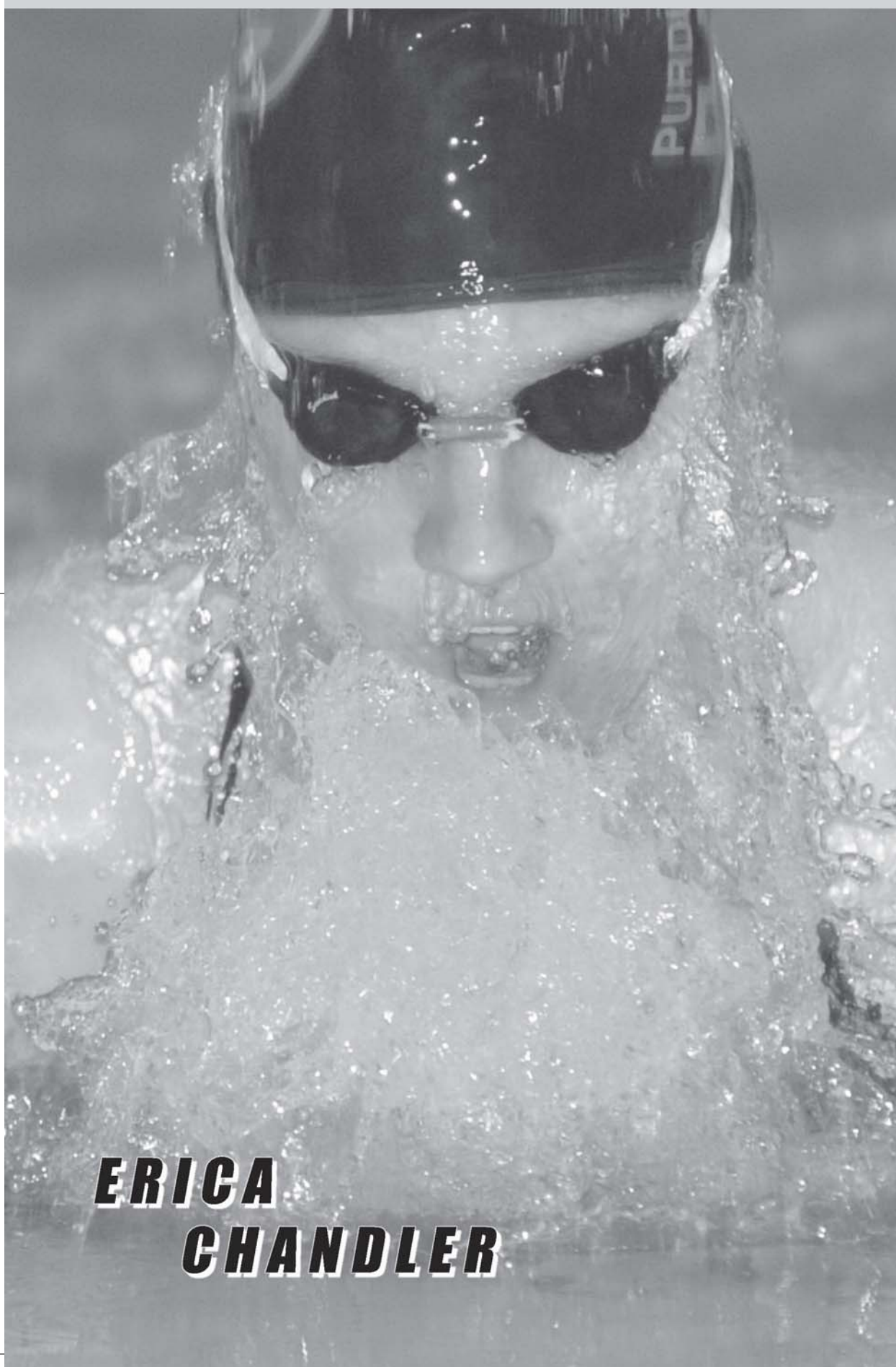

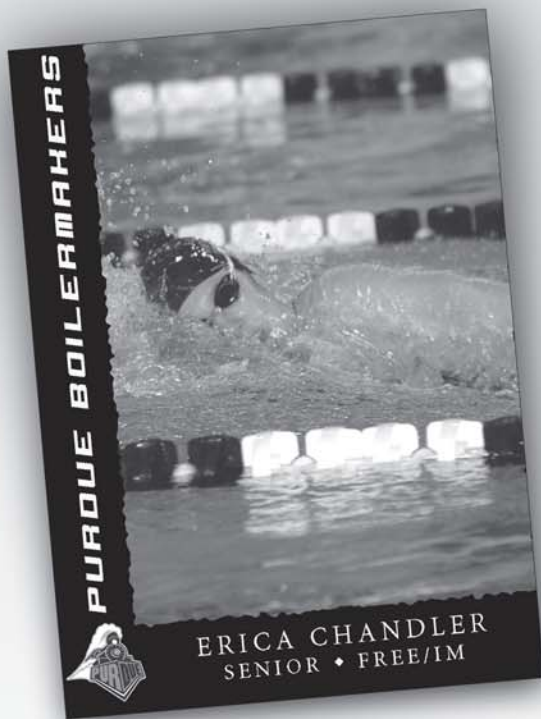

2004-05: Voted team co-captain with Carrie McCambridge for the 2005-06 season ... CSCAA Honorable Mention Academic All-American ... versatile swimmer who possesses the ability to swim any freestyle distance, both individual medleys and 200 backstroke ... helped 800 freestyle relay team establish new varsity record at Big Ten Championships with fourth-place time of 7:17.99 ... won two individual races at Northwestern and Michigan State duals ... winner of 200 back and 200 free titles in 168-75 victory over Spartans ... captured the 500 and 1,000 free crowns against Wildcats, propelling Boilermakers to 188-112 triumph ... placed first in the 200 free and 200 IM at the Indiana Intercollegiates ... posted season best times in the 200 free (:50.47), 1,650 free (17:05.19) and 200 IM (2:05.70) at the North Carolina-based Nike Cup ... 200 free time at Nike Cup placed her second to teammate Christine Leupold ... teamed with Lauren Willis, Katharine Telfer and Susan Hentschel to win Nike Cup's 800 free relay title in 7:25.86 ... just missed consolation finals of the 500 free at the Big Ten Championships with 17th-place prelim time of 4:57.08, which was a season best ... runner-up in the 1,000 free at Wisconsin, Minnesota, Illinois quadrangular with team and season best mark of 10:06.55 ... won 400 free relay vs. Indiana with Tracy Duchac, Katie Seleskie and Kimbre Vogel, finishing in 3:27.41.

2003-04: CSCAA Honorable Mention Academic All-American ... Academic All-Big Ten ... recipient of the team's Pride in Swimming and Diving award ... competed in 11 different individual events in addition to six relays ... recorded a varsity record time of 1:48.50 in the 200 freestyle during the preliminary round of the Big Ten Championships ... helped record a varsity record in the 800 freestyle relay along with Christine Leupold, Jenni Bean and Susan Hentschel at the conference championship meet ... the quartet finished the course in 7:18.64, which was good for fourth place ... Chandler's 200 split on the record-breaking relay was timed at 1:47.58 ... reached the finals of three races at the conference championships (200, 500, 1,650 free) ... placed seventh in the 200 free (1:48.62) ... captured ninth in the 500 free (4:49.12) and 15th in the mile (16:48.85) ... all of her conference marks were season and personal bests ... competed at the long-course meter U.S. Open in the 200 free (1:52.52), 400 free (4:55.24) and 800 free (9:05.68) ... posted NCAA provisional times in four events: 200, 500, 1,650 free and the 800 free relay ... was victorious against Miami (Ohio) in the 200 free (1:51.37), the 200 individual medley (2:07.37) and in the 200 breaststroke (2:24.03) ... grabbed two first-place finishes against Arkansas in the 500 (5:00.68) and the 1,000 free (10:08.70) ... recorded victories in the 1,000 free at meets against Iowa (10:14.03) and Michigan State (10:21.13).

2002-03: Three-time Big Ten scorer ... reached the finals of the 200 and 1650 free ... scored a seventh-place showing in the 200 free, clocking a time of 1:49.62 ... posted a personal best of 1:49.31 in the 200 free prelims ... placed eighth (16:48.21) in the finals of the 1650 free ... was only her second time competing in the 1650 ... finished 13th in the 500 free consolations, coming in at 4:53.31 ... collected at least two wins in all but two regular season meets ... scored three wins (200, 500 and 1,000 free) at the Cincinnati/Georgia Tech triangular ... completed the season with five wins in the 200 free, seven in the 500 free and three in the 1,000 free ... did not finish lower than first in either the 200 or 500 free until the very last regular-season meet of the season at the Minnesota quadrangular ... finished runner-up in the 1,650 free against Indiana (17:00.61) ... won the 200 free relay at Indiana Intercollegiates (1:38.19) with Katie Seleskie, Christine Leupold and Brandy Keever ... swam anchor for the winning 400 free relay team against Notre Dame (3:28.34).

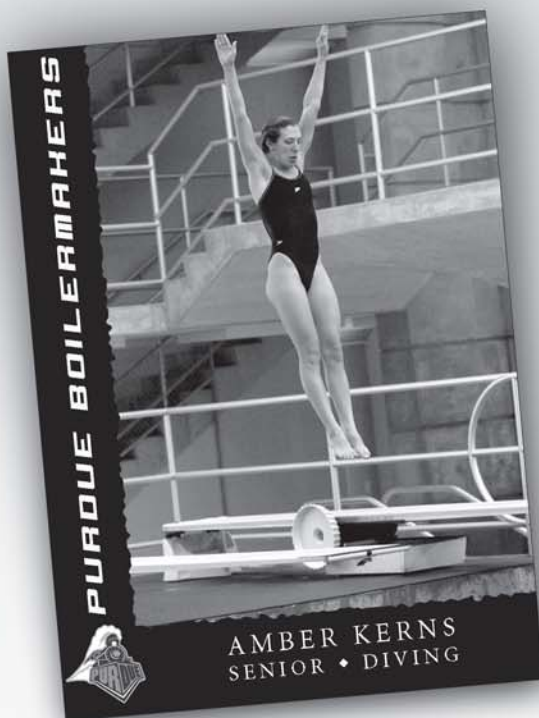

2003-04: Honorable Mention All-American ... is only the second diver in Purdue history to achieve All-America status (Nicole Zlotnik, 1992) ... earned her All-America citation after placing 12th off the three-meter springboard at the NCAA Championships ... finished with a composite score of 483.60 ... also at the NCAA meet, placed 34th off the 1-meter springboard (230.75) and 18th off the platform (352.70) ... enjoyed one of the single greatest individual Big Ten Championships, winning all three diving titles ... recorded a varsity and conference record mark of 321.80 (six dives) off the one-meter springboard ... also posted varsity-record scores of 544.35 (three-meter) and 413.50 (platform) at the conference championship meet ... in the platform competition, ended the prelim session in eighth place, moved up to fifth place after the semifinals and then captured first place during the finals ... is the first diver in team history to win a conference title off the diving boards ... her three conference titles are a program record, breaking the previous record of two titles held by swimmers Maureen Fahey, Kim Fritsch, Sally Johnson, Mary Street and Darlene Warta ... following the conference championship meet was named Big Ten "Diver of the Year" and "Diver of the Championships" ... placed among the top five off all three diving boards at the NCAA Central Regional Diving Zones ... finished third off the 1-meter springboard (530.55) ... was the runner-up off the 3-meter (497.65) and placed fifth off the platform (378.90) ... during the regular season, placed 12th off the 3-meter springboard (626.25) at the World Cup Diving Trials ... completed her stay at the U.S. Olympic Team Trials with a 12th place showing off the 3-meter springboard ... collected 458.34 points in the preliminary and semifinals of the 3-meter competition, clinching the last remaining spot in the finals ... in the finals, McCambridge scored an additional 270.42 points, giving her a cumulative total of 728.76 ... competed at the Speedo National Diving Championships and finished 21st in the quarterfinals off the 3-meter springboard (206.80) ... collected 12 victories during the regular season ... swept the 1 and 3-meter springboard events at meets against Iowa (276.83, 297.30), Miami (285.03, 293.65), Arkansas (286.50, 302.77), at the Indiana Intercollegiates (286.05, 292.50), and at a tri-meet against Georgia Tech and Florida Atlantic (270.30, 305.32) ... grabbed two first-place finishes at the Georgia Invitational off the 3-meter springboard (11), scoring a personal best of 536.70, and off the platform with a score of 392.65.

2004-05: Member of bronze-medal winning team at the World University Games ... reached finals of the 3-meter springboard, scoring an eighth-place finish of 493.02 ... Academic All-Big Ten ... placed fifth (275.46 points) with South Carolina's Allison Brennan in the synchronized 3-meter springboard competition ... CSCAA Academic All-America honoree ... selected team co-captain with Erica Chandler for this season ... voted team's most valuable player ... was Purdue's nominee for the Big Ten's Sportsmanship Award ... finished season as team's varsity record holder in five diving competitions ... was invited by USA Diving to compete at the World University Games ... at the U.S. Open, scored 683.61 points off the 3-meter and was seventh off the platform with 648.48 points ... winner of three All-America titles at NCAA Championships, the most ever earned by any Boilermaker in program history ... was the second-highest-scoring diver at the national championships, collecting 43 points ... finished seventh off the platform tower (417.65), fourth off the 1-meter (314.40) and third off the 3-meter (558.90) springboard ... qualified for her second straight NCAA Championship with pair of runner-up showings off the 1- and 3-meter springboards at the Region C diving zones ... was second off the 3-meter with mark of 546.10 points ... her score of 596.90 off the 1-meter established a new personal best ... third off the platform tower with 445.00 points ... the only non-Indiana Hoosier to score off all three boards at the Big Ten Championships, finishing as the runner-up off the 1-meter, seventh off the 3-meter and fifth off the platform ... her final platform total of 459.05 and 1-meter prelim score of 322.15 established new varsity records ... moved up to fifth place in the Big Ten platform competition after finishing eighth in prelims with 378.35 points ... winner of three Big Ten Diver of the Week certificates ... was honored on Feb. 1 after sweeping the springboard competitions at the Wisconsin, Minnesota, Illinois quadrangular, winning with scores of 306.50 and 524.10 ... won her second conference award on Nov. 23 for scoring 57 points at the Minnesota Invitational ... finished first off the 3-meter springboard (523.70) and platform tower (410.40), and was runner-up to Iowa's Lisette Planken off the 1-meter springboard by just 6.60 points ... winner of 12 diving titles during the regular season, never once finishing below third place at any dual meet ... at the talent-heavy Georgia Invitational, won the platform title with 407.35 points, was eighth off the 3-meter (447.60) and the runner-up in the 1-meter competition (257.75) ... went on to place fourth in the Georgia Invitational's Real Finals of the 1-meter, finishing with 257.75 points.

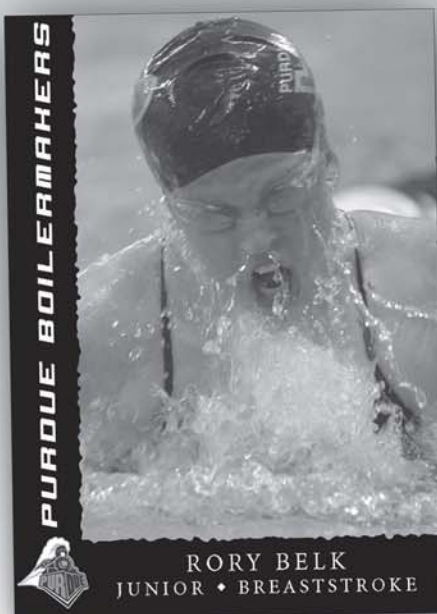
