

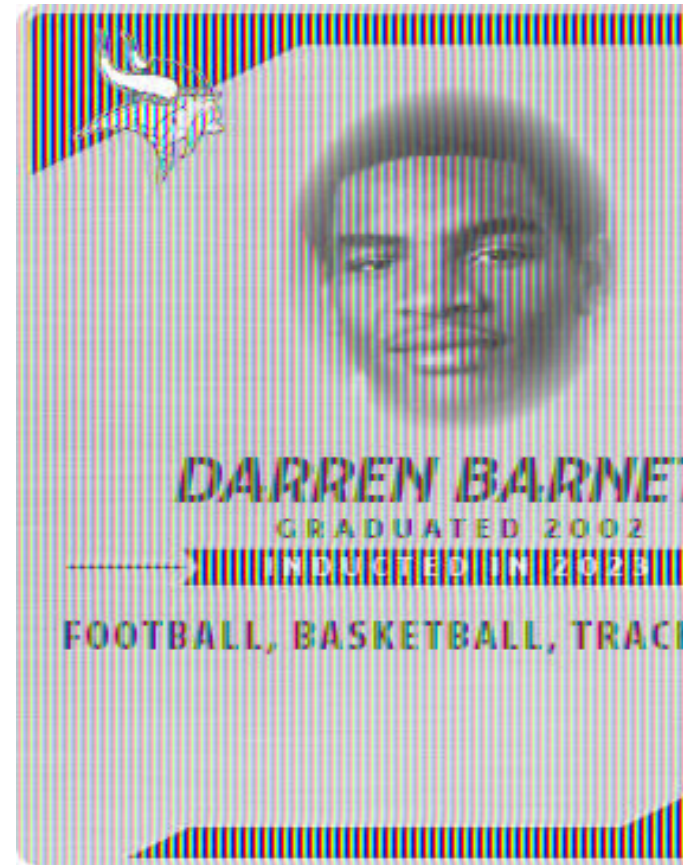

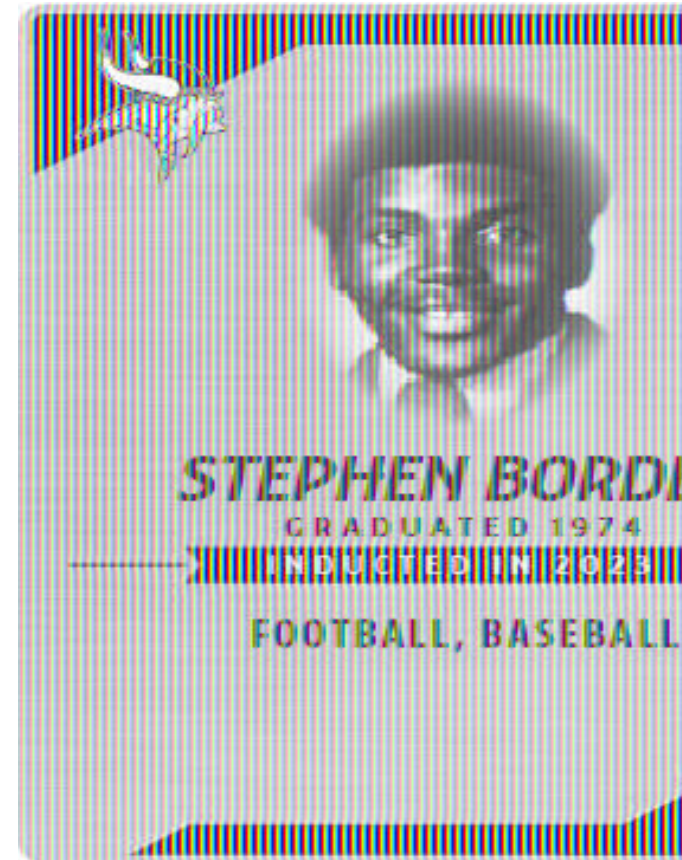
- **Standout in 3 sports: Football, Basketball and Track.**

Football, Baseball

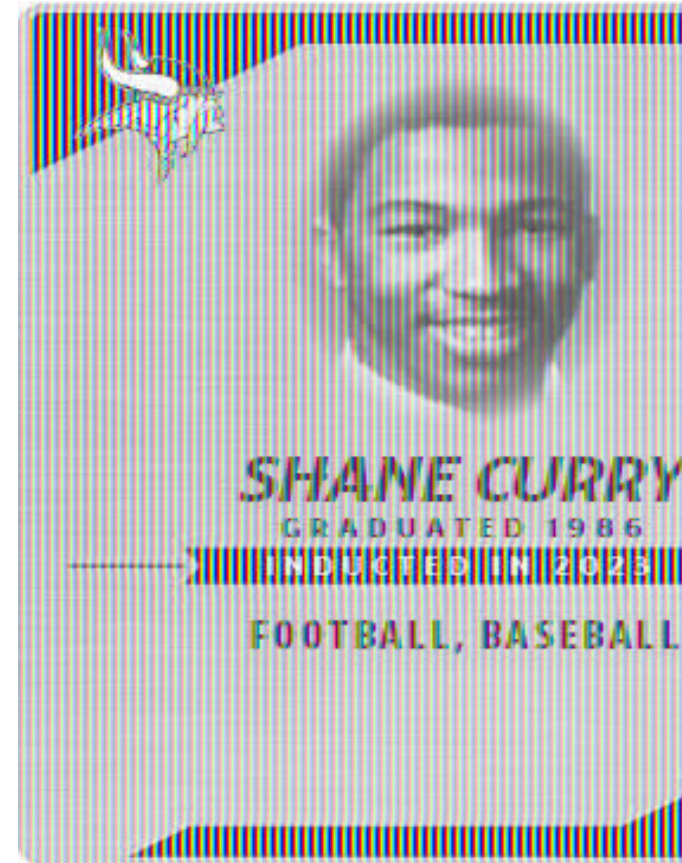
- ***6 Time Lettermen - 3 in Football, 3 in Baseball***

Football, Baseball

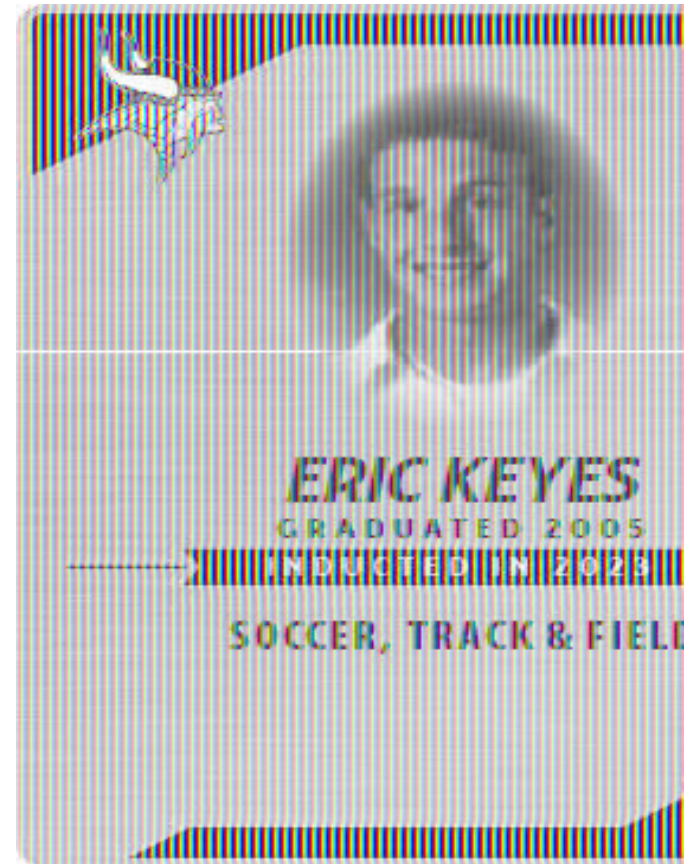
- **Standout in 3 sports: Football, Basketball and Track.**

Soccer, Track & Field

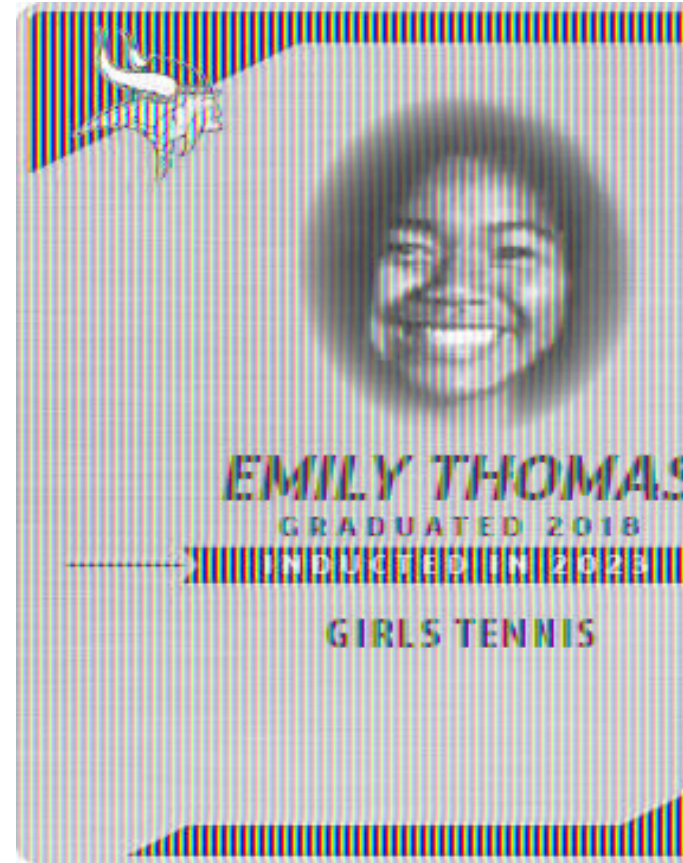
- ***Four year letterwinner in Soccer and Track & Field***

Girls Tennis

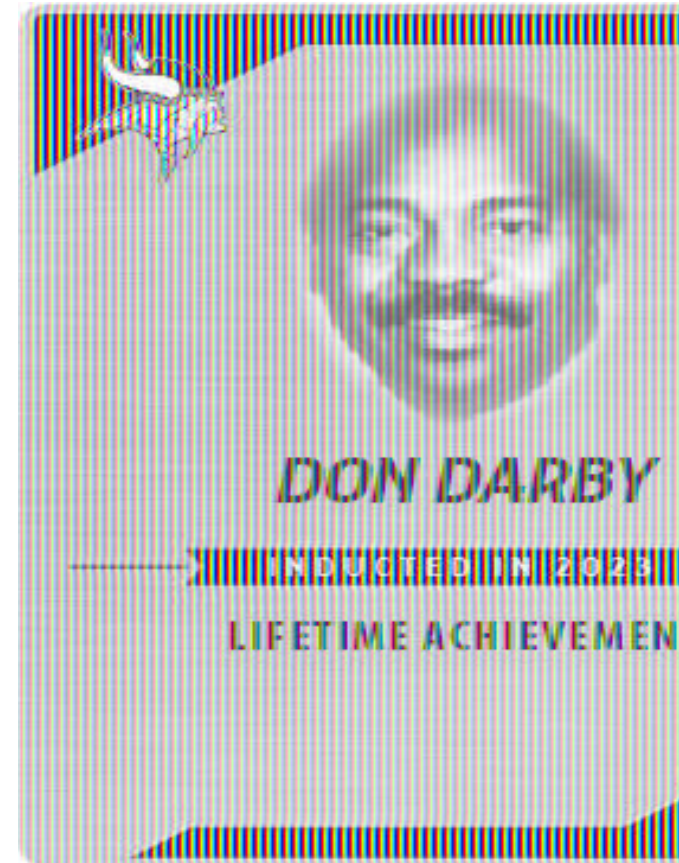
- ***Ranked #1 Female Tennis player in state of Ohio***
