## LAST TIME OUT:

- Pitt opened the season at the NFCA Leadoff Classic with a 3-2 record, including picking up a win over Auburn, 12-11, in nine innings.
- Alena Ball** played a key role in the weekend, batting .611 (11-for-18) while also showcasing her speed by going 4-for-5 on stolen base attempts. She was especially pivotal against Auburn, going 4-for-5 at the plate and scoring two runs, consistently getting on base and creating scoring opportunities for the Panthers. She was named to the NFCA Leadoff Classic All-Tournament Team.
- The Panthers jumped out early against Auburn, scoring four runs in both the first and second innings to build an 8-2 advantage. **Ball** led the offensive surge, going 4-for-5 with two runs scored and an RBI, while **Tieley Vaughn** finished 3-for-4 with three RBI. **Calle Henne** added a pair of hits and drove in two as Pitt capitalized on early chances at the plate.
- The Pitt softball team opened the 2026 season at the Eddie C. Moore Complex, picking up a pair of wins to begin the season 2-0. The Panthers started the day with an 11-3 victory over North Carolina Central before shutting out Longwood, 4-0, in the evening contest.
- The freshmen duo of Gracie Helton and Calle Henne paced the Panthers against NC Central, as Helton went 3-for-4 with two runs scored and an RBI, and Henne finished 2-for-3 with two RBI, two walks and a run scored.
- The Panthers carried their momentum into the second game, earning a 4-0 shutout over Longwood behind a dominant pitching performance from **Gwen Sparks**. Sparks was outstanding in the circle, tossing a complete-game shutout while allowing just three hits and striking out six.

## QUICK NOTES

### RETURNING CORE AND LEADERSHIP

- Pitt enters the 2026 season with a strong blend of experience and youth, returning 12 players from last year's roster while welcoming a class of 13 freshmen.
- The Panthers bring back key contributors at nearly every position, including experience in the circle, up the middle, and in the outfield:
- Pitching**
  - Pitt returns its top two arms in **Kyra Pittman** and **Gwen Sparks**, with **Bekah Duck** also back after an injury-limited season.
  - Pittman was the workhorse last year, leading the team in wins (10), Complete Games (11), Shutouts (3), Innings Pitched (145.2), and starts (27)
- Catcher**
  - KK Esparza** returns behind the plate after battling injuries last season and provides veteran leadership for underclassmen.
- Middle Infield**
  - Tieley Vaughn** (2B) and **Shelby Frazier** (SS) anchor the infield defensively and bring continuity after the graduation of Desirae Martinez and Kaitlyn Brannstrom.
- Outfield**
  - Ahmar Braden** headlines the group and will shift into center field following the graduation of Kylie Griggs. Braden was Pitt's offensive catalyst in 2025, leading the team in, batting average (.315), stolen bases (13), and triples (2). Her stolen base total ranked tied for 11th in the ACC, and her speed and leadership will be central to Pitt's identity.
  - Alena Ball**, **Camryn Murphy**, and **Macy Hamilton** also return to bring experience in the outfield.

### FRESHMAN CLASS AND IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- Pitt's freshman class features six named to the Softball America ACC Freshman Watch List: **Calle Henne** (C), **Gracie Helton** (3B), **Mia Kliethermes** (P), **Amelia Long** (P), **Addison Oberbreckling** (1B), **Addison Toczek** (OF).
- Several freshmen are expected to contribute immediately:
  - Helton and Oberbreckling are candidates to step into open infield roles.
  - Toczek could see early starting time in the outfield.
  - Long and Kliethermes add depth and competition in the pitching staff.

### TEAM CULTURE

- One of the biggest storylines for Pitt this season is culture. The returning players have taken a leadership role in establishing standards and expectations, particularly after late-season wins over Virginia Tech and Duke a year ago.
- Those wins created belief within the locker room, and the veterans are focused on carrying that momentum forward – setting the tone as the freshmen are integrated into the program.
