## Tonight's Top Notes

- It's the final pre-conference game for both teams Saturday afternoon when Cal Poly comes to Jadwin Gym. Princeton will open Ivy League play next Saturday at 7 p.m. against Penn and Cal Poly will head to UC Davis to open Big West play the same day.
- Up Next: Princeton will look for its eighth straight home win against Penn, already the second-longest home winning streak against the Quakers (13 straight from 1957-69). Penn will face back-to-back Princeton alumni head coaches, having hosted Sydney Johnson '97 and Fairfield Friday, Dec. 30 before coming to Jadwin next Saturday. Penn entered the Fairfield game at 5-5 on the season.
- Princeton has played on New Year's Eve 25 times before and has a record of 9-16 on the year's final day. Princeton last played on Dec. 31 two years ago, an 80-66 loss at Wake Forest, and last played at home on NYE three years ago, a 73-68 win over Kent State. This will be just Princeton's fifth home game on NYE and fourth in Jadwin Gym. The Tigers have won all four previous NYE games on campus, defeating Cathedral College (N.Y.) in 1929 in University Gym, and Holy Cross in 1999, Loyola (Md.) in 2004 and Kent State in 2013 in Jadwin.
- Princeton and Cal Poly have never met, but the Tigers have played eight games against Big West teams at the time of the game, most recently against Hawai'i earlier this month at the Pearl Harbor Invitational, a 75-62 Tiger win. This will be just the second game for Princeton against a Big West team at a non-neutral site, as the Tigers fell 69-35 to AP No. 1 UNLV on Dec. 18, 1990 in Las Vegas.
- Princeton and Cal Poly have one common opponent this season: California. Cal topped Princeton 62-51 in Hawaii on Dec. 6 and Cal beat Cal Poly 81-55 on Dec. 17 in Berkeley.
- Cal Poly has faced one Ivy League team in its history. The Mustangs beat Harvard 73-64 on Dec. 28, 1995 in San Luis Obispo.
- Cal Poly has been a Division I program since the 1994-95 season, and the Mustangs have made the D-I NCAA Tournament once. In 2014, Cal Poly beat Texas Southern in a First Four game before taking a loss against Midwest Region top seed Wichita State in the Round of 64.
- Cal Poly hasn't played in an East Coast state since a trip to North Carolina State on Dec. 30, 2000, a 91-63 loss. This will be the Mustangs' second swing through New Jersey, playing at Seton Hall and Saint Peter's in December 1973. Both were defeats, 69-62 at Seton Hall on Dec. 12, 1973 and 71-60 at Saint Peter's on Dec. 14, 1973.
- The closest Division I program to Cal Poly is its Big West Conference foe, UC Santa Barbara, about 80 miles south as the crow flies. There are 24 Division I programs within an 80-mile radius of Princeton.
- This week is the first time Princeton has back-to-back home games since Feb. 26-27, 2016 against Columbia and Cornell. It'll be first time Princeton had back-to-back home non-conference games since a string of three in a row from Nov. 21-30, 2015, against Saint Peter's, Lafayette and Fairleigh Dickinson.

• Devin Cannady needs three points to reach 500 for his career. He'd be the fastest Tiger to 500 since Douglas Davis '12 scored his 500th point in his 40th career game on Jan. 6, 2010. Saturday will be Cannady's 42nd.

• With his next win, Mitch Henderson '98 will catch Butch van Breda Kolff '45 for fourth on Princeton's all-time coaching wins list, at 103.

• Spencer Weisz needs nine points to crack the top 25 on Princeton's career scoring list. That'd put him at 1,057 and alongside Armond Hill '85 for 25th.

• Weisz (307) needs one assist to tie Ian Hummer '13 (308) and make the top five in Princeton history.

• The Ivy League season will start Jan. 7 for the Tigers against Penn in Jadwin Gym, and Princeton is 30-5 against the Ivy at home under Mitch Henderson. Princeton has opened the Ivy season against Penn in each of the past four seasons and has won the last two such games. With the Brown-Yale home weekend coming before the finals break, this will be the first time since 1996 that the Tigers will have played three Ivy games before finals. That year, it was also Penn, Yale and Brown before the break.

• Looking ahead to that first Ivy weekend, the Tigers are 25-5 in home back-to-back Ivy weekend games under Mitch Henderson, including 13-2 in Fridays and 12-3 in Saturdays of home back-to-backs. Princeton is 16-14 in road games on back-to-back Ivy weekends under Henderson, including 9-6 in Friday games and 7-8 in Saturday games of such weekends.

• Under Mitch Henderson, the Tigers now have a 40-35 (.533) record in the pre-New Year portion of the schedule and a 62-24 (.721) record from Jan. 1 forward.

• Through Wednesday's games, Princeton has the second-most wins among New Jersey's eight Division I teams since Mitch Henderson took over at Princeton prior to the 2011-12 season. Princeton's 102 wins during that time are just two back of Seton Hall's 104.

• Through Wednesday's games, Cal Poly's top national statistical ranking was 29th in turnovers per game at 11.4. Princeton opponents turn the ball over an average of 13.3 times per game. The Mustangs' Kyle Toth was 11th in the nation in 3FG percentage at .493. Princeton's 10.6 3-pointers per game were good for eighth in the nation, while the team's 10.5 turnovers per game were 11th, its 126 total turnovers were the 15th fewest, its 127 3s made were 26th and its 1.42 assist-to-turnover ratio was 27th. Spencer Weisz was 20th in the nation with a 3.27 assist-to-turnover ratio.

• Princeton averages 11 (10.6) of 28 (27.8) from 3-point range this season. Only one Cal Poly opponent has tried more than 19 3s this season, and none has made more than 10 3s. Cal State Dominguez Hills, a Division II program, went 9 of 27 on Nov. 17, and Fresno State and Cal went 10 of 19 and 10 of 18 on Dec. 10 and Dec. 17.

• The Tigers have been bitten by the injury bug in a big way this season, losing a pair of starting senior forwards. Hans Brase was injured (knee) during the Nov. 29 game at VCU and was declared out for the season Dec. 11, and Henry Caruso played in the Dec. 10 win at Liberty and was declared out for the season Dec. 14 (toe). Brase, who missed last season due to another right knee injury, was Princeton's leading rebounder in 2014-15 (7.5 rpg) and Caruso was Princeton's leading scorer (15.0 ppg) and a first-team All-Ivy League pick a year ago.

• Princeton got a slight bump in the KenPom rankings from the win over

Hampton Wednesday night, moving up a couple spots to 77th through Wednesday's games. Yale is Princeton's highest-ranking remaining opponent in KenPom at 106 and is one of eight Tiger opponents in KenPom's top 125 along with BYU (64), Lehigh (95), VCU (56), California (48) and Saint Joseph's (104), Monmouth (76) and Bucknell (125).

- Senior Spencer Weisz has been knocking on the door of a triple-double recently, netting 13 assists Dec. 10 at Liberty and getting 10 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists against Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14. Princeton has never had a recorded triple-double.

- At Bucknell, Weisz surpassed the 300-assist and 500-rebound mark, becoming the third player in program history to have 1,000 points along with 500 boards and 300 helpers. Weisz stands at 1,031 points, 502 rebounds and 304 assists. The other two players are Kit Mueller '91 (1,546 points, 560 rebounds, 381 assists) and Ian Hummer '13 (1,625 points, 725 rebounds, 308 assists).

- Cal Poly was picked ninth in the nine-team Big West preseason media poll. Long Beach State, which finished third in the league last year, made the Big West Tournament final and made the first round of the NIT, was the preseason favorite.

- ESPN's Dec. 29 bracketology had the Tigers as a 15th seed in the East in Greenville, S.C., against North Carolina. Among Princeton opponents, VCU is an 11 seed in the East, Lehigh is a 14 seed in the South, and Monmouth is a 13 seed in the Midwest.

- Heading into Thursday's games, Princeton led the Ivy League in scoring margin (+5.8), turnover margin (+2.83), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.4), defensive rebound percentage (.766), and 3s per game (10.6). Steven Cook led the Ivy in steals per game at 1.7, and Spencer Weisz led the league in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.3.

- Princeton has shot better than .400 from the field in nine of 12 games this season and has done so from 3-point range in six of the last nine games.

- Princeton has two current players who have earned All-Ivy League honors during their careers: Spencer Weisz was the 2014 Ivy League Rookie of the Year and 2015 and 2016 second-team All-Ivy. Steven Cook was 2015 second-team All-Ivy and 2016 honorable mention All-Ivy.

- Princeton traveled nearly 15,000 (approx. 14,801) miles before hosting their first Division I opponent in Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14, going to BYU, Lehigh, Lafayette, VCU, Hawaii for Cal and Hawai'i, and Liberty. Now, until their first Ivy League road trip on the first weekend of February, the Tigers won't leave New Jersey and eastern Pennsylvania, going to Bucknell and Monmouth and hosting Hampton, Cal Poly, Penn, Brown and Yale before the finals break takes up the second half of January.

- Princeton was in the top 10 percent of the nation (top 34) in five statistical categories at the end of last season: third in fewest fouls (503), sixth in fewest turnovers (331), 14th in 3s per game (9.7), 21st in scoring margin (+10.5 ppg) and 31st in 3FG percentage (.383).

- Princeton led the Ivy League at the end of last season in scoring offense (79.1 ppg, 39th nationally) in fewest turnovers, fewest fouls, defensive rebounds per game (26.93), fewest personal fouls per game (17.3) and 3s per game. Princeton's 79.1 ppg last season was the third-highest in program history and highest since the 1971-72 season, a program-record 79.69

- Princeton is coming off its quadrennial foreign trip. The Tigers went to Italy in late August, spending two nights each in Rome, Florence, Bologna with a side trip to Venice, Vicenza and Cernobbio on Lake Como. Princeton played three games, starting by closing a 21-point fourth-quarter deficit to defeat Fortitudo Kontatto in Bologna, a second-division Italian team, 93-87 in overtime. Khyan Rayner hit a halfcourt buzzer-beater to send the game to OT. Next, Princeton faced ASD Pallacanestro Vicenza, winning that game 67-58 against a third-division Italian team. The Tigers closed the trip with an 84-80 OT loss to Junior Casale, another second-division Italian team. Princeton had 15 players on the trip, not including the freshmen, and 13, except Hans Brase and Elias Berbari, saw playing time. Among the Tigers on the Italy trip was Devin Cannady, who had also studied in Tanzania earlier in the summer.

- The Ivy League has won five NCAA Tournament games in the last seven seasons. Cornell advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2010, Harvard beat New Mexico in 2013 and Cincinnati in 2014, and Yale beat Baylor in 2016. Princeton came within a buzzer-beating bank shot of adding to that in 2011, but Kentucky's Brandon Knight saved a 57-55 win, and Harvard fell to UNC just 67-65 in 2015.

- The Pete Carril coaching tree is going strong in the 2016-17 season. Seven current Division I head coaches played for and/or coached under Carril, including Mitch Henderson '98, Mike Brennan '94 (American), John Thompson III '88 (Georgetown), Chris Mooney '94 (Richmond), Sydney Johnson '97 (Fairfield), Brian Earl '99 (Cornell) and Bill Carmody (Holy Cross).

- #IVYMADNESS: The inaugural Ivy League men's and women's basketball tournaments will take place Saturday and Sunday, March 11-12, 2017, at the Palestra in Philadelphia. The top four teams will earn berths in the tournament, with the semifinals on Saturday and the championships on Sunday. All six games will be broadcast live on ESPN's networks. The winner of the regular season will be the Ivy League champion, and the tournament winner will receive the automatic NCAA tournament bid with the regular-season champion, if different, earning an NIT bid. The site past 2017 has not been determined.

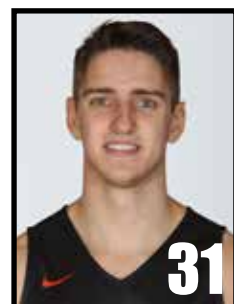
