A WIN WOULD...

- » Give the Panthers the 10-3 all-time series record against the Red Flash.
- » Improve the Panthers home record to 6-3 on the season.
- » Give the Panthers eight non-conference wins, matching last seasons total.
- » Give Pitt 52 victories against Northeast Conference schools in program history.

LAST TIME OUT...

- » The Panthers (7-5, 0-0 ACC) got back to their winning ways on Tuesday night as they used a strong second half to overcome a 13-point deficit and defeat UNCW 60-56.
- » Sophomore **Cara Judkins** continued her great play down low for Pitt as she netted a career-high 16 points, seven rebounds and three blocks while going 8-for-11 from the floor.
- » Senior **Cassidy Walsh** put together another strong performance as she finished off her night with 15 points, a career-high eight rebounds, five assists and a steal across 32 minutes of work.

- » Coming off the bench against the Seahawks, **Kyla Nelson** had a strong showing as she netted 11 points on 4-for-8 from the floor in 25 minutes.
- » The Panthers were able to control the glass on Tuesday as they outrebounded the Seahawks 37-26 including a 13-8 edge in offensive rebounds in the win.

STORYLINES

- » Pitt overcame their biggest second half deficit (13) since December, 31, 2011 when they overcame a 15 point deficit to beat Lafayette.
- » The Panthers have been nearly unstoppable against Northeast Conference opponents as they own a 51-3 record against NEC foes.
- » With the win over UNCW, Pitt improved to 6-0 this season when scoring at least 60 points.

LOOKING AHEAD...

- » The Panthers will conclude their non-conference slate on Dec. 29 as they head to Duquesne for the City Game at 2:00 pm.
- » ACC play for Pitt will open up in 2019 when the Panthers head to Notre Dame for a showdown with the Irish on Thursday, Jan. 3 at 7:00 pm.

>> SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

- » The Saint Francis (PA) Red Flash come to town with a 3-8 overall record after ending a four-game losing streak on Wednesday night as they downed Morehead State 89-83.
- » The Red Flash are led offensively by Jess Kovatch who is averaging 19.5 points, 3.1 rebounds and 1.9 assists while connecting on 41.1% of her three-pointers this season. Earlier this season, Kovatch broke the school and NEC record for points in a career as she now has accumulated 2,373 points over her impressive career. She also holds the NEC record for career three-pointers made with 393 and currently ranks fourth in NCAA history in that category.
- » Karson Swogger is enjoying a nice start to her season as she is averaging 10.9 points, 3.1 rebounds and a team-high 2.9 assists while Courtney Zezza is averaging 8.9 points, a team-high 5.6 rebounds and a team-best 2.9 blocks per outing.
- » As a team, the Red Flash give up a lot of points as they are allowing 86.5 points/game while scoring on average 69.8 points. They do however connect on a lot of three-pointers as they rank third in the NCAA averaging 11.5 three-pointers/game as they have hit 125 on the year.

HOME SWEET HOME

- » Pitt will return to the Petersen Events Center for their fourth straight game on Friday night. The Panthers currently own a 4-3 record at home this season after downing UNCW last time out.
- » The Panthers own a 140-111 (.558) overall record at home over the past 16 seasons.
- » At home this season, the Panthers are averaging 62.3 points/game while holding their opponents to 58.0 points/game.

DOMINATION AGAINST NEC SCHOOLS

- » The Panthers have been really successful against Northeast Conference teams over their program history as they currently own a 51-3 record against NEC schools.
- » The 94.4% winning percentage against NEC schools is the Panthers best winning percentage against any conference that they have played at least three games against.
- » Pitt has collected 13 straight victories against NEC schools with their last loss coming on December 1, 2010 to Saint Francis (PA) on the road by the score of 85-71.

DONT CALL IT A COMEBACK

- » The Panthers looked like they were going to lose their second straight game on Tuesday night as they fell behind UNCW by 13 early in the third quarter but the senior leaders wouldn't let that happen.
- » Pitt started their comeback in the third quarter, cutting the deficit to four heading into the final quarter, and finished it off with a strong fourth.
- » The 13-point comeback marked the Panthers biggest second half comeback since Dec. 31, 2011 when they trailed by 15 against Lafayette and came back to win.
- » Overall it is the largest comeback win since Jan. 30, 2014 when the Panthers trailed Boston College by 14 in the first half before earning the win.

JUDKINS GROWING INTO LOW POST PRESENCE FOR PITT

- » Sophomore post **Cara Judkins** has shown huge growth this season down low for the Panthers and she is turning into a difference maker for Pitt over her last couple games.
- » Last time out, the sophomore had her best game of her career as she was able to net a career-high 16 points, seven rebounds and three blocks while going an efficient 8-for-11 from the floor.
- » Judkins has taken her play to a new level over the last six games for the Panthers as she is averaging 22.0 minutes, 10.3 points, 6.7 rebounds and 1.7 blocks while making 59.1% of her shots from the floor.
- » On the year, Judkins has started nine games while averaging 20.3 minutes, 6.3 points, a team-high 6.5 rebounds and 1.4 blocks while connecting on 50.0% of her shots from the floor.

WALSH LEADING THE WAY

- » Senior guard **Cassidy Walsh** is enjoying her best start to a season since joining the Panthers as she currently ranks second on the squad averaging a career-high 10.5 points/game.
- » Walsh is the lone Pitt player to start all 12 games this season while playing an average of 29.7 minutes/game, dishing out 2.8 assists and grabbing 3.3 rebounds.
- » Last time out, Walsh exploded in the second half as she netted 15 points, a career-high eight rebounds and five assists in the win over UNCW.
- » The senior has also connected on a team-best 22 three-pointers while shooting 36.7% from behind the arc.
- » Walsh has a team-high seven double-digit scoring games this season including a career-high 21 point performance in the win over New Orleans earlier this season.

KAUAI BRADLEY CONTINUES TO MAKE IMPACT

- » Senior forward **Kauai Bradley** has been playing at a high level off the bench for the Panthers this season and she was awarded with a start against UNCW last time out.
- » The athletically-gifted Bradley has posted four games of 30+ minutes including three off the Pitt bench this season.
- » Last time out, Bradley started and was able to contribute defensively with four rebounds, three steals and two blocks across 26 minutes of work.
- » Over her last five games, Bradley is averaging a team-high 30.4 minutes, 6.8 points, 7.6 rebounds and 2.0 steals while grabbing 10 offensive rebounds.
- » The senior netted a season-high 13 points in the win over Fordham and grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds in the win over Northwestern.

GARVEN MAKING STRIDES

- » Senior **Danielle Garven** has seen her role in the Pitt rotation grow over the last couple games and her impact has helped the Panthers win five of their last six.
- » Garven has started eight straight games for Pitt and has scored in double figures in four of those games and in six games overall this season.
- » Across her last six games, Garven is leading the Panthers in scoring as she is averaging 10.8 points, 3.7 rebounds and 2.3 assists while shooting 44.1% from the floor and 81.3% from the charity stripe.
- » Last time out, Garven played 32 minutes and posted seven points, three rebounds and three assists while providing some energy on the defensive end of the court for the Panther during their come-from-behind win.

BUGG OUT INDEFINITELY

- » As announced by head coach **Lance White** last week, the Panthers leading scorer **Aysia Bugg** is out indefinitely due to blood clots.
- » Bugg was pacing the Pitt offense through the first five games of the season before being diagnosed with the blood clots. The redshirt senior was averaging a team-high 29.6 minutes, 14.0 points, 3.4 assists and 2.4 rebounds while starting all five games at point and netting 20+ points two times.
- » The crafty point guard has now played just five games over the last two seasons as she missed all of last season due to a torn ACL.

CHARITY STRIPE PROWESS

- » Junior **Jasmine Whitney** has been efficient at the free throw line all season long for the Panthers as she currently ranks seventh in the ACC in free throw percentage (87.2%).
- » On the year Whitney has connected on 34-of-39 from the charity stripe and has made 27 of her last 30 attempts (90%).
- » Seniors **Danielle Garven** and **Cassidy Walsh** have also produced at the free throw line as Garven is 28-for-37 (75.7%) and Walsh has gone 12-for-16 (75.0%).
- » As a team, the Panthers are shooting 65.6% from the charity stripe but over their last three games they have been strong, shooting 36-for-49 (73.5%).

SHOOTING FOR THE STARS

- » One of the keys to success so far this season for the Panthers has been shooting the ball at a higher percentage than their opponents. Pitt is 6-0 this season when shooting a higher percentage from the floor than their opponent and 1-5 when not doing so.
- » The Panthers have also been shooting the ball better of late as they have four games (4-0) this season shooting higher than 45% from the floor including a season-best 58.7% shooting night in the win over Tennessee State.

>> NOTES

» Pitt has posted an unblemished 6-0 record this season when they score at least 60 points. In the six games that Pitt has scored 60+ points, they are shooting 47.1% from the floor.

FINDING THE RIGHT COMBINATION

- » One of the challenges for a new coaching staff is finding a lineup combination that works and that will put forth maximum effort.
- » The Panthers have used seven different starting lineup combinations this season and the lone player to start all 12 games for Pitt is senior guard **Cassidy Walsh**.
- » After starting five different lineups through the first five games of the season, the Panthers went with a lineup of **Cassidy Walsh, Kyla Nelson, Danielle Garven, Jasmine Whitney and Cara Juddins** over the next six games and they compiled a 4-2 record.
- » Last time out, **Kaui Bradley** replaced Nelson in the starting lineup and the Panthers collected the 60-56 come-from-behind victory over UNCW.

DEFENSE, DEFENSE, DEFENSE

- » The goal for the Pitt defense this season has been holding their opponents to 60 points or less and they have done so seven times this season, winning six of those games.
- » Overall this season, the Panthers rank fourth in the ACC in scoring defense as they are limiting their opponents to 57.7 points/game so far this season.
- » The Pitt defense also ranks third in the ACC by limiting their opponents to just 26.7% shooting from three-point range on the year.

WHITE ANNOUNCES #FIRSTCLASS

- » First-year head coach Lance White announced his first signing class on Nov. 20 when he revealed the names of five student-athletes that will be joining the Panthers for the 2019-20 campaign.
- » Amber Brown comes to Pitt from Monroe, Louisiana where she was named First Team All-District after averaging 28.0 points, 6.0 assists, 3.0 steals and 2.0 blocks during her junior campaign. She is a strong perimeter player who will be a great defender and has a strong pull up jumper.
- » Cynthia Ezeja comes to the Panthers from Athens, Greece where she was a starter for the Greek National U18 team. She is a two-time national champion in U16 and a one-time national champion at the U18 level. Ezeja has limitless athleticism which will help her become

dominant inside the paint and exploding to the basket.

- » Dayshnette Harris comes to Pitt from Youngstown, Ohio where she was an AP First Team Division II All-State performer in 2018. She averaged 25.6 points and 6.0 assists while also tying a school record with 51 points in a game during the first round of playoffs as a freshman. Harris is an attacking guard who has great ability around the basket.
- » Emy Hayford comes to the Panthers from Maastricht, Netherlands where she played for her national team. She was named MVP of the Luxemburg International Invitational for National Teams in 2017. Hayford has incredible basketball IQ and outstanding athletic ability.
- » Rita Igbokwe comes to Pitt from Jonesboro, Georgia where she averaged 8.2 points and 8.0 rebounds last season. She is also ranked 34th amongst all forwards in the class of 2019. Igbokwe can run the floor and will add a strong defensive presence inside the paint.

Lance White was introduced as the ninth head coach of Pitt women's basketball in program history on Thursday, April 19, 2018.

White comes to Pitt after spending the past 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons with 20 or more wins.

During his final season at Florida State (2017-18), the Seminoles posted 25 or more wins for the fourth consecutive season, finishing with a 26-7 overall record and averaged the second-most points in a season in program history with 81.0 points per game. It was just the second time FSU averaged 80 or more points per game in a season. The team ranked in the Top 20 nationally in field goal percentage (20th), offensive rebounds per game (16th), rebound margin (sixth), rebounds per game (11th), scoring margin (10th) and scoring offense (13th). The Seminoles led the ACC in rebounding offense (42.8), rebounding margin (+10.0) and offensive rebounding percentage (41.4 percent).

During his time at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards. He helped the Florida State reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in its past 15 appearances.

For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.

During his time in Tallahassee, White helped FSU reach new levels of success and brought an infectious energy to the program. He directed the Seminole defense and offense during his tenure in addition to being one of the country's top recruiters.

Florida State captured back-to-back regular season ACC co-titles in 2010 and 2011, and advanced to the 2010 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight. After serving as assistant coach for the first nine seasons in Tallahassee, White was promoted to associate head coach prior to the 2012-13 campaign.

Prior to Florida State, White spent 11 seasons at Texas Tech, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp. With White on staff, Texas Tech won three Big 12 championships and advanced to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 and two Elite Eight appearances. He was a student assistant on Tech's 1993 national championship team and a graduate assistant coach for two seasons before being elevated to a full-time coach in 1998.

While in Lubbock, White worked with some of the best players the game has ever seen, including National Player of the Year and three-time WNBA MVP Sheryl Swoopes as well as Plenette Pierson, who was named 2007 WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year.

A 1996 graduate of Texas Tech, White earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science. He went on to receive a master's degree in sports administration in August 1998. He attended Lubbock Christian University for three semesters before transferring to Texas Tech in January 1993.

As a high school athlete in Spur, he was a three-time All-District selection, two-time All-Region, and two-time third team all-state choice in basketball. His high school basketball and football teams advanced to the regional round both his junior and senior years. In addition to his football and basketball accolades, he was listed in the Spalding Top 100 tennis players in 1991.

He is married to the former Melanie Smith. The Whites are the proud parents of Quentin and Vivian.
