A WIN WOULD...

- » Give the Panthers the 21-16 all-time series record against the Dukes.
- » Improve the Panthers road record to 2-1 on the year.
- » Give the Panthers nine non-conference wins, surpassing last seasons total of eight.
- » Give Pitt 42 victories against Atlantic 10 schools in program history.

LAST TIME OUT...

- » The Panthers (8-5, 0-0 ACC) notched their second straight come-from-behind victory as they downed Saint Francis (PA) 78-75 in overtime on Dec. 21 inside the Petersen Events Center.
- » Trailing by 12 at halftime, the Panthers came out of the locker room on fire as they netted a season-high 27 points in the third quarter and shot 65.5% from the floor in the second half to secure the win.
- » Senior **Danielle Garven** had the best game of her career in the win as she netted a career-high 20 points, nine rebounds, three assists and two blocks across 33 minutes of work.

- » Junior point guard **Jasmine Whitney** had an impressive second half in the win as she netted all 17 of her points in the second half and overtime. Whitney finished the game with 17 points, four assists, two steals and two rebounds while going 5-for-7 from the floor and 2-for-2 from behind the arc.
- » Making her second straight start, senior **Kauai Bradley** was all over the floor for the Panthers as she netted eight points, eight rebounds, five assists, five steals and three blocks across 36 minutes.
- » As a team, Pitt was able to outscore the Red Flash 44-26 inside the paint while also forcing 27 turnovers and turning those chances into 29 points.

STORYLINES

- » Pitt has now overcome a deficit of 10+ points in back-to-back games for the first time since joining the ACC in 2013-14.
- » The overtime victory for the Panthers marked their first OT win since Mar. 2, 2016 when they downed North Carolina 82-72 in the extra frame.
- » With the win over Saint Francis (PA), Pitt improved to 7-0 this season when scoring at least 60 points.

>> SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

- » The Duquesne Dukes enter Saturday's contest against Pitt with a 5-6 overall record on the season as they have lost two straight including a 55-51 defeat by Liberty on December 22.
- » The Dukes are being led offensively this season by Kadri-Ann Lass who has started all 11 games and is averaging 10.9 points, 6.7 rebounds and 1.7 blocks while connecting on 43.9% of her field goal attempts. Lass is also playing a team-high 28.6 minutes/game so far this season.
- » Julijana Vojinovic is enjoying a nice start to the season as she ranks second on the team scoring 10.3 points/game while connecting on a team-high 15 three-pointers. Libby Bazelak is averaging 6.5 points while dishing out a team-high 2.7 assists/game.
- » As a team, the Dukes offense is averaging 63.5 points/game while they are allowing 67.5 points/game. Duquesne is being outrebounded 35.5 to 38.9 so far this season but their defense is forcing 16.5 turnovers/game.
- » The Dukes are coached by Dan Burt who has accumulated a record of 119-60 with Duquesne while helping them achieve four 20+ win campaigns over the past five seasons.

37TH EDITION OF THE CITY GAME

- » Crosstown rivals Pitt and Duquesne will clash on the hardwood on Saturday afternoon for the 37th time in the City Game.
- » The Panthers currently own a 20-16 edge over the Dukes in the all-time series while Duquesne holds the slim 8-7 record in games played on their home court.
- » The local rivalry has been one-sided of late as the Dukes have notched four straight wins in the series including a 66-53 win inside the Petersen Events Center last year.

COMEBACK KIDS

- » The Panthers struggled in the first half for the second straight game but for the second straight time, Pitt came out strong in the second half and collected the come-from-behind victory.
- » Pitt has now overcome 10+ point deficits in back-to-back games for the first time since joining the ACC in 2013-14.
- » The 13-point comeback over UNCW marked the Panthers biggest second half comeback since Dec. 31, 2011 when they trailed by 15 against Lafayette and came back to win.
- » Overall it is the largest comeback win since Jan. 30, 2014 when the Panthers trailed Boston College by 14 in the first half before earning the win.
- » Each of the Panthers last three wins have come after trailing by at least nine in the second half.

GARVEN GOES OFF

- » Senior **Danielle Garven** has seen her role in the Pitt rotation grow over the last couple games and her impact has helped the Panthers win six of their last seven.
- » Garven was phenomenal in the Panthers last game as she netted a career-high 20 points, nine rebounds, three assists and two blocks across 33 minutes as Pitt earned the comeback victory over Saint Francis (PA).
- » The 20-point effort by the senior was the first of her career and just the third 20+ point outing by a Panther this season (Bugg, Walsh).
- » Garven has started nine straight games for Pitt and has scored in double figures in five of those games and in seven games overall this season.
- » Across her last seven games, Garven is leading the Panthers in scoring as she is averaging 12.1 points, 4.4 rebounds and 2.4 assists while shooting 44.9% from the floor and 83.3% from the charity stripe.

WALSH CONTINUES STEADY PLAY

- » Senior guard **Cassidy Walsh** is enjoying her best season of her career this year as she has earned more playing time, averaging a team-high 30.5 minutes/game so far.
- » Walsh has been the Panthers most consistent performer this season as she is the lone Pitt player to start all 13 games and is averaging 10.6 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.8 assists so far this season.
- » Last time out, Walsh notched her second straight double digit scoring effort as she netted 12 points, six rebounds, two assists and two steals across a career-high 40 minutes of work in the win over Saint Francis (PA).
- » The senior has also connected on a team-best 24 three-pointers while shooting 35.3% from behind the arc.
- » Walsh has a team-high eight double-digit scoring games this season including a career-high 21 point performance in the win over New Orleans earlier this season.

WHITNEY GROWING INTO A LEADER AT THE POINT

- » Junior guard **Jasmine Whitney** has taken the starting point guard spot and ran with it while showing steady growth so far this season.
- » The junior has started 10 straight games at the point and has helped the Panthers to a 7-3 record in the games she started this season.

- » Last time out, Whitney was the catalyst for Pitt as they earned another come-from-behind victory after trailing by 12 at half. Whitney came out of the locker room and took over the game as she netted all 17 of her points across the second half and overtime. She finished the game with 17 points, four assists, two steals and two rebounds while going 5-for-7 from the floor and 2-for-2 from deep in the win.
- » Over her last six games, the junior is averaging 10.5 points, 3.8 assists, 3.2 rebounds and 1.3 steals while playing an average of 29.0 minutes/game and leading the Panthers to five wins.

KAUAI BRADLEY DOES IT ALL

- » Senior forward **Kauai Bradley** has been a difference maker all season long for the Panthers and her play has earned her two straight starts.
- » Last time out, Bradley did a little bit of everything for the Panthers as she finished off the win over Saint Francis (PA) with eight points, eight rebounds, five assists, five steals and three blocks across 36 minutes.
- » Over her last six games, Bradley is averaging 31.3 minutes, 7.0 points, a team-high 7.7 rebounds and 2.5 steals while grabbing 13 offensive rebounds.
- » The athletically-gifted Bradley has posted five games of 30+ minutes including three off the Pitt bench this season.
- » The senior netted a season-high 13 points in the win over Fordham and grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds in the win over Northwestern.

CONTROL THE PAINT

- » Controlling the paint has been proved to be a pivotal task for the Panthers this season.
- » On the year, Pitt owns a 8-2 record when they score the same or more points inside the paint than their opponent. The Panthers are 0-3 this year when they lose the scoring in the paint category.
- » As a team, Pitt averages 26.9 points/game in the paint while limiting their opponents to just 23.4 points/game.
- » Last time out, the Panthers had their most dominant game inside as they outscored the Red Flash 44-26 in the win. The 44 points inside the paint were a season-high as the Panthers have scored 40+ points in the paint twice this season, both victories.

SHOOTING FOR THE STARS

- » One of the keys to success so far this season for the Panthers has been shooting the ball at a higher percentage than their opponents.
- » Pitt is 7-0 this season when shooting a higher percentage from the floor than their opponent and 1-5 when not doing so.
- » The Panthers have shot 45% or higher from the floor in five games this season, all victories. Earlier this season Pitt shot a season-best 58.7% in the win over Tennessee State.
- » Pitt has posted an unblemished 7-0 record this season when they score at least 60 points. In the seven games that Pitt has scored 60+ points, they are shooting 46.9% from the floor.

FINDING THE RIGHT COMBINATION

- » One of the challenges for a new coaching staff is finding a lineup combination that works and that will put forth maximum effort.
- » The Panthers have used seven different starting lineup combinations this season and the lone player to start all 13 games for Pitt is senior guard **Cassidy Walsh**.
- » After starting five different lineups through the first five games of the season, the Panthers went with a lineup of **Cassidy Walsh, Kyla Nelson, Danielle Garven, Jasmine**

>> NOTES

Whitney and Cara Judkins over the next six games and they compiled a 4-2 record.

- » Over the last two games, **Kaui Bradley** was inserted into the starting lineup in place of Nelson and the Panthers have produced a 2-0 record, both comeback victories.

DEFENSE, DEFENSE, DEFENSE

- » The goal for the Pitt defense this season has been holding their opponents to 60 points or less and they have done so seven times this season, winning six of those games.
- » Overall this season, the Panthers rank sixth in the ACC in scoring defense as they are limiting their opponents to 59.0 points/game so far this season.
- » The Pitt defense also ranks third in the ACC by limiting their opponents to just 27.8% shooting from three-point range on the year.

BUGG OUT INDEFINITELY

- » As announced by head coach **Lance White** last week, the Panthers leading scorer **Aysia Bugg** is out indefinitely due to blood clots.
- » Bugg was pacing the Pitt offense through the first five games of the season before being diagnosed with the blood clots. The redshirt senior was averaging a team-high 29.6 minutes, 14.0 points, 3.4 assists and 2.4 rebounds while starting all five games at point and netting 20+ points two times.
- » The crafty point guard has now played just five games over the last two seasons as she missed all of last season due to a torn ACL.

WHITE ANNOUNCES #FIRSTCLASS

- » First-year head coach Lance White announced his first signing class on Nov. 20 when he revealed the names of five student-athletes that will be joining the Panthers for the 2019-20 campaign.
- » Amber Brown comes to Pitt from Monroe, Louisiana where she was named First Team All-District after averaging 28.0 points, 6.0 assists, 3.0 steals and 2.0 blocks during her junior campaign. She is a strong perimeter player who will be a great defender and has a strong pull up jumper.
- » Cynthia Ezeja comes to the Panthers from Athens, Greece where she was a starter for the Greek National U18 team. She is a two-time national champion in U16 and a one-time national champion at the U18 level. Ezeja has limitless athleticism which will help her become dominant inside the paint and exploding to the basket.

Lance White was introduced as the ninth head coach of Pitt women's basketball in program history on Thursday, April 19, 2018.

White comes to Pitt after spending the past 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons with 20 or more wins.

During his final season at Florida State (2017-18), the Seminoles posted 25 or more wins for the fourth consecutive season, finishing with a 26-7 overall record and averaged the second-most points in a season in program history with 81.0 points per game. It was just the second time FSU averaged 80 or more points per game in a season. The team ranked in the Top 20 nationally in field goal percentage (20th), offensive rebounds per game (16th), rebound margin (sixth), rebounds per game (11th), scoring margin (10th) and scoring offense (13th). The Seminoles led the ACC in rebounding offense (42.8), rebounding margin (+10.0) and offensive rebounding percentage (41.4 percent).

During his time at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards. He helped the Florida State reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in its past 15 appearances.

For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.

During his time in Tallahassee, White helped FSU reach new levels of success and brought an infectious energy to the program. He directed the Seminole defense and offense during his tenure in addition to being one of the country's top recruiters.

Florida State captured back-to-back regular season ACC co-titles in 2010 and 2011, and advanced to the 2010 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight. After serving as assistant coach for the first nine seasons in Tallahassee, White was promoted to associate head coach prior to the 2012-13 campaign.

Prior to Florida State, White spent 11 seasons at Texas Tech, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp. With White on staff, Texas Tech won three Big 12 championships and advanced to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 and two Elite Eight appearances. He was a student assistant on Tech's 1993 national championship team and a graduate assistant coach for two seasons before being elevated to a full-time coach in 1998.

While in Lubbock, White worked with some of the best players the game has ever seen, including National Player of the Year and three-time WNBA MVP Sheryl Swoopes as well as Plenette Pierson, who was named 2007 WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year.

A 1996 graduate of Texas Tech, White earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science. He went on to receive a master's degree in sports administration in August 1998. He attended Lubbock Christian University for three semesters before transferring to Texas Tech in January 1993.

As a high school athlete in Spur, he was a three-time All-District selection, two-time All-Region, and two-time third team all-state choice in basketball. His high school basketball and football teams advanced to the regional round both his junior and senior years. In addition to his football and basketball accolades, he was listed in the Spalding Top 100 tennis players in 1991.

He is married to the former Melanie Smith. The Whites are the proud parents of Quentin and Vivian.
