WAVEPOINTS

- The 174th edition of the PCH Cup rivalry takes place on Thursday between the Pepperdine and Loyola Marymount men's basketball teams.
- Pepperdine has won 21 of the last 22 meetings against LMU in Firestone Fieldhouse.
- This is Pepperdine's home finale and Senior Night. A pregame ceremony will be recorded and shared online.
- The Waves are in the midst of wrapping up the regular season with four games in eight days. This is the only home game in that stretch.
- In the latest KenPom rankings for determining the WCC standings and tournament seedings, Pepperdine remains in third place.
- **Colbey Ross** continues to move up the WCC's all-time stat rankings. He's currently eighth in points (2,106), 10 away from USF's Bill Cartwright and seventh place. He's third all-time in assists (796), 20 away from SMC's Emmett Naar and second place.
- Ross recently became the first player in program history and the 13th in WCC history to reach 2,000 career points. Ross is one of just eight players in the history of Division I men's basketball to accumulate 2,000 points, 750 assists and 400 rebounds. With four more assists, he'll be one of just four players with 2,000/800/400.
- Among active Division I players, Ross ranks first in career assists (796) and free throws made (614), fourth in points (2,106) and eighth in scoring average (17.8).
- Ross ranks #4 in the nation and #1 in the WCC in assists per game (7.6). Ross is sixth in the WCC in scoring (17.2), eighth in steals (1.2) and first in minutes (36.9).
- If Ross plays at least 32 minutes, he'll set another school record, passing Dana Jones' career total of 4,178 minutes played.
- **Kessler Edwards** ranks fifth in the WCC in blocks (1.0), sixth in rebounding (6.7) and seventh in scoring (16.7). He's seventh all-time in blocked shots at Pepperdine (113).
- **Sedrick Altman** is coming off a career-high 22-point effort at Saint Mary's on Monday. He's been in double-figures in five of the last seven games (and scored nine in the other two) and is averaging 13.3 points in that time.
- Pepperdine is #5 in the country in three-point defense (27.5%) and #23 in the country in free throw percentage (77.5%).

SERIES

Pepperdine leads the all-time series 104-69. It's the most wins, and the most games played, between the Waves and any other opponent. The Waves have won 37 of the last 48 games, including 21 of the last 22 in Firestone Fieldhouse. The Waves swept the season series last year for the first time since 2015.

PCH CUP

An annual all-sport competition between two local rivals that are separated by just 19.1 miles of scenic coastline, the PCH Cup is in its 12th season of existence. Pepperdine has won nine of the 11 years that this competition has been held. A home win is worth one point, a road victory is worth 1.5 points.

CONNECTIONS

The Waves' **Andre Ball** and the Lions' **Eli Scott** were teammates at Chino Hills High School.

LIONS

LMU had a four-game winning streak come to an end when the Lions lost 88-71 at home to BYU on Saturday. Eli Scott leads the team in scoring (17.8), rebounding (7.9) and assists (3.7).

LAST MEETING

Back on February 1, 2020 in Los Angeles ... The Waves rallied from a 16-point first-half deficit to sweep the regular-season series from rival LMU and win at Gersten Pavilion for the first time since 2015 with a 68-67 overtime victory. The Waves trailed 28-12 and then 33-26 at halftime, but took the lead with a little more than 11 minutes to go in regulation. Pepperdine led by eight with under four to play, but LMU tied it up at 61, and the Waves missed a shot at the regulation buzzer. Kameron Edwards, who tied his career high with 27 points, scored the first five points of OT, and after leading by as many seven, the Waves held on when LMU came back and missed a three-pointer at the buzzer.

Tied at 52 with six minutes left, the Gaels went on a 9-2 run to take their biggest lead of the game with 3 1/2 minutes left. The Waves cut it two but got no closer in the end. Only four players scored for the Waves.

Ross has set Pepperdine career records for both points and assists. In fact, he holds more than 25 Pepperdine single-game, single-season and career records. He entered the 2020-21 season with more career assists than any active player in NCAA basketball (any division, men's or women's).

Preseason hype:

- Named to both the Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy preseason watch lists for National Player of the Year.
- Named to the Bob Cousy Award preseason watch list, which recognizes the nation's top point guard.
- Dick Vitale put Ross on his preseason All-American fifth team, marking him as one of the nation's top 25 players. He also named Ross leader of his "All-Thomas Edison team" for the best creator.
- Andy Katz, writing for the NCAA's @MarchMadness, listed Ross at #17 on the nation's top returning players and at #9 on his Bob Cousy Award watch list.
- Lindy's preseason annual had him at #37 on its list of the nation's top 150 players, and for the second straight year the magazine labeled him the WCC's top playmaker and most entertaining player.
- Jeff Goodman of Stadium named him one of his five mid-major All-Americans.
- CBS Sports' Jon Rothstein listed Ross as one of the nation's 10 most underappreciated players.

Among his career highlights:

- Has started every game in his four seasons, 118 and counting.
- Two-time All-WCC first team, two-time WCC All-Tournament team and 2020 NABC All-District first team.
- Named The Malibu Times' 2020 Sportsperson of the Year.
- Received third career WCC Player of the Week award on 2/8/2021.
- Broke the Pepperdine career assist record in his 77th game (nearly 50 fewer than the previous record-holder) — 12/14/2019 vs. Central Arkansas.
- Broke the Pepperdine career scoring record in his 100th game (25 fewer than the previous record-holder) — 11/27/2020 vs. UCLA.
- Scored his 2,000th career point in his 113th career game, becoming the first player in program history and the 13th in WCC history to reach that milestone — 1/30/2021 vs. Gonzaga.
- Is one of just eight men's basketball players in Division I history to accumulate 2,000+ points, 750+ assists and 400+ rebounds.
- In 2019-20, Ross averaged better than 20 points, seven assists and four rebounds, only the ninth time that's happened in Division I in the last 25+ years (J.J. Barea/Northeastern twice, Damon Stoudamire/Arizona and Ja Morant/Murray State are among those listed).
- Has had two consecutive seasons with 600+ points, 200+ assists and 100+ rebounds. According to Basketball Reference, that's happened 49 times in Division I since 1992-93. But only four players have done it twice: Ross, Barea, Stoudamire and Jon Elmore/Marshall. Ross is the only WCC player to even do this once in that span.
- Led the WCC and ranked sixth nationally in assists in each of the last two seasons, setting school records at 7.0 per game in 2018-19 and 7.2 in 2019-20.
- Has hit numerous clutch end-of-game shots over the years, including a three-pointer at the buzzer to beat San Diego on February 13, 2020.
- During 2019-20, averaged 26.5 points in four games against "Power 6" teams.
- Among his recent exploits against the Pac-12, last season he scored a then-career-high 38 points at USC (the most ever by a Wave against a Power 5 school) and then had 20 against Arizona. This season, he had 33 points against UCLA (a game in which he broke Pepperdine's career scoring record), and then posted 11 assists in a win against California.
- Scored a career-high 43 points in the quarterfinals of the 2020 WCC Tournament against Saint Mary's, posting the second-best effort in tournament history and the most ever by a Wave at the event. SMC's Jordan Ford scored 42 in the 2OT contest in the greatest scoring duel in WCC history.

Some personal notes:

- His older brother Elijah was an all-conference player at DII Colorado-Colorado Springs and set the school's all-time assist record.
- His younger sister Jady is a freshman women's basketball player at DII CSU-Pueblo.
- Always the first one in the gym — gets up at 4:30 a.m. to shoot baskets.

DEFENSE — Pepperdine's three-point defense has seen an incredible improvement from last year. In 2019-20, opponents shot 38.0%, putting the Waves 344th out of 350 teams. Now, Pepperdine is limiting opponents to 27.5%, fifth-best in the country. Opponents have gone from making 8.2 per game to 6.4 per contest.

FREE THROWS — Last year's Waves set a school record by shooting 79.2% from the free throw line. That led the WCC and ranked fourth nationally. Pepperdine currently ranks #23 in the country in free throw percentage (77.5%).

EDWARDS — With **Kameron Edwards** having graduated and starting his professional career, the Waves are down to one of the two brothers. But junior forward **Kessler Edwards** is breaking out and people are taking notice.

Some preseason accolades:

- Named to the preseason All-WCC team.
- Andy Katz listed him at #12 on his candidates for the Julius Erving Award (nation's top small forward).
- Lindy's preseason annual ranked him as the nation's 56th-best player.

Edwards, who was invited to the USA Basketball U19 national team camp in summer 2019, became the program's 44th player to score 1,000 career points on January 21 against Pacific. He's just the eighth Wave ever to hit the century mark in career blocked shots and he now ranks seventh all-time (113).

Edwards is averaging team highs of 6.7 rebounds and 1.0 blocks along with 16.7 points this season. His career-high 37-point effort against Pacific (1/21) is tied for the most by a WCC player this season. Edwards received his first-ever WCC Player of the Week award on January 25 after that performance. He had two double-doubles and averaged 24.0 points and 10.5 rebounds that week.

In 2019-20, Edwards made the All-WCC second team after leading the WCC in blocked shots (1.9) and finishing 13th in scoring (13.8) and fourth in rebounding (7.5). He blocked 60 shots, tying for seventh on the Waves' single-season list. He hit multiple three-pointers in 15 of 32 games. He was on the WCC All-Freshman team in 2018-19.

MORE FRONTCOURT — In addition to **Kessler Edwards** ... Grad transfer **Kene Chukwuka** has been a nice addition, averaging 7.5 points and 5.5 rebounds. It might not be a coincidence that the Waves are 0-4 against Division I teams in the games that he's missed ... **Victor Ohia Obioha** (3.9 ppg) has started all 13 games in which he's played but missed seven non-conference games due to injury ... Sharp-shooter **Jan Zidek** (third on the team in three-pointers with 24) is averaging 8.8 points (13.0 in the last four games) ... **Kendall Munson** saw his first action in the eighth game of the season and he's averaging 3.6 points.

MORE BACKCOURT — In addition to **Colbey Ross** ... After redshirting last season and missing all but eight games due to injury, **Jadé Smith** is back and is averaging 7.6 points ... **Sedrick Altman** is starting for the second straight year as a sophomore and is averaging 8.7 points (13.3 in the last seven games) ... Third-year player **Darryl Polk Jr.** (3.9 ppg) has been a spark off the bench ... **Andre Ball** missed all of last year due to injury but is back and contributing at 2.8 points per game.

SCHEDULE CHANGES — COVID-19 issues for Pepperdine's opponents canceled four non-conference games from the initial schedule — home games against San Jose State, Fresno State and Tarleton and a road game at UNLV. Home games against Saint Katherine and CSU Bakersfield and a road game at San Diego State were added after the start of the season as replacements.

Pepperdine had its own COVID-19 pause at the start of conference play, postponing a home game against BYU (Dec. 31 to Jan. 27) and road games at Saint Mary's (Jan. 2 to Feb. 22) and San Francisco (Jan. 7 to Feb. 10).

Three games were postponed and eventually canceled due to opponents' pauses (Feb. 4 vs. San Diego, Feb. 6 vs. San Francisco, Feb. 11 at LMU). The Portland road game was moved from Feb. 18 to Feb. 6 to fill a void in the schedule.

WCC NOTES — The Waves were picked fourth in the league's preseason coaches poll. The order went Gonzaga, BYU, Saint Mary's, Pepperdine, San Francisco, Santa Clara, Loyola Marymount, Pacific, San Diego and Portland. Lindy's preseason annual tabbed

the Waves for third place ... The original 16-game schedule didn't have a home game against Santa Clara or a road game at Pacific ... The Waves played BYU in back-to-back games, the first time the Waves had done that in the regular season since 2001-02 against LMU (though Pepperdine has played the same opponent in the regular-season finale and the first round of the WCC Tournament a few times since then).

NON-CONFERENCE NOTES — In the first four games of the season, the Waves played the preseason favorites in the Big West (UC Irvine), Pac-12 (UCLA) and Mountain West (Fresno State) ... Pepperdine hosted (and beat) a Pac-12 school for the first time since November 2012 in the win over California.

ROSTER NOTES — Because of injuries and eligibility processes, the Waves didn't have their entire team available until January 14 (the 10th game of the season and the start of WCC play) ... Pepperdine returned three starters and a total of 11 players who had seen action for the Waves. Seven of the top nine scorers are back. Returning players accounted for 66.2% of the scoring, 67.2% of the rebounding, 82.9% of the assists, 78.5% of the blocks, 74.1% of the steals and 66.8% of the minutes played. The current roster breakdown is one graduate student, one senior, five juniors, three sophomores, one redshirt freshman and two true freshmen. There have been three in-season changes (**Michael Wexler** graduated and became a graduate manager, while **Robbie Heath** and **Everett Perrot** departed).

RECRUITS — In November, the Waves signed four players to NLI's for next season. They will be adding 6-foot-10 center **Carson Basham** (Phoenix, Ariz./Sunnyslope HS), 6-foot-5 guard **Houston Mallette** (Alameda, Calif./Pacifica Christian HS), 6-foot-3 guard **Mike Mitchell Jr.** (San Jose, Calif./Archbishop Mitty HS) and 6-foot-8 forward **Jalen Pitre** (Long Beach, Calif./Long Beach Poly HS).

VIRAL SENSATION — The most famous member of the Waves family right now might be 3-year-old **Jalen Allen**, son of Pepperdine assistant coach **Curtis Allen**. An initial video of him flawlessly shooting baskets in the house on January 10, 2020, was retweeted by the likes of LeBron James, Lamar Jackson and ESPN and was viewed on Twitter more than 8.6 million times. A follow-up video on February 1 where Jalen did his best Kobe Bryant imitation got retweeted by SportsCenter. He's since been in a Facebook commercial. The videos keep coming to a growing audience, and there's now an Instagram account devoted to the Allen brothers (jalenandcompany).

2019-20 SEASON — The Waves finished at .500 with a 16-16 overall record and an 8-8 WCC record, good for sixth place. Pepperdine defeated Santa Clara in the second round of the WCC Tournament before falling to Saint Mary's in a double-overtime thriller in the quarterfinals. **Colbey Ross** made the All-WCC first team, while **Kameron Edwards** and **Kessler Edwards** were both on the second team. **Sedrick Altman** made the WCC All-Freshman team.

PEPPERDINE BASKETBALL — This is the 83rd season of Pepperdine men's basketball, and the 48th year that the Waves have called Firestone Fieldhouse home. The Waves began the campaign with an all-time record of 1,250-1,118 (.528). Pepperdine has been to the NCAA Tournament 13 times (last in 2002) and has won 12 West Coast Conference regular-season titles (last in 2002) and three WCC Tournament crowns (last in 1994).

WAVES IN THE PROS — Pepperdine once had a streak of 34 consecutive seasons with at least one Pepperdine alum on an NBA roster, which began in 1976-77 after the ABA/NBA merger and ended in 2010-11. Seventeen former Pepperdine players have seen action in the NBA, a list that includes notables such as **Dennis Johnson** (a 2010 Naismith Hall of Fame inductee, the 1979 NBA Finals MVP and a three-time NBA champion) and **Doug Christie** (a 15-year NBA veteran who was a mainstay on the All-Defensive Team). **Mychel Thompson** is the most recent Wave to play in the NBA, appearing in five games for the Cleveland Cavaliers in 2011-12. Two Waves — **Yakhouba Diawara** (2012/France) and **Marcos Leite** (1972, 1980, 1984/Brazil) — have competed at the Olympics.

Either currently or in the last year, a number of alums have been active in the pros, including: **Alex Acker** (Italy), **Stacy Davis** (Hungary), **Darnell Dunn** (Germany), **Kameron Edwards** (Belgium), **Chase Griffin** (Germany), **Chris Reyes** (Mexico) and **Nikolas Skouen** (Denmark).

LORENZO ROMAR

Lorenzo Romar, who has been a successful head coach for more than two decades and is known as one of the nation's top recruiters, returned to Pepperdine prior to the 2018-19 season for his second stint in charge of the men's basketball program.

At the start of the 2020-21 season, Romar had a career record of 423-318 over 23 seasons as a head coach at Pepperdine, Saint Louis and Washington.

Romar posted a 42-44 record at Pepperdine from 1997-99 in his first head coaching job. In five full seasons, his record was 74-78.



After an initial rebuilding season in 1996-97, he led the Waves to 17 and 19 wins the next two years. An 11-win improvement from year one to year two ranked as one of the nation's top turnarounds. In 2018-19, he took the Waves from six to 16 victories, meaning that he's been responsible for two of the four times in Pepperdine history that the Waves have improved by double-digit wins.

At UW, he built the Huskies into a perennial contender over 15 seasons. He helped produce 11 NBA first-round draft picks and 17 NBA players, while his teams played in six NCAA Tournaments, three NITs and one CBI. He was a three-time Pac-10 or Pac-12 Coach of the Year. At Washington and Arizona, where he was the associate head coach for one season before coming to Pepperdine, Romar worked with back-to-back NBA #1 overall draft picks (Markelle Fultz and DeAndre Ayton).

Romar won an NCAA title as an assistant coach at UCLA in 1995. He was selected in the seventh round of the 1980 NBA Draft and played five seasons in the NBA. He played collegiately at Washington.

STAFF

Associate head coach **Ken Bone**, a former head coach at Washington State, Portland State and Seattle Pacific, was also an assistant coach under Romar at Washington for three seasons ... Assistant coach **Curtis Allen** played for Romar at Washington and was an assistant coach at Washington State for nine seasons (he was an assistant to Bone at both WSU and Portland State) ... Assistant coach **Gerald Brown** is a former Pepperdine great who played for Romar for two seasons and was a three-time All-WCC first team honoree between 1994-98. He played a season in the NBA with the Phoenix Suns and was also briefly a Harlem Globetrotter ... Director of operations **John Impelman** is in his 12th year on Pepperdine's staff. Romar is the third head coach he has worked for in various capacities. Impelman is the great-grandson of UCLA coaching legend John Wooden, and his father Craig is a former Pepperdine assistant coach ... **Connor Griffin** (who played basketball at Gonzaga and football at Washington) went from graduate manager to video coordinator ... **Amadi Udenyi** (who ranks #5 all-time at Pepperdine in assists) is in his second year as a graduate manager ... **Keith Smith** took a medical retirement ahead of what could have been his final playing season. He graduated in 2020 and stayed on as a graduate manager ... **Michael Wexler** graduated in December 2020 and transitioned from player to graduate manager at the start of conference play.

PEPPERDINE

Pepperdine boasts a one-of-a-kind athletic department with unprecedented success for a school of its size. The Waves have won NCAA Division I championships in five different men's sports — one of just 18 schools to have accomplished this feat — and nine overall. Of this elite group, Pepperdine has the smallest undergraduate enrollment, is the only school without football and is the only university that has not been affiliated with a "major" conference. The Waves have won a total of 25 team or individual national championships in their history. Pepperdine has also earned the Division I-AAA All-Sports Trophy, an award based on postseason success that's given to the top non-football school, three times (most recently in 2011-12). Located in scenic Malibu, California, the university overlooks the Pacific Ocean and its campus and athletic facilities are regularly voted among the nation's most beautiful. Pepperdine, which is affiliated with the Church of Christ, ranks #49 overall on U.S. News and World Report's list of America's best colleges.

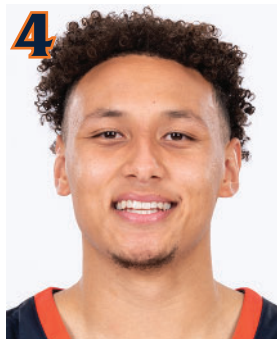

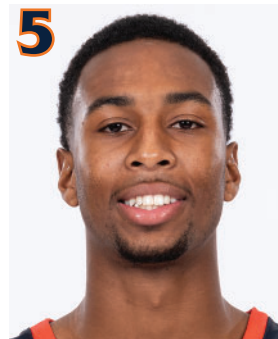
