## SURF REPORT

**GAME #1:** Pepperdine (0-0) vs Western Illinois (1-0) | Wednesday, Nov. 6 | Malibu, Calif. | 6 p.m.

**SCHILLING & COMPANY:** Beginning his first campaign as the Waves' head coach, Ed Schilling has gathered a cabinet of assistant coaches with several decades of coaching experience at all levels of the sport, ranging from Power 5 schools to success at the NAIA, junior college and high school levels.

**NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK:** The 2024-25 roster features 12 new faces and just two returners in Boubacar Coulibaly and David Mager. Seven of the 12 transferred in to Pepperdine while four are true freshmen. The roster is also significantly older than in years past, seeing three graduate students and five upperclassmen.

**PEPPERDINE BASKETBALL:** This is the 86th season of Pepperdine men's basketball, and the 51st year that the Waves have called Firestone Fieldhouse home. The Waves has been to the NCAA Tournament 13 times (last in 2002) and has won 12 West Coast Conference regular-season titles (last in 2002) and three WCC Tournament crowns (last in 1994). The Waves won the College Basketball Invitational in 2021.

**PRO WAVES:** Maxwell Lewis was the 40th pick in the 2023 Draft and earned big minutes in the NBA Summer League. Kessler Edwards began his professional career with the Brooklyn Nets who drafted him at 44th in 2021 but has since been traded to the Sacramento Kings and now resides on the Dallas Mavericks roster. Pepperdine's record-holder for scoring and assists Colbey Ross currently plays for Pallacanestro Trieste— one of the top teams in Italy.

The Leathernecks finished the 2023-24 season at a 21-12– 13-5 in league play for fourth in the Ohio Valley Conference. The team only returns three roster members from last season, however, but has still been selected to finish second in the OVC.

WIU opened up their 2024-25 season at San Jose State on Monday evening, defeating the Spartans 59-55 in a defensive slugfest that saw the Leathernecks out-shoot SJSU 43.1% to 34.8% from the field. Guard Marko Maletic led WIU with 13 points, followed by Sean Smith with 11 points, seven boards, seven assists and two steals.

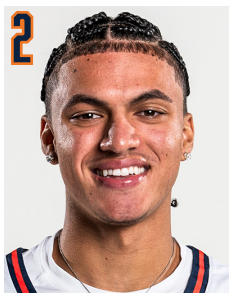

## ED SCHILLING

Pepperdine University has appointed coaching and player development veteran **Ed Schilling** to serve as the Head Coach of the Waves men’s basketball program. During his 13 years as an assistant at UMass, Memphis, UCLA, Indiana and Grand Canyon, his teams went a combined 304-134 and participated in eight NCAA Tournaments—including appearances in the Final Four and Sweet 16.



During Coach Schilling’s first season at GCU, the men’s basketball program won its first conference title and qualified for its first NCAA Tournament. While at GCU, the team went on to claim the 2023 and 2024 Western Athletic Conference title and made three total appearances in the NCAA tournament. Prior to coaching at GCU, Coach Schilling served as an assistant coach at Indiana from 2017 to 2019 and at UCLA from 2013 to 2017. During his tenure at UCLA, the Bruins compiled a 96-45 overall record, made three Sweet Sixteen appearances (2014, 2015, and 2017), and sent nine players to the NBA. Coach Schilling was also the assistant coach under basketball coaching legend John Calipari on three different teams—UMass, Memphis, and the New Jersey Nets. His first collegiate coaching season with UMass posted a 35-2 record and made a Final Four appearance.

Prior to his impressive experience in collegiate and professional basketball, Schilling, a Lebanon, Indiana, native, coached high school basketball at Park Tudor School, Western Boone Junior-Senior High School, and Logansport High School in his home state. Schilling also coached the Adidas High School All-American Team in various national and international competitions and was a director and trainer at the Champions Academy in Indianapolis, Indiana. Schilling has an extensive background in player development and, from 2007 to 2013, trained more than 60 players per year at St. Vincent’s Sports Performance and its NBA readiness program, where he prepared high-profile young players for the NBA draft.

As a student-athlete, Schilling was a four-year starting point guard and a two-time captain at Miami University in Ohio from 1985 to 1988. At Miami, Schilling helped lead the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances and was a three-time academic all-conference selection. He also established single-game, season, and career assist records at Miami University, all of which are still standing.

The Pepperdine men’s basketball program completed its 86th season in 2023-24 and the 51st year playing in the historic Firestone Fieldhouse. The Waves have been to the NCAA Tournament 13 times and have won 12 West Coast Conference regular-season titles, three WCC Tournament crowns and the College Basketball Invitational title in 2021. Thirty-three former Pepperdine players have gone on to be selected on NBA Draft nights over the years, with the most recent Wave to enter the pros being Maxwell Lewis who was selected to the Los Angeles Lakers in 2023.

Deeply passionate about inspiring players to perform at the highest level, Coach Schilling has also co-authored two books—Guard Play (1998), which covers the technical skills and leadership attributes necessary to be a successful point guard or shooting guard, and Five Star Basketball, a collection of inspirational words and playing techniques by some of the greatest collegiate basketball coaches.

Coach Schilling is married to his wife, April, a former assistant coach for the Indiana Fever. He has four daughters—Christiana, Natalie, Ava, and Callie—and one son, Edmund Cross.
