### How Did We Get Here?

There was Princeton Saturday afternoon at Cornell, once again with a two-score lead into the fourth quarter. This time, though, if the score didn't make Tiger fans feel like things were safe, the defense certainly did.

Princeton threw a blanket around Cornell's offense all day and never let the Big Red back into the game. For that matter, the D didn't let Cornell into the end zone either. Add to that some big plays on offense, and the result was a 14-3 win for the Tigers.

Against Princeton, those offensive numbers three points and 330 yards. As far as those 330 yards go, 91 of them came on the first and last Cornell drives of the days, neither of which ended with points. In between, Cornell picked up 239 total yards on its other nine drives. That's winning defense.

What else is winning defense? No Princeton player had double figures in tackles, but six had seven, eight or nine. Marco Scarano, Nasir Hill, Ozzie Nicholas and Jack DelGarbino had nine each; Jalen Newman had eight and Liam Johnson had seven. Big Red QB Jameson Wang, who threw for 330 yards against Brown last week, was held to 26 for 42 passing for 234 yards (39 on that last drive) and one Mason Armstead interception.

Blake Stenstrom was 20 for 32 for 299 yards and the two scores, without an interception. Tamatoa Falatea caught five passes for 105 yards, and AJ Barber caught three for 62.

### Pretty Good Information You Should Know About:

9: Princeton's defense has allowed nine touchdowns in six games, the lowest in the FCS.

13: Princeton has had 13 different players catch a pass this season with Luke Colella leading the way with 31. Roman Laurio caught his first career pass at Cornell to make it 13.

19: The Tigers have not given up more than 30 points in 19 straight contests, dating back to Nov. 5, 2021 at Dartmouth.

54: Princeton's defense has allowed just 54 points this season, the lowest in the FCS.

He's 15th in the NCAA FCS in completions per game (21.86) and 29th in passing yards per game (229.6).

### Double Volker

John Volker's 329 rushing yards this season have more than doubled his career total (551 yards).

More than half his rushing yards (212) have come after contact.

He has forced 21 missed tackles this season.

### Doubling Up Wideouts

AJ Barber set a new career high with eight catches at Brown and 156 yards vs. Lafayette.

After registering eight catches for 84 yards in his first three games, Barber has 22 receptions for 397 yards in his last four games.

Barber's 298 yards combined vs. Lafayette and at Brown is the best two-game stretch by a Princeton wide receiver since Andrei Iosivas had 331 yards (Oct. 21/29, 2022) last year.

The junior has surpassed his career high in yards for a season with 481. 250 of those yards have come after the catch.

Luke Colella has crushed all of his personal marks with 31 catches for 354 yards and three touchdowns. Colella has at least three catches in each game including a season-best seven receptions at Columbia. His season-high 98 yards came vs. Harvard.

### Tackling Machine

Ozzie Nicholas's streak of 10 or more tackles in five straight games came to an end at Cornell when he registered nine stops. He was the first person to have 10 or more tackles in five straight games since Zak Keasey began the 2004 season with 10+ tackles in eight consecutive contests.

Nicholas is 22nd in the FCS in solo tackles per game (5.3) and 14th in total tackles (10.3). He has the fourth highest defensive grade in the PFF database among all FCS players (90.2) (min. 300 snaps).

## Alumni News

Andrei Iosivas was selected in the sixth round of the NFL Draft by the Cincinnati Bengals in April of 2023. He was the first Princeton player to be selected in the NFL Draft since Seth DeValve was picked by the Cleveland Browns in the fourth round of the 2016 draft (138th overall) and 16th Tiger overall. He caught his first career pass in the win over the Arizona Cardinals and caught his first career touchdown in the win over the Seattle Seahawks. He followed that after the team's bye week with another touchdown in the victory over the San Francisco 49ers.

Iosivas will go down as not only one of the all-time great Princeton wide receivers, but one of the all-time great Princeton athletes.

Iosivas was also 2022 NCAA All-American in the heptathlon at the indoor championships highlighted by the fastest 60m time (6.71). He was also a three-time Ivy champion in the heptathlon.

The senior captain, collected four All-American honors following his 2022 season after leading the Ivy League in receptions (66), receiving yards (943) and touchdown catches (seven) while being ranked ninth in the FCS in receiving yards and 14th in receptions per game (6.6). Iosivas ended his Princeton career with two All-Ivy selections and ranked sixth all-time in receiving yards (1,909), 12th in receptions (125), and third in touchdown catches (16).

Jesper Horsted '19 made the Las Vegas Raiders 53-man roster for the second straight season. In his fourth year in the NFL, Horsted has 13 catches and three touchdowns in 28 games. He has been active for one game for Las Vegas.

Stephen Carlson was selected to the Chicago Bears' 53-man roster prior to the team's contest vs. the Green Bay Packers. The former Tiger has played in 25 games, making six catches for 62 yards, adding a touchdown.

Henry Byrd is on the Minnesota Vikings' practice squad. Byrd was a Stats Perform FCS All-American in 2022 after helping Princeton post the Ivy's No. 1 passing offense and the No. 2 scoring offense. During his career, Byrd was a three-time All-Ivy selection including two first-team accolades in 2021 and 2022.

Matthew Jester was selected by the St. Louis Battlehawks in the XFL Draft in June. Jester was first-team All-Ivy in 2022 after leading Princeton in both tackles for loss (six) and sacks (three). He had sacks in Ivy League wins over Brown, Harvard and Dartmouth. The senior captain even got on the scoreboard this season, intercepting a conversion pass against Cornell and returning it for two points.

Jeremiah Tyler '22 finished his first season with the Houston Gamblers in the USFL in the Spring of 2023. In 10 games, Tyler had 51 tackles and five tackles for a loss for the Gamblers.

## Quick Hits

### Player News:

Jalen Travis was named to the 2024 Senior Bowl Watchlist, marking the second straight year that Princeton had a player on that list (Andrei Iosivas). Travis also was named to the East-West Shrine Bowl 1000 list like Iosivas was. Travis earned Stats Perform FCS Preseason Second Team All-America accolades. The senior captain was also selected as a semifinalist for the William V. Campbell Trophy. Each nominee must be a senior or graduate student in their final year of eligibility, have a GPA of at least 3.2 on a 4.0 scale, have outstanding football ability as a first team player or significant contributor and have demonstrated strong leadership and citizenship.

Liam Johnson was named to the Buck Buchanan Award Preseason Watch List for FCS Defensive Player of the Year. He was also named Stats Perform FCS Preseason Third Team All-American.

Nasir Cook was nominated for the AFCA Good Works Team. To be considered for a spot on the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, each player must be actively involved with a charitable organization or service group while maintaining strong academic standing.

Cook started a non-profit called the Nashville Youth Initiative, an organization that strives to increase cultural competence and awareness between law enforcement and youth by using athletics and academics to bring these groups together.

Maya Ana Callender, a former Princeton Football Director of Operations, was hired by the New England Patriots as a scouting assistant in May. According to ESPN, Callender is believed to be the first full-time female scout in Patriots' history.

John Volker's brother, Charlie '19, was a two-time All-Ivy running back who rushed for 1,994 yards, good for eighth all-time. Charlie also ran track and won an Ivy indoor 60-m dash title and was part of the Ivy-League record 4x100 relay squad. Currently, Charlie was on the U.S. Bobsled team in the 2022 Winter Olympics.

AJ Barber is the son of former New York Giants' running back Tiki Barber. Barber played 10 seasons in the NFL, rushing for 10,449 yards and 55 touchdowns.

Blake Feigenspan, Tamatoa Falatea and Christopher Paige all attended the same high school in Hawaii, the Punahou School.

Jack DelGarbino also wrestled for the Princeton wrestling team. His highlight win came against No. 3 ranked Tony Cassioppi of Iowa during the 2021-22 season. In high school, he set school record with a 163-13 record and 106 pins.

## BOB SURACE '90 - 13th Season THE CHARLES W. CALDWELL JR. '25 HEAD COACH OF FOOTBALL

**B**ob Surace '90, a four-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson Jr. National Head Coach of the Year award, has built Princeton football into a model FCS program in his 12 previous seasons as head coach, complete with four Ivy League championships, multiple NFL draft picks and players, Bushnell Cup winners and finalists and the program's first national first-team Academic All-America in more than 20 years.

Surace has a record of 77-50, including a record of 75-30 after a 2-20 start. He is one win shy of tying Steve Toches for second in Princeton history. He has led the Tigers to six seasons of at least eight wins; Princeton had five eight-win seasons in the 44 years prior to when he became head coach. Surace has had three athletic communications contacts while at Princeton. His best winning percentage is under Warren Croxton at .777, followed by Jerry Price at .525 and Craig Sachson at .505.

He has placed 162 players on the All-Ivy League teams throughout his tenure, and he has coached a Bushnell Cup recipient in eight of the last 10 seasons, the most for any coach in the Ivy League. He has seen a quarterback win the Offensive Player of the Year honors four times — Quinn Epperly in 2013, Lovett in 2016/2018, and Chad Kanoff in 2017 – and had and had four Defensive Players of the Year – Mike Catapano in 2012, Mike Zeuli in 2014, Jeremiah Tyler in 2021 and Liam Johnson in 2022.

The 2022 season saw Princeton go 8-2 and be in contention for the Ivy League title into the final week of the regular season. The Tigers had 16 All-Ivy selections tied for second-most at Princeton since 2013 while Liam Johnson was named the Bushnell Cup winner for Ivy League Defensive Player of the Year.

The 2021 season saw the Tigers go 9-1, securing the program's third Ivy League title in five seasons. Princeton had 16 All-Ivy selections including 10 first-team honorees, a program record. Surace's offense ranked first in the conference in scoring, second in passing offense and passing efficiency and third in total offense. The Tigers' defensive unit was one of the best in the NCAA FCS as it allowed the second fewest first downs, third in rushing defense, eighth in team sacks per game and ninth in total defense. Tyler was named Second-Team Stats Perform FCS All-America and the Bushnell Cup winner as the Ivy League Defensive Player of the Year.

Surace has led Princeton football to four Ivy League championships in the last nine playing seasons, including a perfect 10-0 season in 2018, the first perfect year for a Tiger football team since 1964. Princeton was ranked as high as No. 8 in the AFCA Coaches Poll in 2018, the highest it has been ranked since the Division I-AA/FCS level began in 1978. Princeton set an Ivy League record for total points (470) in a season and produced a defense that limited seven of 10 opponents to 10 points or fewer.

Previously, Surace led Princeton to both the 2013 and 2016 Ivy League championships. He was named a National Coach of the Year finalist after all three championship seasons, as well as a 2012 season that saw the Tigers break through from a 1-9 campaign to one where they were in the Ivy race until the final day of the season.

Surace was first named the Ivy League Head Coach of the Year in 2016 after leading Princeton to the Ivy League championship. His team led the Ivy League in scoring, total and rushing offense, as well as scoring, total and rushing defense. Princeton had two All-America honorees, the Ivy League Offensive Player of the Year, a finalist for Ivy League Defensive Player of the Year, and 18 All-Ivy League players. He won the award again after the perfect 2018 season, when 18 Tigers earned All-Ivy honors, and Princeton had both Offensive Player of the Year finalists in Jesper Horsted and eventual winner John Lovett.

That championship performance came three seasons after the memorable 2013 Ivy championship season, when Princeton set Ivy League records in both total offense and scoring offense. Princeton, which averaged 43.7 points per game, saw quarterback Quinn Epperly earn the Bushnell Cup as the league's Top Offensive Player.

A 1990 Princeton grad, Surace was a center for the Tigers, helping the team to the 1989 Ivy League title while winning first-team All-Ivy honors. He is one of two people to win an Ivy League championship as a player and a head coach.

Surace's wife, Lisa, was a four-time letterwinner in women's soccer at Princeton and is a member of the Class of 1992. She holds a Ph.D. in psychology and is now the Lower School Head at Princeton Day School. They have a daughter, Alison, and a son, A.J., both of whom are athletes themselves.
