Darrin Hall rushed for a career-high four touchdowns, but Pitt was edged by North Carolina, 34-31, in an ESPN Thursday night game...Anthony Ratliff-Williams starred for the Tar Heels (2-8, 1-6) in a back-and-forth contest...the UNC sophomore receiver returned the opening kickoff 98 yards for a touchdown, threw for a 35-yard score on a trick play and caught the game-winning TD with 6:18 left in the game...the Panthers (4-6, 2-4) rallied from deficits of 14-3 and 24-17 to take the lead on Hall's fourth TD with 13:16 remaining...however, Ratliff-Williams' 3-yard TD catch from QB Nathan Elliott gave UNC its fifth straight win against Pitt...Hall finished with 121 yards rushing, his third consecutive 100-yard game...Hall's four-score output was the first by a Panther since James Conner also rushed for four TDs at North Carolina on Nov. 15, 2014...led by Hall and mobile QB Ben DiNucci, who rushed for 83 yards, the Panthers outgained the Tar Heels on the ground, 267-96...Pitt dropped to 10-2 under Pat Narduzzi when holding opponents under 100 yards rushing, with both losses coming to UNC.

VIRGINIA TECH 20 • PITT 14

A valiant Pitt effort came up one yard short as the Panthers fell to Virginia Tech, 20-14, in Lane Stadium...a 74-yard pass play from freshman quarterback Kenny Pickett to Jester Weah put Pitt at the Hokies' 1-yard line with under a minute to go...but Virginia Tech's vaunted rush defense stiffened on four consecutive plays and the game ended when Darrin Hall was swarmed for a 3-yard loss...the Panthers (4-7, 2-5) led 14-10 early in the final period after Ryan Winslow hit Nathan Bossory with a 15-yard touchdown pass off a gadget-play fake field goal...Virginia Tech closed to 14-13 on its subsequent possession with a 27-yard field goal...the Hokies then seized the lead for good when Cam Phillips hauled in a 23-yard pass from Josh Jackson with 6:23 left...the game-winning score was set up by a Greg Stroman interception that was returned to the Pitt 40...the INT was one of few mistakes made by Pickett...playing in just his third career game, Pitt's true freshman QB relieved starter Ben DiNucci in the second quarter and completed 15-of-23 passes for 242 yards...Virginia Tech improved to 8-3 overall and 4-3 in ACC play.

Pitt closed the 2017 season by stunning No. 2 Miami, which entered the game undefeated and entertaining College Football Playoff hopes...freshman quarterback Kenny Pickett was the catalyst in the 24-14 victory, accounting for all three Pitt touchdowns and totaling 253 yards in offense...Pickett, the first true frosh to start at QB for the Panthers since 2007 (Pat Bostick), completed 18-of-29 passes (62%) for 193 yards with zero interceptions and was Pitt's second-leading rusher with 60 yards on 13 carries (4.6 avg.)...Pickett's six-yard TD rush gave the Panthers (5-7, 3-5) a 10-7 lead right before intermission...late in the third quarter he connected with Quadree Ollison on a five-yard shovel pass to increase the advantage to 17-7...Pickett's final TD proved to be the clincher—a perfectly executed bootleg on fourth down that the freshman took for a 22-yard score and 24-7 Pitt lead with 2:54 to go...senior cornerback Avonte Maddox iced the upset when he strip-sacked Malik Rosier with 1:45 left...Pitt limited Miami (10-1, 7-1) to 232 total yards and just 45 on the ground...it was the second consecutive year Pitt knocked off an undefeated top-2 opponent...in 2016, Pitt defeated No. 3/2 Clemson, 43-42, in Death Valley...No. 2 Miami became the highest-ranked opponent the Panthers had ever beaten in Pittsburgh...previously, the highest-rated foe Pitt had defeated at home was No. 3 Fordham, 13-0, at Pitt Stadium on Nov. 8, 1941.
