#BOILERNOTES

The Boilermakers close out the non-conference schedule this week with two games in three days, starting today with the first-ever matchup in program history against the Albany Great Danes. Albany is the 199th opponent all-time for Purdue as the Boilermakers enter Wednesday at 143-55 in inaugural meetings, including a 1-1 split this season with Harvard and St. John's.

Purdue looks to bounce back after falling in Sunday's double-overtime thriller against South Carolina, going into extra time for the first time this season and suffering their first loss of the year in Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers rallied from a 10-point second half deficit, but couldn't hold off the Gamecocks down the stretch. Junior Dominique Oden and sophomore Karissa McLaughlin teamed for 44 points as Oden had her first career doubledouble with 19 points and 10 boards.

The Mackey faithful came out to the tune of 10,086 fans Sunday, marking the Boilermakers' highest attendance figure since 2012 and the No. 11 mark in the NCAA this season. The Boilermakers are 1-of-6 schools to welcome at least 10,000 to their arena in 2018-19.

TEAM NOTES

- Purdue is in its 44th season of women's basketball, holding an 850-470 all-time record
- The Boilermakers rank seventh in the NCAA in average attendance at 6,606 fans per game
- Purdue is the only school in the conference with two top-10 scorers as McLaughlin and Oden are tied for seventh at 15.5 points per game
- The Boilermakers rank eighth in the NCAA and are tied for first in the Big Ten with 58 blocks on the season, averaging 5.3 per game
- Purdue has done the bulk of its damage in the third quarter this season, averaging 20.5 points per game and outscoring opponents by an average of 5.5 points per game
- The Boilermakers' season-opening win at Ball State was the fifth-largest road win in program history and the biggest since a 43-point win at Butler in 2006
- Purdue had 16 steals against Ball State, its most since Nov. 28, 2012 vs. Georgia Tech in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge
- The Boilermakers cashed in 12-of-18 3's against Miami, marking the No. 6 single-game performance in the NCAA this season and tied Purdue's No. 7 single-game mark all-time
- Purdue blocked 12 shots at Ohio, tying for the third-most in a game in program history and the most since 2014
- St. John's was the second of three inaugural opponents on the Purdue schedule this season, and the Boilermakers are 143-55 all-time in first-ever meetings
- The Boilermakers' four returning starters marks their most since the 2011-12 season, when they returned four as well With Ae'Rianna Harris and Dominique Oden earning Preseason All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media, Purdue is one-of-two schools to have two players on both teams (lowa)

LAST TIME OUT

- The Boilermakers fell in double overtime to No. 25 South Carolina 82-73, succumbing to foul trouble in the extra sessions and losing their first home game of the season
- Purdue welcomed 10,086 fans to Mackey Arena, marking the Boilermakers' biggest home crowd since 2012, and the No. 11 attendance mark in the NCAA this season
- The Boilermakers are 1-of-6 teams in the nation to host a crowd of 10,000 or more this season
- Purdue overcame a 10-point second-half deficit and led by as many as seven in the fourth quarter, but were unable to close out just the eighth double-overtime game in program history

HEAD COACH SHARON VERSYP

- In her 13th season on the Boilermaker sidelines, Versyp now has the longest tenure of any coach in program history
- She is the winningest coach in program history, owning 264 victories at Purdue
- Has nine 20-win campaigns in 12 seasons with the Boilermakers, and has won at least 20 games in 12 of 18 career seasons as a head coach
- Versyp is tied with Lin Dunn for the Boilermakers' career Big Ten Conference wins mark at 120 heading into 2018-19
- Her 129 career Big Ten wins are ranked eighth in conference history, are third-most among active coaches and are seven wins shy of moving up to fifth all-time (136, Jim Foster, Ohio State)
- Her 22 career Big Ten Tournament victories are an event record, breaking the previous mark (shared by Jim Foster and Rene Portland) with Purdue's 2017 quarterfinal win over Indiana
- She's led the Boilermakers to the Big Ten Tournament championship game six times in 12 seasons (four titles)
- Versyp has guided Purdue to a program-record nine NCAA Tournament appearances in 12 seasons
- The Boilermakers are 1-of-25 schools to make at least nine tournaments over Versyp's tenure as head coach, and 1-of-5 schools in the Big Ten Conference

#1 KARISSA MCLAUGHLIN

- Joined the Boilermaker record books as the fifth player to hit 5-of-5 from 3-point range in a game, draining all five attempts against No. 21 Miami
- Leads the Big Ten and ranks 14th in the NCAA at the free throw line, converting 91.4 percent (32-35) this season and has cashed in 90.9 percent for her Purdue career (70-77)
- Scored a career-high 25 points twice this season first hitting the mark vs. St. John's, hitting 9-of-14 from the field and 3-of-7 from 3-point range, and scoring 25 again vs. South Carolina as she hit 10-of-12 at the free throw line
- Saw a streak of 19-straight games with a 3-point field goal broken vs. Purdue Fort Wayne, six shy of the school record
- Poured in 22 points vs. Western Illinois, hitting on 6-of-12 from the field, 4-of-7 from distance and 6-of-6 at the line
- The Boilermakers are 16-2 when she deals at least five assists in a game $\,$
- Has four games with at least four 3-pointers this season (Ball State, Western Illinois, Miami, Ohio), now owning eight career games with at least four
- Earned 2018 Big Ten All-Freshman Team honors, becoming 10th player in Purdue history, fifth under Versyp and first Boilermaker since 2013
- Her 75 3-point field goals in 2017-18 are most-ever by a Purdue freshman and third-most in a season in Boilermaker history

- Created an annual Special Olympics "Play Unified" event at Purdue, which has been held at Cardinal Court in Mackey Arena the last two years with students from across the athletics department and campus

#3 LYNDSEY WHILBY

- Shooting 46.2 percent from the 3-point line (6-13)
- Transferred to Purdue after one season at Texas Tech, where she averaged 7.2 points in 30 games and nine starts for the Red Raiders
- A three-time Georgia AAAAAA State Champion at McEachern High School

#5 CASSIDY HARDIN

- Started last Sunday's game vs. Loyola and the seasonopener at Ball State, becoming the second freshman in as many years to do so (McLaughlin)
- Hit 96 3-pointers as a senior at Center Grove High School, a school record and the fifth-most in a season in Indiana state history
- Made 260 career 3-pointers, good for eighth-most in state history
- McDonald's All-America nominee

#11 DOMINIQUE ODEN

- Coming off her first career double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds vs. South Carolina

- Matched a career high with four steals at Ball State
- 2018-19 Preseason All-Big Ten (Coaches & Media)
- Earned 2017-18 Second $\bar{\text{Team}}$ All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media
- Averaged 18.8 points over the final 15 games of the 2017-18 season, topping the 20-point mark nine times
- Led Purdue in scoring at 14.1 points per game, becoming the first sophomore to lead the Boilermakers since 2009-10

- Tied her career-best with 12 points vs. Western Illinois, hitting 4-of-6 from the floor and 4-of-5 at the free throw line
- Matched a career high with 13 rebounds in the season opener, including four on the offensive end
- Also tied career-high marks at Ball State for steals, three, and assists two
- Started 17-of-34 games as a freshman, becoming one of five rookie starters for Versyp's career
- Set top-10 Purdue freshman marks for rebounding (163) and blocked shots (28)
- Along with Dawson College teammate Léony Boudreau, they are the first two Canadian players in Purdue women's basketball history

#30 NYAGOA GONY

- Tallied five points, nine rebounds and a pair of blocked shots in her collegaite debut, playing 16 minutes


