Darrin Hall's career rushing performance lifted Pitt to its first ACC win of the season against host Duke, 24-17, in Durham...facing the nation's No. 16 rushing defense (108 yards per game), Hall exploded for career-high marks of 254 yards on 24 carries and three touchdowns...his four-yard score with 10:48 left gave Pitt the lead for good at 21-17...after Duke had taken a 10-point lead late in the third, Hall sprinted 92 yards for a score...it marked the longest touchdown run in school history, eclipsing the 100-yearold record of 91 established by George McLaren in 1917...Half also broke a 79-yard TD run to open the scoring in the first quarter... both of Hall's long TDs were on the first play of Pitt drives...Pitt (3-5, 1-3) piled up a season-high 485 total yards, including 336 on the ground...Duke (4-4, 1-4) managed just 76 rushing yards...after Alex Kessman's 45-yard field goal made it a seven-point game with 1:41 left, the Blue Devils mounted one last drive, reaching the Pitt 22...but Jordan Whitehead ended the threat and the game with a diving interception with 45 seconds remaining...the Panthers pulled off their first comeback win when trailing by double digits in the second half since rallying from a 15-point deficit against Connecticut on Oct. 10, 2009...the victory was Pitt's seventh in the last eight meetings with Duke, and the Panthers' fifth straight win at Wallace Wade Stadium.
