A WIN WOULD...

- » Give the Panthers their first win over the Mountaineers since 2011.
- » Improve the Panthers record to 12-10 against the Mountaineers inside the Petersen Events Center.
- » Give Pitt a season-long five-game winning streak.
- » Improve the Panthers home record to 4-1 on the season.
- » Be the 21st win against a Big 12 school in program history.

LAST TIME OUT...

- » The Panthers (6-4, 0-0 ACC) earned their fourth straight win as they took down the Fordham Rams in front of the home fans at the Petersen Events Center by the score of 65-62.
- » Pitt had three players score in double figures on Wednesday night as **Jasmine Whitney** led the way with a season-high 18 points on 6-for-9 from the floor.
- » Senior **Danielle Garven** had a strong game down low for the Panthers as she was able to net 16 points and five rebounds while going an efficient 8-for-13 from the floor.
- » As a team, Pitt was able to shoot 48.1% from the floor

while holding the Rams to 41.0% shooting. The Panthers also won the battle of the paint, 28-20, in the win.

STORYLINES

- » Pitt is riding a season-long four-game winning streak, the Panthers have been led by their defense as they are allowing just 55.2 points/game while forcing their opponents to shoot just 31.3% from the floor and 21.6% from deep.
- » The four-game winning streak for the Panthers is their longest winning streak since collecting six-straight wins to open up the 2016-17 campaign.
- » The magic number for the Panthers offensively this season has been 60 as they are 5-0 on the year when they score at least 60 points.

LOOKING AHEAD...

- » The Panthers will stay at home for their next two games as they welcome UNCW (Dec. 18) and St. Francis (PA) (Dec. 21).
- » Pitt will wrap up their non-conference slate on Dec. 29 as they take on the Duquesne Dukes in the City Game at 2:00 pm in Duquesne.

>> SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

- » The West Virginia Mountaineers come to Pittsburgh with a 4-2 record on the season after falling to Missouri at home last time out, 68-51.
- » The Mountaineers have four players averaging double figures in points on the year as Tynice Martin leads the way averaging 18.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 2.8 steals while connecting on 45.5% of her shots from behind the arc.
- » Kysre Gondrezick has started each of the last three games for West Virginia and she is averaging 13.8 points, 3.0 assists and 2.8 steals. Naomi Davenport ranks third on the team in scoring as she is averaging 13.7 points but leads the Mountaineers in rebounding, averaging 9.3 boards/game.
- » As a team, the Mountaineers are averaging 80.0 points while allowing just 54.3 points/game on the year. West Virginia is shooting 44.0% from the floor while their defense is holding opponents to just 34.3% from the floor.
- » Head coach Mike Carey has roamed the sidelines for the Mountaineers across the last 18 seasons. He has accumulated 375 career coaching victories.

HOME SWEET HOME

- » Pitt will return to the Petersen Events Center for their second of four straight at home on Saturday afternoon. The Panthers currently own a 3-2 record at home this season as they downed Fordham last time out at home.
- » The Panthers own a 139-110 (.558) overall record inside the Petersen Events Center over the past 16 seasons.
- » At home this season, Pitt is averaging 66.6 points while holding their opponents to just 54.6 points/game. The Panthers are also shooting 42.6% from the floor and 39.1% from behind the arc in their five home contests, considerably higher percentages than on the road and at neutral sites.

FOUR IN A ROW

- » The Panthers have been playing their best basketball of the season of late as they are currently riding a four-game winning streak. Pitt has notched wins over Arkansas, Tennessee State, Northwestern and Fordham over the streak.
- » The four-game winning streak is the longest for the Panthers since they won six straight to open up the 2016-17 campaign.
- » Across the four-game run, the Panthers defense has been the difference as they have held opponents to just 55.2 points/game in those games.
- » Offensively, Pitt has shown signs of progress as they are completing 47.3% from the floor and 38.5% from behind the arc across the last four games.

WHITNEY GROWING INTO EXPANDED ROLE

- » Junior guard **Jasmine Whitney** has been given an expanded role and has excelled at the point for the Panthers so far this season.
- » Last time out, Whitney had her best game of the season as she posted a season-high 18 points on 6-for-9 from the floor. The junior also hit the biggest basket of the season for Pitt as she converted a layup to seal the win on Wednesday.
- » Whitney has posted three straight double figure scoring efforts and has four double digit scoring games in her last five outings.
- » On the year, She is averaging 27.2 minutes, 8.1 points, a team-high 3.4 assists and 3.1 rebounds while starting seven straight games at the point.

KAUAI BRADLEY MAKING NOISE OFF PANTHERS BENCH

- » Senior forward **Kauai Bradley** has been playing at a high level off the bench for the Panthers this season and she has recently taken her play to a new level.
- » The athletically-gifted Bradley is coming off back-to-back outstanding performances for the Panthers as last time out she netted a season-high 13 points and five rebounds while going 4-for-7 from the floor and 3-for-5 from behind the arc.
- » Last week against Northwestern, Bradley had a career-high 13 rebounds as she has brought down 10+ rebounds twice this season
- » During the current four-game winning streak for the Panthers, Bradley is averaging 26.8 minutes, 8.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 1.0 steals while playing great defensively.

GARVEN CONTINUES STRONG PLAY

- » Senior **Danielle Garven** has seen her role in the Pitt rotation grow over the last couple games and her impact has helped the Panthers win four straight.
- » Garven has started six straight games for Pitt and has scored in double figures in four of those games and in a team-high six games overall this season.

- » Across her last four games, Garven is leading the Panthers in scoring as she is averaging 12.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists while shooting 50.0% from the floor and 80.0% from the charity stripe.
- » Last time out, Garven was a difference maker for the Panthers as she finished off the win over Fordham with 16 points, five rebounds, two assists and a block across 32 minutes of work. She was super efficient on Wednesday as she went 8-for-13 from the floor.
- » The senior closed out the Challenge in Music City earlier this season by being named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 14.7 points and 3.7 rebounds while shooting 50% from the floor.

WALSH LEADING THE WAY

- » Senior guard **Cassidy Walsh** is enjoying her best start to a season since joining the Panthers as she currently ranks second on the squad averaging a career-high 10.2 points/game.
- » Walsh is the lone Pitt player to start all 10 games this season while playing an average of 29.5 minutes/game, dishing out 2.8 assists and grabbing 2.7 rebounds.
- » The senior has also connected on a team-best 17 three-pointers while shooting 35.4% from behind the arc.
- » Walsh has a team-high six double-digit scoring games this season including a career-high 21 point performance in the win over New Orleans earlier this season.

NELSON RANKS 2ND IN ACC IN 3PT%

- » Sophomore **Kyla Nelson** has been a consistent contributor this season for the Panthers and she will be asked to do even more down the stretch of the season.
- » The England native has turned into the Panthers best threat from deep this season as she currently ranks second in the ACC by shooting 51.6% from behind the arc (16-31).
- » On the year, Nelson is averaging 22.0 minutes, 5.9 points and 2.4 rebounds while shooting 41.5% from the floor overall.
- » Over Pitt's current three-game winning streak, Nelson has become more important as she has started all three games while averaging 7.3 points and connecting on six triples.

SHOOTING FOR THE STARS

- » One of the keys to success so far this season for the Panthers has been shooting the ball at a higher percentage than their opponents. Pitt is 6-0 this season when shooting a higher percentage from the floor than their opponent and 0-4 when not doing so.
- » The Panthers have also been shooting the ball better of late as they have four games (4-0) this season shooting higher than 45% from the floor including a season-best 58.7% shooting night in the win over Tennessee State.
- » Pitt has posted an unblemished 5-0 record this season when they score at least 60 points. In the five games that Pitt has scored 60+ points, they are shooting 48.2% from the floor.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

- » The three-point shot is called the great equalizer and the Panthers have been great this season at not letting the three-point ball hurt them.
- » Pitt currently ranks second in the ACC in three-point defense as they are holding their opponents to just 24.8% from behind the arc.
- » Offensively, the Panthers have been solid from deep as they rank fifth in the ACC, shooting 35.5% from behind the arc.
- » Over their current four-game winning streak, Pitt has

- held their opponents to just 21.6% shooting from behind the arc.
- » The Panthers have held four of their last five opponents to under 20% from deep while holding seven of their 10 opponents to less than 30% shooting from behind the arc on the year.

DEFENSE, DEFENSE, DEFENSE

- » The goal for the Pitt defense this season has been holding their opponents to 60 points or less and they have done so six times this season, winning five of those games.
- » Overall this season, the Panthers are holding their opponents to 55.9 points/game while holding their last four opponents to just 55.2 points/game during their winning streak.
- » The Pitt defense has been forcing teams to shoot under their season averages on a nightly basis as they rank third in the ACC by holding their opponents to just 34.2% shooting from the floor.

WHITE ANNOUNCES #FIRSTCLASS

- » First-year head coach Lance White announced his first signing class on Nov. 20 when he revealed the names of five student-athletes that will be joining the Panthers for the 2019-20 campaign.
- » Amber Brown comes to Pitt from Monroe, Louisiana where she was named First Team All-District after averaging 28.0 points, 6.0 assists, 3.0 steals and 2.0 blocks during her junior campaign. She is a strong perimeter player who will be a great defender and has a strong pull up jumper.
- » Cynthia Ezeja comes to the Panthers from Athens, Greece where she was a starter for the Greek National U18 team. She is a two-time national champion in U16 and a one-time national champion at the U18 level. Ezeja has limitless athleticism which will help her become dominant inside the paint and exploding to the basket.
- » Dayshannette Harris comes to Pitt from Youngstown, Ohio where she was an AP First Team Division II All-State performer in 2018. She averaged 25.6 points and 6.0 assists while also tying a school record with 51 points in a game during the first round of playoffs as a freshman. Harris is an attacking guard who has great ability around the basket.
- » Emy Hayford comes to the Panthers from Maastricht, Netherlands where she played for her national team. She was named MVP of the Luxemburg International

Invitational for National Teams in 2017. Hayford has incredible basketball IQ and outstanding athletic ability.

- » Rita Igbokwe comes to Pitt from Jonesboro, Georgia where she averaged 8.2 points and 8.0 rebounds last season. She is also ranked 34th amongst all forwards in the class of 2019. Igbokwe can run the floor and will add a strong defensive presence inside the paint.

A NEW CHAPTER

- » **Lance White** was introduced as the ninth head coach of Pitt women's basketball in program history Thursday, April 19, 2018.
- » White is one of four new head coaches in the Atlantic Coast Conference, joining Boston College's Joanna Bernabei-McNamee, Clemson's Amanda Butler and Virginia's Tina Thompson.
- » Joining White on the sidelines this season is associate head coaches **Danielle Atkinson** and **Terri Mitchell**, and assistant coach **Josh Petersen**.

Lance White was introduced as the ninth head coach of Pitt women's basketball in program history Thursday, April 19, 2018.

White comes to Pitt after spending the past 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons with 20 or more wins.

During his final season at Florida State (2017-18), the Seminoles posted 25 or more wins for the fourth consecutive season, finishing with a 26-7 overall record and averaged the second-most points in a season in program history with 81.0 points per game. It was just the second time FSU averaged 80 or more points per game in a season. The team ranked in the Top 20 nationally in field goal percentage (20th), offensive rebounds per game (16th), rebound margin (sixth), rebounds per game (11th), scoring margin (10th) and scoring offense (13th). The Seminoles led the ACC in rebounding offense (42.8), rebounding margin (+10.0) and offensive rebounding percentage (41.4 percent).

Since White's arrival at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards. He helped the Florida State reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in its past 15 appearances.

For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.

Considered by Florida State head coach Sue Semrau to be one of the rising stars of the coaching profession when she hired him in 2003, White helped FSU reach new levels of success and brought an infectious energy to the program. He directed the Seminole defense and offense during his tenure in addition to being one of the country's top recruiters.

Florida State captured back-to-back regular season ACC co-titles in 2010 and 2011, and advanced to the 2010 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight. After serving as assistant coach for the first nine seasons in Tallahassee, White was promoted to associate head coach in advance of the 2012-13 campaign.

White came to Florida State from Texas Tech where he spent 11 seasons, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp. With White on staff, Texas Tech won three Big 12 championships and advanced to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 and two Elite Eight appearances. He was a student assistant on Tech's 1993 national championship team and a graduate assistant coach for two seasons before being elevated to a full-time coach in 1998.

While in Lubbock, White worked with some of the best players the game has ever seen, including National Player of the Year and three-time WNBA MVP Sheryl Swoopes as well as Plenette Pierson, who was named 2007 WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year.

A 1996 graduate of Texas Tech, White earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science. He went on to receive a master's degree in sports administration in August 1998. He attended Lubbock Christian University for three semesters before transferring to Texas Tech in January 1993.

As a high school athlete in Spur, he was a three-time All-District selection, two-time All-Region, and two-time third team all-state choice in basketball. His high school basketball and football teams advanced to the regional round both his junior and senior years. In addition to his football and basketball accolades, he was listed in the Spalding Top 100 tennis players in 1991.

He is married to the former Melanie Smith. The Whites are the proud parents of Quentin and Vivian.

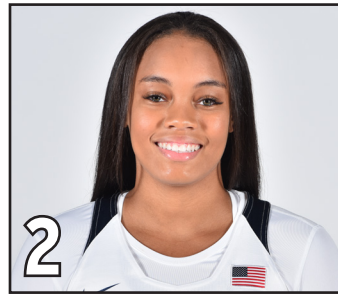

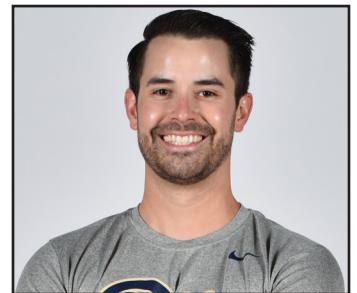
