Tonight's Top Notes

- It's the first weekend of back-to-back Ivy League games as Brown and Yale head to Princeton and Penn. Columbia and Cornell play in Ithaca Saturday and Harvard and Dartmouth will meet again next weekend.
- Up Next: The final exam period runs from Jan. 18-28, keeping the Tiger game schedule open. The annual non-Division I game was back in November this season, so Princeton will have no games between Saturday and Friday, Feb. 3 at Dartmouth.
- Princeton has won 11 Ivy games in a row in Jadwin, with Yale, on Feb. 14, 2015, as the last home Ivy loss. The streak is Princeton's longest since winning 21 in a row from 2010-13.
- Yale took last year's first meeting, 79-75 in New Haven, before the Tigers won 75-63 in Princeton. The Bulldogs prevailed in New Haven by putting together 11-for-19 shooting from 3 with a 52.8 percent to 42.9 percent advantage from the field overall and a 36-30 rebounding edge. In Princeton, the Tigers held Yale to 1 of 12 from 3 and outshot the Bulldogs from the field 46.3 percent to 38.6 percent, overcoming a 39-31 Bulldog rebounding edge.
- The Tigers return most of their leading scorers from the two games against Yale, save Henry Caruso. Devin Cannady led Princeton in the home game with 20 points with Spencer Weisz (15), Caruso (14) and Amir Bell (11) also reaching double figures, while Caruso poured in 26 points in New Haven with Cannady adding 15 and Bell 11. Yale lost all of its double-figure scorers from the two games, whether to graduation or injury, between Brandon Sherrod (19 NH, 18 P), Makai Mason (22 NH, 18 P), Justin Sears (16 NH, 15 P) and Nick Victor (10 NH).
- Princeton and Yale had one common non-league opponents this season. Yale beat Lehigh 89-81 in New Haven on Nov. 17, three days before the Mountain Hawks hosted Princeton and won 76-67.
- While Mitch Henderson has already passed two coaches on Princeton's all-time wins list since the start of the season, he'll have a little more time before jumping the next spot. After starting the season with 96 wins, Henderson (105) has since passed Frederick Leuhring (100) and Butch van Breda Kolff (103) to stand as Princeton's fourth-winningest coach with Albert Wittmer (115) in third.
- Princeton is 32-5 against the Ivy at home under Mitch Henderson. With the Brown-Yale home weekend coming before the finals break, this will be the first time since 1996 that the Tigers will have played three Ivy games before finals. That year, it was also Penn, Yale and Brown before the break.
- The Tigers are 26-5 in home back-to-back Ivy weekend games under Mitch Henderson, including 14-2 in Fridays and 12-3 in Saturdays of home back-to-backs. Princeton is 16-14 in road games on back-to-back Ivy weekends under Henderson, including 9-6 in Friday games and 7-8 in Saturday games of such weekends.
- Under Mitch Henderson, the Tigers now have a 41-35 (.539) record in the pre-New Year portion of the schedule and a 64-24 (.727) record from Jan. 1 forward.
- Through Friday's (1/13) games, Princeton has the second-most wins among New Jersey's eight Division I teams since Mitch Henderson took over at Princeton prior to the 2011-12 season. Princeton's 105 wins during

that time are just one back of Seton Hall's 106.

- Through Thursday's (1/12) games, Princeton ranked third in the nation in fewest total turnovers, then at 149 (now 160). The Tigers were also in the top 10 percent of the nation in 3s per game (10th, then 10.2, now 10.3), turnovers per game (13th, then 10.6/gm, now 10.7), fewest fouls (21st, then 254, now 273), and assist-to-turnover ratio (26th, then 1.39, now 1.43).

- Through Thursday's (1/12) games, Yale was No. 1 in the nation in fewest total fouls (then 218, now 235) and was also top-10 percent nationally in fewest turnovers (10th, then 163, now 180), assists per game (13th, then 17.8/gm, now 17.5), and assist-to-turnover ratio (21st, then 1.42, now 1.36). The Bulldogs are 5-1 this year when committing 15 or fewer fouls and 4-4 when committing 15+. Yale's 12.9 turnovers per game are right at what Princeton opponents have averaged this season.

- Princeton averages 10 (10.3) of 27 (26.7) from 3-point range this season. Only Temple has made 10+ 3s against Yale this season, and the Owls won that one. Only Temple (31), Hartford (28) and last night Penn (27) have taken more than 22 3s against the Bulldogs this season, but Yale won the Hartford and Penn games.

- The Tigers have been bitten by the injury bug in a big way this season, losing a pair of starting senior forwards. Hans Brase was injured (knee) during the Nov. 29 game at VCU and was declared out for the season Dec. 11, and Henry Caruso played in the Dec. 10 win at Liberty and was declared out for the season Dec. 14 (toe). Brase, who missed last season due to another right knee injury, was Princeton's leading rebounder in 2014-15 (7.5 rpg) and Caruso was Princeton's leading scorer (15.0 ppg) and a first-team All-Ivy League pick a year ago.

- Princeton has settled in the 70s in the KenPom rankings of late, checking in 71st through Friday's (1/13) games. Yale is Princeton's highest-ranking remaining opponent in KenPom at 98 and is one of eight Tiger opponents in KenPom's top 125 along with BYU (61), Lehigh (102), VCU (47), California (44), Saint Joseph's (125), Monmouth (93) and Bucknell (112).

- Senior Spencer Weisz has been knocking on the door of a triple-double recently, netting 13 assists Dec. 10 at Liberty, getting 10 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists against Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14, and getting nine points, eight rebounds and seven assists Dec. 31 against Cal Poly. Princeton has never had a recorded triple-double.

- At Bucknell, Weisz surpassed the 300-assist and 500-rebound mark, becoming the third player in program history to have 1,000 points along with 500 boards and 300 helpers. Weisz stands at 1,070 points, 524 rebounds and 319 assists. The other two players are Kit Mueller '91 (1,546 points, 560 rebounds, 381 assists) and Ian Hummer '13 (1,625 points, 725 rebounds, 308 assists).

- ESPN's Jan. 12 bracketology had the Tigers as a 14th seed in the East in Greenville, S.C. against Duke. VCU, as a 9 seed in the West, was the only Princeton opponent from this season in that edition of the bracket.

- Heading into Friday's (1/13) games, Princeton led the Ivy League in turn-over margin (then +2.14, now 2.2), defensive rebound percentage (then .772, now .763), and 3s per game (then 10.2, now 10.3). Devin Cannady led the Ivy in free throw percentage (then .921, now .925), while Steven Cook led in steals (then 1.6/gm, now 1.5/gm). Yale led the Ivy in scoring margin (then

(then .392, now .399), 3FG pctg. defense (then .305, now .301), rebounding offense (then 37.5 rpg, now 37.9 rpg), rebounding defense (then 33.5 reb. allowed/gm, now 33.4 reb. allowed/gm), rebounding margin (then +4.0/gm, now +4.5/gm), assists/gm (then 17.8, now 17.5), assist/turnover ratio (then 1.4, now 1.4), offensive rebounds (then 11.4/gm, now 11.3/gm), and offensive rebound pctg. (then .332, now .338).

- Princeton traveled nearly 15,000 (approx. 14,801) miles before hosting their first Division I opponent in Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14, going to BYU, Lehigh, Lafayette, VCU, Hawaii for Cal and Hawai'i, and Liberty. Now, until their first Ivy League road trip on the first weekend of February, the Tigers won't leave New Jersey and eastern Pennsylvania, having to Bucknell and Monmouth and hosting Hampton, Cal Poly, Penn, Brown and Yale before the finals break takes up the second half of January.

- Princeton was in the top 10 percent of the nation (top 34) in five statistical categories at the end of last season: third in fewest fouls (503), sixth in fewest turnovers (331), 14th in 3s per game (9.7), 21st in scoring margin (+10.5 ppg) and 31st in 3FG percentage (.383).

- Princeton led the Ivy League at the end of last season in scoring offense (79.1 ppg, 39th nationally) in fewest turnovers, fewest fouls, defensive rebounds per game (26.93), fewest personal fouls per game (17.3) and 3s per game. Princeton's 79.1 ppg last season was the third-highest in program history and highest since the 1971-72 season, a program-record 79.69 points per game. The 1964-65 Final Four team averaged 79.69 ppg.

- Princeton is coming off its quadrennial foreign trip. The Tigers went to Italy in late August, spending two nights each in Rome, Florence, Bologna with a side trip to Venice, Vicenza and Cernobbio on Lake Como. Princeton played three games, starting by closing a 21-point fourth-quarter deficit to defeat Fortitudo Kontatto in Bologna, a second-division Italian team, 93-87 in overtime. Khyan Rayner hit a halfcourt buzzer-beater to send the game to OT. Next, Princeton faced ASD Pallacanestro Vicenza, winning that game 67-58 against a third-division Italian team. The Tigers closed the trip with an 84-80 OT loss to Junior Casale, another second-division Italian team. Princeton had 15 players on the trip, not including the freshmen, and 13, except Hans Brase and Elias Berbari, saw playing time. Among the Tigers on the Italy trip was Devin Cannady, who had also studied in Tanzania earlier in the summer.

- The Pete Carril coaching tree is going strong in the 2016-17 season. Seven current Division I head coaches played for and/or coached under Carril, including Mitch Henderson '98, Mike Brennan '94 (American), John Thompson III '88 (Georgetown), Chris Mooney '94 (Richmond), Sydney Johnson '97 (Fairfield), Brian Earl '99 (Cornell) and Bill Carmody (Holy Cross).

- #IVYMADNESS: The inaugural Ivy League men's and women's basketball tournaments will take place Saturday and Sunday, March 11-12, 2017, at the Palestra in Philadelphia. The top four teams will earn berths in the tournament, with the semifinals on Saturday and the championships on Sunday. All six games will be broadcast live on ESPN's networks. The winner of the regular season will be the Ivy League champion, and the tournament winner will receive the automatic NCAA tournament bid with the regular-season champion, if different, earning an NIT bid. The site past 2017 has not been determined.
