Introduction

Rugby is my passion and I have dedicated most of my life to it.

Over the years I have gained a vast knowledge of the game through first hand experience, mentorship and studying the game. I have played the game as kid and have worked at all levels in the game from coaching 7 year old kids to professional players in different environments and different cultures as well as serving on committees and starting and running a club.

My coaching style is suited to leader positions where I can make decisions and be responsible for their outcome. I am very good at seeing the big picture and understanding the success factors of both human-, structural- and technical attributes of a team or programme. A person's character is what I value most and I see strong human relations as the primary factor for long term success. I have a wide array of tactical knowledge to solve most situations in the game as well as the technical knowledge to develop skills and structures that do not exist.



I grew up in a rugby mad family in a rugby mad country (South Africa) and started playing at the age of six. Despite being born with only one hand, I quickly established myself as one of the top players in my age group and was captain of my school teams until under 11 before an infection in my left leg stopped me playing for a number of years. I played half a season at u16 level before the infection came back and half a season at u18 before tearing my cruciate knee ligaments which ended my playing career.

I attended Stellenbosch University (world renowned for its rugby tradition). Here I got the opportunity to start my coaching career as an 18 year old. It started at a local high school and progressed to the my residence teams and then to the club sides. During this time I was blessed to rub shoulders with many top coaches, administrators and players, many of whom currently occupy top positions in South African rugby and around the world.

Stellenbosch was my home club and I returned there several times after stints elsewhere. I wrote the business plans for the academies both playing and referees which is currently run by the club alongside the Western Province Rugby Institute and the Sports Institute at the University. I helped to establish the Western Province Institute in its first year of existence where I worked as a technical assistant. On another occasion I went back and coached one of the Residence teams to their first title in 45 years of existence.

Outside of Stellenbosch and Western Province I have spent a season at Eastern Province where I worked as a Technical Assistant to the Professional team and worked with their Academy players at u21, u19 and u18 level.



My first overseas coaching experience was a 3 months stint (2001) at the Arlington Rugby Club in Texas as a guest coach while still at University. In 2012 I returned to the USA and spent 6 months with the Ventura Rugby Club in California.

In 2007 I went to Portugal for the first time and have spent 3 years there coaching professionally at 3 of the top clubs (Agronomia, Cascais and Belenenses). Here I worked with some of the country's top players on a daily basis and helped to develop youth structures in these clubs. Independently from these clubs, I established a rugby project in the Lisbon Metro dedicated to taking the game to areas without rugby and started a club for the players of the project to have the opportunity to play.

During 3 seasons at Los Troncos Rugby Club in Concepcion, Chile (2016-2018), the team made the semi-final (2018) and final (2020) of the national club competition. We also won the Centro Sur competition in 2017.

I am currently the head coach at Principia College in Illinois, USA. We won the D2 national title in 2022.


