#### LAST TIME OUT

- Pepperdine defeated Life Pacific by a score of 88-80 in the season opener on Monday in Malibu, with five Waves scoring in double figures.
- Aaron Clark led the Waves with 14 points and four steals while Javon Cooley and Pavle Stosic each netted 13 points.
- The Waves are one of four teams in the nation to collect 19 or more offensive rebounds in a game while shooting over 40-percent from three-point distance (10-for-25).
- It marked the fourth straight season-opening win for the program.
- The 19 offensive rebounds marked the most in a game since collecting 22 against William & Mary on Dec. 21, 2023.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- The Waves hold an all-time record of 4-21 against the Bruins which features a 3-19 mark on the
- The most recent meeting saw a 100-53 win for the Bruins at home on Nov. 23, 2022.
- Two seasons prior, the teams played to a three-overtime thriller in San Diego on Nov. 27, 2020, as the Bruins eventually prevailed 107-98.
- The Waves' most recent victory came on Nov. 18, 2001, securing an 85-78 win on the road.

#### **SCOUTING THE BRUINS**

- UCLA comes in at No. 12 in the AP Poll, having brought back its top-two returning scorers from last season in Tyler Bilodeau and Eric Dailey Jr.
- The Bruins earned an 80-74 win at home over Eastern Washington on Monday to open the new campaign.
- · New Mexico transfer Donovan Dent led the way in the opener with 21 points and nine assists.
- Dent was named to the Naismith and Bob Cousy Award Watch Lists prior to the season.
- · Bilodeau tabbed Karl Malone Award Watch List recognition while Dailey Jr. was named to the Julius Erving Award Watch List.

#### **BRUIN ROYALTY**

- Pepperdine assistant coach and UCLA legend Tyus Edney returns to Pauley Pavilion.
- Edney etched his name into UCLA lore with his game-winning buzzer-beater over Missouri in the second round of the 1995 NCAA Tournament, as the Bruins would go on to win the National Championship in Edney's senior season.
- A Three-time First Team All-Pac-10 selection, Edney still ranks 22nd on the Bruins' all-time scoring list with 1,515 points.
- He went on to serve as an assistant coach with the Bruins from 2017-19.
- Ed Schilling also has ties to the UCLA program, having served as an assistant coach for the Bruins from 2013-17.

#### **DEBUTING IN STYLES**

- Sophomore guard Styles Phipps drew the start at point guard for the Waves in the season opener, totaling nine points with seven rebounds and five assists.
- Phipps is one of 13 underclassmen in the nation to have a nine-point, seven-rebound, five-assist effort in the country this season.
- He added a steal and two offensive rebounds while knocking down all three free throw attempts.

#### A MAGER SPARK

- Redshirt junior guard David Mager recorded a career-high 12 points, four rebounds and a steal to spark the Waves off the bench against Life Pacific.
- Mager contributed eight points on an 11-0 run upon entering in the first half, eventually logging a game-best plus-minus of +24.
- Mager knocked down two of five looks from downtown, marking the first time in his career that he's connected on multiple triples.

#### **WELCOMED RETURNS**

- Graduate student Javon Cooley and redshirt sophomore Aaron Clark each returned after missing the 2024-25 season due to injury in their first seasons at Pepperdine.
- · Clark had a team-high 14 points in the win over Life Pacific, adding a game-high four steals.
- Cooley registered 13 points and five rebounds on 5-for-9 shooting while logging 30 minutes in his first game action since the 2024 MAAC Tournament with Marist.

#### **SERBIA TO MALIBU**

- Three of the Waves' native Serbians made an instant impact in the season opener.
- Redshirt sophomore Pavle Stosic posted career-bests of 13 points and seven rebounds on 6-for-10 shooting, coralling a game-high four offensive boards.
- Sophomore Danilo Dozic drew the start and logged 11 points while dishing out three assists and knocking down two of his four looks from three-point range.
- Freshman Luka Vudragovic also earned the start in his first collegiate game, scoring eight points while hitting on two of his four three-point looks.

#### JOHNY ON THE SPOT

- Freshman Nikola 'Johny' Radovanovic posted four points, three rebounds and three assists off the bench for the Waves against Life Pacific in his collegiate debut.
- He is one of six players in the country this season to log a four-point, three-rebound, three-assist effort in under 12 minutes of action.
- Among those six, he was the only to maintain a 1.000 field goal percentage.

#### **FAREWELL FIRESTONE**

- This season marks the 53rd and final season with Firestone Fieldhouse as the home for Pepperdine basketball.
- The Waves opened the arena on November 30, 1973 with a matchup against Pacific before earning the first win in the building on 12/20/73 versus Chicago State.
- Pepperdine will move into the Mountain at Mullin Park for the 2026-27 season.
- The Mountain is a new 3,600-seat arena that will give Pepperdine a state-of-the-art competition venue, complete with a 360-degree high-definition scoreboard, VIP and hospitality spaces, and custom team locker rooms.

#### **SCHEDULE NOTES**

- The Waves non-conference slate features 11 Division I opponents from eight different conferences around the country including the Big Ten, Big Sky, Southland, Mountain West, WAC, America East, Big West and The American.
- The lone power-four matchup comes at UCLA this Friday.
- The Waves will take part in the Acrisure Series MTE, matching up with Fresno State on Wednesday, Nov. 26 at 4 p.m. from Acrisure Arena in Palm Desert.
- Vermont and New Orleans feature as first-time opponents for the program, with each making the trip to Malibu.
- Pepperdine will not leave the state of California until its trip to Spokane (Jan. 21) to take on Gonzaga.

#### **FAMILIAR FACES**

- The Waves return just two players who saw action this past season in Danilo Dozic and David Mager.
- Dozic emerged as a key piece for the Waves down the stretch in 2024-25, starting the final 15 games of the season after missing the first portion of the campaign due to injury.
- In 28 appearances, Dozic logged 22.3 minutes per game with 5.8 points per game and 2.6 rebounds per game.
- Mager leads all returners with 34 career games in a Pepperdine uniform, seeing action in 25 games this past season and nine in 2023-24.
- In 4.7 minutes per game last season, Mager logged 2.0 points per game and scored a career-high 10 points at UNLV in November.

#### **COOLEY & CLARK RETURN**

- Graduate student Javon Cooley and redshirt sophomore Aaron Clark enter the season healthy after each missing the 2024-25 season with Pepperdine due to injury.
- · Cooley appeared in 109 games for Marist including 66 starts from 2020-24, featuring as a starter across his junior and senior seasons.
- Cooley averaged 7.3 PPG and 4.4 RPG in his two years as a starter, ranking second in the MAAC with a 47.5% clip from three-point range in 2023-24.
- Clark transferred to Pepperdine following one season at Wake Forest.
- He appeared in seven games for the Demon Deacons in 2023-24.
- Clark was the No. 91 rated recruit from Rivals.com in the high school Class of 2023.

#### PEPPERDINE VIA THE PORTAL

- The Waves added six players via the transfer portal this offseason: Stefan Cicic, Yonatan Levy, Preston Phillips, Styles Phipps, Pasha Shemirani and Pavle Stosic.
- Redshirt freshman center Stefan Cicic appeared in three games for Tulane this past season before utilizing a redshirt season.
- · Sophomore forward Yonatan Levy joins the Waves after spending last season at Green Bay.
- Levy joined the Phoenix midway through the 2024-25 campaign, eventually making 11 starts in 13 appearances while averaging 7.8 PPG, 6.1 RPG and 2.6 APG.
- Levy scored in double figures four times including a 19-point effort against Cleveland State.
- Graduate student Preston Phillips enters as a transfer from Bethel (Ind.), where he helped the Pilots to three wins in the NAIA Tournament over his two seasons.
- Starting all 49 games with Bethel, Phillips registered 11.2 points per game and 6.3 rebounds per game.
- Phillips spent his first two seasons at Evansville from 2021-23, making 49 appearances.
- · Sophomore guard Styles Phipps came by way of Grand Canyon University where he won a WAC Championship this past season.
- Phipps appeared in 20 games for the Antelopes and averaged 2.0 PPG, 1.2 RPG and 1.1 APG in 7.8 MPG.
- · Pasha Shemirani enters as a redshirt freshman, utilizing his redshirt this past season at Fresno State.
- Pavel Stosic comes to Malibu after redshirting this past season at Utah State.
- Stosic has West Coast Conference experience, playing his freshman season at Gonzaga in 2023-24.
- With the Bulldogs, Stosic totaled 14 points and 11 rebounds across 46 minutes of action in 14 appearances.

#### **FRESHMAN CLASS**

- The Waves add a mix of local and international talent with its five-member true freshman class featuring Anto Balian, Nikola Radovanovic,
- Vladimir Sudar, Ty Virgil and Luka Vudragovic.
- Anto Balian joins as a guard from Glendale, California, having finished a storied high school career at Pilibos with 2,980 points which ranks 15th all-time in California High School basketball history.
- Balian joined the Armenian Senior National Team at the age of 16 and has started at point guard ever since under head coach Rex Kalamian.
- He is the first player to receive a Division I basketball scholarship from an Armenian High School.
- Nikola Radovanovic joins the Waves after a standout junior career in Europe.
- Radovanovic played the past three seasons with Mladost Zemun in the Serbian Pro League, winning the 2023 league championship.
- Representing Serbia at the 2019 FIBA U16 Euros, Radovanovic averaged 15.1 PPG and 7.3 RPG in the tournament among Europe's top young talent.
- Vladimir Sudar comes to Pepperdine having spent the past six seasons with SC Derby Podgorica, playing in the Montenegrin Basketball League.
- Competing with the Montenegrin National Team as well, Sudar averaged 9.9 points, 3.1 rebounds and 2.1 assists in seven games of FIBA U20 Eurobasketball play in 2024 in Gdynia.
- $\bullet$  Ty Virgil enters as a true freshman guard out of Hillcrest Prep in Gilbert, Ariz.
- Virgil averaged over 22 points, seven rebounds and four assists as a senior, after a standout run on the AAU circuit with DreamVision, Team
- · Lillard and Team Dtermined.
- Luka Vudragovic joins as a wing who averaged 8.1 points per game for KK Metalac in the Serbian Pro League in 2024-25.
- Vudragovic has also represented Serbia at the international level, including the FIBA U19 Basketball World Cup and FIBA U18 European
- Challengers
- Cicic, Radovanovic, Sudar and Vudragovic join Stosic and Dozic as Waves with Serbian ties.

#### **WAVES IN THE NBA**

- · Former Pepperdine great Doug Christie enters his first full season as head coach of the Sacramento Kings.
- Christie was a former first round NBA draft pick after starring in three seasons for the Waves from 1989-92.
- 2025 graduate Stefan Todorovic begins the 2025-26 season with the Maine Celtics of the NBA G-League after being selected 7th in the G League draft following a standout summer league with the Philadelphia 76ers.

### THE MOUNTAIN AT MULLIN PARK

The Mountain at Mullin Park will become the new home for Pepperdine's basketball programs in 2026-27. The 3,600-seat arena will give Pepperdine a state-of-the-art competition venue, complete with a 360-degree high-definition scoreboard, VIP and hospitality spaces, and custom team locker rooms. The facility will elevate the experience for student-athletes and provide fans with one of the premier indoor collegiate environments on the West Coast. Connected to the arena is a three-story, 45,000-square-foot student center that will house the University's RISE Institute along with a broad range of wellness and recreation amenities. Construction reached a major milestone with the topping-out ceremony in May 2025, marking the completion of the arena's highest structural point. Following interior build-out and finishing, Pepperdine men's and women's basketball are expected to be the first teams to compete in the new arena beginning the 2026-27 season.

# Head Coach Ed Schilling 2nd season

Ed Schilling was named head men's basketball coach at Pepperdine University in April 2024 and enters his second year at the helm in 2025-26.

In his first season in Malibu in 2024–25, Schilling led the Waves to their first WCC Semifinal appearance in four seasons which marked the 17th semifinal appearance in program history. The Waves won three consecutive games in the tournament, knocking off Portland, Oregon State and Santa Clara in consecutive days.

During his 13 years as an assistant at UMass, Memphis, UCLA, Indiana and Grand Canyon, his teams went a combined 304-134 and participated in eight NCAA Tournaments-including appearances in the Final Four and Sweet 16.

"Throughout his decorated tenure at GCU and in the years prior, Coach Schilling has demonstrated the highest levels of leadership in player development and preparedness for the rigors of collegiate and professional basketball," said Pepperdine president Jim Gash in a message to the community. "His extensive coaching experience throughout his career has exemplified the visionary leadership, strategic thinking, adaptability, and emotional intelligence required to navigate the world of college athletics. I look forward to a new era of Pepperdine basketball under Coach Schilling's leadership."

During Coach Schilling's first season at GCU, the men's basketball program won its first conference title and qualified for its first NCAA Tournament. While at GCU, the team went on to claim the 2023 and 2024 Western Athletic Conference title and made three total appearances in the NCAA tournament. Prior to coaching at GCU, Coach Schilling served as an assistant coach at Indiana from 2017 to 2019 and at UCLA from 2013 to 2017. During his tenure at UCLA, the Bruins compiled a 96-45 overall record, made three Sweet Sixteen appearances (2014, 2015, and 2017), and sent nine players to the NBA. Coach Schilling was also the assistant coach under basketball coaching legend John Calipari on three different teams—UMass, Memphis, and the New Jersey Nets. His first collegiate coaching season with UMass posted a 35-2 record and made a Final Four appearance.

"I am thrilled and appreciative to start this new chapter as the head coach for the men's basketball team at Pepperdine University," Schilling said. "The university's prestigious academic reputation, beautiful campus and the passionate vision for basketball success from President Gash, Dr. Tim Perrin and Tanner Gardner make this opportunity a remarkable blessing."

Prior to his impressive experience in collegiate and professional basketball, Schilling, a Lebanon, Indiana, native, coached high school basketball at Park Tudor School,

Western Boone Junior-Senior High School, and Logansport High School in his home state. Schilling also coached the Adidas High School All-American Team in various national and international competitions and was a director and trainer at the Champions Academy in Indianapolis, Indiana. Schilling has an extensive background in player development and, from 2007 to 2013, trained more than 60 players per year at St. Vincent's Sports Performance and its NBA readiness program, where he prepared high-profile young players for the NBA draft.

As a student-athlete, Schilling was a four-year starting point guard and a two-time captain at Miami University in Ohio from 1985 to 1988. At Miami, Schilling helped lead the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances and was a three-time academic all-conference selection. He also established single-game, season, and career assist records at Miami University, all of which are still standing.

The Pepperdine men's basketball program completed its 86th season in 2023-24 and the 51st year playing in the historic Firestone Fieldhouse. The Waves have been to the NCAA Tournament 13 times and have won 12 West Coast Conference regular-season titles, three WCC Tournament crowns and the College Basketball Invitational title in 2021. Thirty-three former Pepperdine players have gone on to be selected on NBA Draft nights over the years, with the most recent Wave to enter the pros being Maxwell Lewis who was selected to the Los Angeles Lakers in 2023.

"We are excited to welcome Coach Schilling to the Pepperdine Family," Director of Athletics Tanner Gardner said. "I look forward to partnering with him to chart a bright future for Pepperdine Men's Basketball."

Schilling succeeds Lorenzo Romar who served as the Head Coach of the Waves' men's basketball program from 2018 to 2024 and previously from 1996 to 1999. Under Romar's leadership, the Waves won the 2021 College Basketball Invitational, the program's first-ever postseason championship. Since 1944, the Waves have qualified for the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in 2002.

As a student-athlete, Coach Schilling was a four-year starting point guard and a two-time captain at Miami University in Ohio from 1985 to 1988. At Miami, Coach Schilling helped lead the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances and was a three-time academic all-conference selection. He also established single-game, season, and career assist records at Miami University, all of which are still standing.

Deeply passionate about inspiring players to perform at the highest level, Coach Schilling has also co-authored two books—Guard Play (1998), which covers the technical skills and leadership attributes necessary to be a successful point guard or shooting guard, and Five Star Basketball, a collection of inspirational words and playing techniques by some of the greatest collegiate basketball coaches.

Coach Schilling is married to his wife, April, a former assistant coach for the Indiana Fever. He has four daughters— Christiana, Natalie, Ava, and Callie—and one son, Edmund Cross.
