#### >> OPENING TIPS

##### A WIN WOULD...

- » Give the Panthers the 2-1 series lead over UNCW, both wins coming inside the Petersen Events Center.
- » Improve the Panthers home record to 5-2 on the season.
- » Give the Panthers seven non-conference wins after winning eight non-conference games a season ago.
- » Be the 19th win against a CAA school in program history.

##### LAST TIME OUT...

- » The Panthers (6-5, 0-0 ACC) saw their four-game winning streak snapped by the West Virginia Mountaineers on Dec. 8, falling 77-43 in the Backyard Brawl.
- » Sophomore **Cara Judkins** was the lone Panther to score in double figures against the Mountaineers as she netted a team-high 12 points, nine rebounds and three blocks in the loss.
- » Senior **Cassidy Walsh** played 29 minutes and finished with nine points, four rebounds and two steals while connecting on three triples.
- » Off the bench, senior **Kauai Bradley** played a season-high 35 minutes while posting six points, six rebounds

and three steals in the loss.

- » The Panthers weren't able to protect the ball against the Mountaineers as they turned the ball over 28 times and West Virginia turned those chances into 31 points.

##### STORYLINES

- » Pitt will look for a big response after seeing their four-game winning streak snapped last time out by West Virginia. Prior to the WVU loss, the Panthers previous loss was to Wisconsin in Nashville and they responded with a big win over Arkansas.
- » Pitt has dominated opponents from the Colonial Athletic Association over their history as they own a 18-8 record against CAA foes.
- » The magic number for the Panthers offensively this season has been 60 as they are 5-0 on the year when they score at least 60 points.

##### LOOKING AHEAD...

- » The Panthers wrap up their four-game homestand on Friday, Dec. 21 as they welcome Saint Francis (PA) to the Petersen Events Center for a 7:00 pm tip.
- » Pitt will conclude their non-conference slate on Dec. 29 as they head to Duquesne for the City Game at 2:00 pm.

## &gt;&gt; SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

- » The UNCW Seahawks come to town with a 5-3 overall record on the season as they were handed a 82-55 loss last time out by North Carolina.
- » The Seahawks are led by Rutgers transfer Shrita Parker who is averaging a team-best 19.8 points, 4.1 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 2.6 steals while connecting on a team-high 13 three-pointers.
- » Old Dominion transfer GiGi Smith is enjoying a strong start to her redshirt junior campaign as she ranks second on the team averaging 15.3 points, 4.6 rebounds and 1.6 steals while starting all eight games and playing a team-high 33.2 minutes/game.
- » As a team, the Seahawks are averaging 68.6 points/game while shooting 41.2% from the floor and 25.7% from behind the arc. They are being outrebounded this season 37.4 to 34.4 but their defense is forcing an average of 21.1 turnovers/game.
- » The Seahawks are coached by Karen Barefoot who is in her second season roaming the sidelines for UNCW. Barefoot has been a head coach for 21 seasons and she has accumulated 330 career head coaching victories.

## HOME SWEET HOME

- » Pitt will return to the Petersen Events Center for their third of four straight at home on Tuesday evening. The Panthers currently own a 3-3 record at home this season after falling to WVU last time out.
- » The Panthers own a 139-111 (.556) overall record at home over the past 16 seasons.
- » At home this season, the Panthers are averaging 62.7 points/game while holding their opponents to 58.3 points/game.

## SUCCESS AGAINST CAA SCHOOLS

- » The Panthers have been really successful against Colonial Athletic Association teams over their program history as they currently own a 18-8 record.
- » The 69.2% winning percentage against CAA schools is the Panthers third best winning percentage against any conference. Pitt owns a 94.4% winning percentage against Northeast schools and a 78.6% winning percentage against Horizon League teams.
- » Pitt has collected three straight victories over CAA foes by an average of 18.7 points/game. The three wins came against UNCW last season, Towson in 2017 and Drexel in 2014.

## JUDKINS GROWING INTO LOW POST THREAT

- » Sophomore post **Cara Judkins** has shown huge growth this season down low for the Panthers and she will be relied on heavily moving forward.
- » Last time out, the sophomore led Pitt with 12 points, nine rebounds and three blocks across 26 minutes of work against West Virginia. The three blocks were a season-high and tied her career-high.
- » Judkins has taken her play to a new level over the last five games for the Panthers as she is averaging 21.2 minutes, 9.2 points, 6.6 rebounds and 1.4 blocks while making 54.5% of her shots from the floor.
- » On the year, Judkins has started eight games while averaging 19.8 minutes, 5.4 points, a team-high 6.5 rebounds and 1.3 blocks while connecting on 45.1% of her shots from the floor.

## KAUAI BRADLEY CONTINUES TO MAKE IMPACT

- » Senior forward **Kauai Bradley** has been playing at a high level off the bench for the Panthers this season and she is being awarded for her efforts.
- » The athletically-gifted Bradley is coming off back-to-back games in which she played 30+ minutes for the Panthers. She has now played at least 30 minutes in four games this season, three of which were off the bench.
- » Last time out, Bradley was effective off the Pitt bench in the loss to WVU as she netted six points, six rebounds and three steals while playing a season-high 35 minutes.
- » Over her last four games, Bradley is averaging a team-high 31.5 minutes, 8.3 points, 8.5 rebounds and 1.8 steals off the Panthers bench.
- » The senior netted a season-high 13 points in the win over Fordham and grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds in the win over Northwestern.

## GARVEN MAKING STRIDES

- » Senior **Danielle Garven** has seen her role in the Pitt rotation grow over the last couple games and her impact has helped the Panthers win four of their last five.
- » Garven has started seven straight games for Pitt and has scored in double figures in four of those games and in a team-high six games overall this season.
- » Across her last five games, Garven is leading the Panthers in scoring as she is averaging 11.6 points, 3.8 rebounds and 2.1 assists while shooting 45.3% from the

floor and 83.3% from the charity stripe.

- » Last time out, Garven struggled a little bit from the floor as she netted eight points, three rebounds and three steals across 26 minutes of work. The senior went 3-for-11 from the floor in the loss.

## WALSH LEADING THE WAY

- » Senior guard **Cassidy Walsh** is enjoying her best start to a season since joining the Panthers as she currently ranks second on the squad averaging a career-high 10.1 points/game.
- » Walsh is the lone Pitt player to start all 11 games this season while playing an average of 29.5 minutes/game, dishing out 2.6 assists and grabbing 2.8 rebounds.
- » Last time out, Walsh provided the Panthers with a deep threat as she netted nine points, four rebounds and two steals while knocking down three triples in the loss.
- » The senior has also connected on a team-best 20 three-pointers while shooting 37.0% from behind the arc.
- » Walsh has a team-high six double-digit scoring games this season including a career-high 21 point performance in the win over New Orleans earlier this season.

## BUGG OUT INDEFINITELY

- » As announced by head coach **Lance White** last week, the Panthers leading scorer **Aysia Bugg** is out indefinitely due to blood clots.
- » Bugg was pacing the Pitt offense through the first five games of the season before being diagnosed with the blood clots. The redshirt senior was averaging a team-high 29.6 minutes, 14.0 points, 3.4 assists and 2.4 rebounds while starting all five games at point and netting 20+ points two times.
- » The crafty point guard has now played just five games over the last two seasons as she missed all of last season due to a torn ACL.

## SHARING THE WEALTH

- » The Pitt offense has proved to be very spread out this season as they have seven players who are averaging at least 5.0 points/game this season.
- » The Panthers have seen six different players lead the team in scoring this season. Aysia Bugg and Cassidy Walsh have led Pitt in scoring a team-high three times this season.

## SHOOTING FOR THE STARS

- » One of the keys to success so far this season for the Panthers has been shooting the ball at a higher percentage than their opponents. Pitt is 6-0 this season when shooting a higher percentage from the floor than their opponent and 0-5 when not doing so.
- » The Panthers have also been shooting the ball better of late as they have four games (4-0) this season shooting higher than 45% from the floor including a season-best 58.7% shooting night in the win over Tennessee State.
- » Pitt has posted an unblemished 5-0 record this season when they score at least 60 points. In the five games that Pitt has scored 60+ points, they are shooting 48.2% from the floor.

## FINDING THE RIGHT COMBINATION

- » One of the challenges for a new coaching staff is finding a lineup combination that works and that will put forth maximum effort.
- » The Panthers have used six different starting lineup combinations this season and the lone player to start all 11 games for Pitt is senior guard **Cassidy Walsh**.
- » After starting five different lineups through the first five games of the season, the Panthers have seemed to find

a lineup that works. The lineup of **Cassidy Walsh, Kyla Nelson, Danielle Garven, Jasmine Whitney and Cara Judkins** have started the last six games for Pitt.

- » The most recent starting combination for the Panthers has produced a 4-2 record.

## DEFENSE, DEFENSE, DEFENSE

- » The goal for the Pitt defense this season has been holding their opponents to 60 points or less and they have done so six times this season, winning five of those games.
- » Overall this season, the Panthers rank third in the ACC in scoring defense as they are limiting their opponents to 57.8 points/game so far this season.
- » The Pitt defense also ranks second in the ACC by limiting their opponents to just 26.7% shooting from three-point range on the year.

## WHITE ANNOUNCES #FIRSTCLASS

- » First-year head coach Lance White announced his first signing class on Nov. 20 when he revealed the names of five student-athletes that will be joining the Panthers for the 2019-20 campaign.
- » Amber Brown comes to Pitt from Monroe, Louisiana where she was named First Team All-District after averaging 28.0 points, 6.0 assists, 3.0 steals and 2.0 blocks during her junior campaign. She is a strong perimeter player who will be a great defender and has a strong pull up jumper.
- » Cynthia Ezeja comes to the Panthers from Athens, Greece where she was a starter for the Greek National U18 team. She is a two-time national champion in U16 and a one-time national champion at the U18 level. Ezeja has limitless athleticism which will help her become dominant inside the paint and exploding to the basket.
- » Dayshanette Harris comes to Pitt from Youngstown, Ohio where she was an AP First Team Division II All-State performer in 2018. She averaged 25.6 points and 6.0 assists while also tying a school record with 51 points in a game during the first round of playoffs as a freshman. Harris is an attacking guard who has great ability around the basket.
- » Emy Hayford comes to the Panthers from Maastricht, Netherlands where she played for her national team. She was named MVP of the Luxemburg International Invitational for National Teams in 2017. Hayford has incredible basketball IQ and outstanding athletic ability.
- » Rita Igboke comes to Pitt from Jonesboro, Georgia

where she averaged 8.2 points and 8.0 rebounds last season. She is also ranked 34th amongst all forwards in the class of 2019. Igboke can run the floor and will add a strong defensive presence inside the paint.

## A NEW CHAPTER

- » **Lance White** was introduced as the ninth head coach of Pitt women's basketball in program history Thursday, April 19, 2018.
- » White is one of four new head coaches in the Atlantic Coast Conference, joining Boston College's Joanna Bernabei-McNamee, Clemson's Amanda Butler and Virginia's Tina Thompson.
- » Joining White on the sidelines this season is associate head coaches **Danielle Atkinson** and **Terri Mitchell**, and assistant coach **Josh Petersen**.
- » Over his 15 years at Florida State, White helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons with 20 or more wins.

**Lance White** was introduced as the ninth head coach of Pitt women's basketball in program history on Thursday, April 19, 2018.

White comes to Pitt after spending the past 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons with 20 or more wins.

During his final season at Florida State (2017-18), the Seminoles posted 25 or more wins for the fourth consecutive season, finishing with a 26-7 overall record and averaged the second-most points in a season in program history with 81.0 points per game. It was just the second time FSU averaged 80 or more points per game in a season. The team ranked in the Top 20 nationally in field goal percentage (20th), offensive rebounds per game (16th), rebound margin (sixth), rebounds per game (11th), scoring margin (10th) and scoring offense (13th). The Seminoles led the ACC in rebounding offense (42.8), rebounding margin (+10.0) and offensive rebounding percentage (41.4 percent).

During his time at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards. He helped the Florida State reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in its past 15 appearances.

For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.

During his time in Tallahassee, White helped FSU reach new levels of success and brought an infectious energy to the program. He directed the Seminole defense and offense during his tenure in addition to being one of the country's top recruiters.

Florida State captured back-to-back regular season ACC co-titles in 2010 and 2011, and advanced to the 2010 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight. After serving as assistant coach for the first nine seasons in Tallahassee, White was promoted to associate head coach prior to the 2012-13 campaign.

Prior to Florida State, White spent 11 seasons at Texas Tech, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp. With White on staff, Texas Tech won three Big 12 championships and advanced to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 and two Elite Eight appearances. He was a student assistant on Tech's 1993 national championship team and a graduate assistant coach for two seasons before being elevated to a full-time coach in 1998.

While in Lubbock, White worked with some of the best players the game has ever seen, including National Player of the Year and three-time WNBA MVP Sheryl Swoopes as well as Plenette Pierson, who was named 2007 WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year.

A 1996 graduate of Texas Tech, White earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science. He went on to receive a master's degree in sports administration in August 1998. He attended Lubbock Christian University for three semesters before transferring to Texas Tech in January 1993.

As a high school athlete in Spur, he was a three-time All-District selection, two-time All-Region, and two-time third team all-state choice in basketball. His high school basketball and football teams advanced to the regional round both his junior and senior years. In addition to his football and basketball accolades, he was listed in the Spalding Top 100 tennis players in 1991.

He is married to the former Melanie Smith. The Whites are the proud parents of Quentin and Vivian.
