Sky Conference in blocked shots (1.6).
- JR F Gio Nelson, originally a walk-on, was presented with a scholarship from new Head Coach Jase Coburn in May.
- Portland State had five Academic All-Big Sky Conference selections in 2020-21. Four of them return to the team: Alexis Angeles, Ian Burke, Paris Dawson and Jacob Eyman.
- The Vikings have nine Division I transfers on the roster. In the off-season, Head Coach Jase Coburn signed seven transfers - six from Division I schools and one from a Division II school.
- Coach Jase Coburn signed three players that led their teams in scoring last year: JR G Michael Carter III (14.6, Long Beach State); JR G/F Marlon Ruffin (13.1, Omaha); SR G Zeke Alley (19.9, Northwest Nazarene).
- JR G/F Marlon Ruffin was the Summit League Sixth Man of the Year in 2019-20. He was named Summit League honorable mention in 2020-21.
- The Division II transfer is SR G Ezekiel Alley. In a game against the Vikings last season, Alley led his Northwest Nazarene team with 27 points. Alley was named NABC All-District, averaging 19.9 points, 3.4 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game for Northwest Nazarene, winning Great Northwest Athletic Conference Player of the Week honors five times. In two seasons at NNU, Alley shot .444 from three-point range.
- JR G Michael Carter III has a bachelor's degree in Consumer Affairs from Long Beach State... SR G Ezekiel Alley has a degree from Northwest Nazarene in Applied Sciences... SR F Khalid Thomas has completed his degree in Social Science at Portland State.
- JR G Alexis Angeles will redshirt the 2021-22 season.
- Due to hip surgery, JR G Damion Squire is not expected to play until some time in December.
- The NCAA has granted a one season waiver to all basketball players who competed during the 2020-21 COVID-19-impacted season. Therefore all players, whether they competed or not, did not use a year of eligibility (EX: Paris Dawson played in all 22 games but is still considered a freshman).

THE 2021-22 SCHEDULE

PSU has a balanced slate of 14 home games and 14 road games with the Big Sky Conference Tournament at the end of the season. Included in non-conference play are two games with Big West opponents, and one game each against the Pac-12, Big 12, Mountain West and West Coast Conferences. The Big Sky Conference will return to normal scheduling this season with the home-and-home, 20-game round robin format.

PORTLAND STATE AND THE BIG SKY CONFERENCE

Portland State begins its 26th campaign in the Big Sky Conference this week. PSU joined the league in 1996-97, reinstating a once-dormant (for 15 seasons) basketball program.

The Vikings have won Big Sky Conference regular season titles in 2004-05 and 2007-08. They won Big Sky Tournament titles in 2007-08 and 2008-09, advancing to the NCAA Tournament each season. Since then, PSU's best finish in the Big Sky has been third place.

Prior to the start of the 2021-22 Big Sky campaign, Portland State was 202-210 all-time in Big Sky Conference games, 214-225 including Big Sky Tournament games. PSU was 140-72 in home games, 68-141 in road games and 6-12 in neutral-site games.

First-year Head Coach Jase Coburn, hired last April, is PSU's seventh Head Coach in the Big Sky era and 14th all-time in its 61st competitive season.

The Vikings were picked to place seventh in the Big Sky Conference in the preseason coaches poll, eighth in the preseason media poll.

In Big Sky play, Portland State will have five Thursday home games, four Saturday home games and one Monday home game.

Once again, the Big Sky Conference Championship Tournament will take place in Boise, ID at Idaho Central Arena, Mar. 9-12.

HE'S HUNGRY: JASE COBURN IS NOT YOUR AVERAGE BASKETBALL COACH

New Head Coach Jase Coburn made national news, and was trending on social media when, at his introductory press conference, he pointed out that he "doesn't eat breakfast because he wants to come to work hungry every day." It was a curiosity, and maybe good for a laugh or two, but it speaks to who the man is, and his intensity about coaching the game.

Viking faithful have gotten to know Coburn over the years as he came to Portland State as an assistant under Tyler Geving in 2013. He has spent the past eight years in the Vikings' program. When Barret Peery took over the program in 2017, his first move was to keep Coburn on staff. He elevated Jase to the title of Associate Head Coach in 2018.

Most of that information is common knowledge. What many don't know is the unique path Coburn took to get here, and the fact that he has been a coach at the high school, AAU and junior college levels. All Coburn ever wanted in life, since he was a child, was to be a college basketball coach. But his route was not traditional. Whenever someone talks about "paying their dues", Jase knows his story can't be beaten.

- At age 18, Coburn became a head coach for the first time. He formed an AAU team in Arizona, and coached 16-17 year olds, some weekends driving them to Las Vegas for tournaments. "Those parents put a lot of trust in me."
- At 21, Coburn became assistant coach at Phoenix Junior College. He routinely coached players older than him, some as old as 27.
- At 23, he was named head coach at McClintock (AZ) High School, where he stayed four seasons. By the age of 26, he had led McClintock to the Arizona state title, becoming the youngest coach in history to do so, and the youngest to be named Arizona State 4A Coach of the Year.
- At 27, he moved on to junior college powerhouse Howard (TX) to be an assistant under then-coach Mark Adams. He lived in the dorm with the players.
- At 29, Coburn came to Portland State to be an assistant coach, hired by Tyler Geving. He drove to Portland in his 2003 Chevy Tahoe with just a twin mattress, a TV and a suitcase of clothes. He subsisted on a box of pasta and pasta sauce, iceberg lettuce and ranch dressing each night while sleeping on his mattress on the floor in low-income housing. Jase soon had a major impact on the Viking program. Coburn played an instrumental role in recruiting top players to Portland State. They included the addition of top scorers DaShaun Wiggins and Cameron Forte, key transfer point guard Calaeen Robinson and many other Arizona prospects including PSU's all-time leader in assists and steals, Holland Woods. Under Peery, the Vikings began to make waves as an exciting program that year-in and year-out was among the nation's best in forcing turnovers, steals, rebounding margin and offensive rebounding. Coburn was the coordinator of that defense. He was proven to be such a passionate leader, he had the role of the team's pre-game talk under Barret Peery.
- In 2019-20, Portland State went into the Big Sky Conference Tournament as the hottest team in the league, having won six in a row. They were considered a true contender for the title with a chance at the NCAA Tournament. Then, on the day the Vikings were to play their first game in Boise, ID, the tournament was canceled due to COVID-19. Not to be deterred, Coburn still had a story to tell. He and fiancée Lindsay Meiggs (Portland State Athletics Academic Advisor) had a May wedding planned. But with the pandemic raging, they were concerned it would prevent them from having their big day. As the team was waiting for an opportunity to fly home, Coburn and Meiggs decided to go ahead with their wedding right then and there. With an assist from the Big Sky Conference and Idaho Central Arena (home of the tournament), the couple got married at center court in front of the entire basketball team, staff members and several relatives who were in town for the tournament. The ceremony made news, rightfully so, around the country. Happily, a year later, Lindsay and Jase welcomed their first child, a son named Kyler, to the family.

Now, after all the time and work he has put in, Jase Coburn has finally realized his dream of becoming a Division I Head Coach. Oh, and he is still driving that 2003 Tahoe.

THE VIKING PAVILION

Portland State Athletics began play in the new Viking Pavilion during the 2018-19 season. The long-awaited arena and events facility became a first-class venue for the university and the Viking Athletics program.

Viking Basketball looks forward to the return of fans in the 2021-22 season. PSU played without fans in 13 home games in 2020-21 due to COVID-19 protocols.

The Viking Pavilion, a 141,700-square foot facility seats 3,094 people for basketball. Seating is more than double the size of the old Stott Center main gym. The facility also has a new weight room, locker rooms, academic center, administrative offices, OHSU Sports Medicine Center, and Viking Athletics Hall of Fame. Other additions include five new classrooms, new student lounges and a new cafe.

The \$52.1 million project, which was part renovation and part rebuild, was designed by Woffter Architects/Perkins+Will. Fortis Construction was the general contractor. \$19.1 million came from private gifts and PSU project funds, \$7.5 million was a sponsorship from OHSU, \$24 million are from state bonds and \$1.5 million are from student fees. None of the funding came from general operating funds or tuition dollars. Formal fund-raising began in 2013. An official ground breaking took place on April 23, 2016.

- The crowd of 2,077 that attended the game against Montana State (3/9/19) in the Viking Pavilion was the largest crowd of the season and was the third over the 2,000 mark (also vs. Portland and Montana).
- PSU averaged 1,238 fans in 16 home games during 2018-19 - the best regular season attendance since 2002-03. The last time PSU averaged as many as 1,000 fans in attendance was 2009-10 (1,009).
- The largest recent crowd, prior to the opening of the Pavilion, was a sellout of that 1,500 attended the Portland State/Oregon State game in the old Stott Center gym on Dec. 12, 2012.

TASTY VIKING HISTORY TIDBITS

- Portland State will compete in its 26th season as a member of the Big Sky Conference and Division I. PSU played basketball from 1946-1981 before discontinuing the program. Basketball was reinstated for the 1996-97 season. Portland State won Big Sky Conference regular season titles in 2004-05 and 2007-08. The Vikings won Big Sky Conference Tournament titles in 2007-08 and 2008-09, advancing to the NCAA Tournament.
- Portland State's biggest star was Freeman Williams (1974-78), who still ranks as the second all-time leading scorer in college basketball history behind Pete Maravich. Williams, a Division I All-American in 1978, scored 3,249 points in his career.
- Former Viking Ime Udoka played seven seasons in the NBA. He started 75 games for the Portland Trail Blazers in 2006-07. Udoka spent seven seasons as an assistant coach with the San Antonio Spurs, and won an NBA title with the team in 2013-14. He went on to be an assistant coach with the Philadelphia 76ers, then the Brooklyn Nets, before being named Head Coach of the Boston Celtics this past summer.
- Julius Thomas (2006-10), who holds Portland State records for games played (121), field goal percentage in a season and career (.671/.663), and career wins (78), was a two-time Pro Bowler for the NFL's Denver Broncos. Thomas played on two Big Sky Conference Championship/NCAA Tournament teams (2007-08, 2008-09) at PSU. He went on to play one season of football at PSU (2010). Thomas competed in Super Bowl XLVIII in 2014. He later signed a free agent contract with the Jacksonville Jaguars in 2015 making him the highest paid tight end in the NFL, then moved on to play for the Miami Dolphins before retiring after the 2017 season.

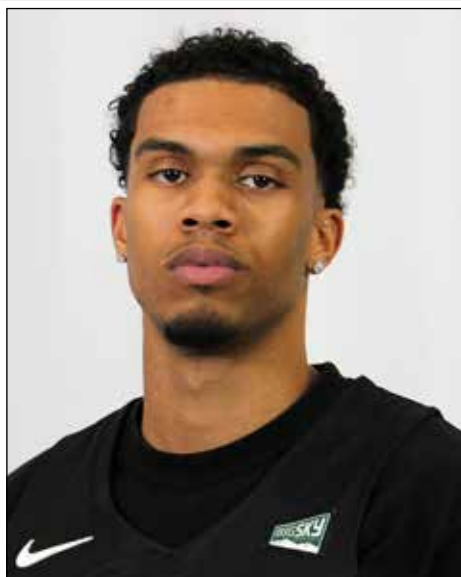

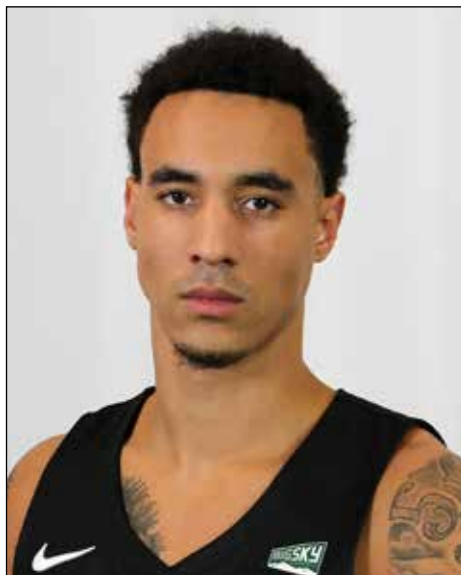

The Portland Pilots took advantage of a frosty shooting Portland State team. The Pilots had four players in double figures and shot 30-69 (.435) from the field, which was more than enough as PSU could never get started offensively. PSU made only 23-73 (.315) in the game and was 2-23 from three-point range.

Portland was led by 15 points and nine rebounds from Chris Austin. Tyler Robertson had 12 points and nine rebounds, and Moses Wood scored 10 points with 10 rebounds. The win was the fifth in a row for the Pilots who are now 5-1.

Portland State dropped to 2-2 on the season. James Jean-Marie led the way with a season-high 17 points and 10 rebounds for his fourth straight double-double. Ezekiel Alley came off the bench for a season-high 11 points and three assists.

The Vikings got multiple looks inside early, but couldn't convert. In fact, PSU started the game 2-17 from the field. A six-minute scoring drought and an 11-0 Pilot run had Portland ahead 13-4 after eight minutes.

The Vikings got back within 18-16 before Austin sparked a 17-0 run. He hit four shots for nine points in the rally and UP led 35-16. Meanwhile, PSU went six minutes without scoring. Portland was up 37-20 at halftime.

PSU was only 10-32 from the field in the half, including 0-9 from three-point range.

A pair of baskets by Khalid Thomas out of half-time helped the Vikings get back within 11 quickly. But again the Pilots had an answer with an 11-2 run. Up 20 at 51-31 midway through the half, the Pilots cruised to the win. The closest the Vikings would get was the final score as Alley made a pair of baskets in the last minute of the game.

Portland State had 11 offensive rebounds, but only scored nine points from them. Portland had 14 offensive rebounds and 18 second-chance points.

Marlon Ruffin matched his season-high with 18 points for PSU, hitting 7-14 from the field and 3-4 at the line. James Jean-Marie grabbed a game-high 15 rebounds for the Vikings.

In the first half, Portland State suffered from poor shooting and a myriad of turnovers. Despite the lack of offensive efficiency, the Vikings hung around behind good defense and rebounding.

Weber State continued its early-season dominance with an 80-69 win over Portland State at Dee Events Center.

Michael Carter III led four Vikings in double figures with a season-high 14 points. He added three rebounds and three assists.

Seikou Sisohe Jawara had 17 points to lead four Wildcats in double figures. He hit 5-10 three-pointers in the game.

Weber State brought a strong resume to the game, including a 67-44 win over Northern Arizona in their Big Sky opener on Thursday. The Wildcats didn't miss a step in this contest, taking the early lead on PSU. The Vikings trailed 23-19 midway through the half before the Wildcats outscored then 18-10 over the final 10 minutes.

Jawara did the most damage for Weber State, hitting 4-6 three-pointers and scoring 14 points by halftime. The Wildcats held a 41-29 advantage after 20 minutes.

Ian Burke had eight points for the Vikings at halftime, including a pair of three-pointers. However, eight PSU turnovers led to a dozen Weber State points. The Wildcats shot .483 from the field in the half to .310 for the Vikings.

Weber State grew the lead to 57-39 in the second half. Three-pointers by Paris Dawson and Khalid Thomas helped the Vikings trim it back to just a dozen with 11 minutes left in the game.

A conventional three-point play by Ruffin at the 6:20 mark got the Vikings within 10 at 69-59. It was still 10 at 71-61 when Jean-Marie dunked with 2:24 to play. Then Jawara answered with another three-pointer and the Wildcats had the space they needed for the win.

A Portland State rally in the final four minutes came up agonizingly short as the Vikings took a 61-58 non-conference loss to Cal Poly.

PSU trailed 60-50 with 3:57 to play after a driving three-point play by the Mustangs' Camren Pierce. But defense gave the Vikings a chance as they threw on a ¾ court, then full-court, trap.

Big man James Jean-Marie scored inside with 3:43 to play, and followed that with a pair of free throws on the Vikings' next possession. Those scores were sandwiched around a Cal Poly turnover. It was the first of four straight turnovers forced by PSU's pressure.

Michael Carter III was fouled twice on drives to the hoop in the final two minutes. He made all four free throws and the score was 60-58 with 32.7 seconds to play.

PSU nearly forced a fifth turnover, but instead fouled Cal Poly's Kobe Sanders. He made one of two free throws with 25.8 ticks on the clock and it was 61-58.

After a Carter three-point miss, the Mustangs' Jacob Davison was fouled. He missed both attempts and PSU still had life.

For the second game in a row a late Portland State comeback came up one shot short.

The Vikings trailed 49-34 with 10:41 to play in the game but rode good shooting from Ian Burke, then Marlon Ruffin, to eventually take a brief lead at 64-63. However, the Matadors got an important put-back basket inside the final two minutes, then hit four straight free throws in the last 15 seconds to hang on.

Ruffin rallied the Vikings with a season-high 26 points, getting 18 in the second half, including 11 straight down the stretch. Burke scored a season-high 10 points. His back-to-back three-pointers pulled the Vikings with six at 59-53 with 5:06 to play.

Ruffin then went to work, single-handedly out-scoring the Matadors 11-3 in a span of two minutes and 12 seconds. Ruffin's three-pointer with 2:20 to play put the Vikings ahead 64-63.

On CSUN's next possession it got three chances, with the third coming from Brendan Harrick who scored inside off a teammate's miss. That put the Matadors back in the lead at 65-64 with 1:50 remaining.

The Vikings missed shots on their next four possessions. CSUN couldn't convert either until PSU had to resort to fouls in the closing seconds. Elijah Hardy made two for the Matadors with 15 seconds left to make it 67-64.

Michael Carter III brought it back up the court for PSU, drove the lane and was fouled. He made both free shots with 6.4 seconds to go pulling the Vikings within 67-66.

Portland State fouled immediately on the ensuing inbound play. Atin Wright, who scored a game-high 28 points, went to the line for the Matadors and knocked down both shots with 5.3 seconds left.

After a timeout, Carter raced up court with the ball, looking for a tie. He fired a contested three from 28 feet but it was off as the final buzzer sounded.
