### **#BOILERNOTES**

The Boilermakers opened their season with a win for the 36th time in program history Wednesday, posting a dominant 80-38 victory at Ball State. It marks the 12th season-opening win in 13 seasons under head coach Sharon Versyp and the fifth-largest road victory all-time for the Boilermakers. Dominique Oden led all scorers with 17 points, posting 15 in the second half, and was one of four Boilermakers in double-figures.

With Sunday marking the home opener for the Boilermakers as well, they boast a 40-2 all-time record in the first game of the season at Mackey Arena, including an 11-1 record under Versyp. Sunday is the first-ever meeting between Purdue and Harvard, making the Crimson the 197th opponent in Boilermaker history. Harvard is the second team from the Ivy League to face the Boilermakers, following a 70-66 win over Dartmouth in the opening round of the 2000 NCAA Tournament at Mackey Arena, and the fourth school from the state of Massachuetts. Purdue is 142-54 all-time in inaugural meetings.

Harvard opened its season Friday night at defending NCAA Champions and top-ranked Notre Dame. The Crimson fell to the Fighting Irish 103-58, with just two players in double figures and a 55-30 deficit on the boards

### **TEAM NOTES**

- Purdue is in its 44th season of women's basketball, holding a 844-466 all-time record
- The Boilermakers opened the season on the road for the third straight season and the fourth time in the last five years, earning an 80-38 win at Ball State
- Purdue is now 36-8 all-time in season openers, including a 9-6 record on the road and a 12-1 mark under Versyp
- The win was the fifth-largest road win in program history and the biggest since a 43-point win at Butler in 2006
- The opener is the 36th time Purdue has held an opponent under 40 points, remaining undefeated all-time when doing so, and the 44th time the Boilermakers have beat a team by 40 points or more
- Purdue pulled down 51 rebounds, it's most in the last two seasons, and the Boilermakers' 24 offensive boards were their most since securing 25 vs. Northwestern in 2014
- The Boilermaker bench chipped in 33 points, its highest mark since adding 54 points vs. Incarnate Word in 2015
- With a record of 20-14 last season, the Boilermakers logged their 25th 20-win season in program history
- Went 4-1 against the AP Top-25 in 2017-18, marking Purdue's most ranked wins 2006-07, and their best win percentage against ranked opponents (.800) since their 10-0 season in 1998-99
- The Boilermakers head into the 37th Big Ten Conference women's basketball season, having won seven regular season titles, including outright championships in 1991, 1999, 2001 and 2002
- Purdue has won a Big Ten Conference record nine postseason conference tournaments (24 total tournaments played since 1995), and has advanced to the Big Ten Tournament championship on 14 occasions
- The Boilermakers' 42 all-time Big Ten Tournament wins are the most of any conference school, and their .737 (42-15) win percentage is second-best of any team in the conference (Maryland)
- The Boilermakers set a program record, committing 13.4 fouls per game, good for No. 9 in the NCAA in 2017-18
- Purdue led the Big Ten and finished 18th in the NCAA with 175 blocked shots
- The Boilermakers' blocked shots total tied for the fourthmost in a season in program history
- Purdue returns the No. 8 sophomore scoring duo in the NCAA (No. 2 in the Big Ten) in 2017-18 as Dominique Oden and Ae'Rianna Harris combined to score 876 points, most by a pair of Boilermaker sophomores in program history
- Purdue owns an active streak of 28 consecutive wins when leading after three quarters, including a 17-0 mark last season, and last surrendered a fourth-quarter lead on Jan. 15, 2017 to 11th-ranked Ohio State
- The Boilermakers' four returning starters marks their most since the 2011-12 season, when they returned four as well - With Ae'Rianna Harris and Dominique Oden earning Preseason All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media, Purdue is one-of-two schools to have two players on both

### **HEAD COACH SHARON VERSYP**

- In her 13th season on the Boilermaker sidelines, Versyp now has the longest tenure of any coach in program history - She is the winningest coach in program history, owning 258 victories at Purdue
- Has nine 20-win campaigns in 12 seasons with the Boilermakers, and has won at least 20 games in 12 of 18 career seasons as a head coach
- Versyp is tied with Lin Dunn for the Boilermakers' career Big Ten Conference wins mark at 120 heading into 2018-
- Her 129 career Big Ten wins are ranked eighth in conference history, are third-most among active coaches and are seven wins shy of moving up to fifth all-time (136, Jim Foster, Ohio State)
- Her 22 career Big Ten Tournament victories are an event record, breaking the previous mark (shared by Jim Foster and Rene Portland) with Purdue's 2017 quarterfinal win
- She's led the Boilermakers to the Big Ten Tournament championship game six times in 12 seasons (four titles)
- Versyp has guided Purdue to a program-record nine NCAA Tournament appearances in 12 seasons
- The Boilermakers are 1-of-25 schools to make at least nine tournaments over Versyp's tenure as head coach, and 1-of-5 schools in the Big Ten Conference

### **#1 KARISSA MCLAUGHLIN**

- Opened her sophomore campaign with 14 points, five rebounds and a team-high four assists at Ball State
- Hit four 3's against the Cardinals, her sixth career game with at least four triples
- Earned 2018 Big Ten All-Freshman Team honors, becoming 10th player in Purdue history, fifth under Versyp and first Boilermaker since 2013
- Her 75 3-point field goals in 2017-18 are most-ever by a Purdue freshman, third-most in a season in Boilermaker history and second-most by a returning player in the Big Ten

- Averaged 7.5 points and 7.2 rebounds per game in 2017-18

- Put up 12 points, four assists and three steals at Ball State, hitting 6-of-6 at the free throw line
- Second Purdue freshman in as many years to score in double figures in their first career game (McLaughlin)

- 2018 Indiana Miss Basketball finalist
- McDonald's All-America nominee

### **#25 TAMARA FARQUHAR**

- Matched a career high with 13 rebounds in the season opener, including four on the offensive end

### **OPPONENT NOTES**

- Harvard comes to Mackey Arena for the first time and is the 197th opponent in program history
- Kathy Delaney-Smith is one of the longest tenured head coaches in the country, going into her 37th season with the Crimson and owning 585 career victories
- Harvard posted an 18-11 record in 2017-18, finishing third in the Ivy League at 10-4 and earning a bid to the WNIT, where they fell in the opening round to Fordham 65-47
- The Crimson return three starters from the 2017-18 squad, including leading scorer Katie Benzan who averaged 13.5 points and 3.8 assists per game as a sophomore and hit 45 percent from 3-point range
- Junior Jeannie Boehm averaged 9.5 points, a team-high 7.6 rebounds and 2.4 blocks per game last season
- Harvard was slated to return redshirt senior Taylor Rooks for the 2018-19 season, who was their secondleading scorer at 12.5 points and 7.3 rebounds per game, but the 2018 graduate transferred to Michigan, where she'll face the Boilermakers on Jan. 5
