Tonight's Top Notes

- After the Tigers' longest in-season break since the 1942-43 season, Princeton will head to Dartmouth and Harvard Friday and Saturday. That season, Princeton visited Rutgers on Dec. 16, 1942 and picked it up again three weeks later at Seton Hall on Jan. 6, 1943. This break was one day shorter, as Princeton last played Jan. 14 against Yale and will resume 20 days later at Dartmouth.

- Up Next: Princeton will visit The Palestra Tuesday, Feb. 7, wrapping up the season series against Penn at the earliest time since 1992, when the second Penn game was on Feb. 4. It'll also be a chance for Princeton to record its first-ever seven-game winning streak in the series against Penn. It would also be just the fourth seven-game winning streak for any Ivy team over Penn. Columbia won eight in a row from 1929-33, Dartmouth won seven straight from 1939-42, and Yale has an active nine-game winning streak since 2013.

- Steven Cook is 27 points from 1,000 for his career. He would join Spencer Weisz as an active member of the 1,000-point club, and it'd mark the first time since the last month-plus of the 2011-12 season that Princeton had two 1,000-point scorers at the same time (Douglas Davis '12 & Ian Hummer '13). Cook would be the fifth player to reach 1,000 points under Mitch Henderson (Davis, Hummer, T.J. Bray '14, Weisz), and that would put Henderson alongside only Pete Carril as Princeton coaches who have had as many as five players reach 1,000 during their tenures. Carril had 14 during his 29-season career.

- Following the Penn game is Princeton's only home weekend of the month, as Cornell and Columbia come to Jadwin Feb. 10-11. Princeton has won 12 Ivy games in a row in Jadwin, with Yale, on Feb. 14, 2015, as the last home Ivy loss. The streak is Princeton's longest since winning 21 in a row from 2010-13.

- Princeton has won the last two and seven of eight at Dartmouth. At Harvard, the Crimson has won the last six over Princeton. Along with being the last time Princeton won at Harvard, 2010 is also the last time Princeton swept the Dartmouth-Harvard trip.

- Princeton swept Dartmouth last season with wins of 13 (at Princeton) and 19 (at Dartmouth). Princeton shot 53.8 and 53.7 percent from the field in those two games, hitting 13 and 12 3-pointers on the way to the wins. Evan Boudreaux had 17 points in the first game and didn't play in the second game, Taylor Johnson (13 in the first meeting) and Guillen Smith (11 in the second game) are the only other Dartmouth returners who had double-figure points against Princeton last year. Steven Cook had 27 points in each game against the Big Green last year, with Spencer Weisz (14 in the first game), Pete Miller (11 in the second game) and Amir Bell (10 in the second game) as the only other Tiger returners who had double-figure points against Dartmouth last season.

- In the first meeting between Princeton and Harvard last season, Princeton added up a 51.6 percent to 48.9 percent shooting edge from the field, 12 3-pointers, a 35-27 rebounding edge and 19 Harvard turnovers in an 83-62 win. In the rematch, Harvard flipped that to a 51.8 percent to 43.1 percent shooting edge, held Princeton to just seven 3-pointers, outrebounded Princeton 31-30 and cut the turnovers to 13. Zena Edosomwan didn't play in the first game for Harvard due to injury, but in the rematch, he scored

16 points and grabbed 14 boards. Agunwa Okolie went from 14 points and eight rebounds in the first game to 12 and 5, and Tommy McCarthy had 16 points in the first game and seven in the second. Along with Edosomwan, Patrick Steeves broke out in the second game, going 9 of 13 from the field for 25 points after going 2 of 5 for four points in the first game. Steven Cook had double-figure points in each game against Harvard last season (21, 16), as did Devin Cannady (14, 10), while Amir Bell had 14 in the second game.

- Amir Bell has heated up since the calendar flipped to 2017, going 14 of 19 from the field, 6 of 8 from 3 and 9 of 12 from the line to average 14.3 points over those three games after not reaching double figures in any of the team's first 13 games. Bell was 19 of 71 (.268) from the field and 3 of 25 (.120) from 3 over the first 13 games, and he's made a 3-pointer in five straight games after hitting one in one game of the first 11.

- During Princeton's six-game win streak, the Tigers have shot .473 from the field, limited opponents to .390 from the field, and shot .401 from 3-point range. During Princeton's 4-6 start, the Tigers shot .442 from the field, allowed .429 from the field, and shot .372 from 3. Princeton has also gone from a 2.5 rebound/game disadvantage after 10 games to a 6.0 rebound/game advantage during the streak. Princeton is also shooting better from the stripe, making 78.4 percent during the streak after standing at 66.9 percent after the first 10 games. Princeton has blocked 22 shots to 11 for its opponents during the streak after seeing foes block 35 Tiger shots to 18 Princeton blocks through the first 10 games. Finally, while the Tigers have maintained a similar scoring average during the streak (75.7 ppg) to the first 10 games (74.0), opponents' scoring average has dropped from 70.0 ppg to 57.8 ppg.

- Princeton hasn't played any of the same opponents as Dartmouth or Harvard yet this season, though the Big Green were felled by another Princeton alum-led team in Fairfield and Sydney Johnson '97, 79-62 on Nov. 15, and Harvard fell to Holy Cross and former Tiger coach Bill Carmody, 63-52, on Nov. 22.

- While Mitch Henderson has already passed two coaches on Princeton's all-time wins list since the start of the season, he'll have a little more time before jumping the next spot. After starting the season with 96 wins, Henderson (106) has since passed Frederick Leuhring (100) and Butch van Breda Kolff (103) to stand as Princeton's fourth-winningest coach with Albert Wittmer (115) in third.

- The Tigers are 27-5 in home back-to-back Ivy weekend games under Mitch Henderson, including 14-2 in Fridays and 13-3 in Saturdays of home back-to-backs. Princeton is 16-14 in road games on back-to-back Ivy weekends under Henderson, including 9-6 in Friday games and 7-8 in Saturday games of such weekends.

- Princeton is 33-5 against the Ivy at home under Mitch Henderson and 19-16 on the road.

- Under Mitch Henderson, the Tigers now have a 41-35 (.539) record in the pre-New Year portion of the schedule and a 65-24 (.730) record from Jan. 1 forward.

- Through Saturday's (1/28) games, Princeton has the second-most wins among New Jersey's eight Division I teams since Mitch Henderson took over at Princeton prior to the 2011-12 season. Princeton's 106 wins during that time are just one back of Seton Hall's 107.

- Through Saturday's (1/28) games, Princeton ranked No. 1 in the nation in fewest fouls (283) and fewest turnovers (169), and was top 10 percent in the nation in 3s per game (ninth, 10.1), turnover per game (10th, 10.6), and assist-to-turnover ratio (20th, 1.41),

- Through Saturday's (1/28) games, Dartmouth ranked ninth in the nation in fewest fouls (314), and Harvard's best ranking was 19th in blocks per game at 5.5.

- Princeton averages 10 (10.1) of 27 (26.5) from 3-point range this season. Dartmouth opponents have taken 20+ 3s in 7 of 12 games this season, but Longwood's 26 3s tried in an 86-80 Longwood win were the most tried against the Big Green this season. Harvard (13), Longwood (12) and Boston College (11) are the only teams to make 10+ 3s against Dartmouth this season, and all three opponents won. Six Harvard opponents have tried 20+ 3s this season with Boston College's 26 as the most. BC is also the only team to make 10+ 3s against Harvard this season, but the Crimson won that game, 74-66.

- Princeton was 80th in the KenPom rankings through Saturday's (1/28) games. The Tigers had six non-league opponents in the KenPom top 110, including VCU (45), California (60), BYU (72), Bucknell (89), Monmouth (91) and Lehigh (104).

- Senior Spencer Weisz has been close to a triple-double this season, netting 13 assists Dec. 10 at Liberty, getting 10 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists against Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14, and getting nine points, eight rebounds and seven assists Dec. 31 against Cal Poly. Princeton has never had a recorded triple-double.

- At Bucknell, Weisz surpassed the 300-assist and 500-rebound mark, becoming the third player in program history to have 1,000 points along with 500 boards and 300 helpers. Weisz stands at 1,080 points, 531 rebounds and 324 assists. The other two players are Kit Mueller '91 (1,546 pts., 560 reb., 381 ast.) and Ian Hummer '13 (1,625 pts., 725 reb., 308 ast.).

- ESPN's Jan. 26 bracketology had the Tigers as a 14th seed in the West in Indianapolis against Louisville. VCU, Among Princeton opponents, Bucknell was a 15th seed in the East, VCU was an 11th seed in the West, and Monmouth was a 13th seed in the South.

- Heading into this weekend's games, Princeton led the Ivy in scoring margin (+9.2), 3FG percentage (.382), turnover margin (+2.38), assist-to-turnover ratio (+1.4), defensive rebounding percentage (.764) and 3s per game (10.1). Dartmouth had the Ivy's top rebounder in Evan Boudreaux (9.2 rpg), who also led in defensive rebounds (7.1 drpg). Harvard had the Ivy's top scoring defense (64.4 ppg), FG percentage defense (.404), rebounding defense (32.7 reb allowed/gm), blocks (5.5/gm). Chris Lewis had the Ivy's top FG percentage (.659), Siyani Chambers was the top assist man (5.9/gm) and in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.2).

- The Tigers have been bitten by the injury bug in a big way this season, losing a pair of starting senior forwards. Hans Brase was injured (knee) during the Nov. 29 game at VCU and was declared out for the season Dec. 11, and Henry Caruso played in the Dec. 10 win at Liberty and was declared out for the season Dec. 14 (toe). Brase, who missed last season due to another right knee injury, was Princeton's leading rebounder in 2014-15 (7.5 rpg) and Caruso was Princeton's leading scorer (15.0 ppg) and a first-team

- Princeton traveled nearly 15,000 (approx. 14,801) miles before hosting its first Division I opponent in Saint Joseph's on Dec. 14, going to BYU, Lehigh, Lafayette, VCU, Hawaii for Cal and Hawai'i, and Liberty.

- Princeton was in the top 10 percent of the nation (top 34) in five statistical categories at the end of last season: third in fewest fouls (503), sixth in fewest turnovers (331), 14th in 3s per game (9.7), 21st in scoring margin (+10.5 ppg) and 31st in 3FG percentage (.383).

- Princeton led the Ivy League at the end of last season in scoring offense (79.1 ppg, 39th nationally) in fewest turnovers, fewest fouls, defensive rebounds per game (26.93), fewest personal fouls per game (17.3) and 3s per game. Princeton's 79.1 ppg last season was the third-highest in program history and highest since the 1971-72 season, a program-record 79.69 points per game. The 1964-65 Final Four team averaged 79.69 ppg.

- Princeton is coming off its quadrennial foreign trip. The Tigers went to Italy in late August, spending two nights each in Rome, Florence, Bologna with a side trip to Venice, Vicenza and Cernobbio on Lake Como. Princeton played three games, starting by closing a 21-point fourth-quarter deficit to defeat Fortitudo Kontatto in Bologna, a second-division Italian team, 93-87 in overtime. Khyran Rayner hit a halfcourt buzzer-beater to send the game to OT. Next, Princeton faced ASD Pallacanestro Vicenza, winning that game 67-58 against a third-division Italian team. The Tigers closed the trip with an 84-80 OT loss to Junior Casale, another second-division Italian team. Princeton had 15 players on the trip, not including the freshmen, and 13 (except Elias Berbari and Hans Brase) saw playing time. Among the Tigers on the Italy trip was Devin Cannady, who had also studied in Tanzania earlier in the summer.

- The Pete Carril coaching tree is going strong in the 2016-17 season. Seven current Division I head coaches played for and/or coached under Carril, including Mitch Henderson '98, Mike Brennan '94 (American), John Thompson III '88 (Georgetown), Chris Mooney '94 (Richmond), Sydney Johnson '97 (Fairfield), Brian Earl '99 (Cornell) and Bill Carmody (Holy Cross).
