Tonight's Top Notes

• Princeton and Penn will meet for the 235th time Saturday as Ivy League play begins.

• Up Next: Princeton will host the first full Ivy weekend next Friday and Saturday when Brown and Yale visit for 8 p.m. starts each night. Both are doubleheaders with the women's team, with each women's game starting at 5:30 p.m.

• Princeton has the opportunity to equal its program-best winning streak against Penn. The Tigers have won the last five meetings against the Quakers and won six in a row four times, most recently from 1996-99.

• Princeton has not lost at home to Penn since Feb. 17, 2009, a streak of seven in a row and a perfect 5-0 in the Mitch Henderson era. It is the second-longest home winning streak against Penn in program history behind only a 13-game run from 1957-69.

• Penn returns 58 of its 71 points from the last time these teams met on Mar. 8, 2016 in Jadwin, with all 13 not returning belonging to the graduated Darien Nelson-Henry. Princeton returns 59 of its 72, with the 13 not back belonging to injured Henry Caruso. Penn outshot Princeton 50 percent to 40.6 percent, but the Tigers made nine 3s to Penn's six and outrebounded the Quakers 39-32. Princeton's 18 offensive rebounds contributed to the Tigers winning the second-chance points stat 23-6. Pete Miller had a game-high 10 rebounds and Nelson-Henry led Penn with eight.

• Princeton is 3-2 in Ivy League openers under Mitch Henderson, winning the last two and three of the last four. The Tigers have opened Ivy play against Penn the last four seasons.

• Penn is the only Ivy League series Princeton does not lead. The Tigers' have at least a 62-percent all-time winning percentage against every other team in the league.

• Mitch Henderson would have a better winning percentage against Penn than any other coach, if the Tigers win. At .800 (8-2) now, Henderson is even with Butch van Breda Kolff and J. Hill Zahn. Henderson is also two wins away from passing van Breda Kolff (eight) and Albert Wittmer (nine) for third-most wins against Penn among Princeton coaches. The top two spots belong to Cappy Cappon (22) and Pete Carril (27).

• Princeton and Penn have one common opponent this season, as both teams defeated Lafayette. Penn won 81-52 on Dec. 7, and Princeton won 71-55 on Nov. 23. It'll be Penn's second consecutive game against a Princeton-alum head coach, as the Quakers defeated Sydney Johnson '97 and Fairfield 74-68 on Dec. 30.

• With his next win, which would be his 104th, Mitch Henderson '98 will pass Butch van Breda Kolff '45 for fourth on Princeton's all-time coaching wins list. Henderson needs 13 wins to become Princeton's outright third-winningest coach in program history.

• Princeton is 30-5 against the Ivy at home under Mitch Henderson. With the Brown-Yale home weekend coming before the finals break, this will be the first time since 1996 that the Tigers will have played three Ivy games before finals. That year, it was also Penn, Yale and Brown before the break.

• Looking ahead to that first Ivy weekend, the Tigers are 25-5 in home

back-to-back Ivy weekend games under Mitch Henderson, including 13-2 in Fridays and 12-3 in Saturdays of home back-to-backs. Princeton is 16-14 in road games on back-to-back Ivy weekends under Henderson, including 9-6 in Friday games and 7-8 in Saturday games of such weekends.

- Under Mitch Henderson, the Tigers now have a 41-35 (.539) record in the pre-New Year portion of the schedule and a 62-24 (.721) record from Jan. 1 forward.

- Through Sunday's (1/1) games, Princeton has the second-most wins among New Jersey's eight Division I teams since Mitch Henderson took over at Princeton prior to the 2011-12 season. Princeton's 103 wins during that time are just two back of Seton Hall's 105.

- Through Sunday's (1/1) games, Penn ranked in the nation's top 10 percent in fewest turnovers (18th, 143) and fewest fouls (22nd, 208). AJ Brodeur's 2.18 blocks per game were 34th nationally. Princeton stood fifth in the nation in 3s per game at 10.8, 12th in fewest turnovers at 139, 13th in turnovers per game at 10.7, 20th in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.45, and 23rd in total 3s made at 140. Spencer Weisz was 21st in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.29.

- Princeton averages 11 (10.8) of 28 (27.5) from 3-point range this season. Two Penn opponents have made 10+ 3s in a game, with Villanova going 12 of 26 on Nov. 29 and Fairfield going 10 of 28 on Dec. 30. Those are also the two highest games for Penn opponent 3s attempted this season, and Penn fell to the defending NCAA champs 82-57 and beat Fairfield 74-68.

- The Tigers have been bitten by the injury bug in a big way this season, losing a pair of starting senior forwards. Hans Brase was injured (knee) during the Nov. 29 game at VCU and was declared out for the season Dec. 11, and Henry Caruso played in the Dec. 10 win at Liberty and was declared out for the season Dec. 14 (toe). Brase, who missed last season due to another right knee injury, was Princeton's leading rebounder in 2014-15 (7.5 rpg) and Caruso was Princeton's leading scorer (15.0 ppg) and a first-team All-Ivy League pick a year ago.

- Princeton got a slight bump in the KenPom rankings from the 29-point win over Cal Poly Saturday, moving up to 71st from 77th through Sunday's games. Yale is Princeton's highest-ranking remaining opponent in KenPom at 106 and is one of eight Tiger opponents in KenPom's top 125 along with BYU (57), Lehigh (89), VCU (51), California (47) and Saint Joseph's (103), Monmouth (84) and Bucknell (120).

- Senior Spencer Weisz has been knocking on the door of a triple-double recently, netting 13 assists Dec. 10 at Liberty, getting 10 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists against Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14, and getting nine points, eight rebounds and seven assists Dec. 31 against Cal Poly. Princeton has never had a recorded triple-double.

- At Bucknell, Weisz surpassed the 300-assist and 500-rebound mark, becoming the third player in program history to have 1,000 points along with 500 boards and 300 helpers. Weisz stands at 1,057 points, 517 rebounds and 314 assists. The other two players are Kit Mueller '91 (1,546 points, 560 rebounds, 381 assists) and Ian Hummer '13 (1,625 points, 725 rebounds, 308 assists).

- ESPN's Dec. 29 bracketology had the Tigers as a 15th seed in the East in Greenville, S.C., against North Carolina. Among Princeton opponents, VCU is an 11 seed in the East, Lehigh is a 14 seed in the South, and Monmouth is

a 13 seed in the Midwest.

- Heading into Monday's (1/2) games, Princeton led the Ivy League in scoring margin (+7.6), turnover margin (+1.92), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.5), defensive rebound percentage (.764), and 3s per game (10.8). Steven Cook led the Ivy in steals per game at 1.6, and Spencer Weisz led the league in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.3.

- Princeton has shot better than .400 from the field in 10 of 13 games this season and has done so from 3-point range in seven of the last 10 games.

- Princeton has two current players who have earned All-Ivy League honors during their careers: Spencer Weisz was the 2014 Ivy League Rookie of the Year and 2015 and 2016 second-team All-Ivy. Steven Cook was 2015 second-team All-Ivy and 2016 honorable mention All-Ivy.

- Princeton traveled nearly 15,000 (approx. 14,801) miles before hosting their first Division I opponent in Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14, going to BYU, Lehigh, Lafayette, VCU, Hawaii for Cal and Hawai'i, and Liberty. Now, until their first Ivy League road trip on the first weekend of February, the Tigers won't leave New Jersey and eastern Pennsylvania, going to Bucknell and Monmouth and hosting Hampton, Cal Poly, Penn, Brown and Yale before the finals break takes up the second half of January.

- Princeton was in the top 10 percent of the nation (top 34) in five statistical categories at the end of last season: third in fewest fouls (503), sixth in fewest turnovers (331), 14th in 3s per game (9.7), 21st in scoring margin (+10.5 ppg) and 31st in 3FG percentage (.383).

- Princeton led the Ivy League at the end of last season in scoring offense (79.1 ppg, 39th nationally) in fewest turnovers, fewest fouls, defensive rebounds per game (26.93), fewest personal fouls per game (17.3) and 3s per game. Princeton's 79.1 ppg last season was the third-highest in program history and highest since the 1971-72 season, a program-record 79.69 points per game. The 1964-65 Final Four team averaged 79.69 ppg.

- Princeton is coming off its quadrennial foreign trip. The Tigers went to Italy in late August, spending two nights each in Rome, Florence, Bologna with a side trip to Venice, Vicenza and Cernobbio on Lake Como. Princeton played three games, starting by closing a 21-point fourth-quarter deficit to defeat Fortitudo Kontatto in Bologna, a second-division Italian team, 93-87 in overtime. Khyan Rayner hit a halfcourt buzzer-beater to send the game to OT. Next, Princeton faced ASD Pallacanestro Vicenza, winning that game 67-58 against a third-division Italian team. The Tigers closed the trip with an 84-80 OT loss to Junior Casale, another second-division Italian team. Princeton had 15 players on the trip, not including the freshmen, and 13, except Hans Brase and Elias Berbari, saw playing time. Among the Tigers on the Italy trip was Devin Cannady, who had also studied in Tanzania earlier in the summer.

- The Ivy League has won five NCAA Tournament games in the last seven seasons. Cornell advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2010, Harvard beat New Mexico in 2013 and Cincinnati in 2014, and Yale beat Baylor in 2016. Princeton came within a buzzer-beating bank shot of adding to that in 2011, but Kentucky's Brandon Knight saved a 57-55 win, and Harvard fell to UNC just 67-65 in 2015.

- The Pete Carril coaching tree is going strong in the 2016-17 season. Seven current Division I head coaches played for and/or coached under Carril,

The top four teams will earn berths in the tournament, with the semifinals on Saturday and the championships on Sunday. All six games will be broadcast live on ESPN's networks. The winner of the regular season will be the Ivy League champion, and the tournament winner will receive the automatic NCAA tournament bid with the regular-season champion, if different, earning an NIT bid. The site past 2017 has not been determined.
