THE MATCH

•The University of Pittsburgh men's soccer team is set to host Columbia Tuesday, Oct. 2 at 7 p.m. at Ambrose Urbanic Field in the Petersen Sports Complex.

LAST TIME OUT

- Pitt recorded a 2-0 loss to No. 11 Virginia Friday, Sept. 28 at Ambrose Urbanic Field.
- •The Cavaliers scored two second half goals to earn the victory over the Panthers.
- Senior Javi Perez led Pitt with three shots in the match. Sophomores Edward Kizza, Marcony Pimentel and Jose Luis Sena Arbona recorded two shots each, with freshman Jackson Walti adding one shot.

SURVEYING THE STATS

- Six different Panthers have scored a goal so far this season in Kizza, Perez, Pimentel, Walti redshirt senior Robby
 Dambrot and redshirt freshman Fiorre
 Mane.
- Kizza leads the team with six scores, followed by Perez and Pimentel with two. Dambrot, Mane and Walti have each netted one goal apiece.
- Pitt has also seen seven players record assists on the season.
- •Sophomore Alexander Dexter leads the squad with three assists, followed by Pimentel with two. Dambrot, Sena Arbona and freshmen Nyk Sessock, Alec Townsend and Chandler Vaughn have all added one helper each.

SIZING UP THE 2018 SLATE

- •Pitt faces some tough competition in the 2018 season, with a schedule that includes 12 NCAA Tournament teams from a year ago.
- •In nine matches, the Panthers have already faced six ranked opponents this season in then-ranked No. 25 Colgate, No. 4 Akron, No. 5 North Carolina, No. 6 Louisville, No. 12 NC State and No. 11 Virginia.
- Of Pitt's remaining eight matches, three teams are currently ranked in the top 25 of the United Soccer Coaches Poll.

KIZZA COMMANDING ATTENTION

- Coming off a freshman campaign in which he scored four goals, Kizza has already notched six goals through nine games this season.
- The Kampala, Uganda, native currently leads the team in shots (22), shots on goal (14), points (12) and goals (six).
- The sophomore currently ranks 20th in the nation in goals and 48th in points, while ranking second and fifth in the ACC in the same categories, respectively.
- Kizza also ranks 20th in the nation in shot accuracy (.636) while leading the ACC in the category.
- Kizza netted three goals in Pitt's second match of the season against Delaware Monday, Aug. 27, making him just the 20th player in program history to record a hat trick.
- The sophomore's goal in the opening minutes of the contest was also the quickest goal to start a game in school history, coming just 1:40 into the match and besting the previous record of 1:58 set in 2006.

THE SERIES - COLUMBIA

•The Panthers and Lions have met just once before in program history, with Pitt owning a 1-0-0 record against Columbia.
•The teams' lone meeting came Tuesday, Oct. 3, 2017 in New York, N.Y., with the Panthers earning a 1-0 victory over thenranked No. 13 Columbia.

SCOUTING THE LIONS

- Columbia enters Tuesday's match with a 4-2-1 [1-0-0 lvy League] record, most recently earning a 3-1 win over Brown Saturday, Sept. 29 in Providence, R.I.
- •The Lions are led by head coach Kevin Anderson, who is in his 10th season with the program. Anderson has compiled a 76-62-20 (.544) overall record during his time with Columbia.
- •Through seven games, senior Kynan Rocks leads the team with three goals, followed by junior Danny Laranetto with two scores. Five other players have also added one goal apiece for the Lions.
- In goal, senior Dylan Castanheira has started all seven matches for Columbia, collecting two shutouts while recording 18 saves and allowing five goals.

UP NEXT

•The Panthers will continue their homestand as they host Clemson Friday, Oct. 5 at 7 p.m. at Ambrose Urbanic Field.

PITT TOPS #12 NC STATE, 3-1

- Pitt earned its first ACC win of the season with a 3-1 victory over No. 12
 NC State Tuesday, Sept. 25 at Ambrose Urbanic Field.
- •The win was Pitt's first over a ranked opponent since it defeated No. 7 Notre Dame, 1-0, Friday, Oct. 13, 2017 in South Bend, Ind.
- •The Panthers bounced back from an early deficit, surrendering a goal off a free kick to the Wolfpack in the sixth minute, before reeling off three unanswered goals to win the game.
- *Sophomore Marcony Pimentel led the team with four shots to go along with a goal and an assist on the night, while sophomore Alexander Dexter followed with two shots and two assists. Sophomore Edward Kizza also contributed two shots while adding his team-high sixth goal of the season. Seniors Javi Perez and Robby Dambrot, sophomore Jose Luis Sena Arbona and freshman Jackson Walti all recorded one shot apiece, with Walti adding his first career goal.

PITT FALLS TO #6 LOUISVILLE, 1-0

- •Pitt fell to No. 6 Louisville, 1-0, Friday, Sept. 21 at Lynn Stadium in Louisville, Ky.
- A penalty kick goal in the 79th minute of the match gave the Cardinals the win.
- Senior **Shane Wiedt** and sophomore **Edward Kizza** led the Panthers with two shots each, while senior **Javi Perez** and sophomores **Alexander Dexter** and **Marcony Pimentel** added one apiece.

- •Pitt earned a 2-0 victory over Detroit Mercy Tuesday, Sept. 18 at Ambrose Urbanic Field in Pittsburgh, Pa.
- Senior Javi Perez and sophomore
 Marcony Pimentel each recorded
 goals in the match, with freshman Alec
 Townsend adding an assist.
- •The Panthers closed the match with advantages in shots (16-2), shots on goal (7-1) and corners (6-2).

PITT TAKES 1-0 VICTORY OVER VCU

- •Pitt earned a 1-0 victory over VCU Wednesday, Sept. 12 at SportsBackers Stadium in Richmond, Va.
- •The Panthers Ione goal of the match came from sophomore **Edward Kizza**, who added his fifth score of the season in the 21st minute off of a feed from sophomore **Marcony Pimentel**.
- •Pimentel finished the match with a team-high four shots and one assist, while senior Javi Perez and redshirt freshman Fiorre Mane notched two shots apiece. Kizza and sophomore Alexander Dexter each added one shot, with Kizza contributing the lone goal of the day.

PANTHERS FALL TO #5 UNC IN 20T

- Pitt fell in double overtime to No. 5 North Carolina, 2-1, in its ACC opener Saturday, Sept. 8 at Koskinen Stadium on the campus of Duke University in Durham, N.C.
- •The Panthers got out to an early lead after sophomore **Edward Kizza** found the back of the net in the 13th minute off a feed from redshirt senior **Robby Dambrot**.

- •North Carolina's first goal didn't come until the 73rd minute, sending the game into overtime. The Tar Heels ultimately prevailed in the match after a goal in the 109th minute gave them the 2-1 victory.
- Kizza finished the match with a teamhigh three shots and one goal, while
 Dambrot added a shot and assist.

HATS OFF FOR KIZZA

- After finishing the 2017 season with four goals, sophomore Edward Kizza collected three goals in Pitt's second match of the season against Delaware.
- •Kizza's hat trick made him just the 20th player in program history to accomplish the feat.
- Pitt's last hat trick came in 2013 when Chris Davis recorded three goals against Howard.
- •The sophomore's goal in the opening minutes of the contest was also the quickest goal to start a game in school history, coming just 1:40 into the match and besting the previous record of 1:58 set in 2006.

PANTHERS FALL TO #25 COLGATE

- Pitt dropped its season opener to No. 25 Colgate, 1-0, Friday, Aug. 24.
- •Colgate's Freddy Jonsson scored the lone goal of the match in the 74th minute, giving the Raiders the eventual win.
- •The Panthers finished the match with advantages in shots (11-7), shots on goal (6-2) and corner kicks (6-3) but were unable to capatalize.

PITT'S PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- •The Panthers earned multiple preseason honors, both as a team and individually, heading into the 2018 slate.
- Pitt received votes in the United Soccer Coaches Preseason Poll released Tuesday, Aug. 7 earning nine total points.
- •The team's incoming freshman class was also rated sixth in the nation by Top

Drawer Soccer.

- •Individually, senior **Javi Perez** and sophomore **Edward Kizza** landed in Top Drawer Soccer's Preseason Top 100 Players list, with Perez coming in at No. 26 and Kizza coming in at No. 99.
- •Two Panthers also earned recognition in Top Drawer Soccer's Preseason Best XI, with Perez being named to the Second Team and freshman **Chandler Vaughn** collecting Freshman Team honors.

SYNOPSIS OF THE SQUAD

- •Pitt returns 13 players from a year ago, including senior **Javi Perez**, who earned All-ACC Second Team honors, as well as sophomores **Alexander Dexter** and **Edward Kizza**, who were both named to the ACC All-Freshman Team.
- •The Panthers also welcome 12 new players into the fold, with a mix of freshmen and transfers.
- •Senior Peter Prescott, a transfer from Creighton, and redshirt senior Shane Wiedt, a transfer from Akron, both have experience making deep NCAA College Cup runs with their former teams.

2017 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Pitt amassed an 8-10 overall record while collecting multiple marquee wins.
- •The Panthers earned the program's first wins over ranked opponents since 2008 after producing victories against No. 7 Notre Dame, No. 13 Columbia and No. 21 Syracuse.
- •Pitt's wins over the Orange and Fighting Irish were also its first conference victories since joining the ACC in 2013.
- •The Panthers also defeated longtime

- rivals West Virginia and Penn State during the season, including a dominant 7-0 victory over the Mountaineers.
- Pitt's seven goals marked the 28th time in program history that the team had achieved the feat and the first time since 1998.

VIDOVICH'S COACHING CAREER

- Head coach Jay Vidovich enters his third year with the program heading into the 2018 season.
- •Following a rebuilding year in 2016, Vidovich led the Panthers to an 8-10 record in a 2017 season that included multiple marque wins against ranked opponents.
- Prior to Pitt, Vidovich spent 21 years as the head coach at Wake Forest, where he led the Demon Deacons to a 2007 National Championship, made four College Cup appearances and claimed five ACC regular season titles.
- •The two-time NSCAA Coach of the Year has produced 36 professional players, 21 All-Americans and five ACC Player of the Year honorees while compiling a 282-144-53 (.644) career record.



Jay Vidovich, one of America's most respected and accomplished soccer coaches, was named the third Pitt men's soccer head coach at the University of Pittsburgh in December of 2015.

Following his first year at the helm, Vidovich led the Panthers to wins over No. 7 Notre Dame, No. 13 Columbia and No. 21 Syracuse in the 2017 season. The win over Syracuse would be the Panthers' first win over a ranked opponent since the 2008 season. The victory over the Orange was also the first conference win for Pitt since moving into the ACC at the start of the 2013 season, and they would add their second conference win against the Fighting Irish on Oct. 13. The Panthers would also capture victories against rivals Penn State and West Virginia throughout the season.

Vidovich also guided four players to All-ACC recognition, with Javi Perez earning Second Team honors, Pol Planellas receiving Third Team recognition and both Alexander Dexter and Edward Kizza being named to the All-Freshman Team. The postseason accolades were the team's first in program history since joining the ACC.

Planellas would go on to become the first Pitt men's soccer player in program history to be drafted by an MLS Club team after being selected by the Los Angeles Football Club in the second round of the 2018 MLS SuperDraft, becoming the 36th professional player under Vidovich's tutelage.

Prior to making the move to Pittsburgh, Vidovich oversaw the men's soccer program at Wake Forest for 21 seasons (1994-2014), building the Demon Deacons into a national power and winning the 2007 NCAA championship. He spent this past year in professional soccer, coaching the Portland Timbers 2 (T2) in the United Soccer League (USL).

During his Wake Forest tenure, Vidovich compiled a 272-121-50 record and led the Demon Deacons to the NCAA Tournament in 13 of his final 14 seasons. Wake Forest won five Atlantic Coast Conference titles under his watch, compiling a 76-52-22 mark in one of the nation's most challenging leagues.

In 2007, Wake Forest went 22-2-2-the winningest season in school history-and defeated Ohio State, 2-1, in the national final to claim the program's first NCAA title. The Demon Deacons made four consecutive appearances in the College Cup from 2006-09.

Vidovich, a two-time National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) National Coach of the Year (2007 and 2008) and five-time ACC Coach of the Year (2002, 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2009), ranks among the most decorated coaches in collegiate soccer.

Vidovich was the 2008 recipient of the prestigious Walt Chyzowych Award for lifetime contributions to the sport of soccer. Vidovich was an assistant under the legendary Chyzowych for eight seasons at Wake Forest from 1986-93.

Widely regarded as one of the game's top evaluators and developers of talent, Vidovich has produced 21 All-Americans and five ACC Player of the Year honorees (three offensive and two defensive). He also coached Marcus Tracy, the first player in Wake history to win the Missouri Athletic Club's (MAC) Hermann Trophy, which honors the top individual player in college soccer.

Thirty-five players under Vidovich went on to play in the professional ranks from 2002-14. His Wake Forest teams also achieved academically, evidenced by two ACC Scholar-Athlete of the Year honorees, two Academic All-Americans, one adidas National Scholar-Athlete of the Year and one Senior CLASS Award recipient.

Born in Detroit, Mich., Vidovich was an all-state player for New Canaan High School in Connecticut. He played for Indiana University in 1978 before transferring to Ohio Wesleyan, where he was a three-year starter. As a senior, Vidovich was team captain and helped lead OWU to the semifinals of the NCAA Tournament.

A 1982 graduate of Ohio Wesleyan with a bachelor's degree in physical education, he went on to earn a master's degree in sports sciences from the University of Denver in 1983.

It was at Denver where Vidovich's coaching career was launched as an assistant in 1982. He served in additional assistant posts at Regis College (1983) and his alma mater Ohio Wesleyan (1984-85) before joining Wake Forest's staff in 1986.
