Tonight's Top Notes

• It's the final non-conference road game of the season for the Tigers, and it brings Princeton to Lewisburg for the first time since 2013. Princeton has won the last three against Bucknell and has a 13-4 lead in the series.

• The Tigers and Bison have played in five of Mitch Henderson's first six seasons, and Princeton won three of the first four meetings with Bucknell taking Henderson's fifth game as the program's head coach on Nov. 25, 2011, 62-56.

• Up Next: Princeton will have two more games before the calendar flips to 2017 with Hampton coming to Jadwin Gym Wednesday, Dec. 28 at 5 p.m. and Cal Poly coming to town Saturday, Dec. 31 at 1 p.m. It'll be the second time Princeton has played Hampton, which entered Wednesday's game at Appalachian State at 2-8, following an 89-59 win at Hampton last season, and the first time Princeton has faced Cal Poly, which will head to Grand Canyon Wednesday at 5-7.

• Entering Wednesday's games, Spencer Weisz led all of Division I in assist-to-turnover ratio at 5.13, with 41 assists and eight turnovers. He shared the honor with Texas Tech's Devon Thomas, who had the same numbers. Texas Tech was set to play Longwood Wednesday night.

• Also among national rankings, Princeton entered Wednesday's games ninth in the nation in 3s per game (10.5), 11th in the nation in fewest turnovers, at 109, and was 18th in fewest turnovers per game (10.9). Bucknell's opponents have averaged 7.5 3s and 14.5 turnovers per game.

• Princeton averages 11 (10.5) of 28 (28.2) from 3-point range this season. The most 3s a Bucknell opponent has tried this season is Wake Forest, which went 13 of 26 on Nov. 13. Manhattan (Nov. 11) and Mount Saint Mary's (Dec. 19) each went 8 of 22 in Sojka Pavilion, the most tries and the most made for a Bison opponent in Bucknell's building this season.

• Princeton scored 90 points in defeat for the first time in program history Tuesday night at Monmouth. A 1957 game against Illinois, when the No. 6 Illini won 108-87, was previously the most points Princeton had scored in a loss. It was also the third game in program history, and first in regulation, where both teams scored 90 points. Princeton beat Columbia 100-96 in OT on Jan. 8, 1957 in Dillon Gym and won at Rutgers, 94-92 in OT, on Dec. 15, 1960.

• Tuesday night's game was also the first since 2006, and seventh all-time, in which two Tigers scored at least 26 points. Scott Greenman '06 had 27 and Princeton color analyst Noah Savage '08 had 28 in a 76-68 double-OT win at Cornell on Feb. 17, 2006. Steven Cook had 30 and Devin Cannady had 26 against Monmouth in the 96-90 defeat, the first time since 1971, when Bill Sickler '71 and Brian Taylor '84 (originally '73) had 26 apiece in a win at Cornell, that two Tigers had 26-plus points in regulation.

• Princeton has split its two games with the Patriot League this season, and all three will be on the road. The Tigers won at Lafayette, 71-55, on Nov. 23, and lost at Lehigh, 76-67, on Nov. 20. Those two teams are the only common

opponents for Bucknell and Princeton this year, and Bucknell hasn't faced either team yet.

- Bucknell has already faced two Princeton alum-coached teams this year, with the Bison picking up a 75-64 win at Fairfield, coached by Mitch Henderson's teammate Sydney Johnson '97, on Dec. 6 and a 73-68 win over Richmond, coached by Chris Mooney '94, on Nov. 30 in Lewisburg. They'll face another after Mitch Henderson in Mike Brennan '94 and American on Jan. 5 (D.C.) and Feb. 1 (Lewisburg).

- Bucknell returns two players who scored in double figures in the last meeting, an 89-77 Princeton win in Jadwin Gym one year ago to the day from Thursday's game, Dec. 22, 2015, and three Tigers who had 10-plus points in that game will be in uniform Thursday night. Bucknell graduated Chris Hass (21) but returns Zach Thomas (16) and Stephen Brown (10), and Princeton returns Devin Cannady (17), Spencer Weisz (14) and Steven Cook (13) with Henry Caruso (13) injured. Bucknell outshot Princeton from the field in the game, 56.1 percent to 54.5 percent, but the Tigers hit 10 3-pointers and owned the glass, outrebounding Bucknell 41-22. Weisz had a double-double with 10 rebounds, his fourth of five career double-doubles (had his most recent one Dec. 14, 2016 vs. Saint Joseph's).

- The Tigers have been bitten by the injury bug in a big way lately, losing a pair of starting senior forwards. Hans Brase was injured (knee) during the Nov. 29 game at VCU and was declared out for the season Dec. 11, and Henry Caruso played in the Dec. 10 win at Liberty and was declared out for the season Dec. 14 (toe). Brase, who missed last season due to another right knee injury, was Princeton's leading rebounder in 2014-15 (7.5 rpg) and Caruso was Princeton's leading scorer (15.0 ppg) and a first-team All-Ivy League pick a year ago.

- Princeton fell to 80th in the KenPom rankings after Tuesday night's 96-90 loss at Monmouth, and Thursday's game is against Princeton's second-highest remaining opponent on the KenPom list with Bucknell at No. 124 entering Wednesday's games. Yale checked in at 107th. Princeton set up a challenge for itself with its non-conference slate, facing five teams in KenPom's top 110 (through Tuesday's games): BYU (62), Lehigh (97), VCU (57), California (48) and Saint Joseph's (113). Princeton is 3-0 against teams outside KenPom's top 120 and won't face any more teams in the top 120 (through Tuesday's games) after Bucknell, except for Yale.

- Senior Spencer Weisz has been knocking on the door of a triple-double recently, netting 13 assists Dec. 10 at Liberty and getting 10 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists against Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14. Princeton has never had a recorded triple-double.

- Weisz is also climbing some Princeton career lists, now standing 30th with 1,023 points. Former teammate T.J. Bray '14 is next with 1,024, followed by John Hummer '70 at 1,031. Weisz is seventh in career assists, with 299, just behind coach Mitch Henderson '98, who had 304.

- Coach Mitch Henderson '98 picked up his 100th win at Liberty on Dec. 10, tying him for the fifth-most in Princeton history. Henderson could get to third this season, standing tied with Frederick Leuhring (1912-20, 100) and

behind fourth-place Butch van Breda Kolff '45 (1962-67, 103) and third-place Albert Wittmer '22 (1923-32, 115). Pete Carril (1967-96, 514) is Princeton's all-time winningest coach, followed by Cappy Cappon (1938-43, 46-61, 250).

- Princeton traveled nearly 15,000 (approx. 14,801) miles before hosting their first Division I opponent in Saint Joseph's, going to BYU, Lehigh, Lafayette, VCU, Hawaii for Cal and Hawai'i, and Liberty. Until their first Ivy League road trip on the first weekend of February, however, the Tigers won't leave New Jersey and eastern Pennsylvania, going to Bucknell and Monmouth and hosting Hampton, Cal Poly, Penn, Brown and Yale before the finals break takes up the second half of January.

- Spencer Weisz is close to becoming the third player in program history with at least 1,000 points, 550 rebounds and 300 assists (assists kept since the 1974-75 season). Kit Mueller '91 had 1,546 points, 560 rebounds and 381 assists, and Ian Hummer '13 had 1,625 points, 725 rebounds and 308 assists. Weisz enters the Bucknell game with 1,023 points, 491 rebounds and 299 assists.

- Bucknell was picked third in the Patriot League in the preseason coaches and sports information director poll behind Lehigh and Boston U. Nana Foulland was a preseason first-team all-league pick. Bucknell's top national statistical ranking through Tuesday's games was 77th in total steals (81), and Nana Foulland had the top individual stat ranking with a 24th-best five double-doubles.

- ESPN's Dec. 15 bracketology had the Tigers as a 13th seed in the West in Sacramento against Butler with the winner meeting Saint Mary's, Pittsburgh or VCU. Among Princeton opponents, Monmouth was a 13th seed, Lehigh was a 14th seed in the Midwest and VCU was a 12th seed in the West.

- Mitch Henderson is 8-3 against the Patriot League as Princeton's coach, going 3-1 against Bucknell, 5-1 against Lafayette and 0-1 against Lehigh.

- Following Tuesday's game, Princeton led the Ivy League in 3FG percentage defense (.308), turnover margin (+1.90), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.4), defensive rebounds (27.2 drpg), defensive rebound percentage (.762) and 3s per game (10.5). Devin Cannady led the Ivy in free throw percentage at .955, Steven Cook led the Ivy in steals per game at 1.8 and Spencer Weisz led in assist-to-turnover ratio (5.1).

- Princeton has shot better than .400 from the field in seven of 10 games this season and has done so from 3-point range in five of the last seven games.

- Among available players, Princeton has two who have earned All-Ivy League honors during their careers: Spencer Weisz was the 2014 Ivy League Rookie of the Year and 2015 and 2016 second-team All-Ivy. Steven Cook was 2015 second-team All-Ivy and 2016 honorable mention All-Ivy.

- Princeton was in the top 10 percent of the nation (top 34) in five statistical categories at the end of last season: third in fewest fouls (503), sixth in fewest turnovers (331), 14th in 3s per game (9.7), 21st in scoring margin (+10.5

ppg) and 31st in 3FG percentage (.383).

- Princeton led the Ivy League at the end of last season in scoring offense (79.1 ppg, 39th nationally) in fewest turnovers, fewest fouls, defensive rebounds per game (26.93), fewest personal fouls per game (17.3) and 3s per game. Princeton's 79.1 ppg last season was the third-highest in program history and highest since the 1971-72 season, a program-record 79.69 points per game. The 1964-65 Final Four team averaged 79.69 ppg.

- Princeton is coming off its quadrennial foreign trip. The Tigers went to Italy in late August, spending two nights each in Rome, Florence, Bologna with a side trip to Venice, Vicenza and Cernobbio on Lake Como. Princeton played three games, starting by closing a 21-point fourth-quarter deficit to defeat Fortitudo Kontatto in Bologna, a second-division Italian team, 93-87 in overtime. Khyran Rayner hit a halfcourt buzzer-beater to send the game to OT. Next, Princeton faced ASD Pallacanestro Vicenza, winning that game 67-58 against a third-division Italian team. The Tigers closed the trip with an 84-80 OT loss to Junior Casale, another second-division Italian team. Princeton had 15 players on the trip, not including the freshmen, and 13, except Hans Brase and Elias Berbari, saw playing time. Among the Tigers on the Italy trip was Devin Cannady, who had also studied in Tanzania earlier in the summer.

- The Ivy League has won five NCAA Tournament games in the last seven seasons. Cornell advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2010, Harvard beat New Mexico in 2013 and Cincinnati in 2014, and Yale beat Baylor in 2016. Princeton came within a buzzer-beating bank shot of adding to that in 2011, but Kentucky's Brandon Knight saved a 57-55 win, and Harvard fell to UNC just 67-65 in 2015.

- The Pete Carril coaching tree is going strong in the 2016-17 season. Seven current Division I head coaches played for and/or coached under Carril, including Mitch Henderson '98, Mike Brennan '94 (American), John Thompson III '88 (Georgetown), Chris Mooney '94 (Richmond), Sydney Johnson '97 (Fairfield), Brian Earl '99 (Cornell) and Bill Carmody (Holy Cross).

- #IVYMADNESS: The inaugural Ivy League men's and women's basketball tournaments will take place Saturday and Sunday, March 11-12, 2017, at the Palestra in Philadelphia. The top four teams will earn berths in the tournament, with the semifinals on Saturday and the championships on Sunday. All six games will be broadcast live on ESPN's networks. The winner of the regular season will be the Ivy League champion, and the tournament winner will receive the automatic NCAA tournament bid with the regular-season champion, if different, earning an NIT bid. The site past 2017 has not been determined.

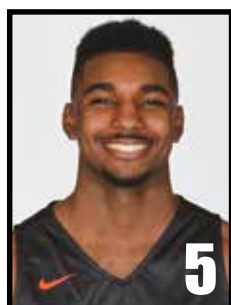

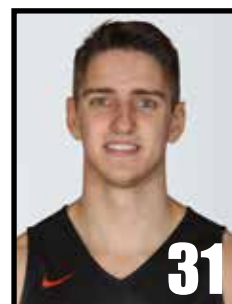
