The Pepperdine women's tennis program has long been a player on the national stage with repeated strong showings at the NCAA Championships. The Waves first made their first of nine quarterfinal finishes in 1989 and reached the national championship match in 2021. The Waves have also dominated the West Coast Conference throughout the league's long history. Over the last 10 years, the Waves have won 80 percent of their dual matches and finished with seven top-10 rankings, and nine in the top-15.

Former Pepperdine head coach Gualberto Escudero made quite a lasting impact on the Waves' program, as he earned 651 career wins over 37 seasons. During his 11 year tenure, Per Nilsson took over the reins ahead of the 2014-15 season and brought the program to new heights, peaking with the program's first-ever NCAA title match appearance in 2021. All told, the Waves made two semifinal and six quarterfinal appearances under Nilsson.

In 2025, Tassilo Schmid took over for Nilsson after serving as the associate head coach for Pepperdine's men's tennis team. Playing with six freshmen on the roster, Schmid helped the Waves win the 2025 WCC Championship title and led Pepperdine to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Despite playing in a mid-major league, Pepperdine has made 41 NCAA Tournament appearances since 1982 and hasn't missed the postseason since 1987.

Since 1976, Pepperdine has produced an overall record of 876-389 (.692). None of the opposition in the WCC comes close to matching the Waves, who have won a total of 31 league tournament crowns and an additional 11 regular-season titles. Pepperdine won 14 straight tournament crowns from 1988-2001, another seven in a row from 2003-09, and currently has a streak of 11 tournament titles in a row. The Waves have won all but five of the WCC Tournaments ever held, and no other school has won more than two.

Over the years, 25 Pepperdine student-athletes have earned All-American honors 49 times. Ashley Lahey was the nation's #1 player and earned the ITA's National Senior Player of the Year recognition in 2020. There have been 12 WCC Player of the Year awards and 14 WCC Freshman of the Year accolades.

The Waves have had two four-time All-Americans: Janna Kovacevich (1988-91) and Angela Lawrence (1996-99). Three-time All-Americans include Lahey, Ginger Helgeson, Noelle Porter, Ipek Senoglu, Luisa Stefani and Lisa Zaar, while Savannah Broadus, Zsafia Csapo, Lorraine Guillermo, Pam Jung, Paola Palencia, Isabela Petrov and Mayar Sherif were two-time All-Americans.

Lahey made it to the final of the NCAA Singles Tournament in 2018. Three others have reached the semifinals: Porter (1989), Stefani (2016) and Sherif (2018). Three doubles teams have reached the NCAA semifinals with Kovacevich and Porter, Palencia and Senoglu in 2000 and Savannah Broadus and Janice Tjen in 2022 and 2024. Broadus and Tjen made history in 2024 by becoming the first Pepperdine women's doubles team to reach the NCAA Championship match, where they fell to Georgia's Dasha Vidmanova and Aysegul Mert.

The Waves have also produced many standouts in the classroom, including Lahey, the school's first-ever two-time CoSIDA All-Academic first team selection. Lahey was also the WCC's Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 2021. Anna Brunstrom made the CoSIDA second team honors in 1991. In addition, there have been 70 WCC All-Academic selections since 1992. In 2024, Nikki Redeljik became the second Pepperdine women's tennis athlete to win the WCC Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year award.

Pepperdine had women's tennis Olympians for the first time in 2021 when both Sherif (Egypt) and Stefani (Brazil) earned spots in the Tokyo Games. Stefani won a bronze medal in doubles. Sherif and Stefani repeated the feat at the 2024 Paris Olympics.

WCC TOURNAMENT HISTORY

In the 38 years in which the West Coast Conference has held a postseason tournament, Pepperdine has won the conference tournament title on 31 occasions, including a run of 14 consecutive titles from 1988-2001. The Waves then put together a streak of seven consecutive championships between 2003-09. Currently, Pepperdine is on an 11-year streak of taking home the crown from 2013-25 (the tournament was not held during the 2020 or 2021 seasons due to the coronavirus pandemic). Below are the complete Pepperdine women's tennis results from the WCC Tournament since 1995, when the current dual-match team format was established. The Waves boast a remarkable 73-3 (.961) record in that time.

NCAA TOURNAMENT TEAM RESULTS

Dating back to 1982, Pepperdine has advanced to the NCAA postseason on 42 occasions (37 not including NCAA regionals) and has compiled an all-time record of 53-41 (.563). The 2021 squad reached the national championship match, the best finish in program history. That's followed by nine different quarterfinal appearances — 1989, 1990, 1991, 1994, 2016, 2017, 2019, 2022 and 2024. Pepperdine has made the semifinals twice (2021 and 2024).

The women's tournament, introduced in 1982, began with the nation's top 16 teams playing a single-elimination tournament to determine the NCAA champion. From 1994 to 1998, Pepperdine competed in Region VIII, with the winner of each regional meeting at the NCAA Championships. In 1999, the NCAA Tournament moved to a 64-team format that requires teams to win six matches for the title.

The Waves have only missed the NCAA Tournament twice in its history. Since the tournament went to the 64-team format, Pepperdine has played host to the first two rounds in 1999, 2000, 2006, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024, while also hosting the first-ever Super Regional in 2019 (and again in 2022 and 2024).

The Waves have also had considerable success in the individual tournaments. Since 1984, Pepperdine has sent student-athletes a combined 64 times to the NCAA Singles Championship. Of those appearances, 27 have advanced the second round while 16 advanced to the round of 16.

In 2018, Ashley Lahey became the first-ever Pepperdine women's tennis player to reach the final. Four have finished as semifinalists including Noelle Porter (1989), Luisa Stefani (2016) and Mayar Sherif (2018). Nine Pepperdine standouts have reached the quarterfinal stage, including Janna Kovacevich (1988), Porter (1989), Ginger Helgeson (1989, 1990), Stefani (2016, 2018), Sherif (2018), Lahey (2017, 2018) and Lisa Zaar (2022).

Kovacevich, Helgeson, Lahey and Isabela Petrov all competed in the singles draw four times in their collegiate careers.

NCAA DOUBLES CHAMPIONSHIP RESULTS

The Waves have had 30 doubles teams compete at the NCAA Championships since 1982. Janna Kovacevich and Noelle Porter became the first Pepperdine team to reach the semifinals in 1991, while Paola Palencia and Ipek Senoglu achieved the same feat in 2000 at home in Malibu.

Savannah Broadus and Janice Tjen are the only team in Pepperdine history to make the semifinals on multiple occasions, having accomplished the feat in 2022 and 2024.

After spending most of their careers as one of the nation's top doubles teams Broadus and Tjen saved their highest level for their swan song in 2024. With their combination of experience, Broadus' athleticism and Tjen's stellar serving — in fact, she never lost a service game in five matches — the duo rolled through the draw in Stillwater, Okla. to become the first Pepperdine women's doubles team to reach the NCAA Championship match.

After surviving an epic third-set super-breaker in the first round, Broadus and Tjen cruised through the draw. The Waves won two blowout, straight-set matches — including a 6-2, 6-2 rout of the defending national champions Fiona Crawley and Carson Tanguilig from North Carolina in the quarterfinals — to reach the semifinals. There, they beat Tennessee's Sofia Cabezas and Elza Tomase 6-2, 6-1 to punch their ticket to the national championship match.

While Broadus and Tjen's road to title match featured little drama aside from the first round, the championship match against Georgia's Dasha Vidmanova and Aysegul Mert made up for it in spades. The Bulldogs took the first set off the Waves in a close tiebreaker before Broadus and Tjen rallied in the second set to push the match to a third-set super-breaker. Unfortunately for Pepperdine, Georgia saved two match points and the Waves finished as the national runners-up.

Collectively, Pepperdine teams are 34-32 at the NCAA Championships.

RALPHS-STRAUS TENNIS CENTER



The Pepperdine men's and women's tennis teams play all of their home dual matches at the picturesque Ralphs-Straus Tennis Center.

The nine-court, fully lighted facility served as the host site for the 1995 and 2000 NCAA Division I Women's Tennis Championships.

The Ralphs-Straus Tennis Center has also hosted the 1996 women's NCAA West Regional Championships, the 1997 men's NCAA Region VIII Championships, men's NCAA First/Second Round action seven times (2000, 2002, 2005, 2006, 2008, 2012, 2013) and women's NCAA First/Second Round play 11 times (1999, 2000, 2006, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024), as well as three women's Super Regional rounds (2019, 2022, 2024).

In addition to resurfaced courts and improved lighting, the refurbished complex includes seating for nearly 2,000 people. The beautifully landscaped facility offers many excellent vantage points for fans, and a large patio overlooks Raleigh Runnels Memorial Pool and has a breathtaking view of the Pacific Ocean. During the summer of 1998, the 800-seat Harilela International Grandstand was added to the facility.

The Ralphs-Straus Tennis Center includes a large lounge in addition to team meeting and locker room facilities and office space for the men's and women's tennis coaching staffs. Both locker rooms are due for renovations, which are expected to begin in 2025.

The Pepperdine women have won three-quarters of their home matches since 1978 (501-164, .753). In 1993, 2014, 2016, 2020, 2021 and 2023 the Waves were undefeated at home.
