The NCAA's FCS stats leaders page is dotted with single digit numbers next to Princeton and Harvard up and down the page, signaling that those two teams are in the top 10 nationally in a whole bunch of categories.

The number that matters the most for this week, though, is 3-0. As in, which of these two teams will come out of Saturday's game with a 3-0 Ivy League record.

Princeton and Harvard meet for the 112th time with a lot on the line for both beyond just the longtime rivalry. They are both heading into the weekend tied with Dartmouth atop the Ivy League standings at 2-0 and are both looking to position themselves to make a serious run for a championship.

Five storylines

Ivy standings

Each Ivy League team has played five games and has five games to play. There are three teams currently 2-0, the aforementioned Princeton, Harvard and Dartmouth.

The next three weekends will be something of a round-robin among them. After this weekend's Princeton-Harvard game, the Crimson will then host Dartmouth next Saturday before Princeton and Dartmouth meet at Yankee Stadium on Nov. 9.

National leaders

Princeton is in the top 10 in the FCS in 24 different stats. Harvard is in the top 10 in 10 different stats.

One of the stats in which they're both ranked in the top 10 is scoring offense, where Princeton leads the Ivy League and is second nationally at 43.8 points per game. Harvard is second in the Ivy League and 10th in the country at 38.6 points per game.

Individually, Harvard has four players in the top 10 in a statistical category. Princeton has two, but they're ranked in five different categories.

Collin Eaddy is sixth in the country in scoring, with 10.5 points per game. The other four are all quarterback Kevin Davidson, who is seventh in the country in passing yards per game (308.4).

He's also first in three pretty good ones to be first in: completion percentage, passing efficiency rating and average yards per attempt.

Block that kick

Back in the third quarter of the 2015 game against Columbia, Princeton had a punt blocked that turned into a safety in a 10-5 Tiger win.

Why bring that up now?

It was the last punt against Princeton to be blocked. Since then, Princeton has punted 154 times without having one blocked.

Harvard, in 2019, has been on the opposite end of that. The Crimson are a punt-blocking machine, with an FCS best five blocked punts in five games. In fact, Harvard has blocked five of the 34 punts its opponents have attempted. That's one block every 6.8 punts.

Streaking

Harvard lost its opener at San Diego but has won four straight since.

Princeton's last loss was in the 2017 season finale against Dartmouth. Since then, Princeton has won 15 straight, trailing only the 28 straight won by North Dakota State in the FCS.

The current winning streak is Princeton's longest since the 1964 and 1965 teams won 17 straight between them. The only longer streak than that in program history was the school record of 24 straight, a run that began in 1949 and lasted until 1952.

Sack exchange

Harvard leads the FCS in sacks, with 5.2 per game. Princeton is second in the league in fewest sacks allowed, at 1.20 per game.

That's six sacks allowed in five games, or less than one total sack allowed for half the season more than Harvard averages per game.

For its part, Princeton is second in the Ivy League (and 11th nationally) with 3.0 sacks per game. The progression of sacks per game by Princeton, though, suggests the Tigers are heating up in getting to the quarterback: 0, 2, 4, 4, 5. In other words, that was two sacks in the first two games and then 13 in the next three. Princeton also has nine sacks in two Ivy League games; Harvard has 11 in two league games.

Other notes

* Princeton and Harvard first met in 1877, when they split a pair of games. Princeton leads the all-time series 56-48-7.

* Princeton defeated Harvard 29-21 last year in Cambridge in one of only two games the Tigers played in their perfect season that was decided by fewer than two touchdowns and one of three that was decided by fewer than 35.

* Princeton ranks second in the Ivy League and fourth in the FCS in scoring defense at 13.0 points allowed per game.

* Princeton and Kennesaw State are the only FCS teams ranked in the top five in both scoring offense and scoring defense. The only other team ranked in the top 10 in both is North Dakota State.

* Jacob Birmelin leads the Ivy League with 31 receptions. A week ago against Brown, he had 12 receptions, including 11 in the first half, to become the 11th Princeton player with at least 12 catches in a game.

* Since the start of the 2018 season, Princeton has thrown 40 touchdown passes and five interceptions. Princeton has thrown 16 touchdown passes with two interceptions this year and threw 24 TD passes last year with three picks.

* Princeton ranks second in the FCS in fewest penalties and is first in fewest penalty yards. Princeton has also committed fewer turnovers than any FCS team, with just two.

* Ryan Quigley had three rushing touchdowns last week against Brown. He became the first Princeton player to run for three TDs in a game since ... Collin Eaddy one week earlier, against Lafayette.

* Kevin Davidson is the only player in Princeton history with two career games of at least five touchdown passes.

* Kevin Davidson has thrown for 1,542 yards in five games. Should he double that in the next five games, he'd become the third Princeton quarterback to reach 3,000 yards in a season (Chad Kanoff 3,474 in 2017, Doug Butler 3,175 in 1983).

* Kevin Davidson's completion percentage of 73.6 is the best in the FCS. The Princeton single-season record is 73.2, set by Chad Kanoff two years ago.

* James Johnson leads Princeton in tackles with 33; his older brother Tom led the team in tackles a year ago while earning first-team All-Ivy League honors Johnson is the only player on the team with more than 23 tackles, but five players – Jeremiah Tyler, Daniel Beard, Delan Stallworth, Samuel Wright, T.J. Floyd – have between 20 and 23.

* Princeton has scored 31 touchdowns in five games – 15 rushing and 16 passing.

* Princeton seniors Sam Johnson and Zach Kelly each scored his first career touchdown in the win over Brown.

* Princeton is celebrating the 150th anniversary of college football and its role in having played in the first game, back on Nov. 6, 1869, against Rutgers. In conjunction with the celebration, Princeton will be playing Dartmouth at Yankee Stadium on Nov. 9, three days after the anniversary.

- has coached six Bushnell Cup winners (Catapano, 2012; Epperly, 2013; Zeuli, 2014; Lovett, 2016/2018; Kanoff, 2017)
- coached Chad Kanoff to single-season Ivy League passing yardage record during 2017 season
- one of two people to win an Ivy League title as a player (1989) and head coach (2013, 2016)
- has coached 116 All-Ivy League honorees, including 37 first-team selections
- first-team All-Ivy League center when he led Princeton to the 1989 Ivy League title
- coached nine years in the NFL with the Cincinnati Bengals

Bob Surace '90, a four-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson Jr. National Head Coach of the Year award, has led Princeton football to three Ivy League championships in the last six years, including a perfect 10-0 season a year ago, the first perfect year for a Tiger football team since 1964. Princeton was ranked as high as #8 in the AFCA Coaches Poll last year, the highest it has been ranked since the Division I-AA/FCS level began in 1978. Princeton set an Ivy League record for total points (470) in a season and produced a defense that limited seven of 10 opponents to 10 points or fewer.

Previously, Surace led Princeton to both the 2013 and 2016 Ivy League championships. He was named a National Coach of the Year finalist after all three championship seasons, as well as a 2012 season that saw the Tigers break through from a 1-9 campaign to one where they were in the Ivy race until the final day of the season.

Surace was first named the Ivy League Head Coach of the Year

in 2016 after leading Princeton to the program's 11th Ivy League championship. His team led the Ivy League in scoring, total and rushing offense, as well as scoring, total and rushing defense. Princeton had two All-America honorees, the Ivy League Offensive Player of the Year, a finalist for Ivy League Defensive Player of the Year, and 18 All-Ivy League players. He won the award again after the perfect 2018 season, when 18 Tigers earned All-Ivy honors, and Princeton had both Offensive Player of the Year finalists in Jesper Horsted and eventual winner John Lovett.

That championship performance came three seasons after the memorable 2013 Ivy championship season, when Princeton set Ivy League records in both total offense and scoring offense. Princeton, which averaged 43.7 points per game, saw quarterback Quinn Epperly earn the Bushnell Cup as the league's Top Offensive Player.

Surace, in his 10th season at Princeton, has placed 116 players on the All-Ivy League teams throughout his tenure, and he has coached a Bushnell Cup recipient in six of the last seven seasons, the most for any coach in the Ivy League. He has seen a quarterback win the Offensive Player of the Year honors in each of the last three seasons — Lovett in 2016/2018, and Chad Kanoff in 2017.

Surace's wife, Lisa, was a four-time letterwinner in women's soccer at Princeton and is a member of the Class of 1992. She holds a Ph.D. in psychology and is now the Lower School Head at Princeton Day School.

They have a daughter, Alison, and a son, A.J.

Surace is part of one of the richest traditions in all of college football. Princeton was involved in the first college football game ever played on Nov. 6, 1869, and has played a total of 778 all-time games with an all-time winning percentage of .675 and five former head coaches in the College Football Hall of Fame: William W. Roper, Fritz Crisler, Tad Wieman, Charles W. Caldwell, Jr. and Dick Colman.
