Tonight's Top Notes

- The Tigers and Hampton will play the back half of a home-and-home series Wednesday after Princeton won 89-59 late in the non-conference slate last season.

- Princeton's 53.8 percent shooting was the catalyst in last season's meeting in Hampton, as the Pirates shot 30.3 percent. Princeton went 12 of 31 (.387) from 3 to 6 of 22 (.273) for Hampton, and rebounds (41-41) and turnovers (12 for Hampton, 11 for Princeton) were close. The Tigers also overcame Hampton getting to the line more than twice as often (13-19 Hampton, 7-9 Princeton).

- Princeton returns 72 of its 89 points from the Hampton game with Henry Caruso's 14 points as most of the difference. Caruso is injured and out for the season. Hampton returns just 11 of its 59 points with Akim Mitchell both the lone starter and leading scorer (four) returning from that game.

- Up Next: Princeton will host Cal Poly for the first time Saturday at 1 p.m. The teams have never met, but it'll be Princeton's second Big West opponent of the season along with Hawai'i. Cal Poly headed to Grand Canyon Wednesday at 5-7.

- The Hampton and Cal Poly games will be the first time Princeton has back-to-back home games since Feb. 26-27, 2016 against Columbia and Cornell. It'll be first time Princeton had back-to-back home non-conference games since a string of three in a row from Nov. 21-30, 2015, against Saint-Peter's, Lafayette and Fairleigh Dickinson.

- Cal Poly's visit will be the first for a Big West team to Jadwin Gym. The Tigers are 5-3 all-time against teams in the Big West at the time of the game, and seven of the eight games were played at neutral sites. The only other non-neutral/on-campus game for Princeton against a Big West foe was against AP No. 1 and defending national champion UNLV on Dec. 18, 1990, a 69-35 defeat. Prior to the Dec. 7 game against Hawai'i, Princeton hadn't played a Big West team since Dec. 5, 2003, a 57-55 loss to UC Irvine in Fresno, Calif.

- The Ivy League season will start Jan. 7 for the Tigers against Penn in Jadwin Gym, and Princeton is 30-5 against the Ivy at home under Mitch Henderson.

- Princeton will have its first three Ivy games at home, including against Brown and Yale Jan. 13-14. The Tigers are 25-5 in home back-to-back Ivy weekend games under Henderson, including 13-2 in Fridays and 12-3 in Saturdays of home back-to-backs. Princeton 16-14 in road games on back-to-backs under Henderson, including 9-6 in Friday games and 7-8 in Saturday games of such weekends.

- Under Mitch Henderson, the Tigers now have a 39-35 (.527) record in the pre-New Year portion of the schedule and a 62-24 (.721) record from Jan. 1 forward.

- Entering last Sunday's games, Princeton ranked sixth in the nation in

fewest total turnovers (117), 11th in 3s per game (10.3) and 14th in fewest turnovers per game (10.6), among stats in which the Tigers were in the nation's top 10 percent. Spencer Weisz had Princeton's top individual statistical ranking, standing 14th nationally with a 3.54 assist to turnover ratio.

- Princeton averages 10 (10.3) of 28 (27.5) from 3-point range this season. The most 3s a Hampton opponent has tried this season came from Stony Brook, which went 9 of 30 on Nov. 26. Another Princeton-alum coach, Chris Mooney '94 and Richmond, went 9 of 28 for the second-most 3s tried against Hampton on Nov. 22. Six of Hampton's 11 opponents have tried 23 or more 3s and the other five have tried 18 or fewer, and Hampton is 1-5 against the former group and 1-4 against the latter. Only Kansas State (12) and Appalachian State (12) have made more than 10 3s against Hampton this year.

- Hampton's opponents average 14.4 turnovers per game, higher than Princeton's average of 10.6. Only two Hampton opponents, Richmond on Nov. 22 (eight) and Gardner-Webb on Dec. 7 (seven), have committed fewer than 11 turnovers against the Pirates.

- Princeton is unbeaten against the MEAC all-time, and five of the team's seven wins have come under Mitch Henderson. The Tigers have had home-and-home series with Florida A&M, Norfolk State and Hampton under Henderson and will look to complete the sweep of those three Wednesday.

- The Tigers have been bitten by the injury bug in a big way lately, losing a pair of starting senior forwards. Hans Brase was injured (knee) during the Nov. 29 game at VCU and was declared out for the season Dec. 11, and Henry Caruso played in the Dec. 10 win at Liberty and was declared out for the season Dec. 14 (toe). Brase, who missed last season due to another right knee injury, was Princeton's leading rebounder in 2014-15 (7.5 rpg) and Caruso was Princeton's leading scorer (15.0 ppg) and a first-team All-Ivy League pick a year ago.

- Princeton got a slight bump in the KenPom rankings from the win at Bucknell, moving up a spot to 79th through Saturday. Yale is Princeton's highest-ranking remaining opponent in KenPom at 111 and is one of eight Tiger opponents in KenPom's top 125 along with BYU (62), Lehigh (95), VCU (58), California (48) and Saint Joseph's (108), Monmouth (73) and Bucknell (125).

- Senior Spencer Weisz has been knocking on the door of a triple-double recently, netting 13 assists Dec. 10 at Liberty and getting 10 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists against Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14. Princeton has never had a recorded triple-double.

- At Bucknell, Weisz surpassed the 300-assist and 500-rebound mark, becoming the third player in program history to have 1,000 points along with 500 boards and 300 helpers. Weisz stands at 1,031 points, 502 rebounds and 304 assists. The other two players are Kit Mueller '91 (1,546 points, 560 rebounds, 381 assists) and Ian Hummer '13 (1,625 points, 725 rebounds, 308 assists).

- Weisz is also climbing some Princeton career lists, now tied for 28th with

1,031 points alongside John Hummer '70 and right behind Sydney Johnson '97 (1,044). Weisz is tied for sixth in career assists at 304 with coach Mitch Henderson '98 and just behind Ian Hummer '13 (308).

- At 101 career wins, coach Mitch Henderson '98 broke a tie for fifth with the win at Bucknell last week. He's two back of Butch van Breda Kolff '45 (1962-67, 103) and 14 behind third-place Albert Wittmer '22 (1923-32, 115). Pete Carril (1967-96, 514) is Princeton's all-time winningest coach, followed by Cappy Cappon (1938-43 & 46-61, 250).

- Hampton was picked third in the MEAC's coach/sports information director preseason poll behind top-pick Howard and South Carolina State.

- ESPN's Dec. 22 bracketology had the Tigers as a 15th seed in the East in Indianapolis, capital of Mitch Henderson's and Devin Cannady's home state, against North Carolina. Among Princeton opponents, Monmouth was a 12th seed in the Midwest and Lehigh was a 14th seed in the South.

- Heading into Tuesday's (12/27) games, Princeton led the Ivy League in scoring margin (+3.8), turnover margin (+2.09), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.4), defensive rebounds (27.3 drpg), offensive rebound percentage (.773), and 3s per game (10.3). Steven Cook led the Ivy in steals per game at 1.7.

- Princeton has shot better than .400 from the field in eight of 10 games this season and has done so from 3-point range in five of the last eight games.

- Among available players, Princeton has two who have earned All-Ivy League honors during their careers: Spencer Weisz was the 2014 Ivy League Rookie of the Year and 2015 and 2016 second-team All-Ivy. Steven Cook was 2015 second-team All-Ivy and 2016 honorable mention All-Ivy.

- Princeton traveled nearly 15,000 (approx. 14,801) miles before hosting their first Division I opponent in Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14, going to BYU, Lehigh, Lafayette, VCU, Hawaii for Cal and Hawai'i, and Liberty. Now, until their first Ivy League road trip on the first weekend of February, the Tigers won't leave New Jersey and eastern Pennsylvania, going to Bucknell and Monmouth and hosting Hampton, Cal Poly, Penn, Brown and Yale before the finals break takes up the second half of January.

- Princeton was in the top 10 percent of the nation (top 34) in five statistical categories at the end of last season: third in fewest fouls (503), sixth in fewest turnovers (331), 14th in 3s per game (9.7), 21st in scoring margin (+10.5 ppg) and 31st in 3FG percentage (.383).

- Princeton led the Ivy League at the end of last season in scoring offense (79.1 ppg, 39th nationally) in fewest turnovers, fewest fouls, defensive rebounds per game (26.93), fewest personal fouls per game (17.3) and 3s per game. Princeton's 79.1 ppg last season was the third-highest in program history and highest since the 1971-72 season, a program-record 79.69 points per game. The 1964-65 Final Four team averaged 79.69 ppg.

- Princeton is coming off its quadrennial foreign trip. The Tigers went to Italy in late August, spending two nights each in Rome, Florence, Bologna with a side trip to Venice, Vicenza and Cernobbio on Lake Como. Princeton

played three games, starting by closing a 21-point fourth-quarter deficit to defeat Fortitudo Kontatto in Bologna, a second-division Italian team, 93-87 in overtime. Khyan Rayner hit a halfcourt buzzer-beater to send the game to OT. Next, Princeton faced ASD Pallacanestro Vicenza, winning that game 67-58 against a third-division Italian team. The Tigers closed the trip with an 84-80 OT loss to Junior Casale, another second-division Italian team. Princeton had 15 players on the trip, not including the freshmen, and 13, except Hans Brase and Elias Berbari, saw playing time. Among the Tigers on the Italy trip was Devin Cannady, who had also studied in Tanzania earlier in the summer.

- The Ivy League has won five NCAA Tournament games in the last seven seasons. Cornell advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2010, Harvard beat New Mexico in 2013 and Cincinnati in 2014, and Yale beat Baylor in 2016. Princeton came within a buzzer-beating bank shot of adding to that in 2011, but Kentucky's Brandon Knight saved a 57-55 win, and Harvard fell to UNC just 67-65 in 2015.

- The Pete Carril coaching tree is going strong in the 2016-17 season. Seven current Division I head coaches played for and/or coached under Carril, including Mitch Henderson '98, Mike Brennan '94 (American), John Thompson III '88 (Georgetown), Chris Mooney '94 (Richmond), Sydney Johnson '97 (Fairfield), Brian Earl '99 (Cornell) and Bill Carmody (Holy Cross).

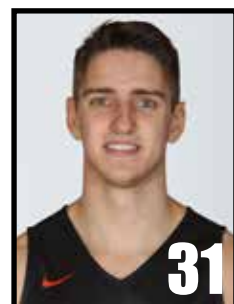
